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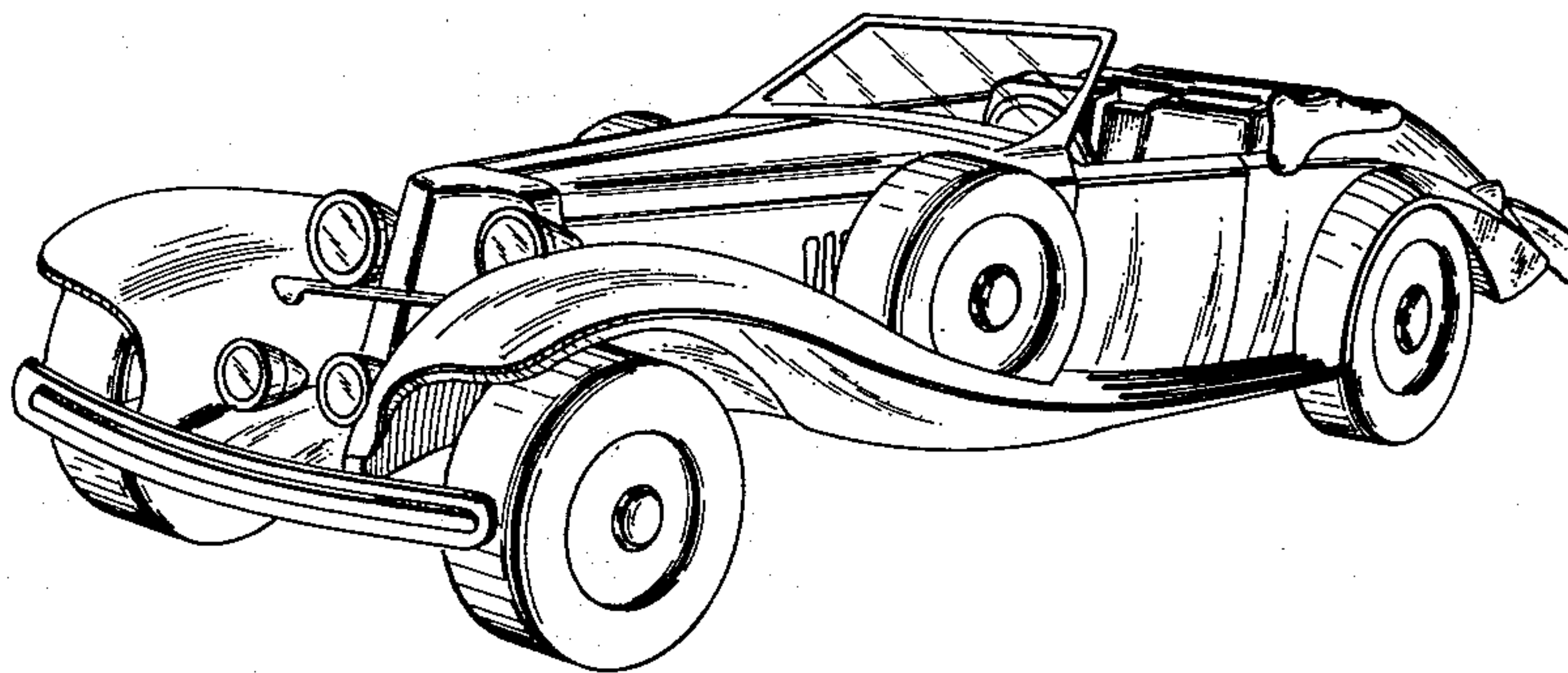

FIG. 8 is another front perspective view thereof, with the design in an extended position.



