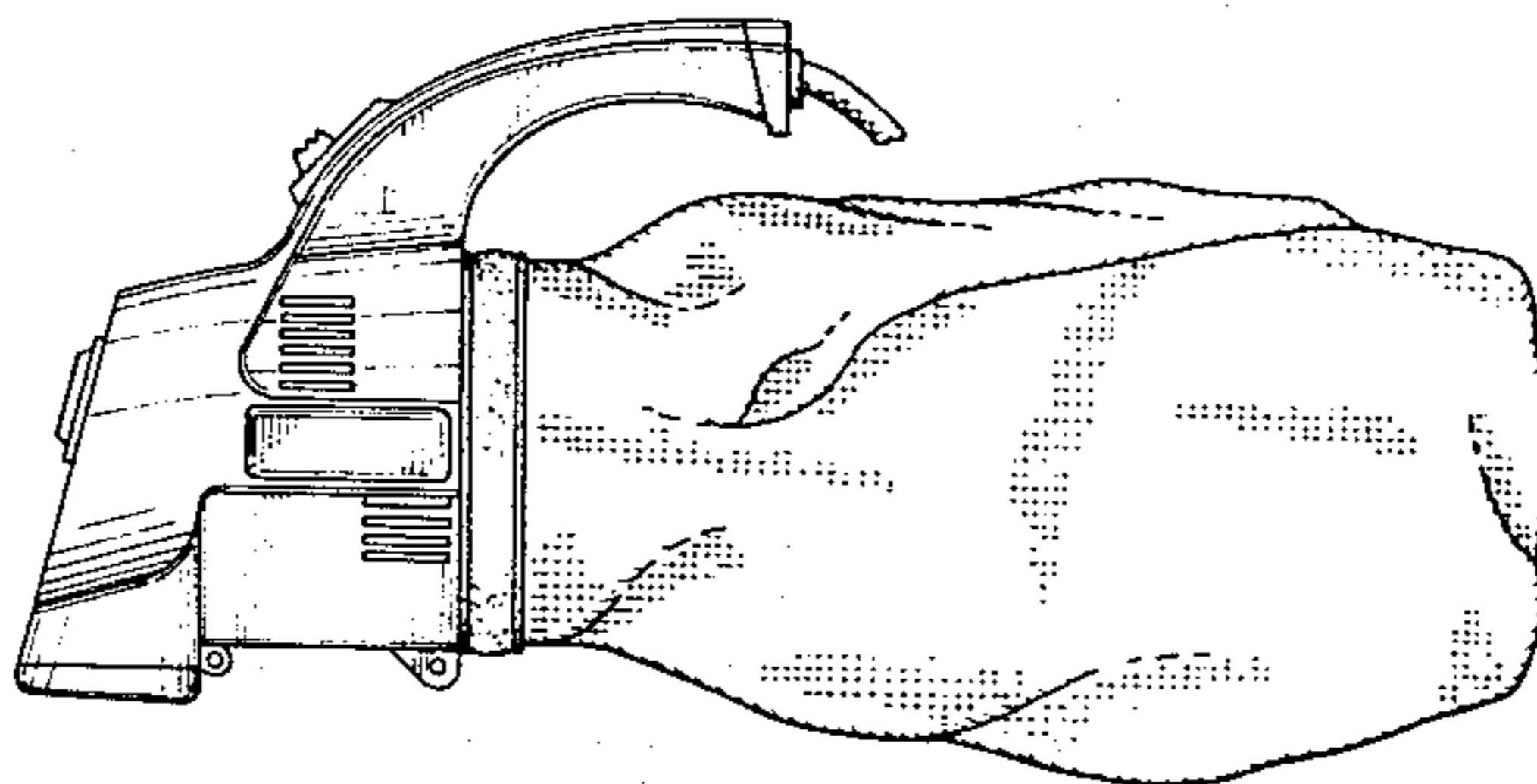
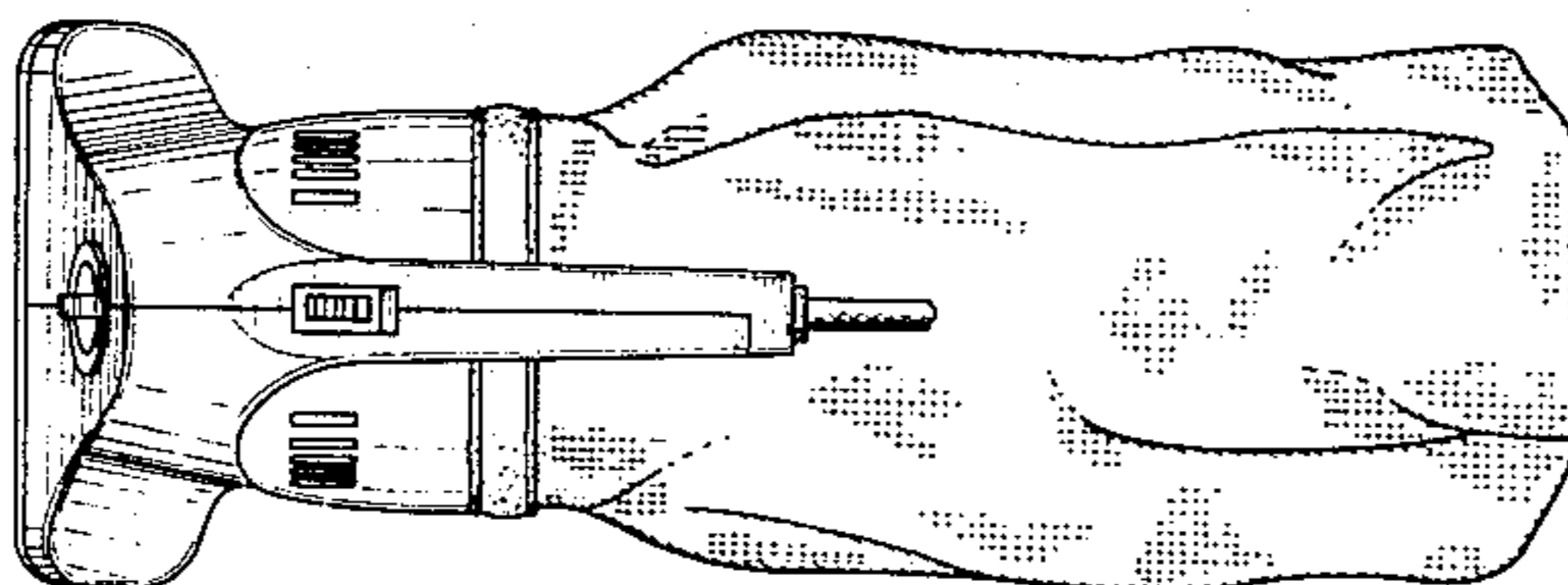

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hand vacuum, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a hand vacuum, formed in accordance with the present invention; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view opposite of the view of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof. The conventional electrical cord has been shown fragmentarily for ease of illustration.



