**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a brush, showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

 The broken line disclosure of a handle in FIG. 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

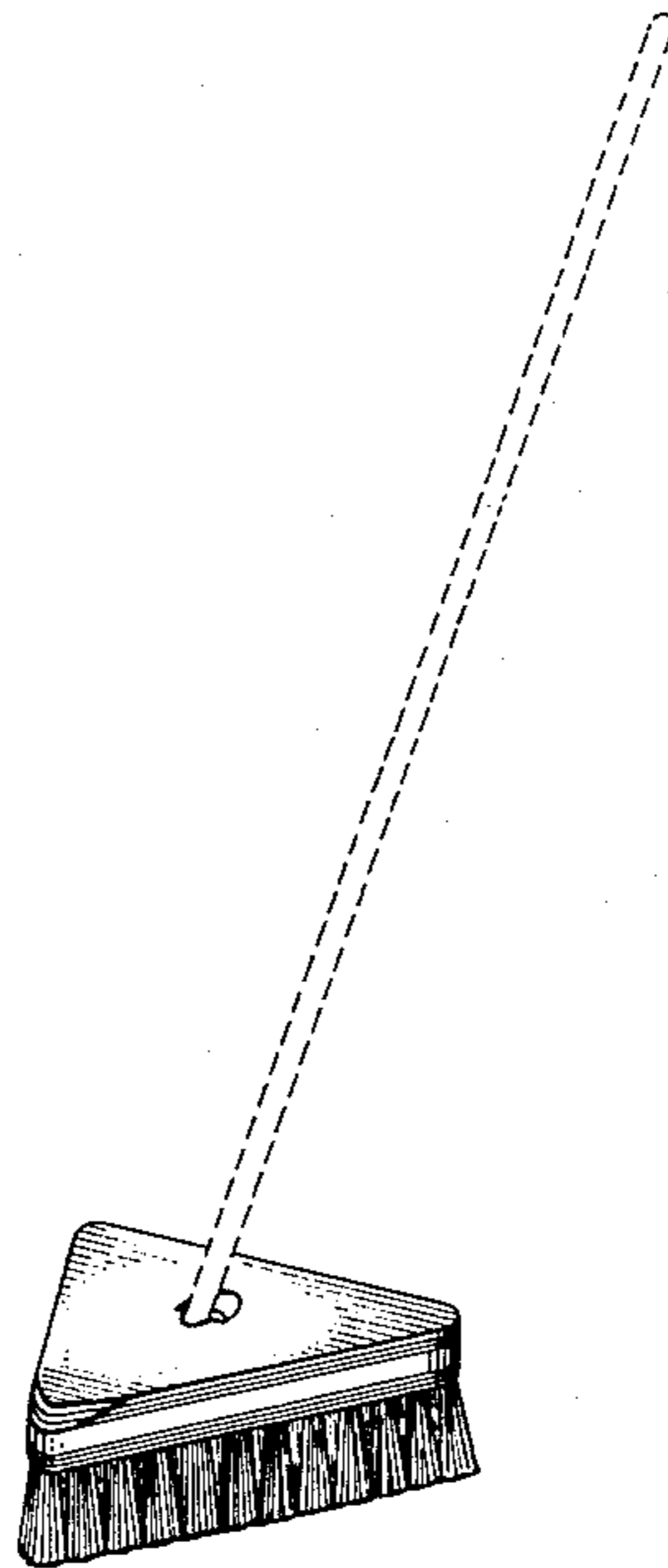

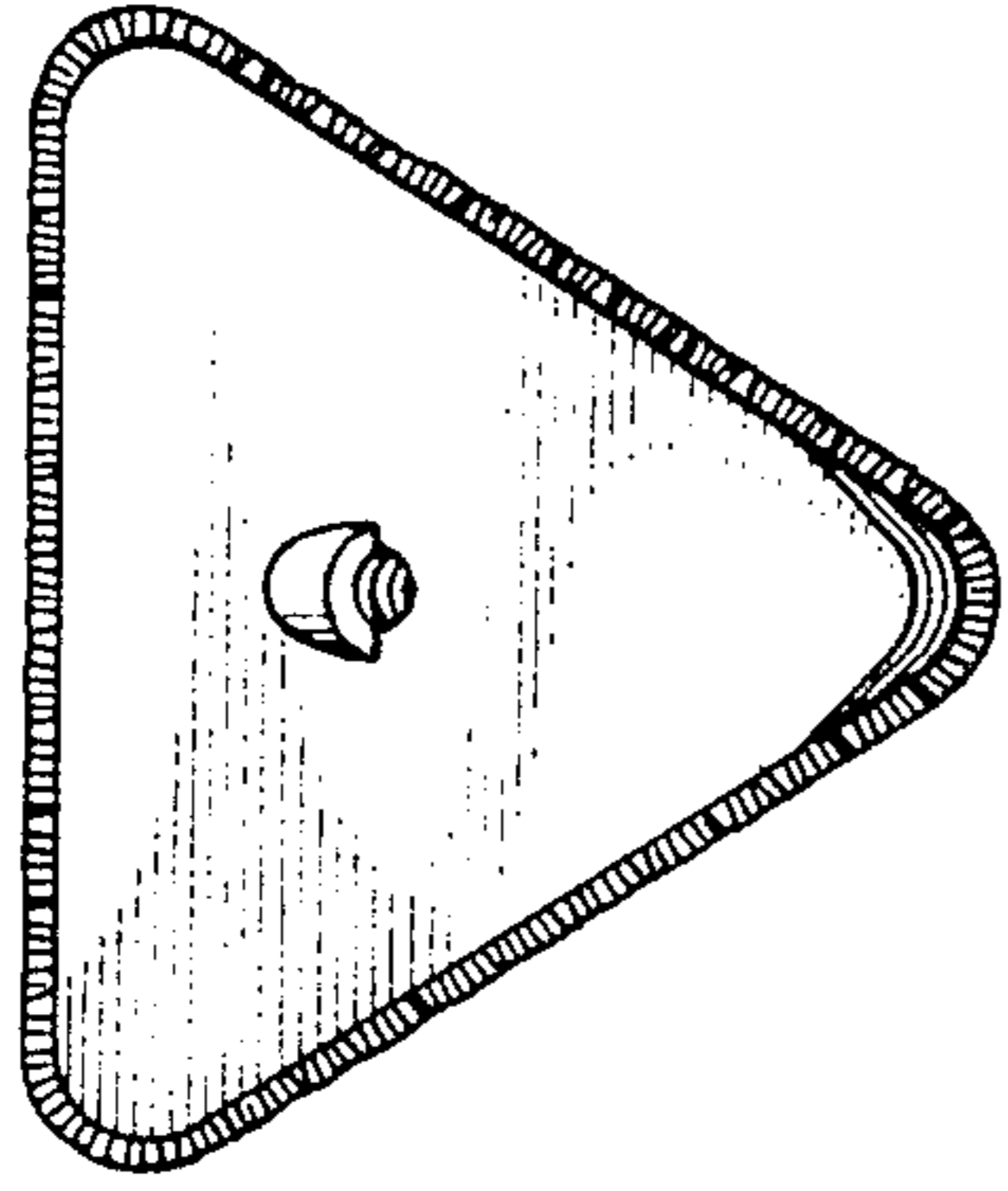