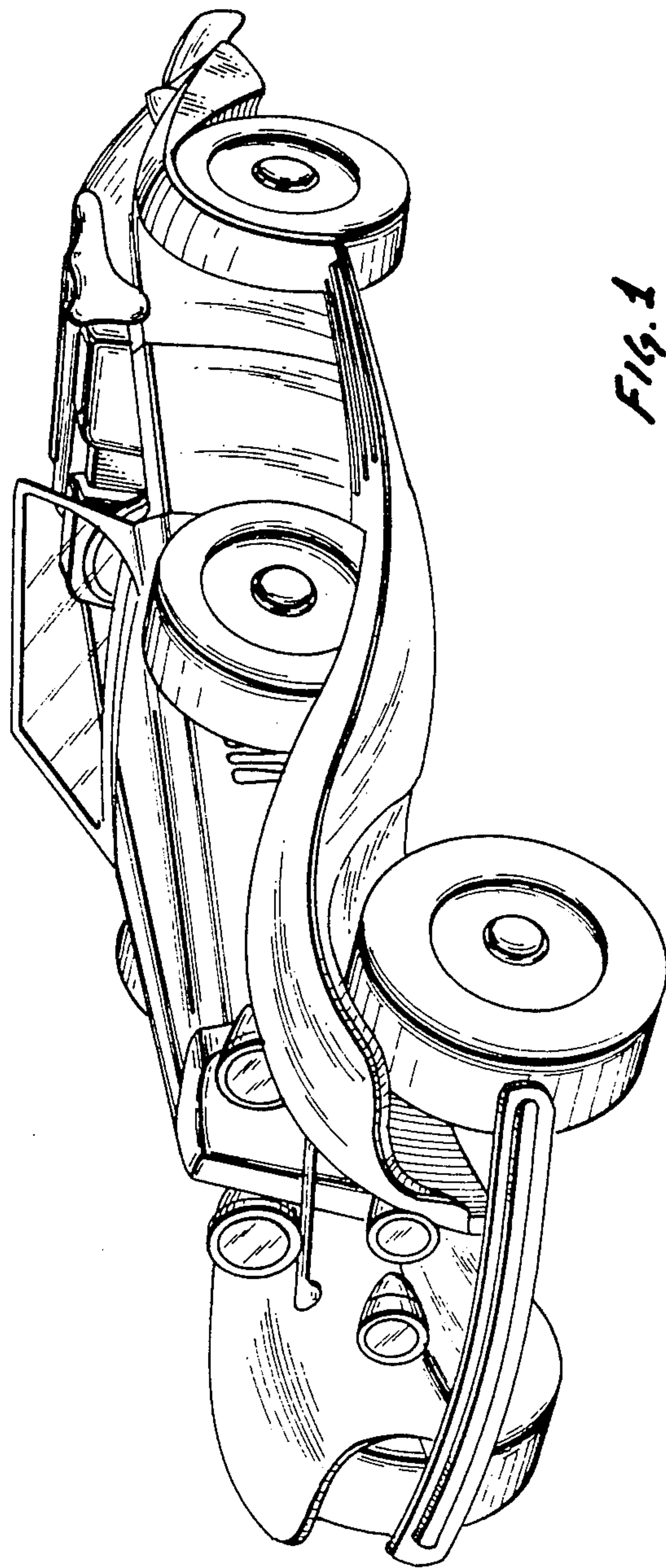

