FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a first alternate embodiment of a table showing my new design;


FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the first alternate embodiment; and


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the first alternate embodiment.

The right and left side elevational views of the table are substantially identical to the front elevational views of FIGS. 2 and 5, respectively.