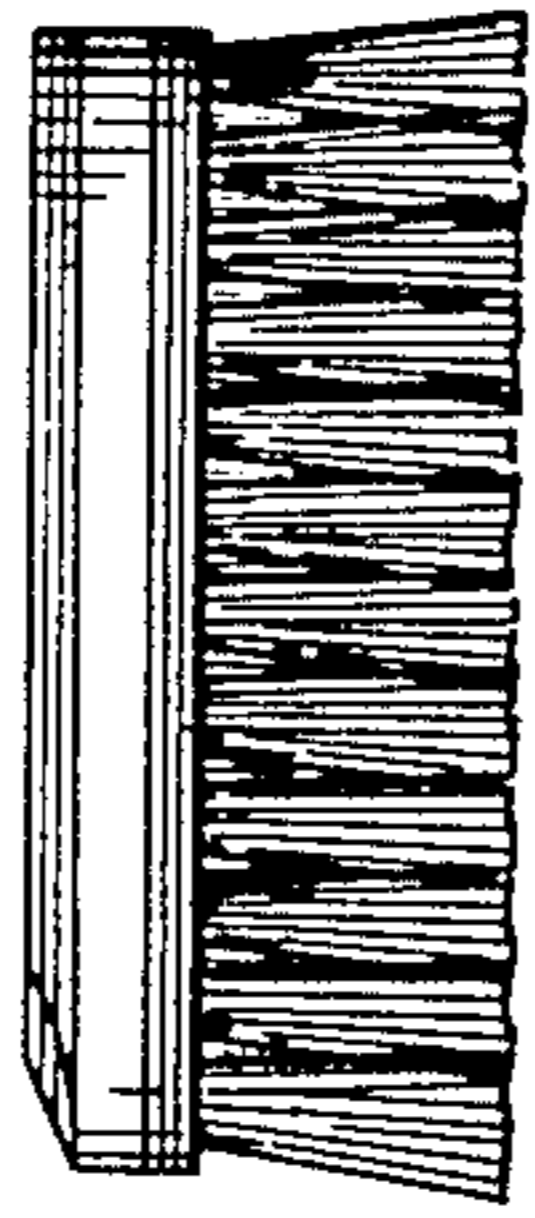

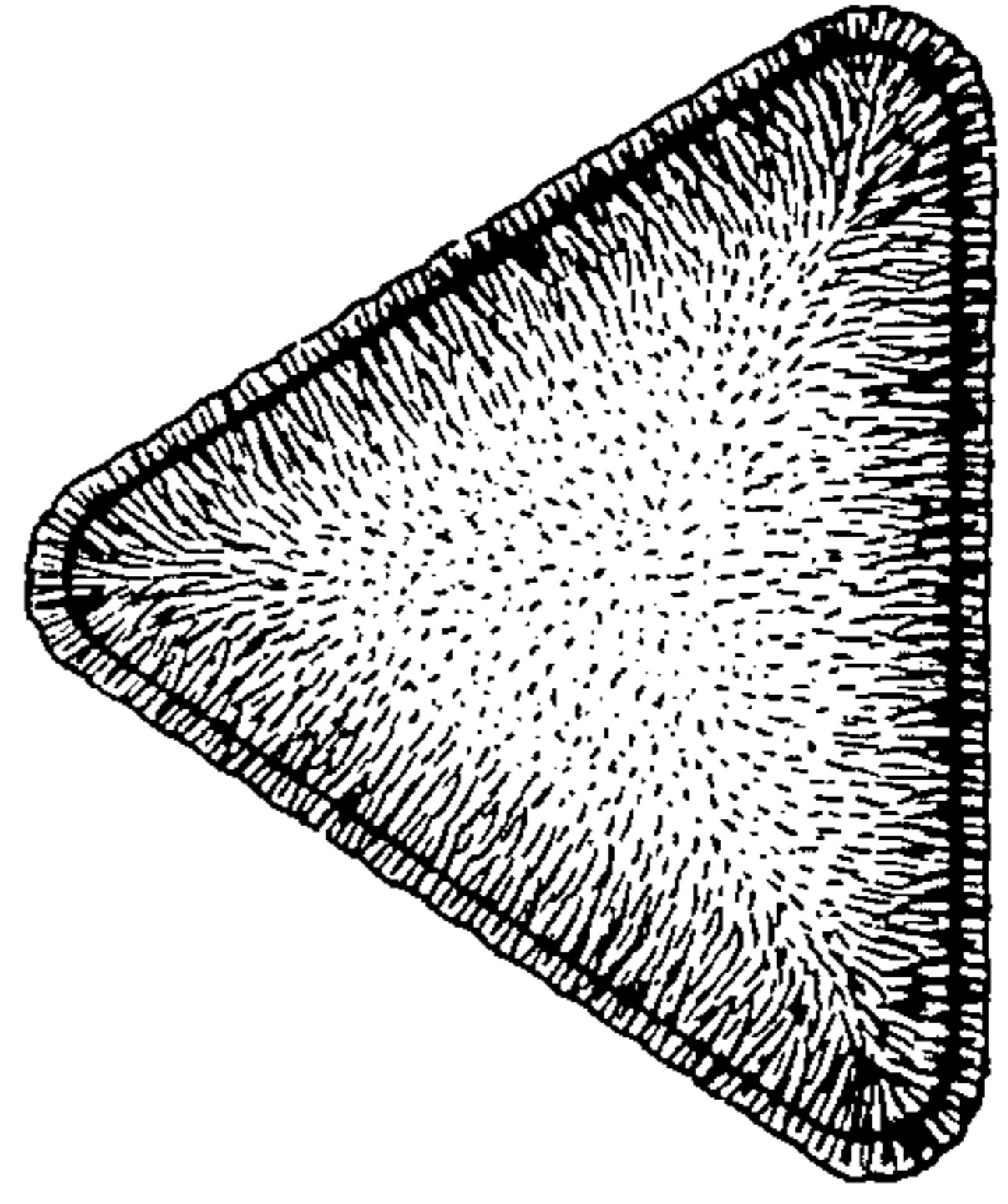

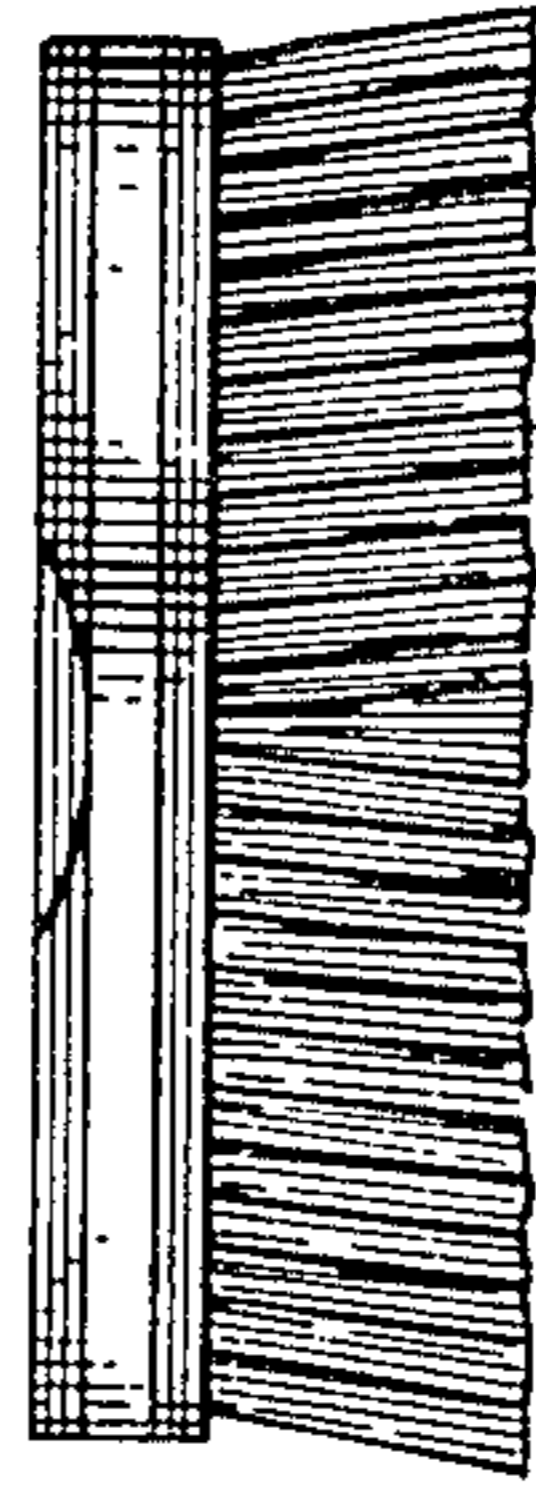