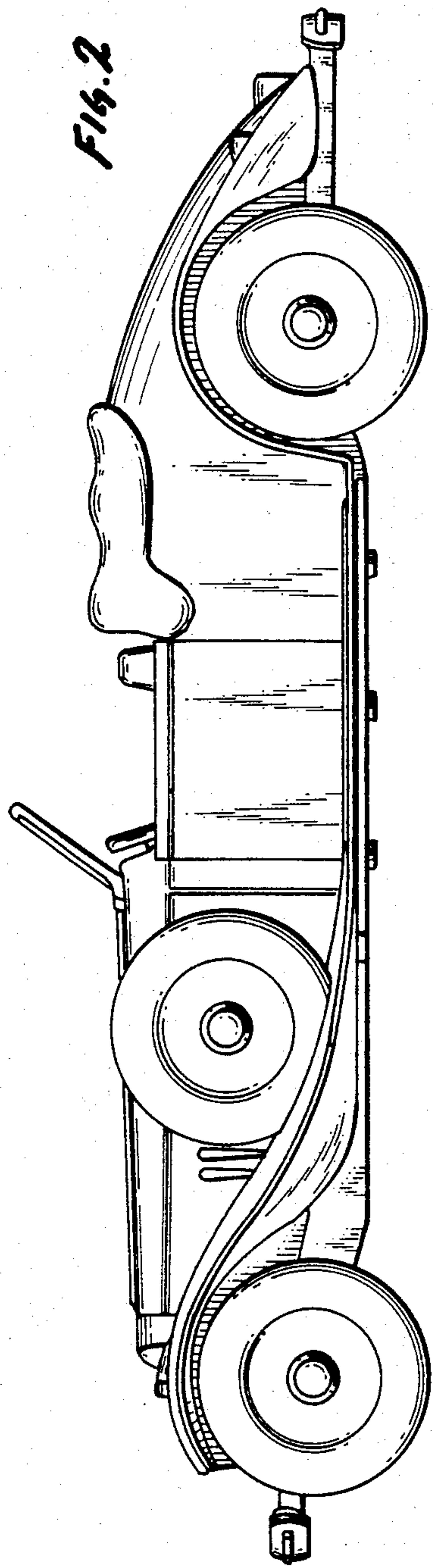
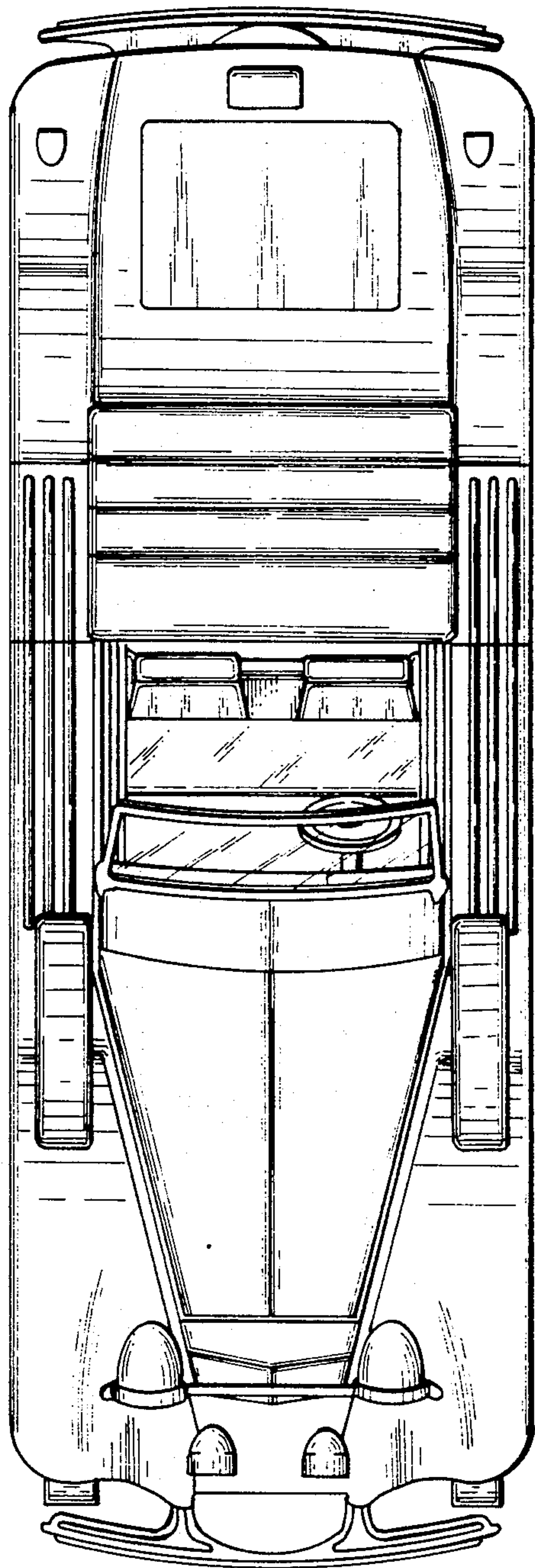

