FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

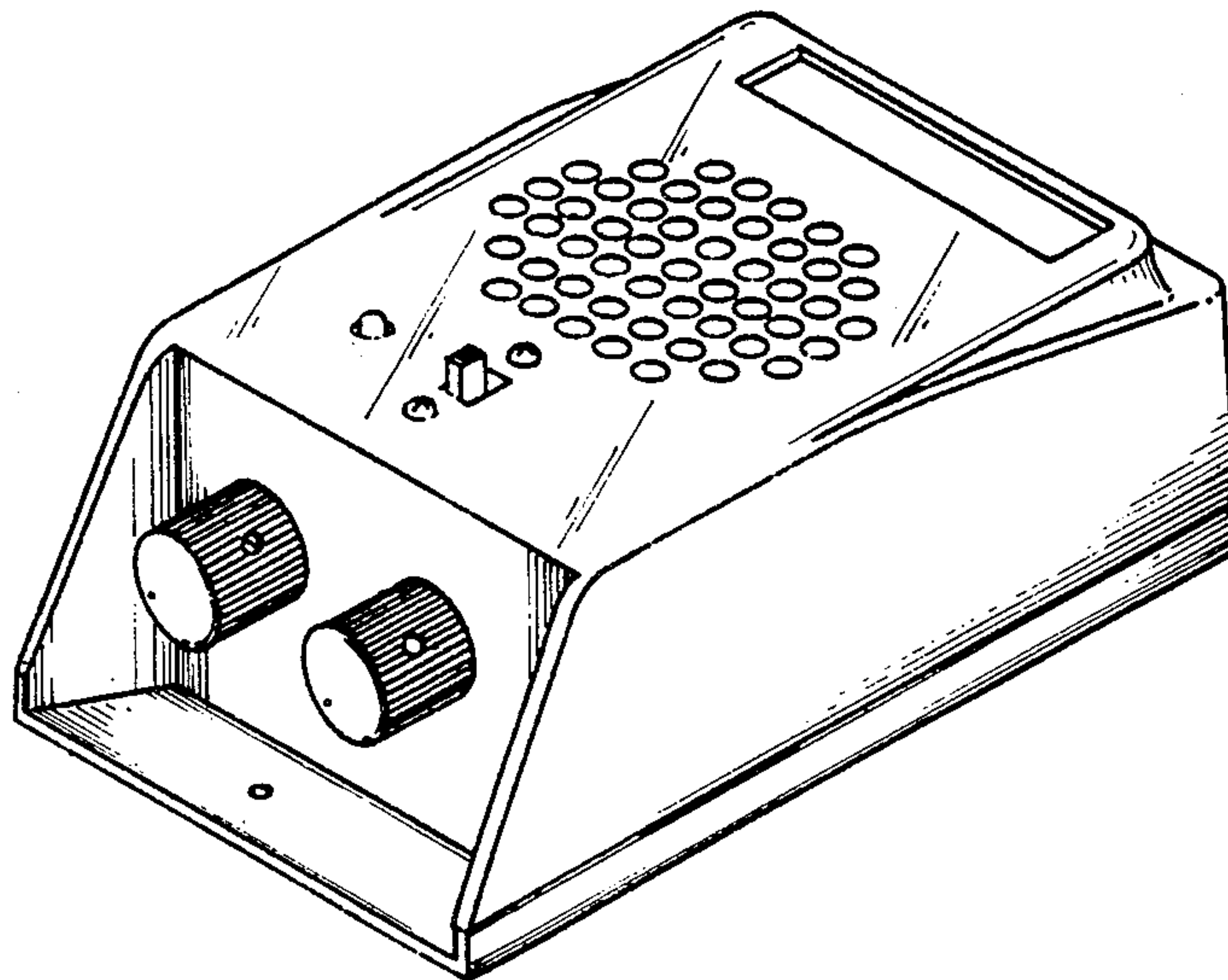

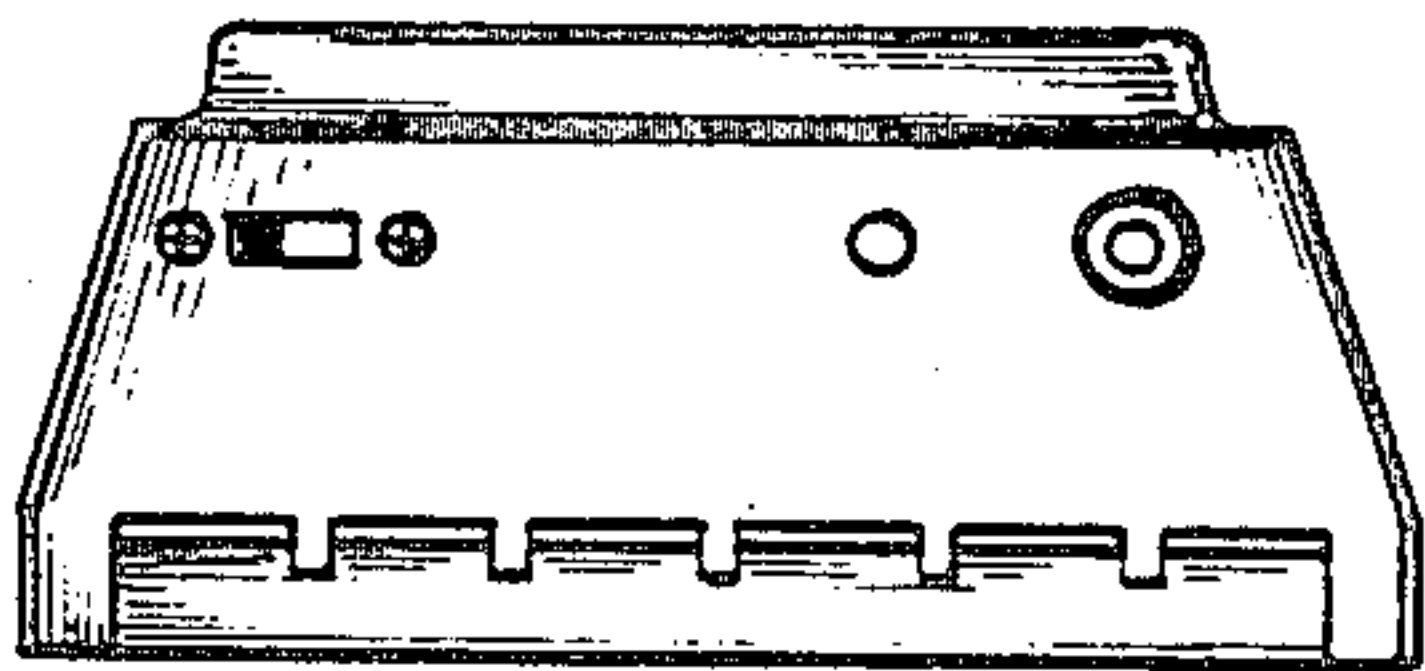
