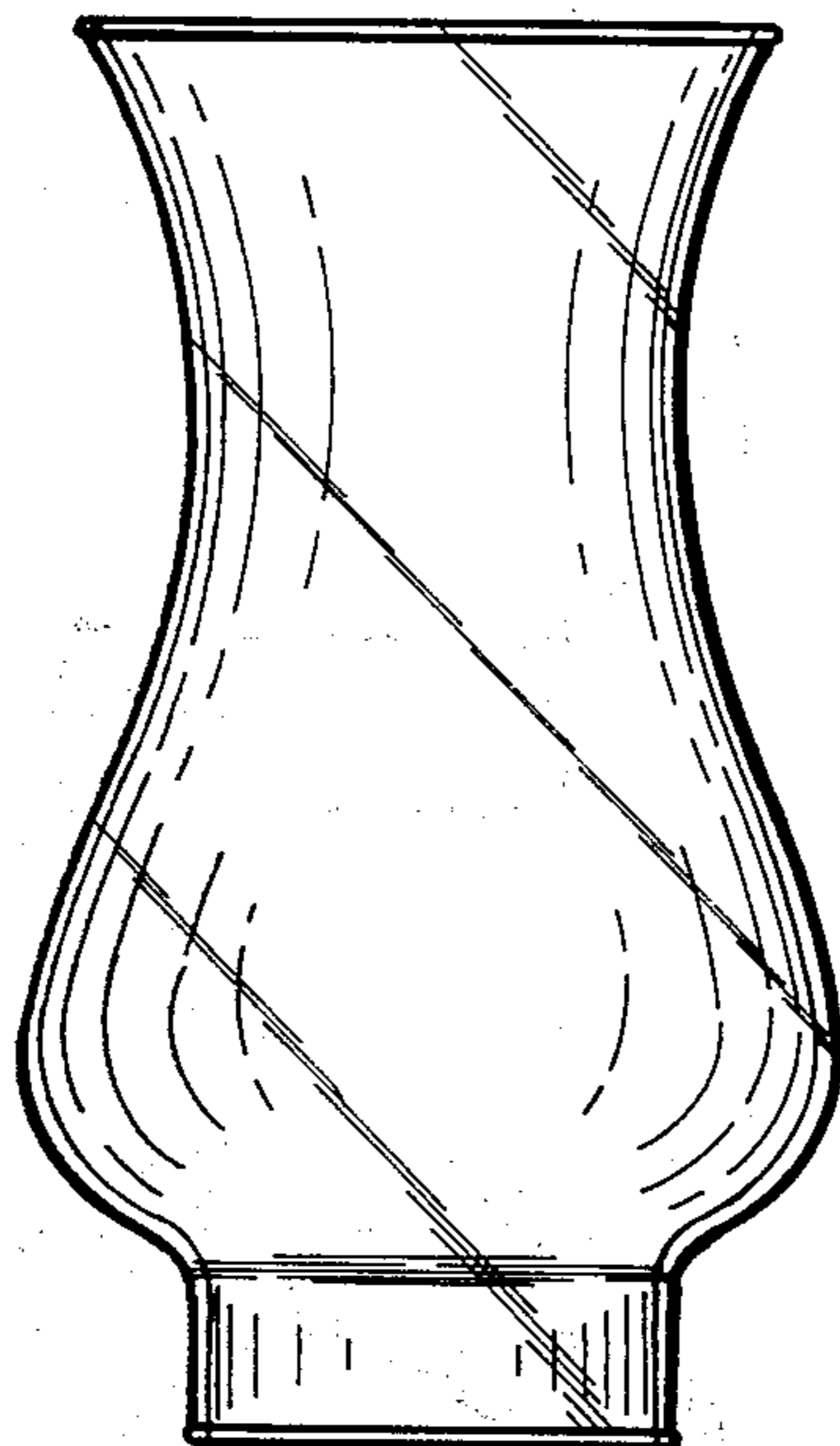

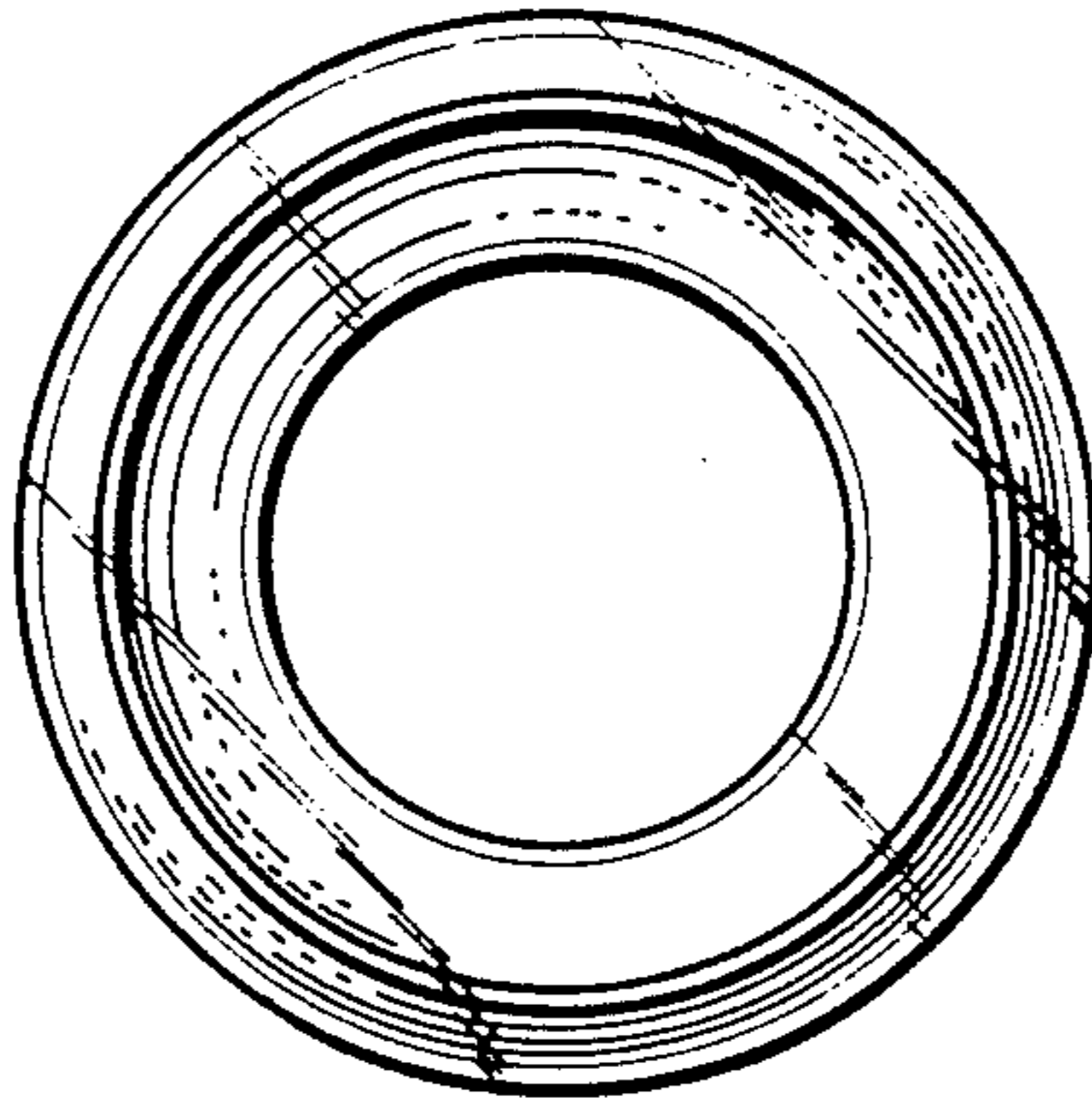
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shade for light fixtures, as shown.