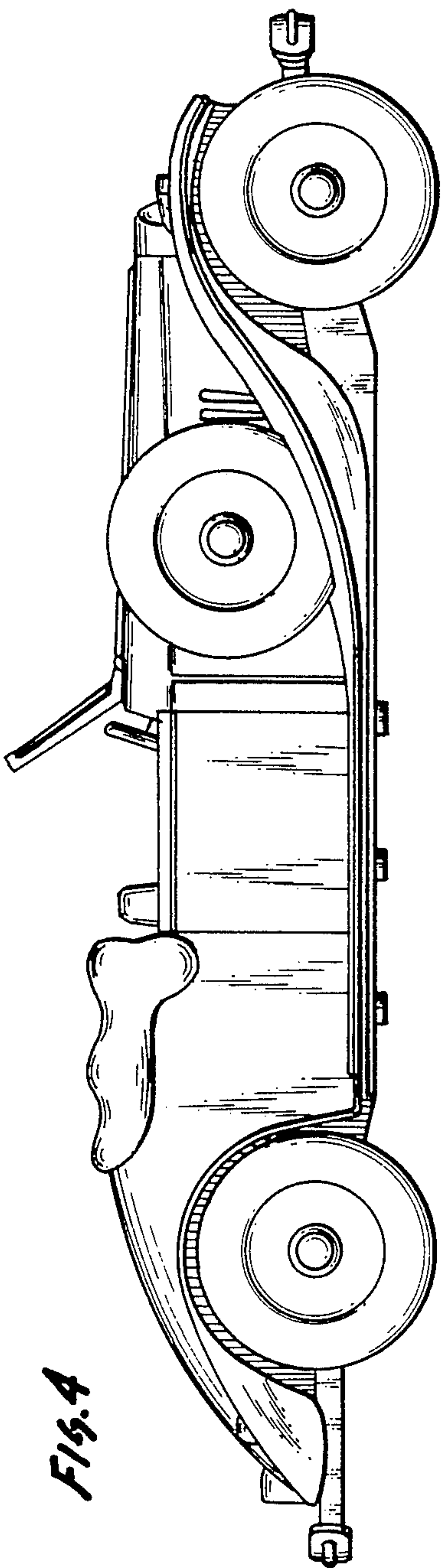