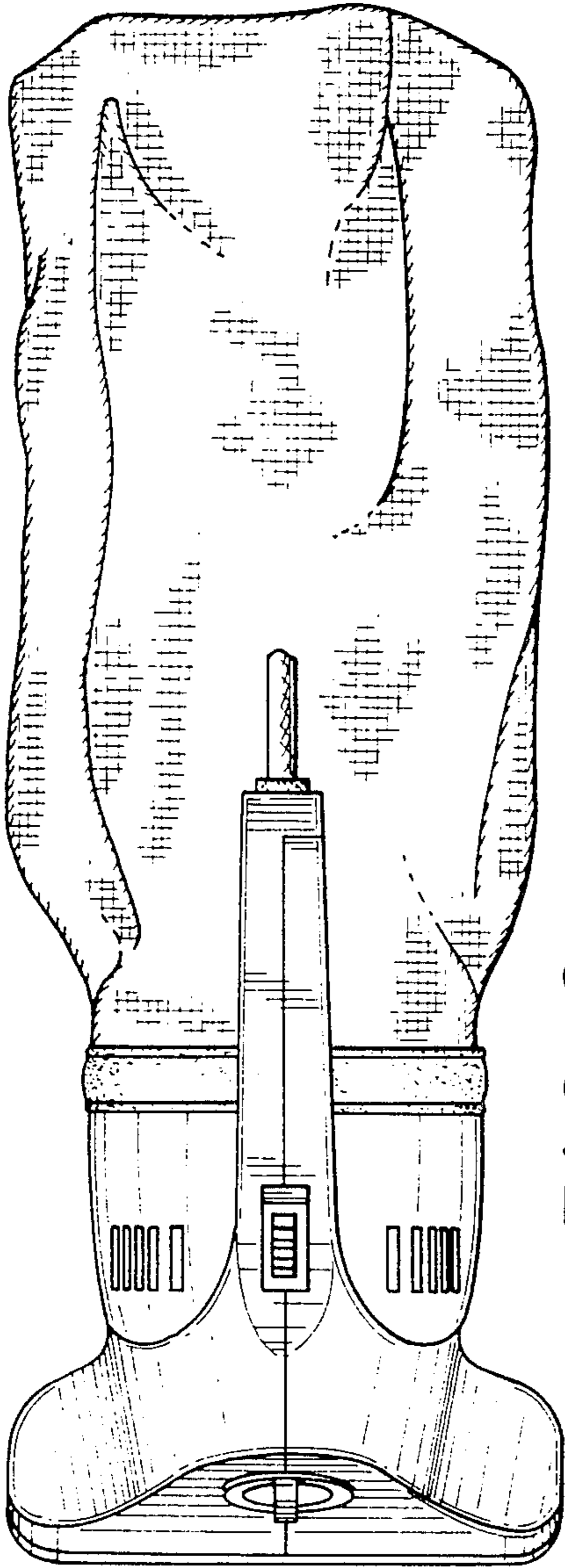

