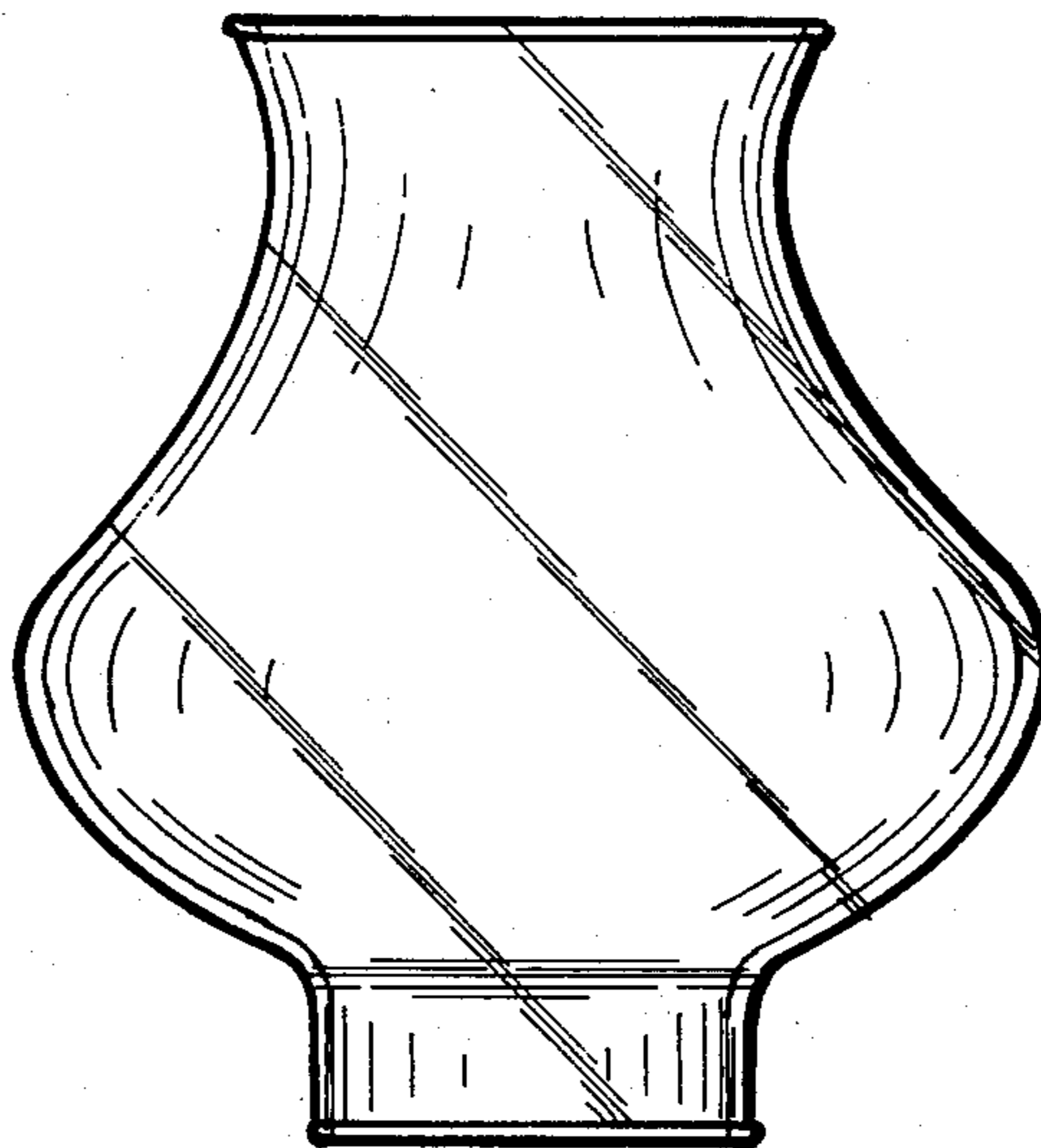
The ornamental design for a shade for light fixtures, as  
shown.