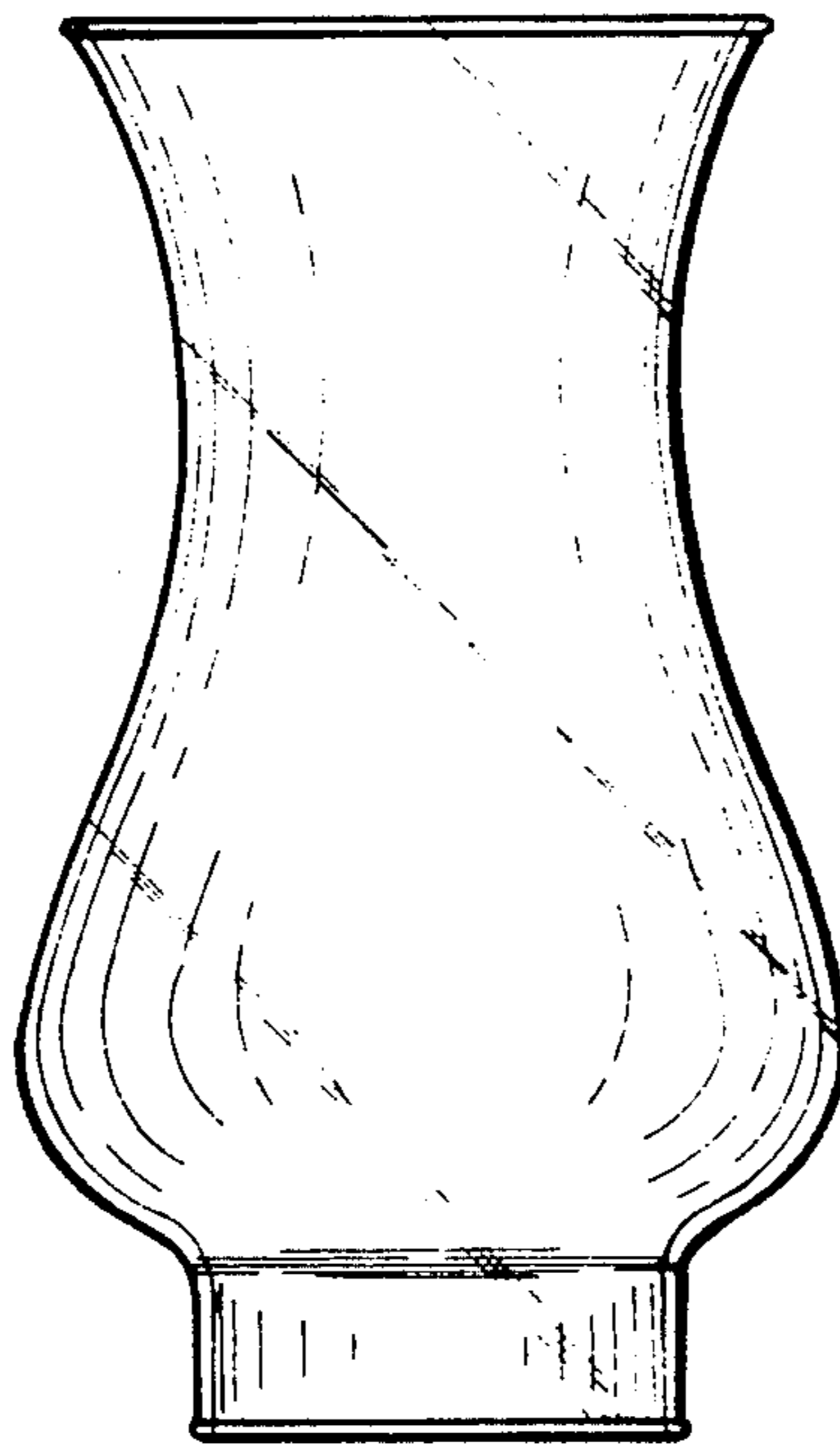
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

