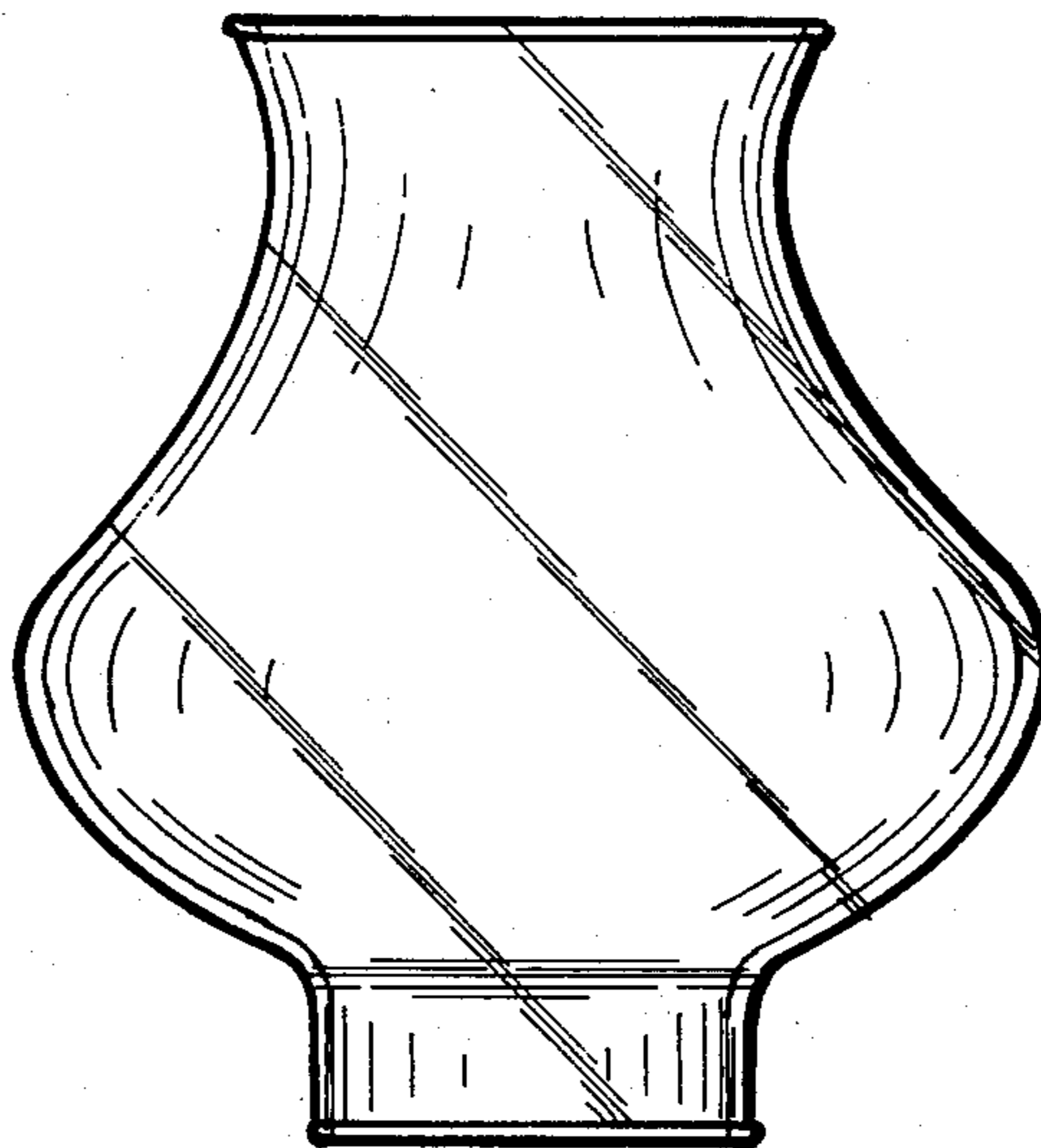
The ornamental design for a shade for light fixtures, as

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.



