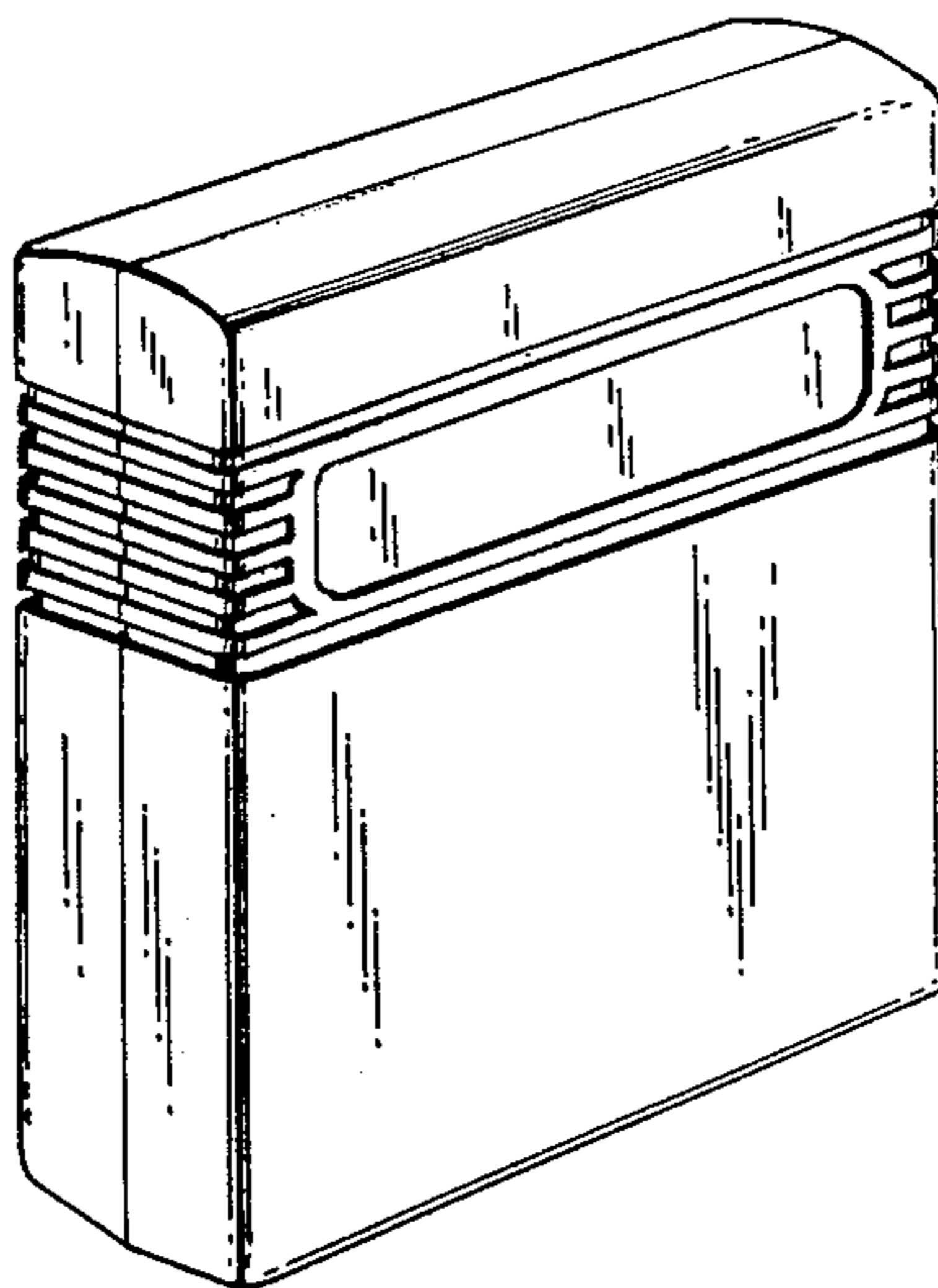

