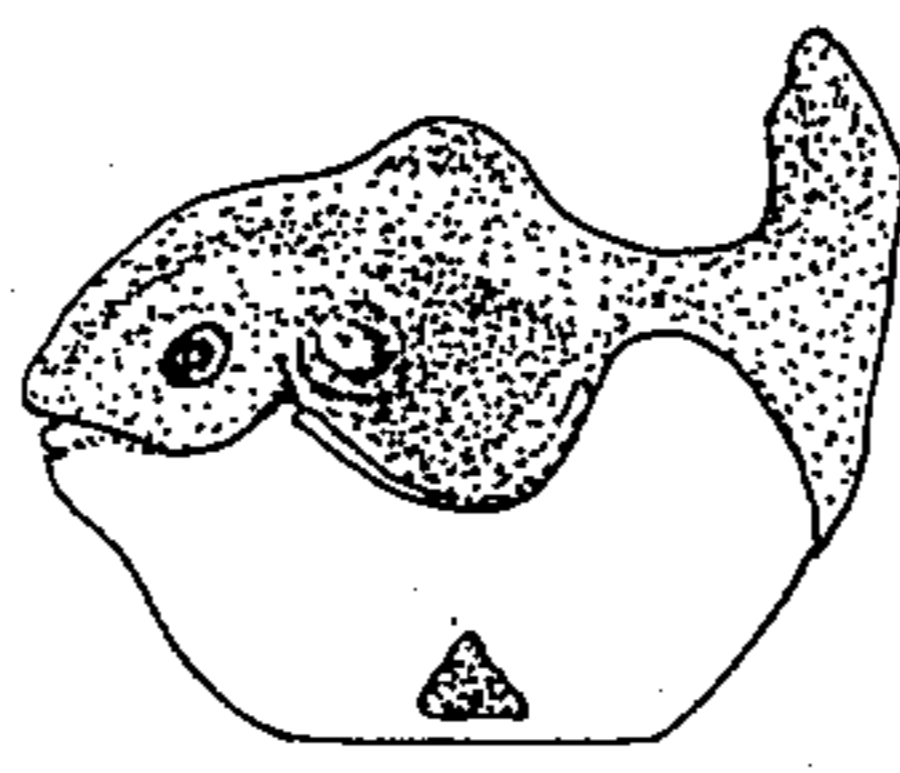
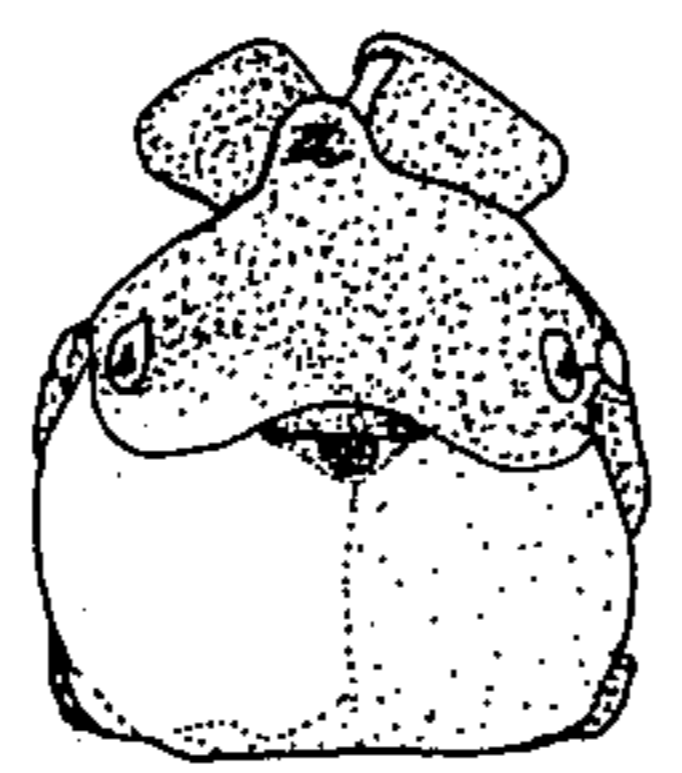

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.