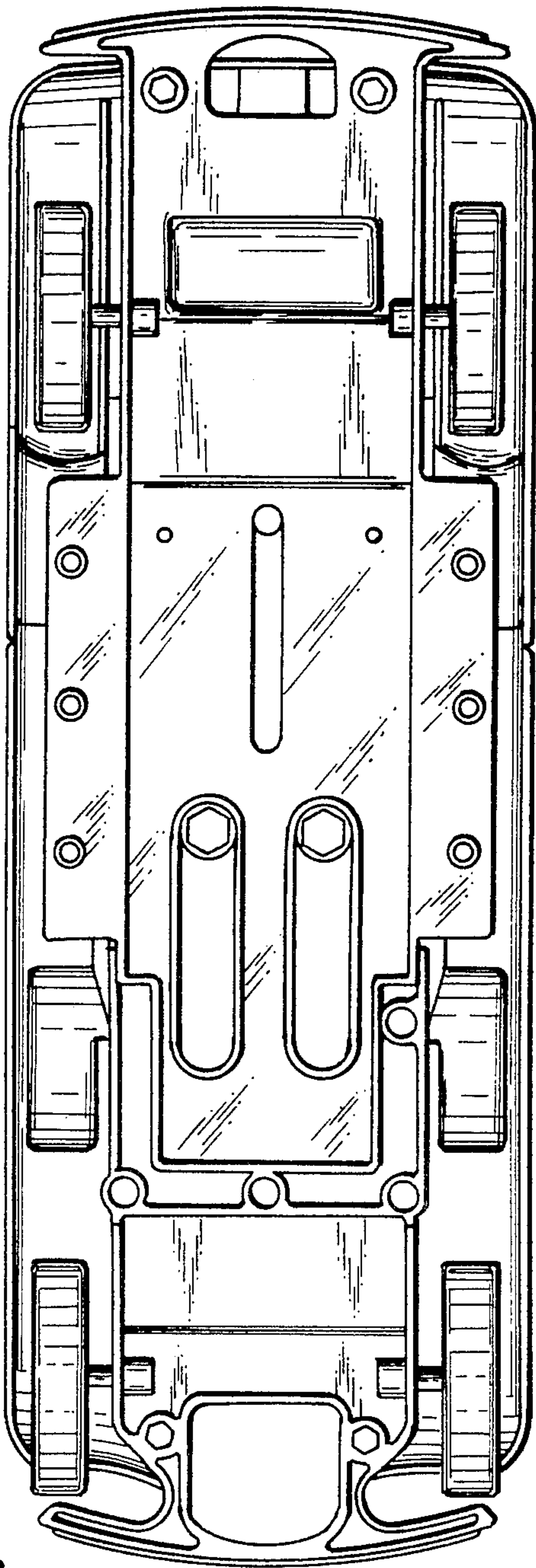