DESCRIPTION

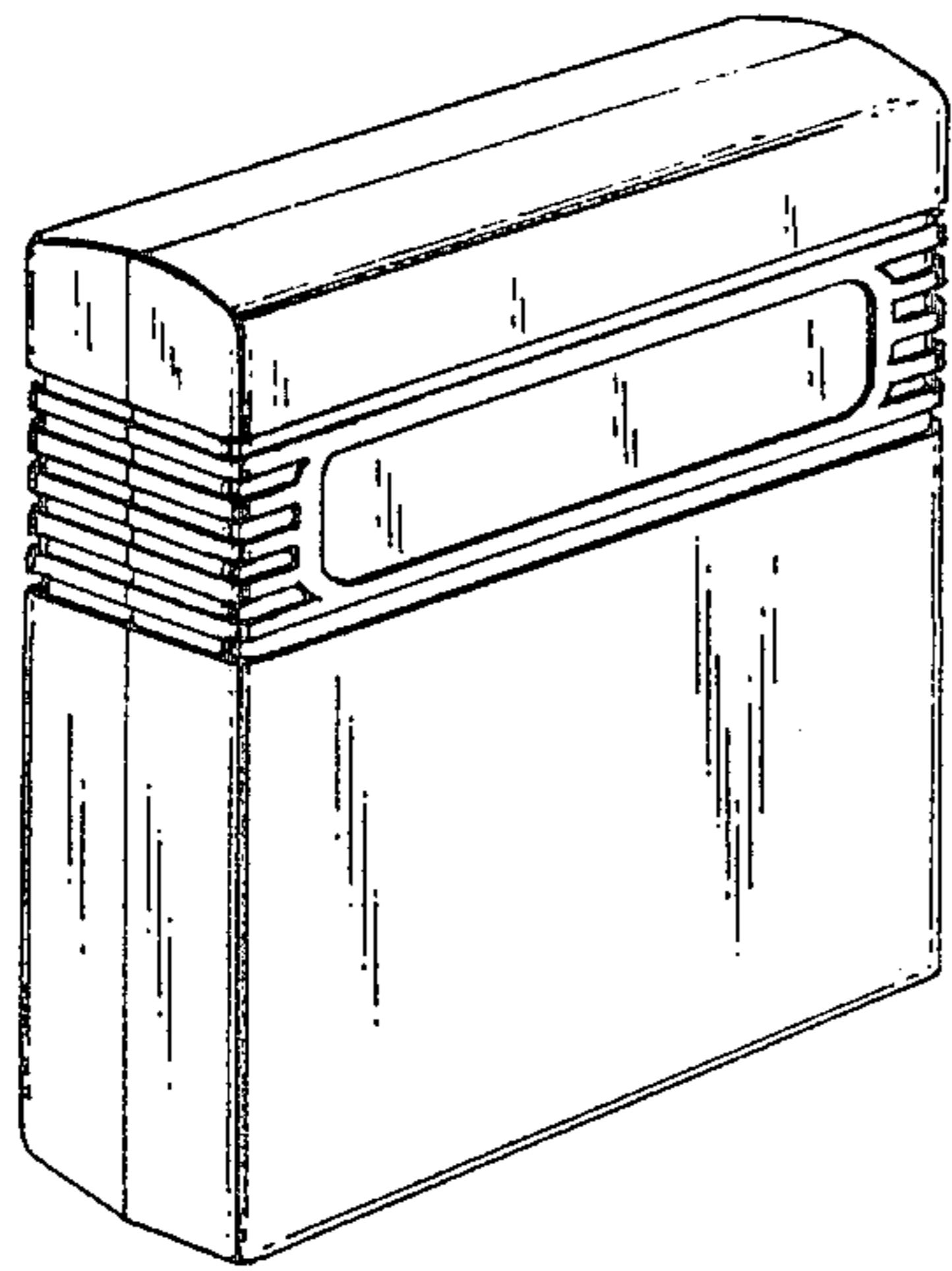