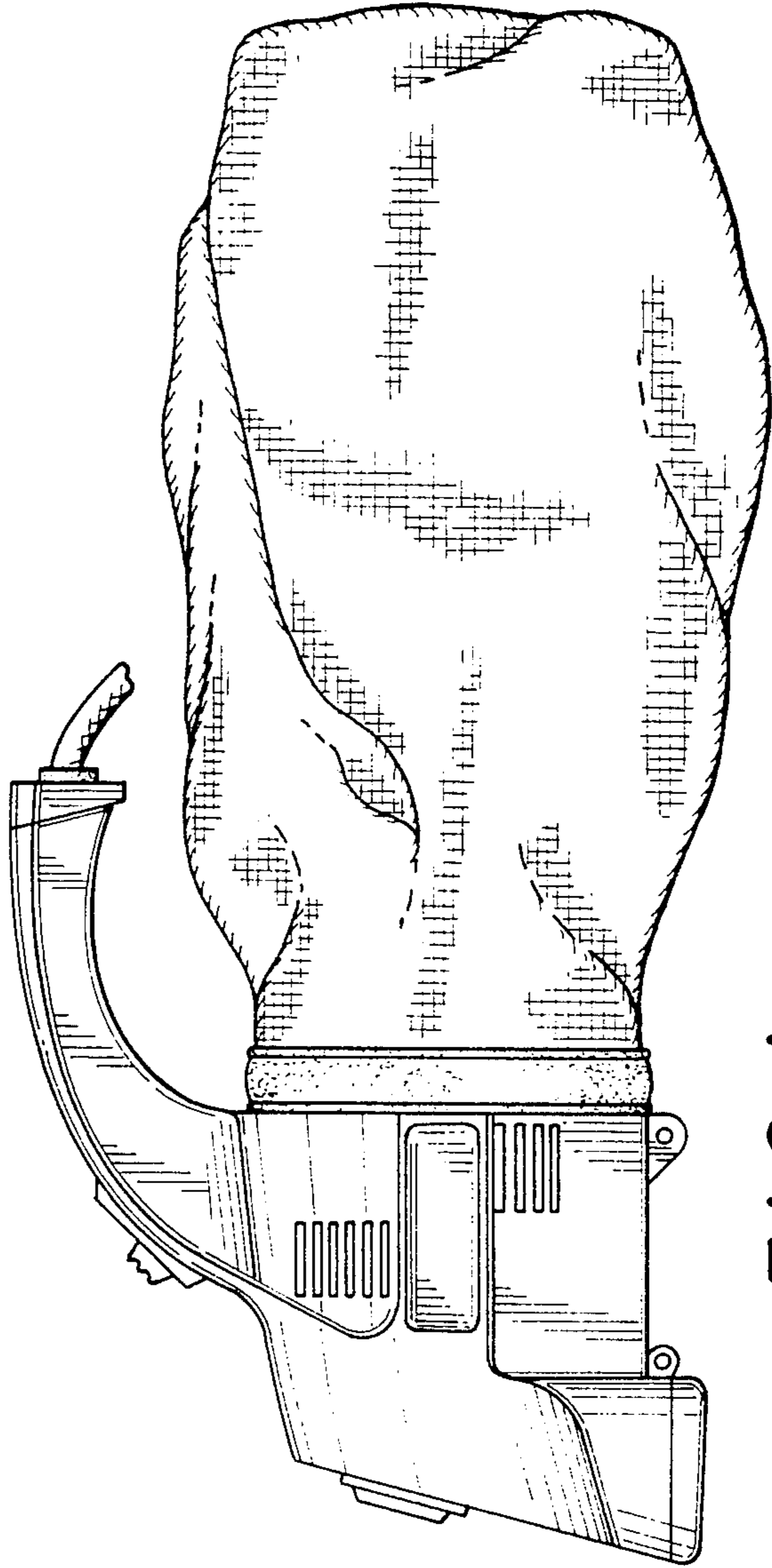