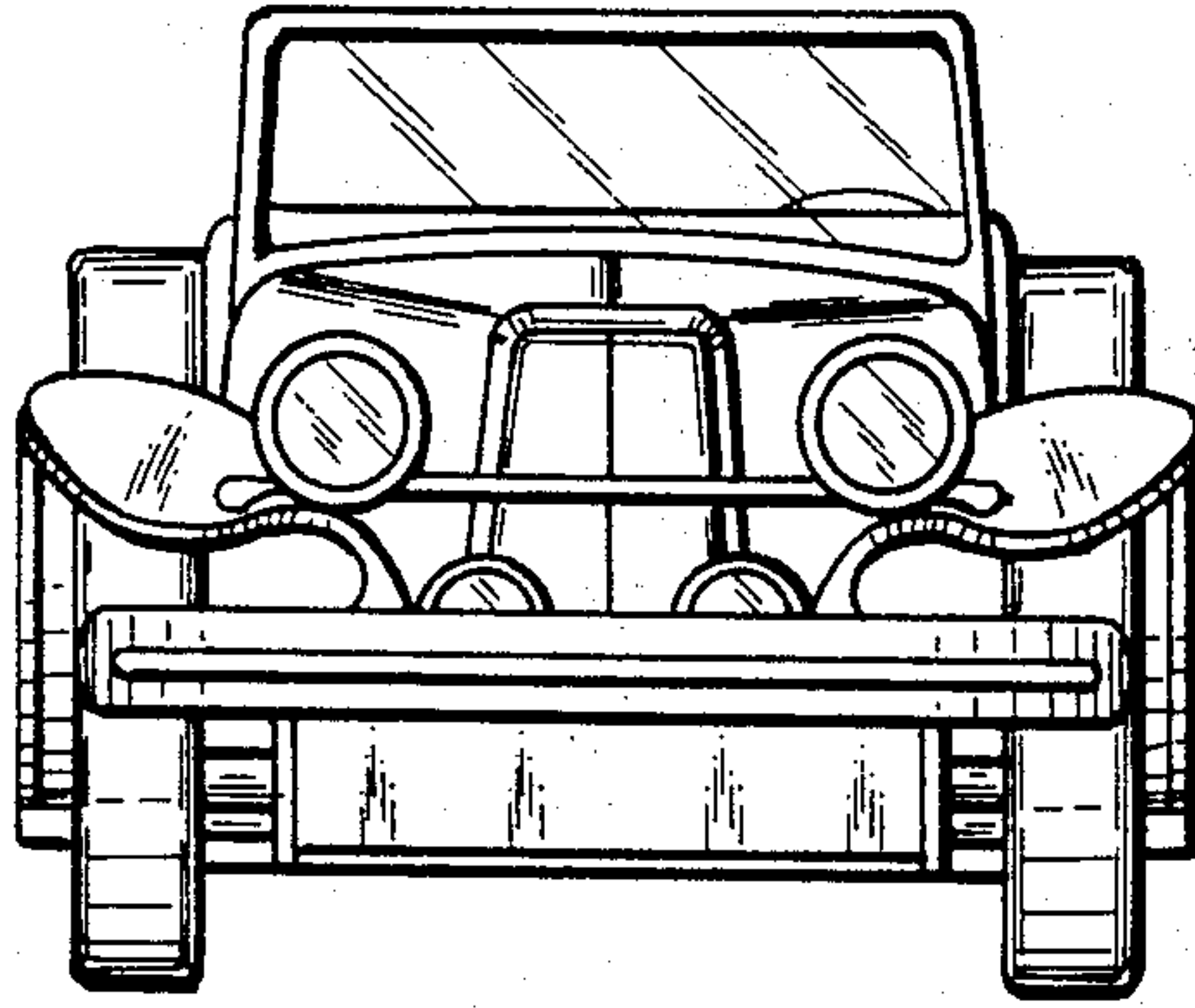

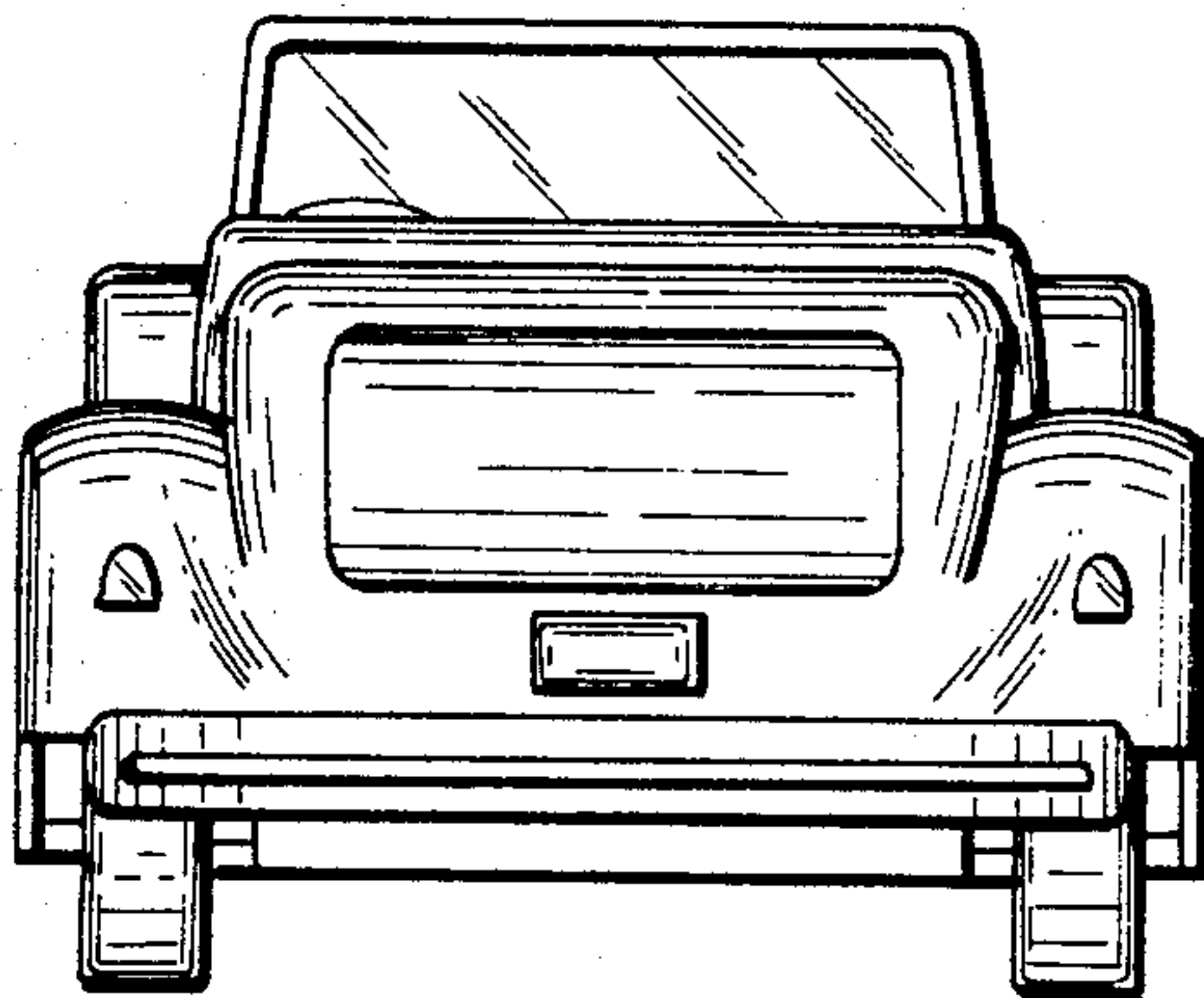