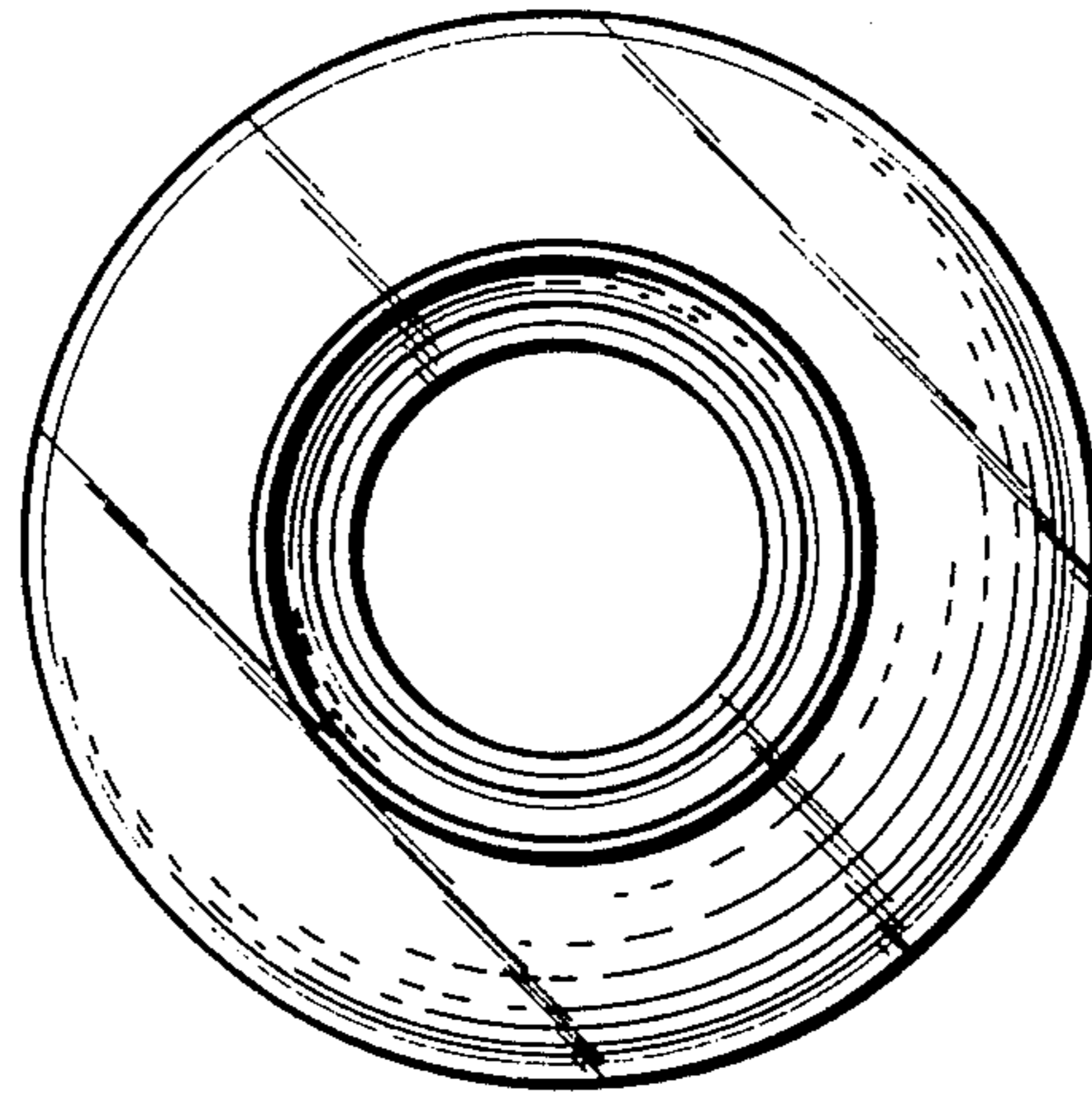

