FIG. 6 is a right view thereof.

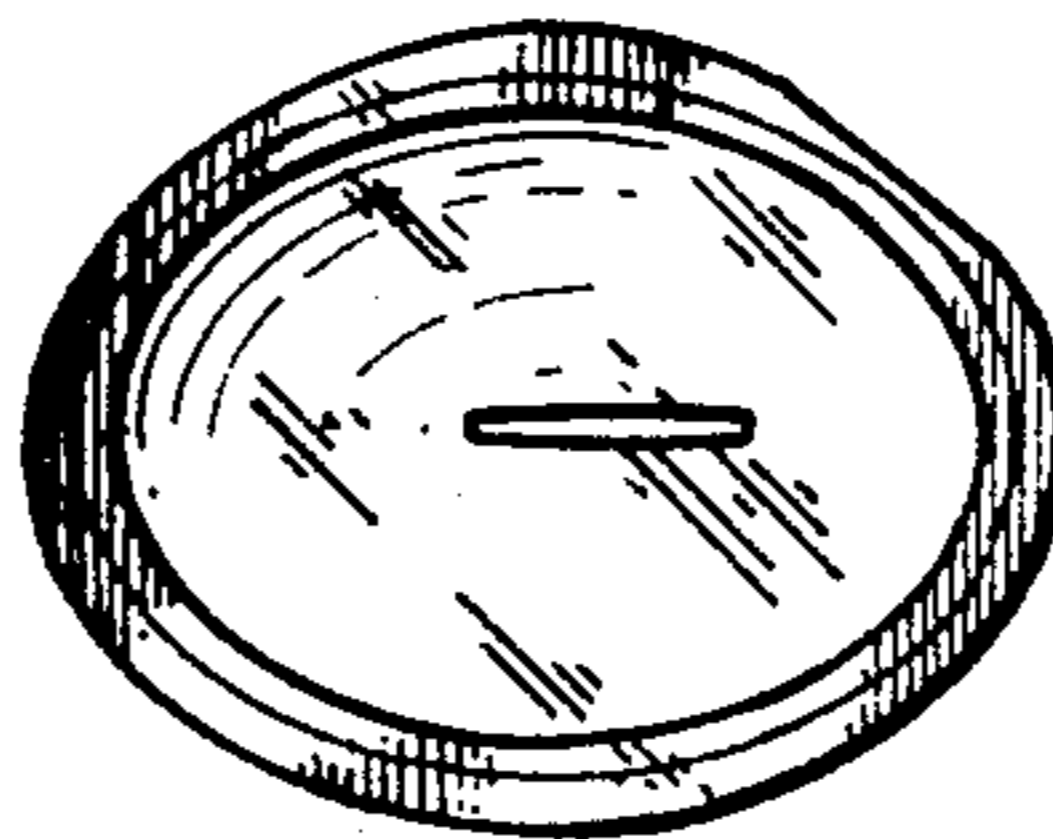

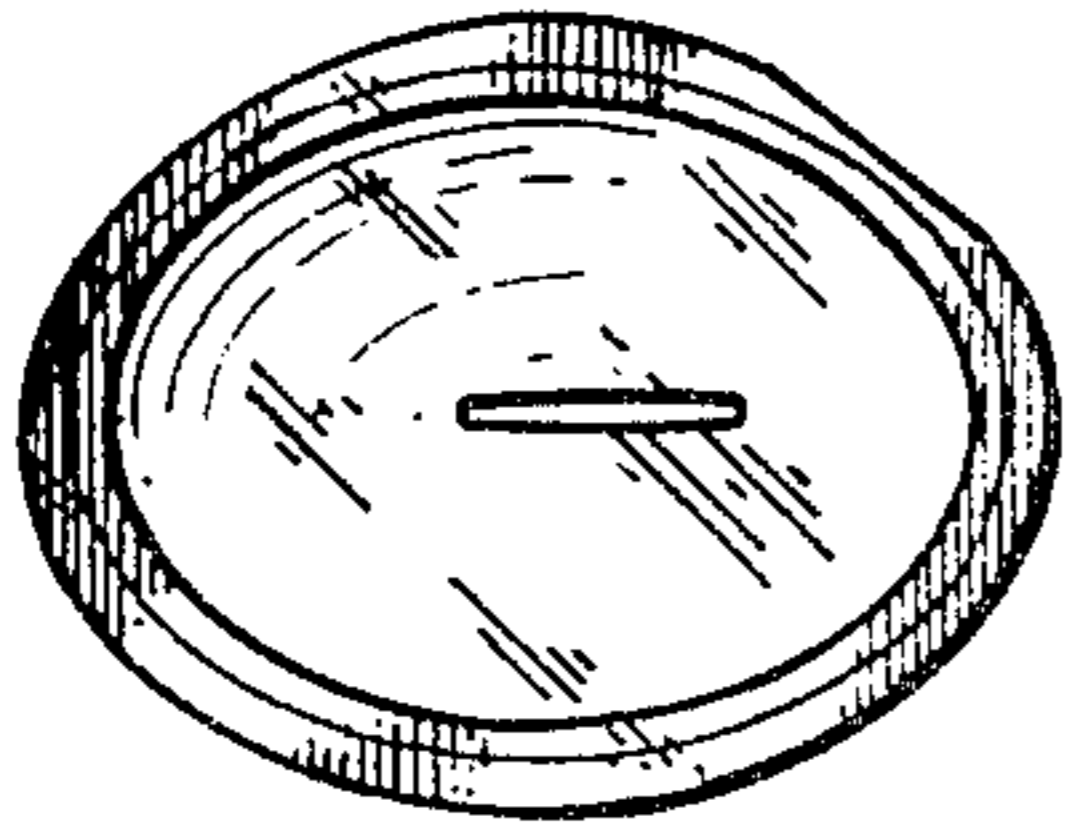