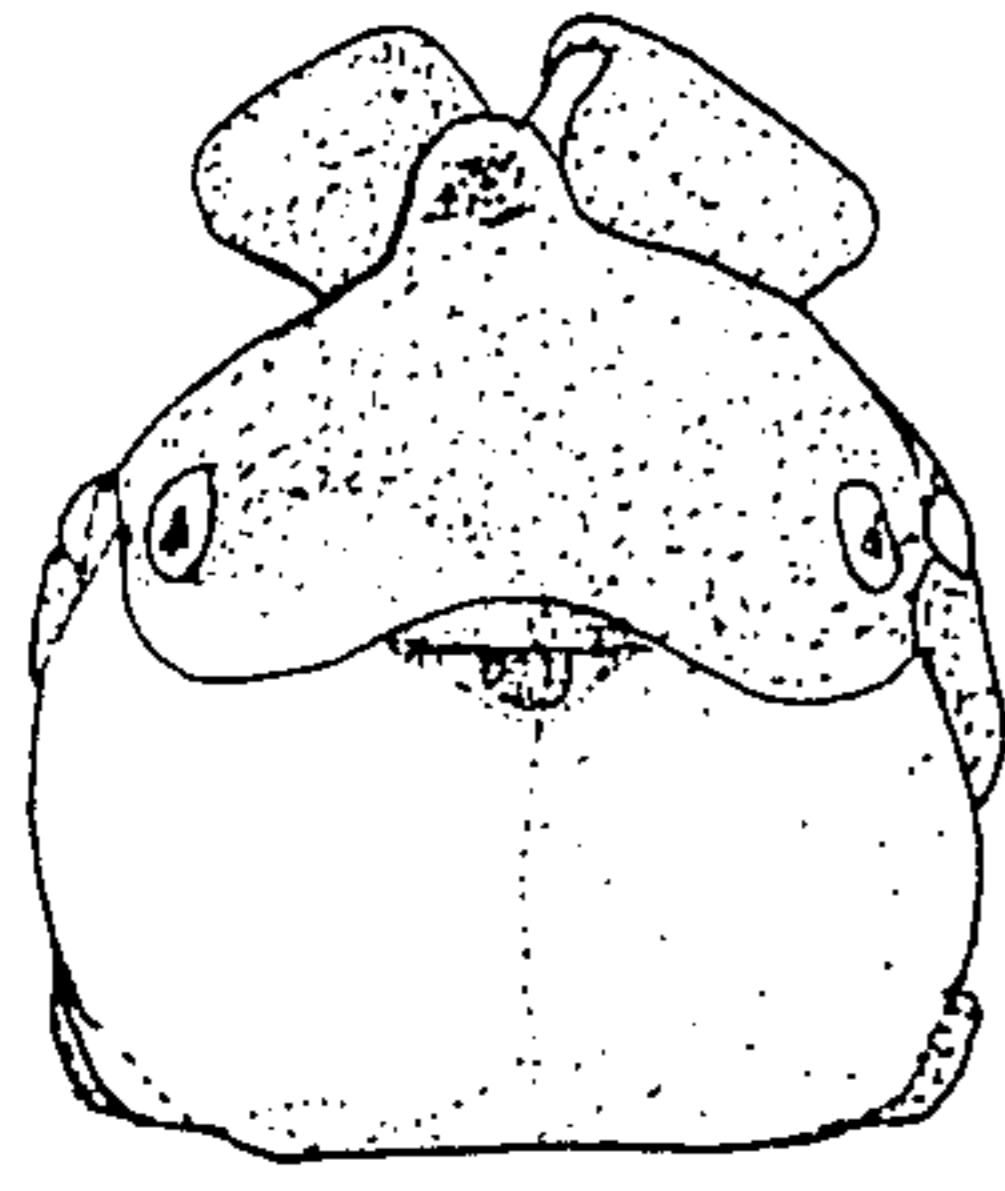