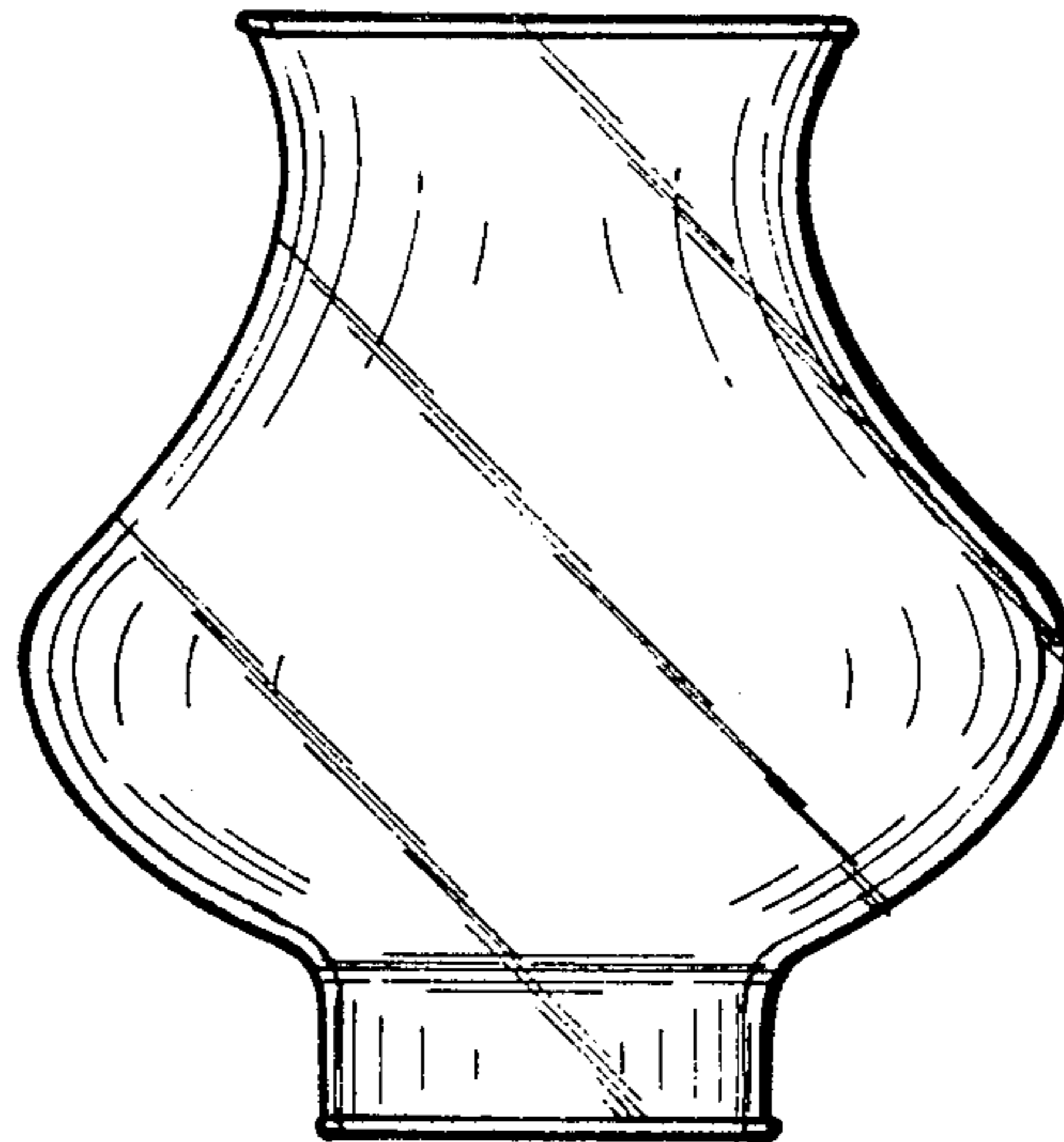