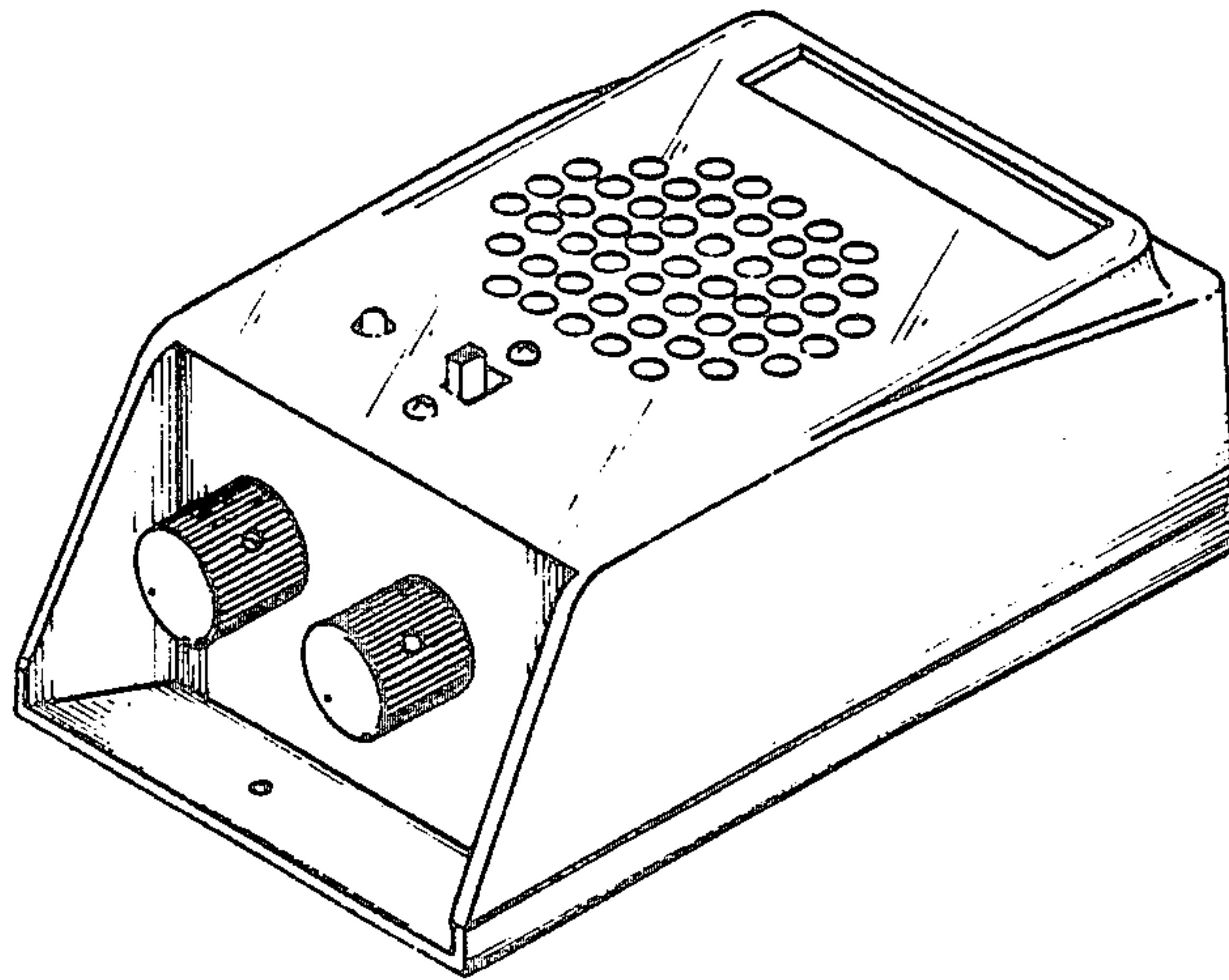