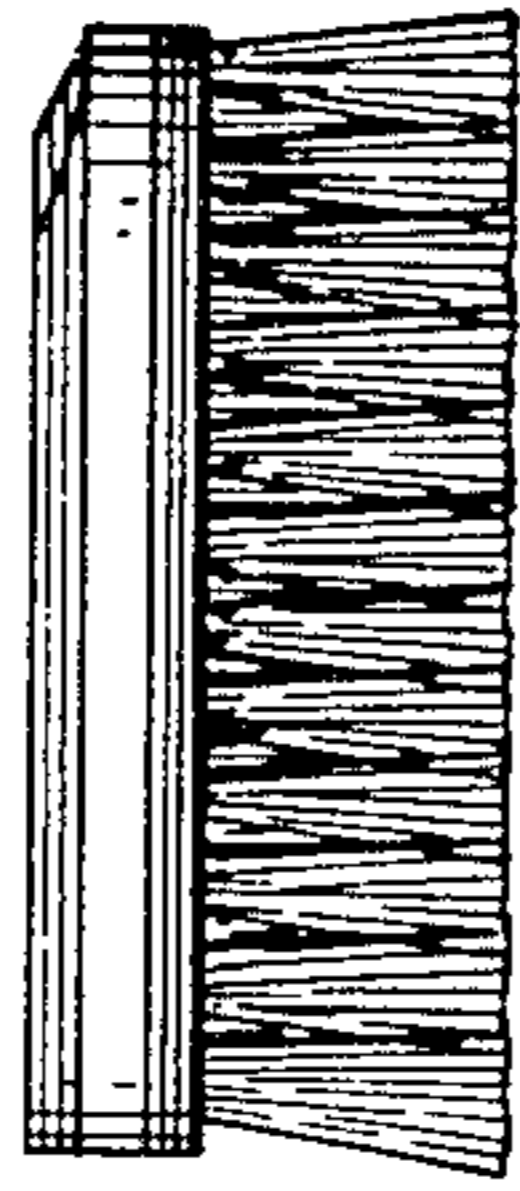

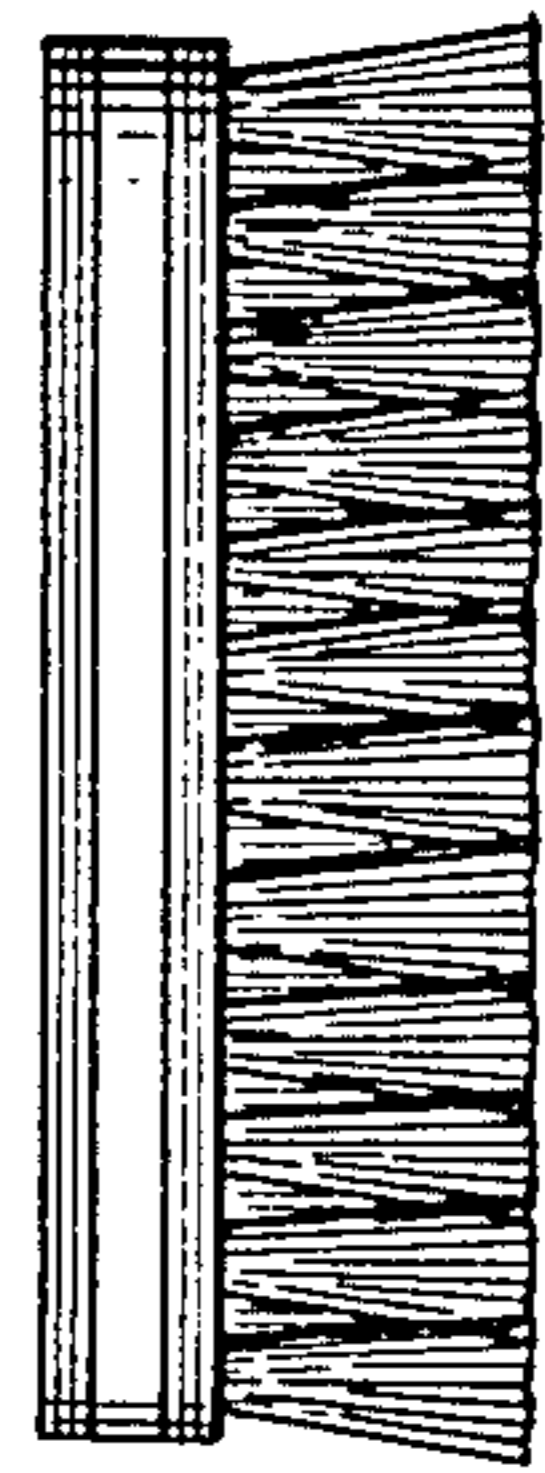