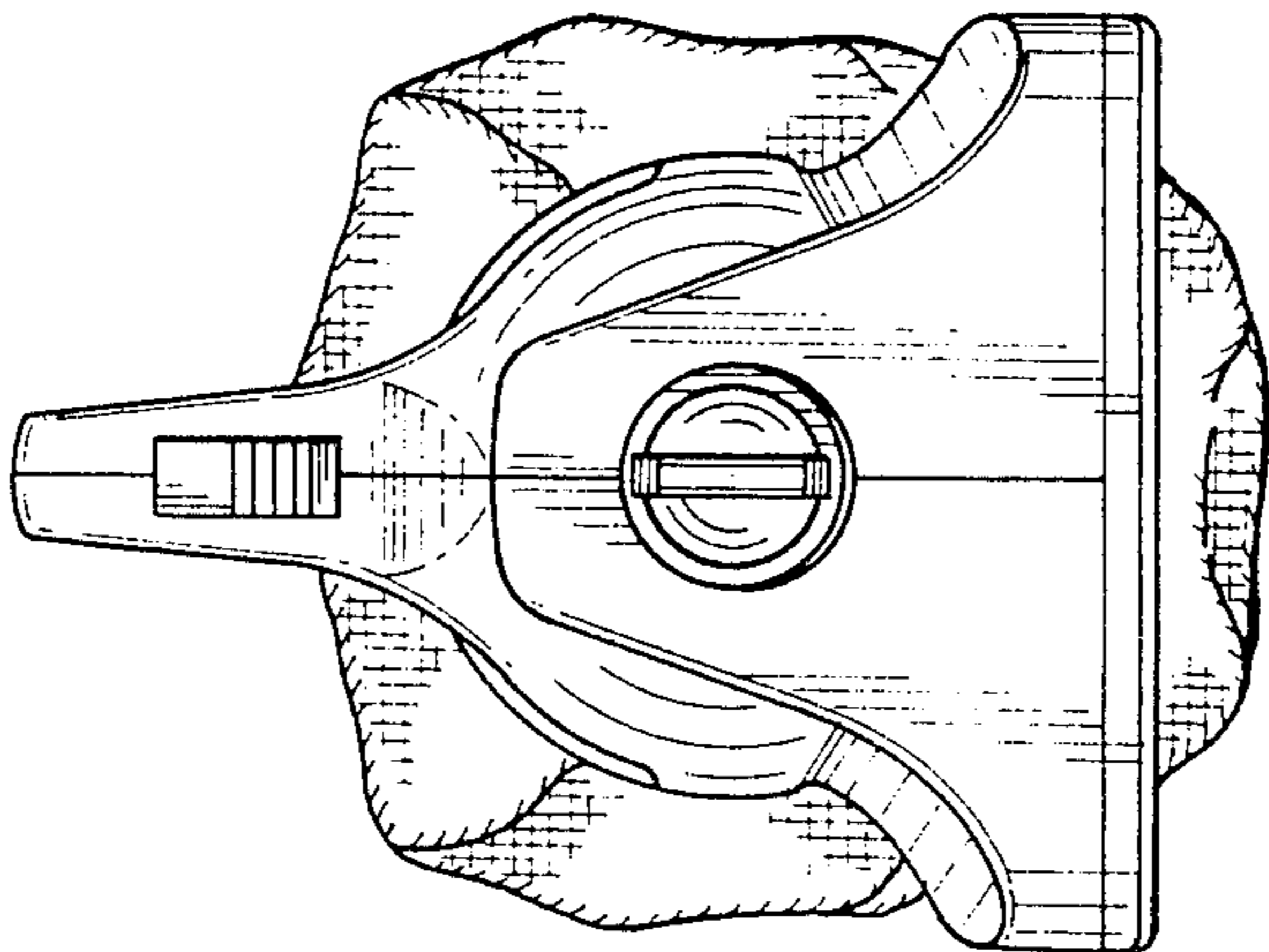

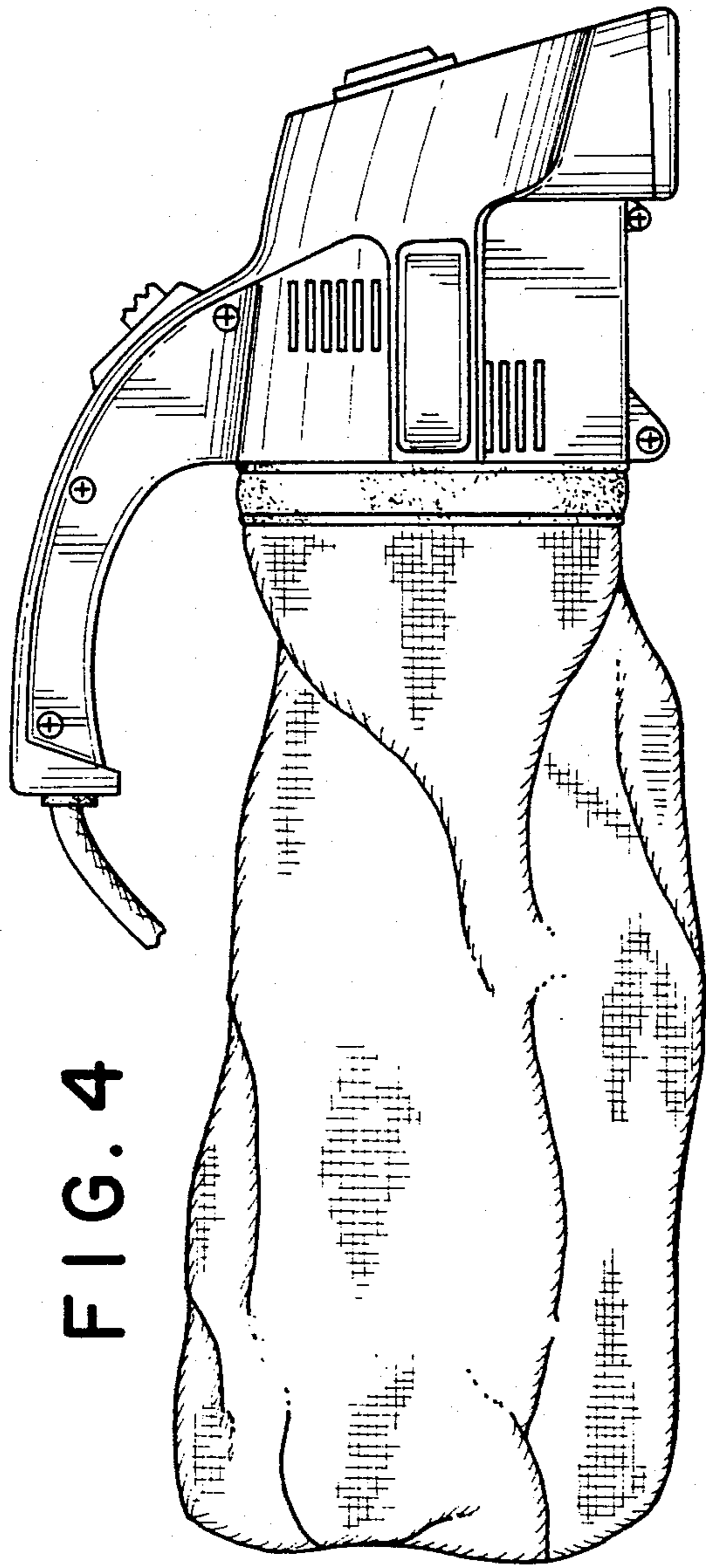