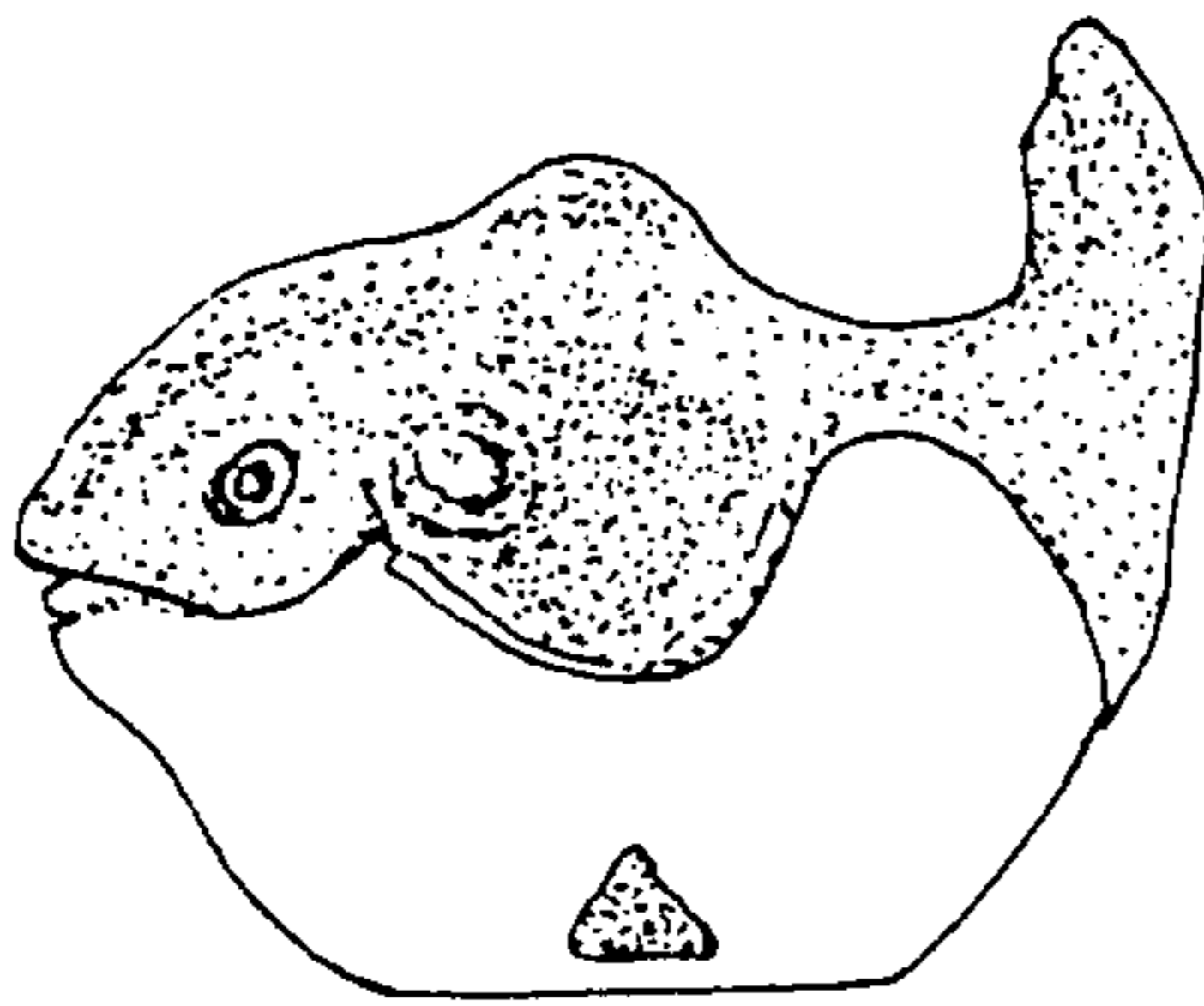