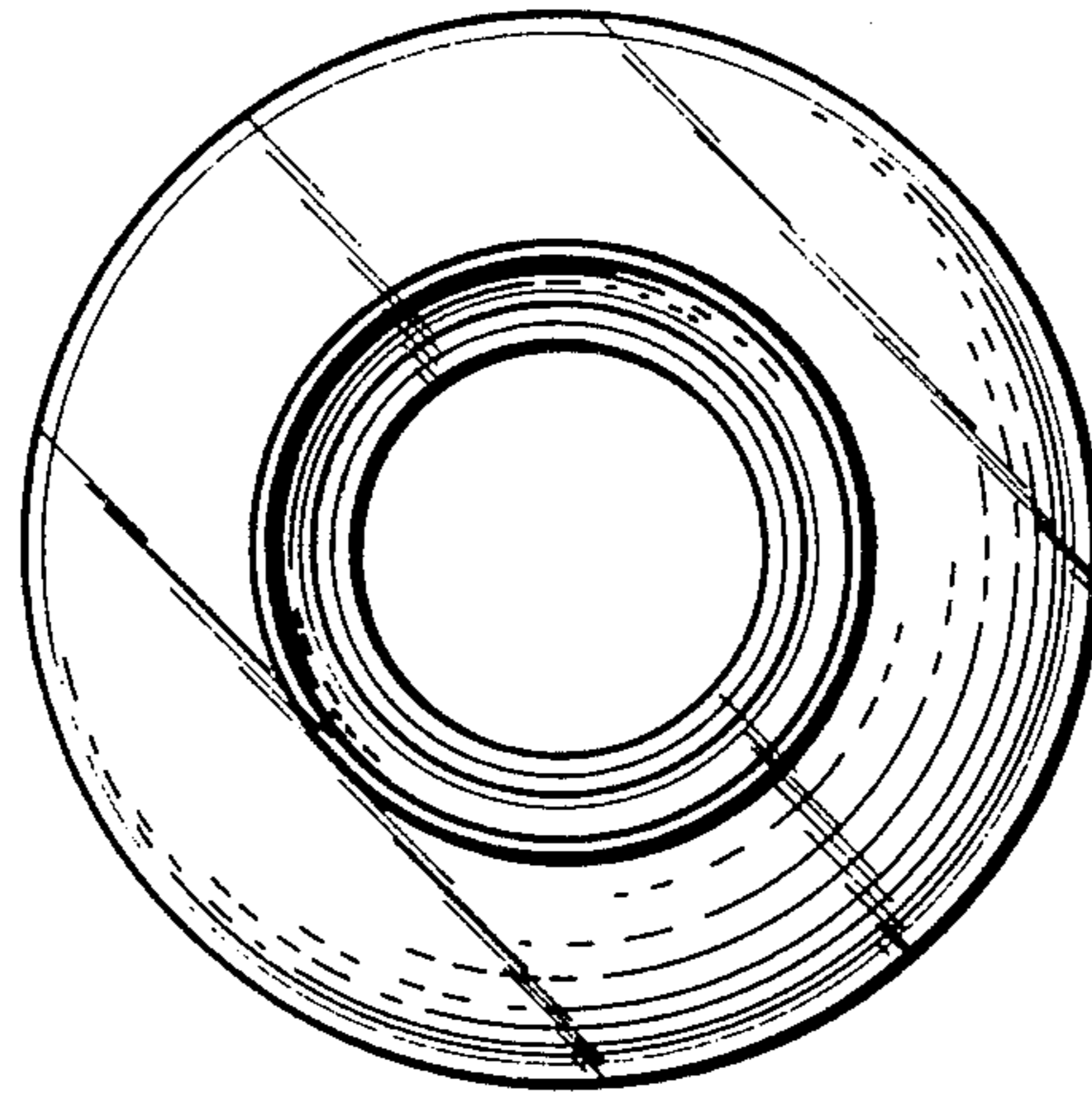
**DESCRIPTION**

showing our new design;