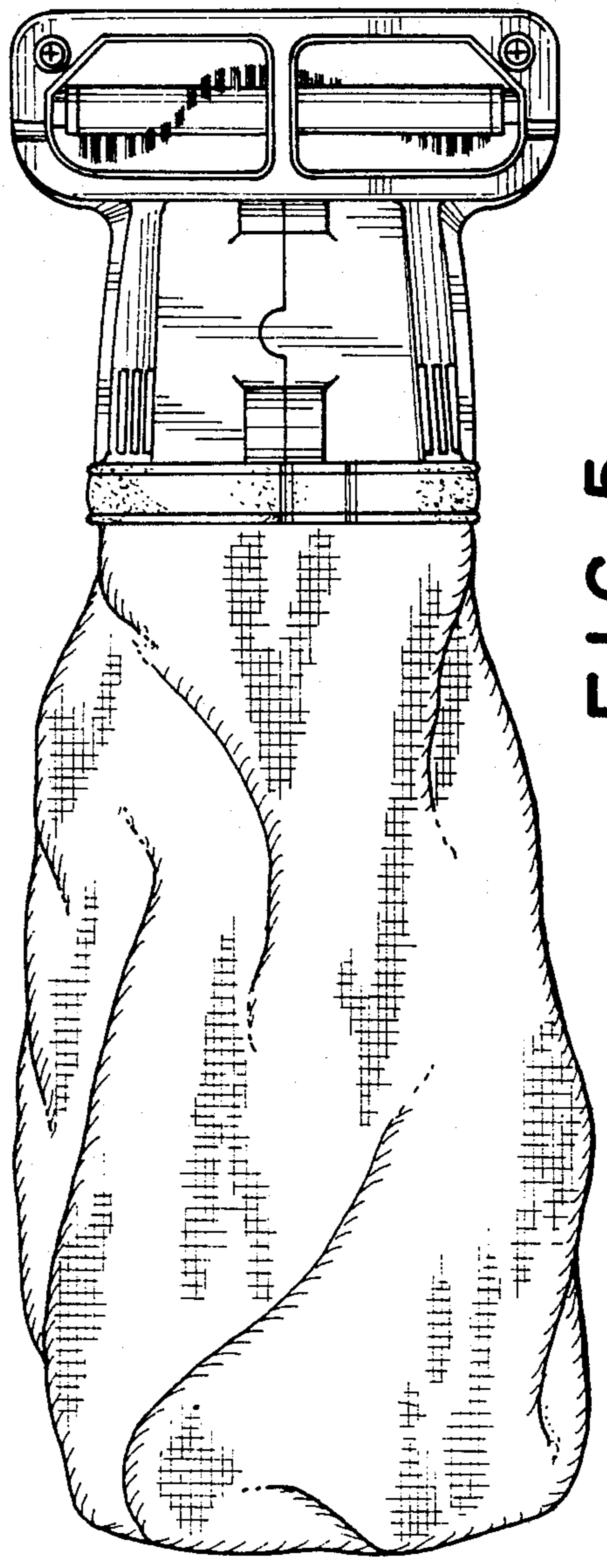