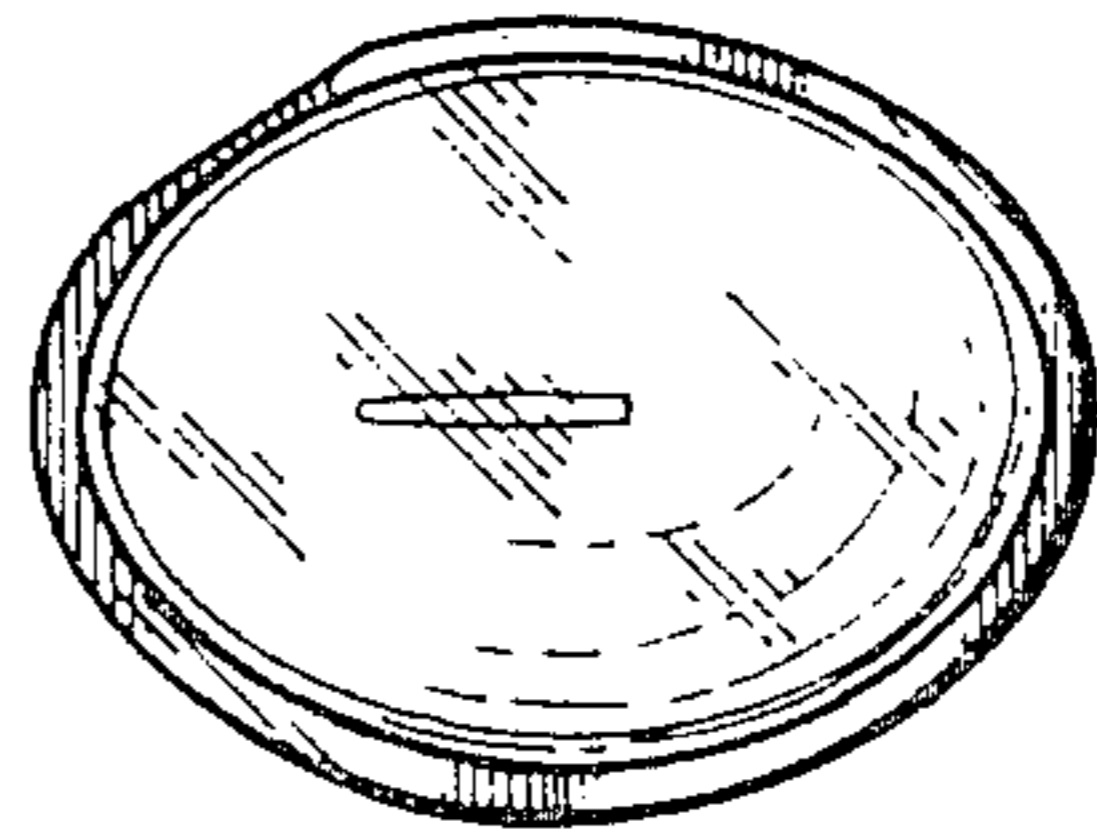

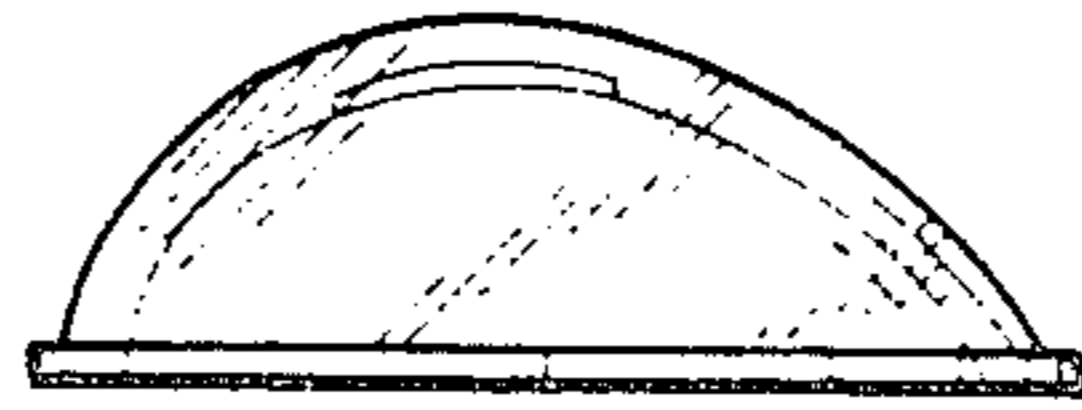

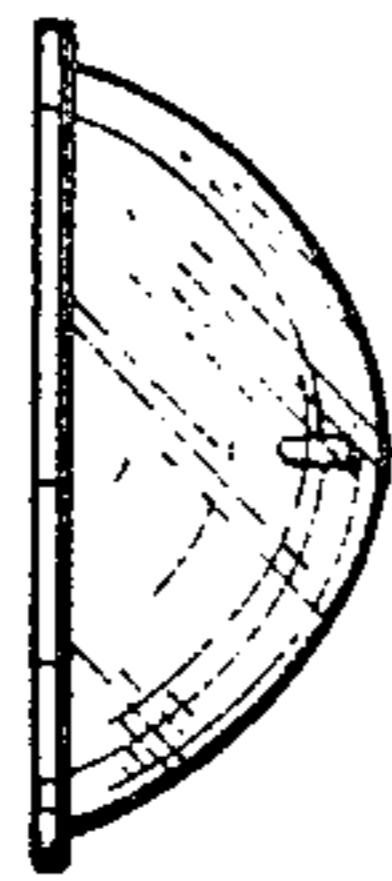