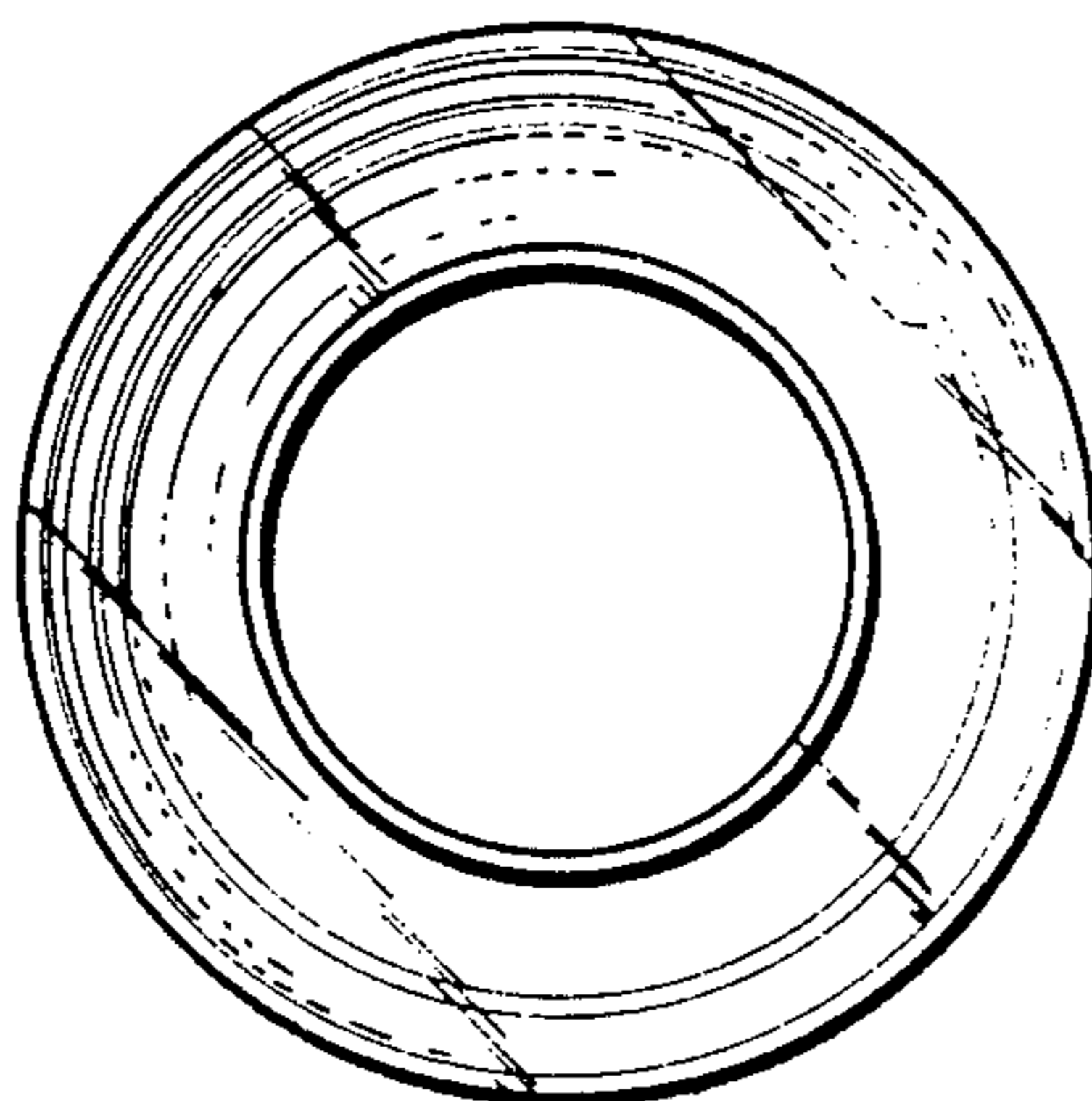