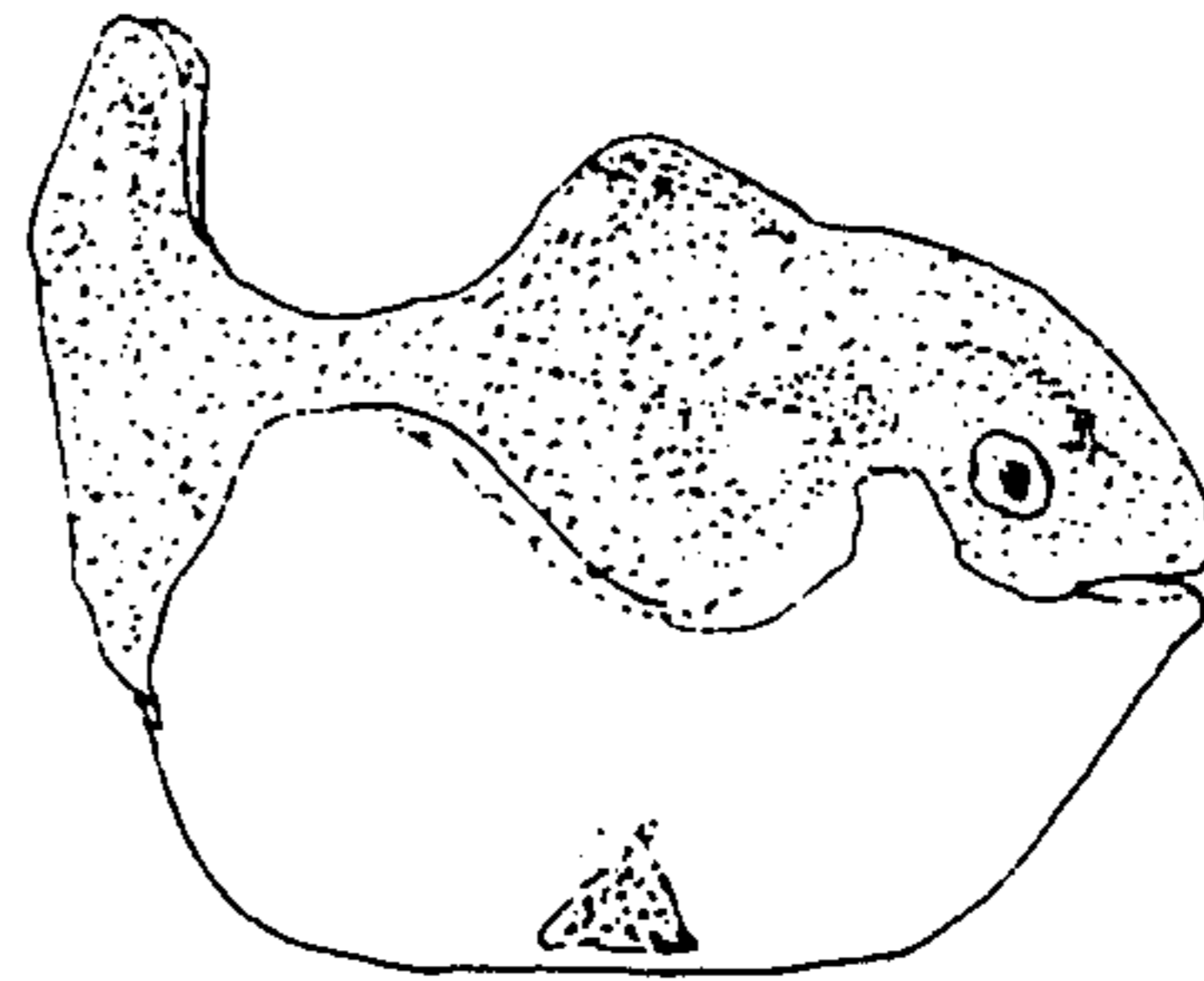