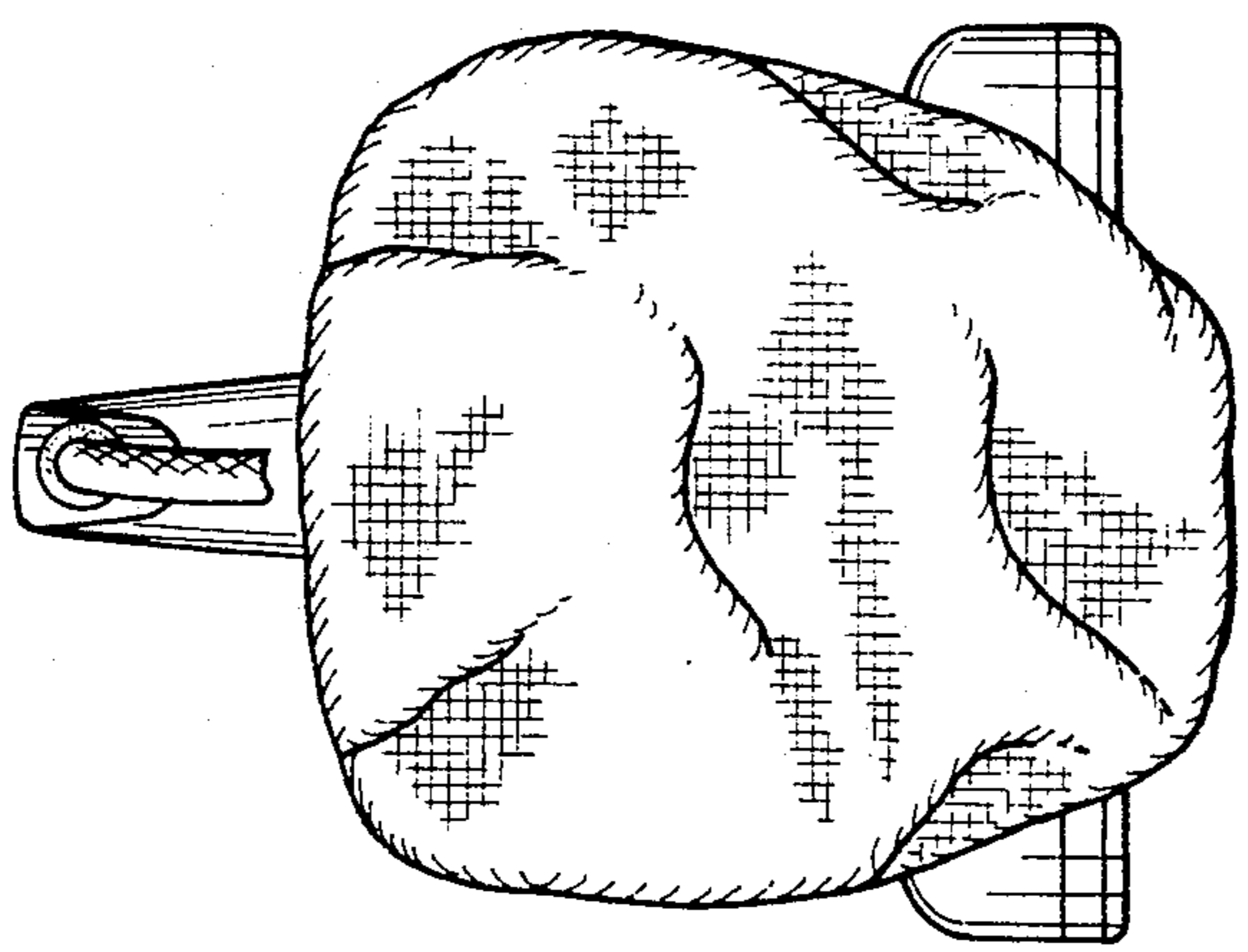