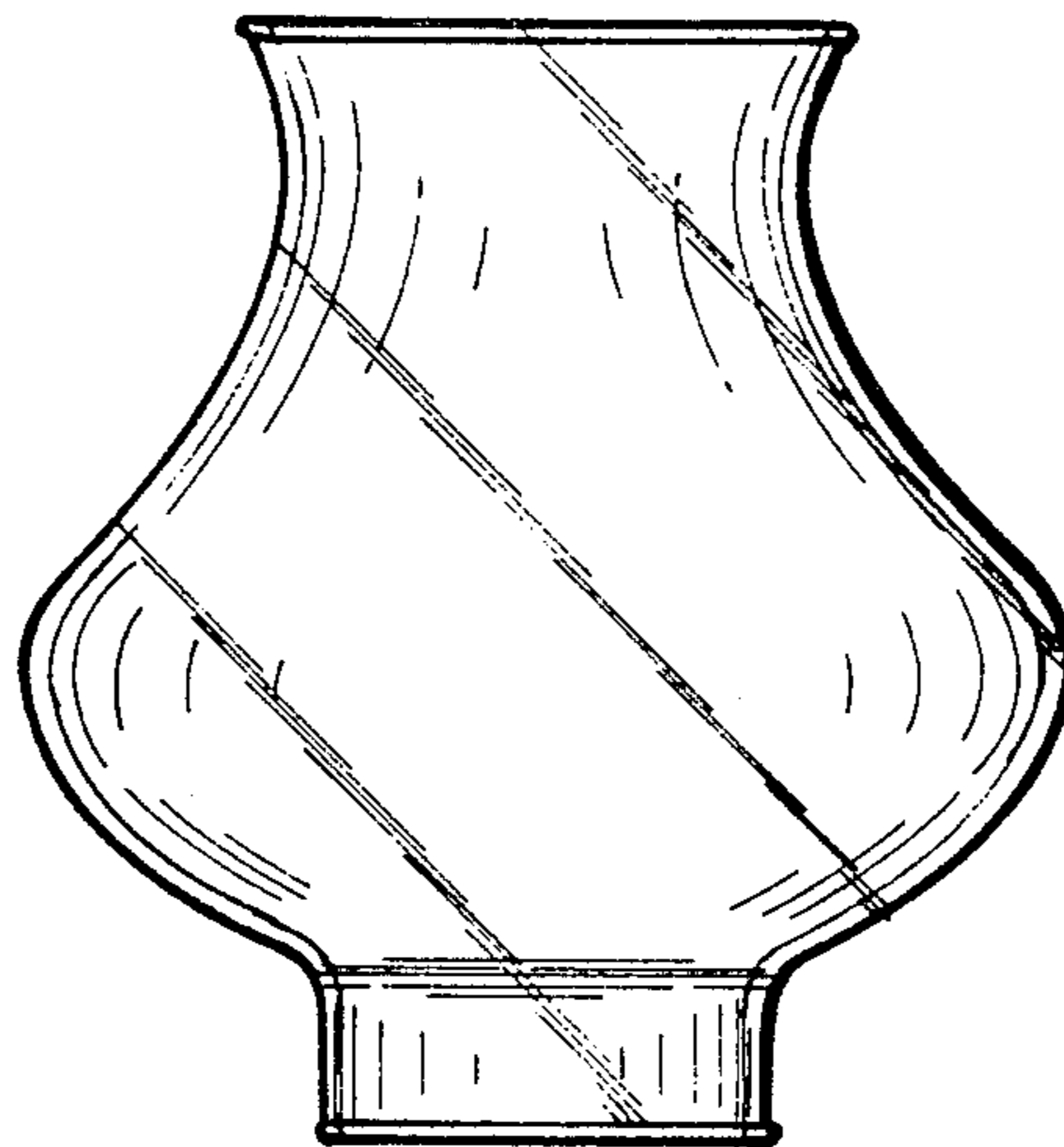
FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

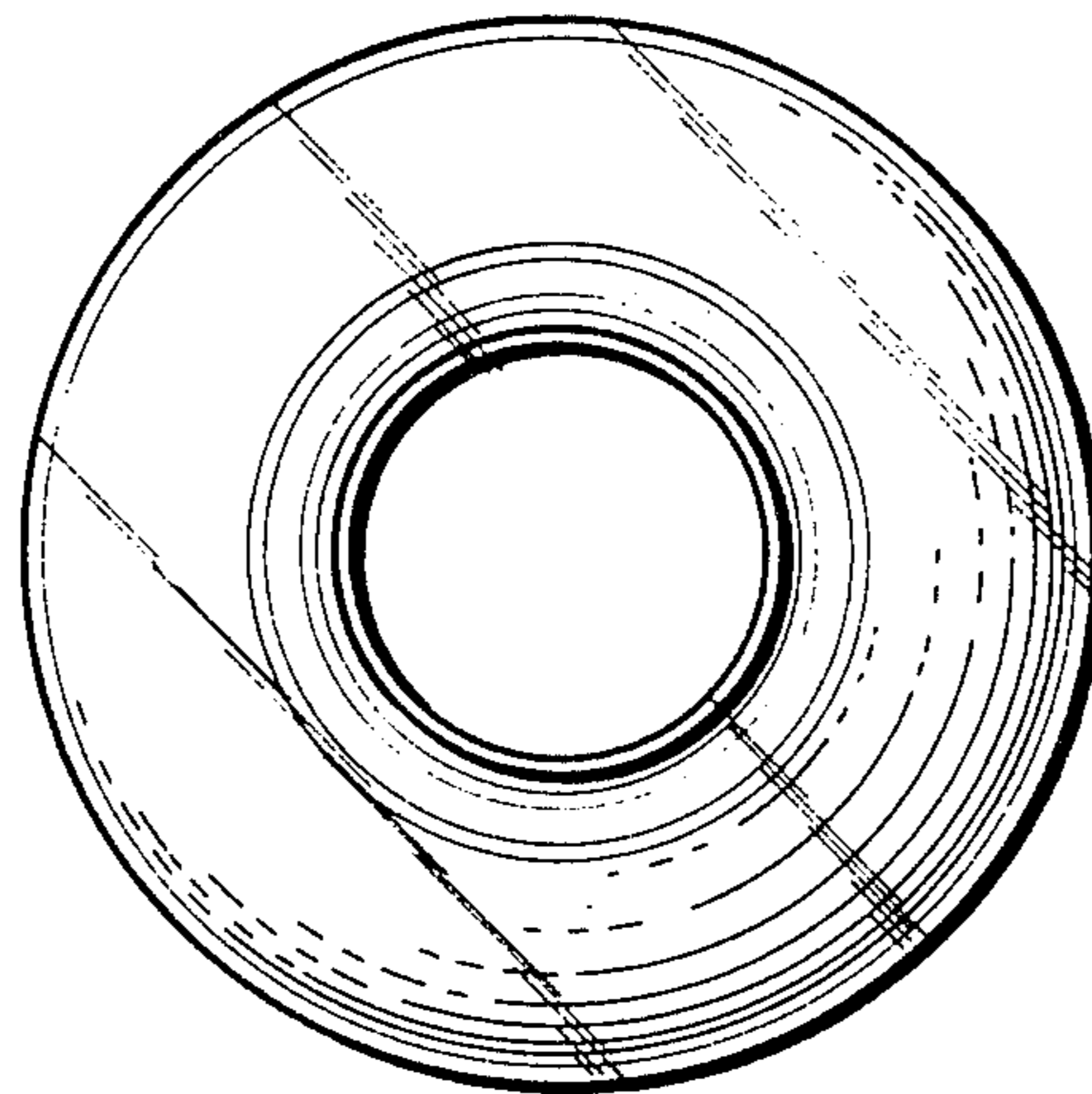