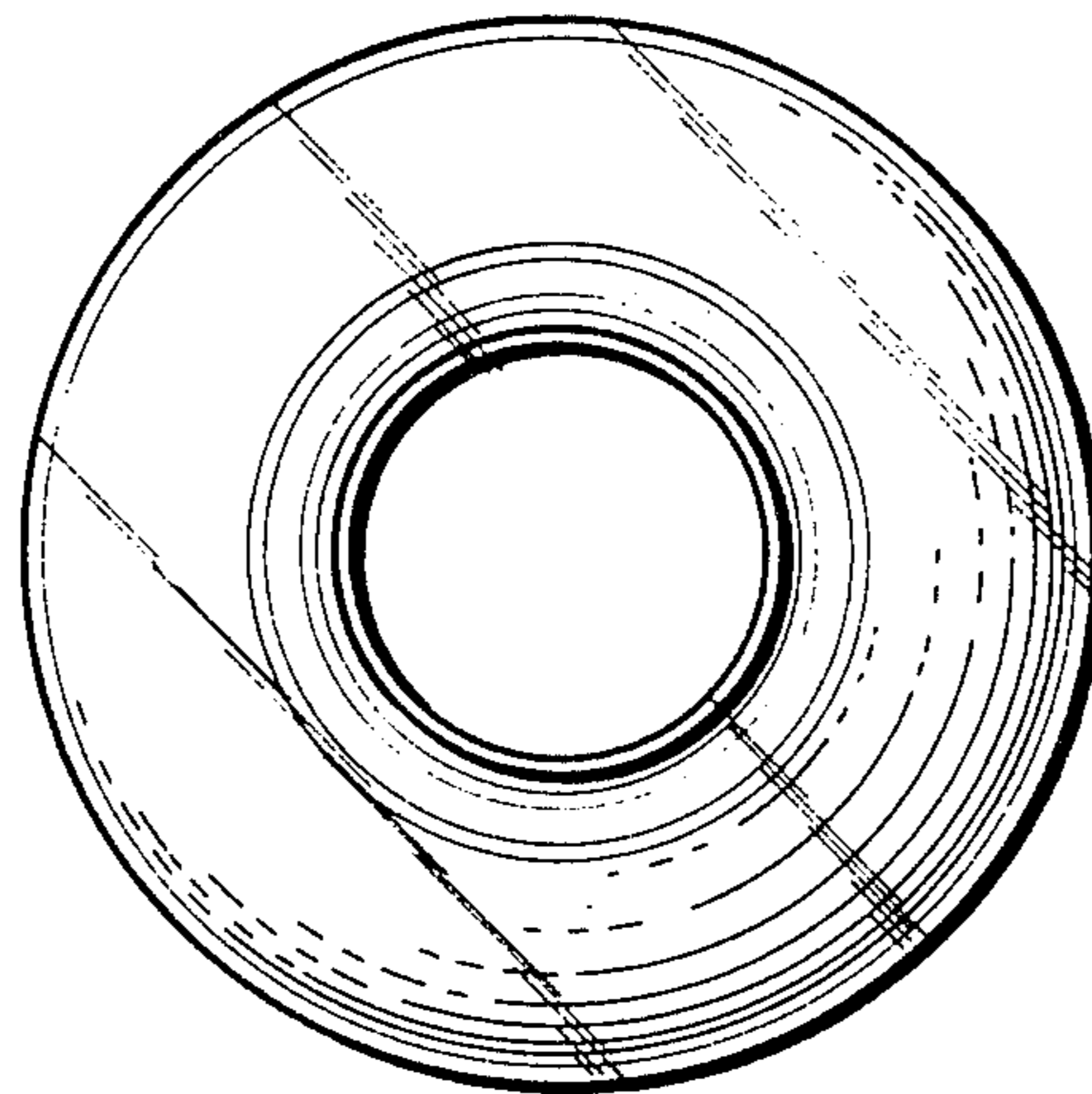