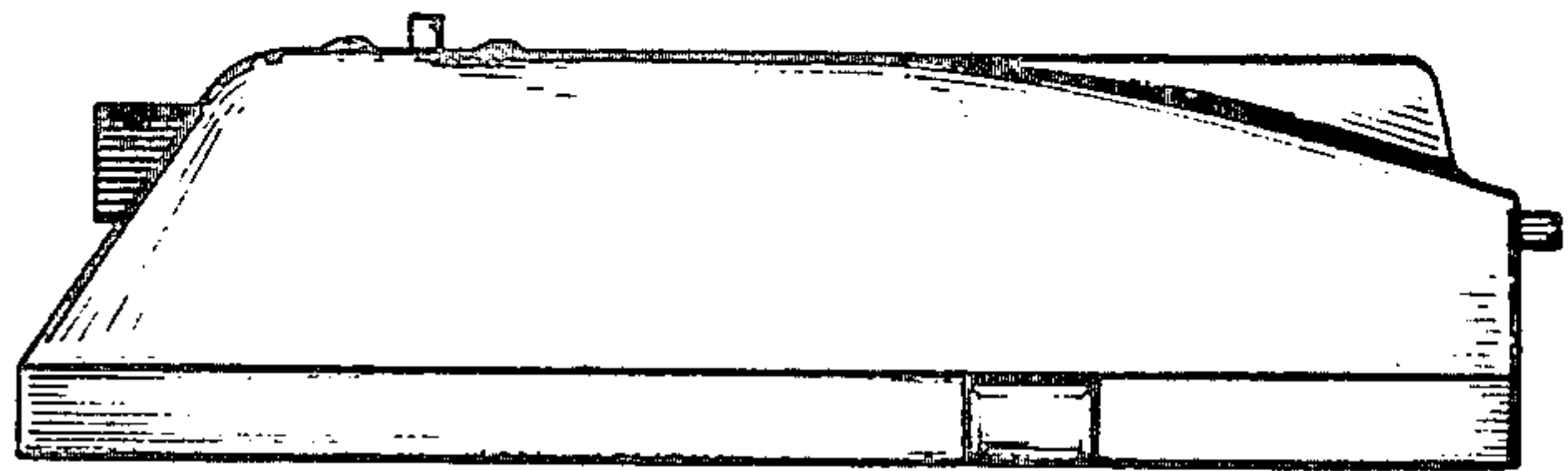

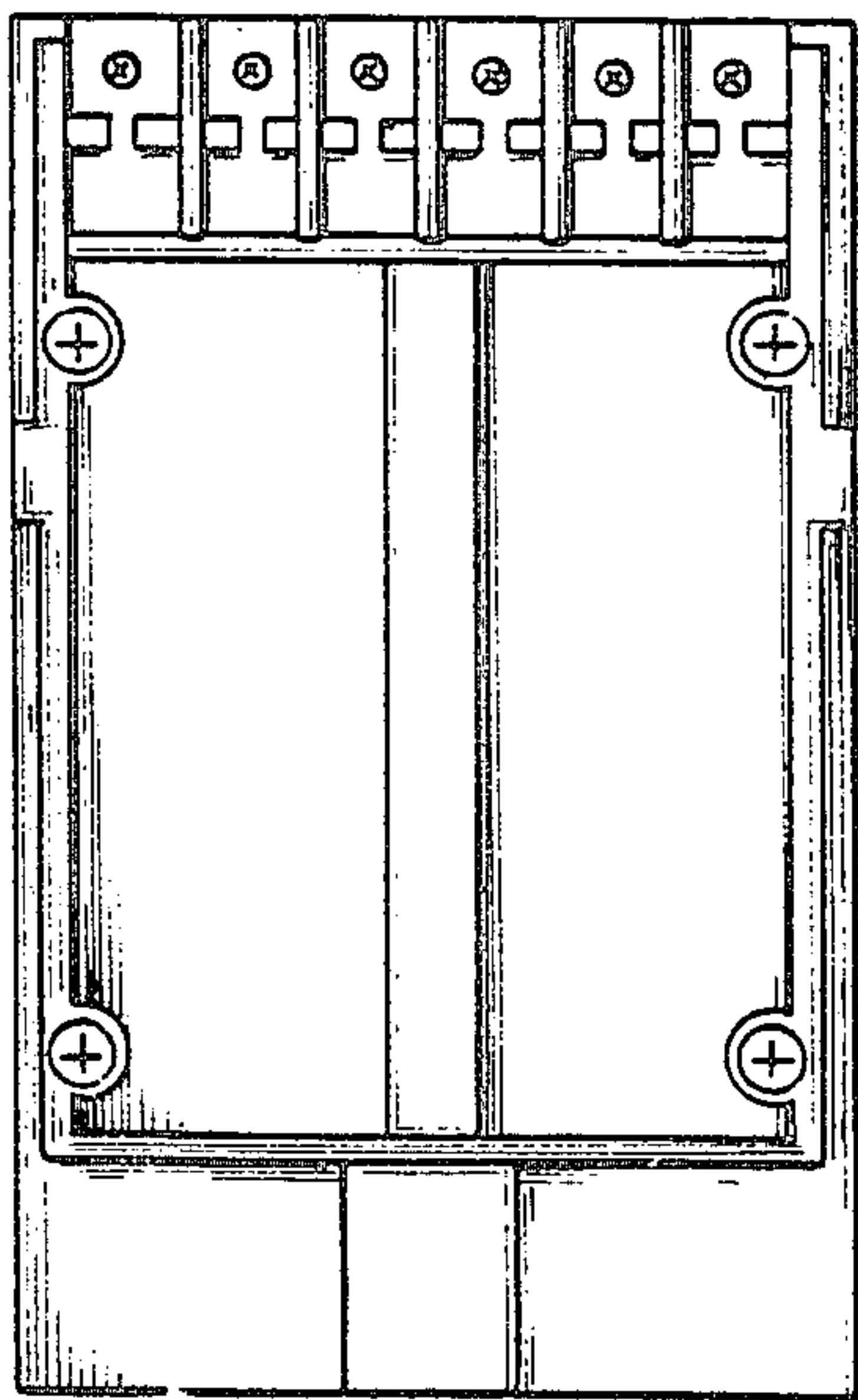