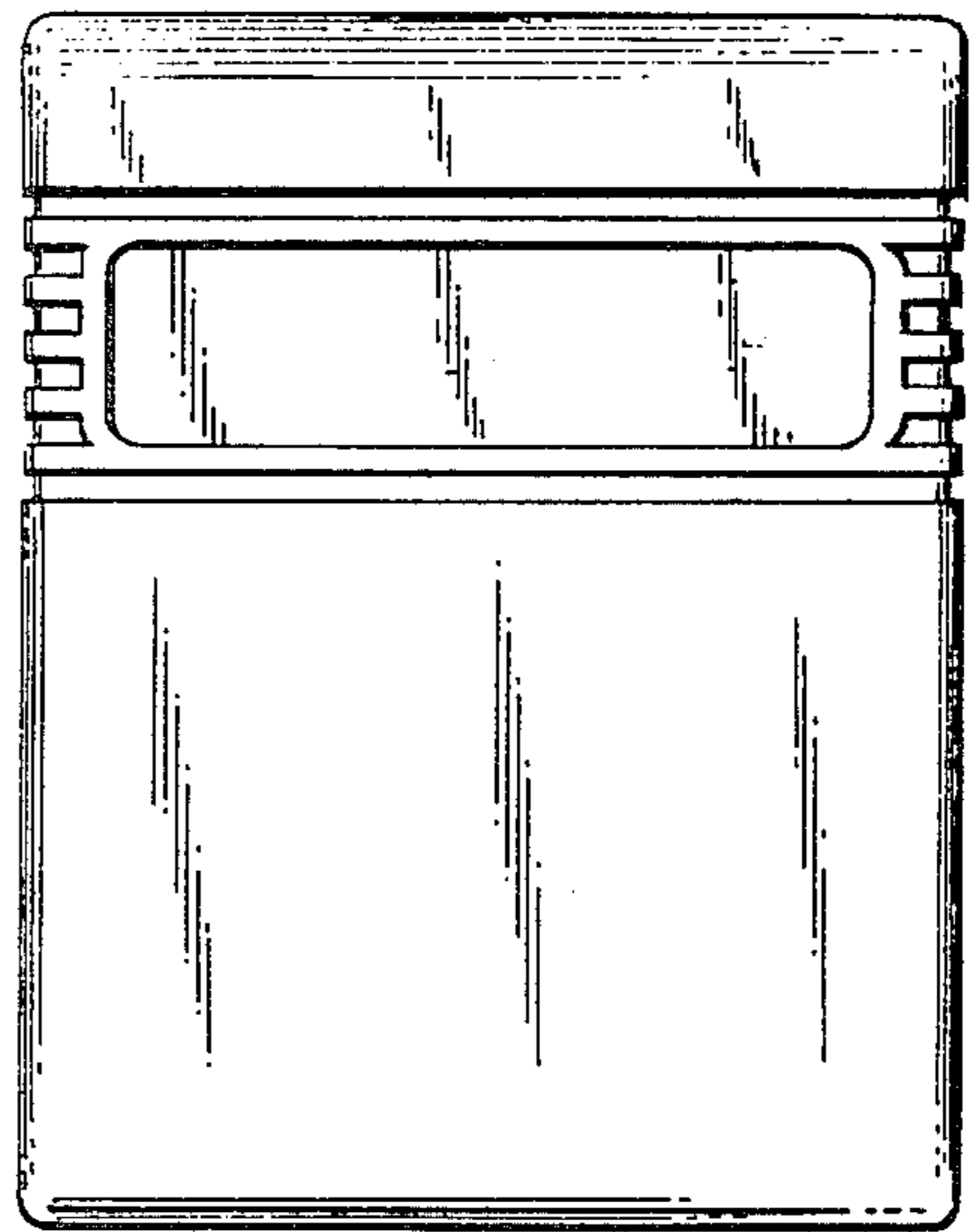