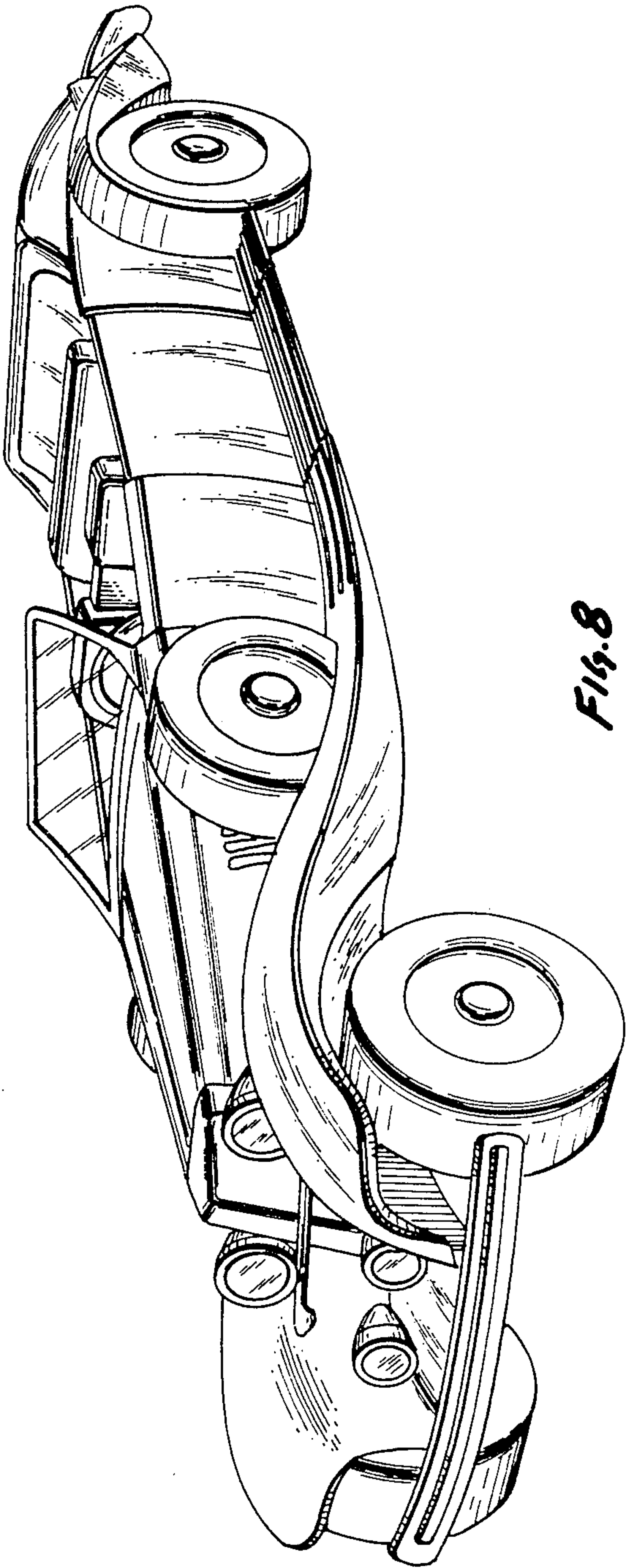