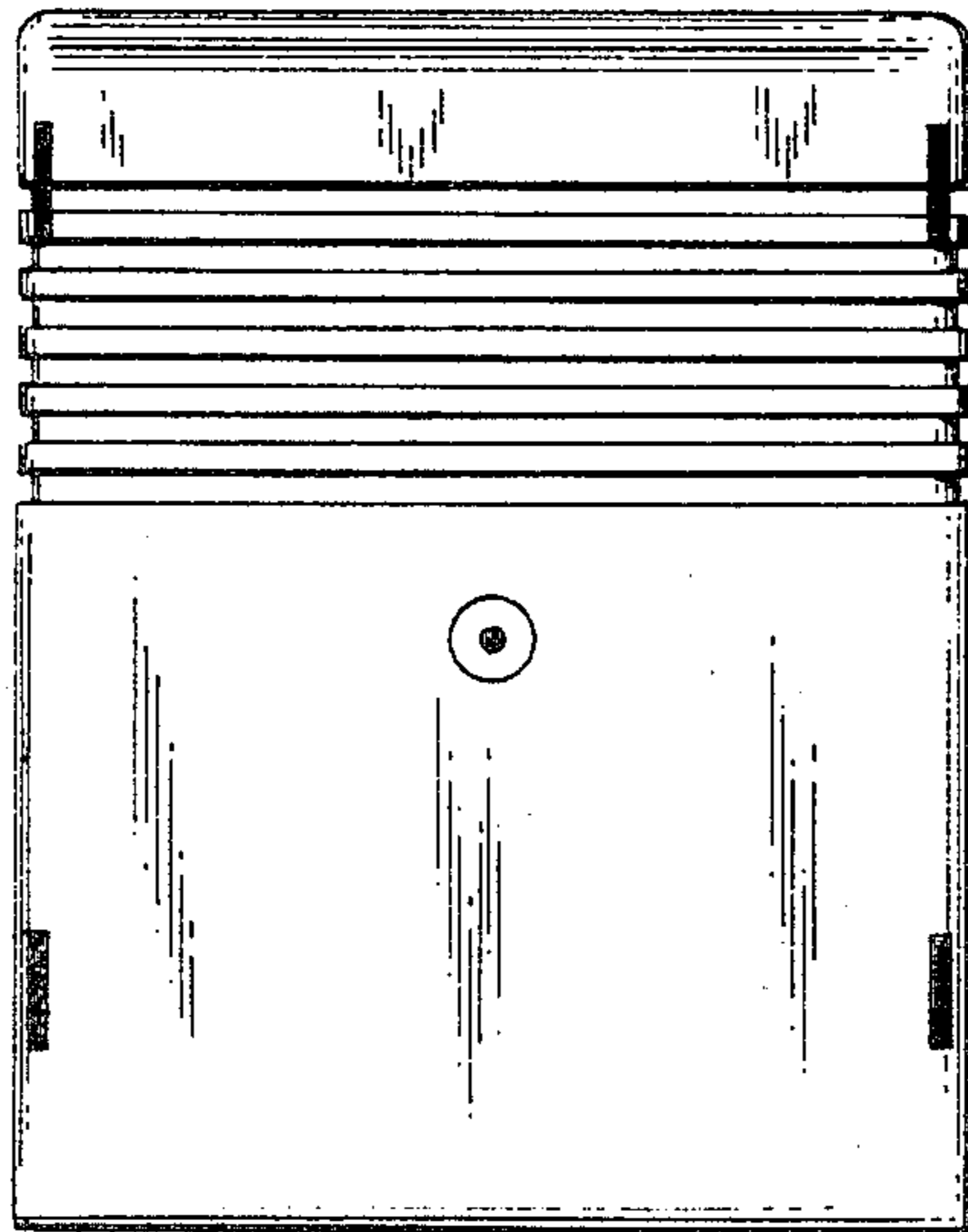

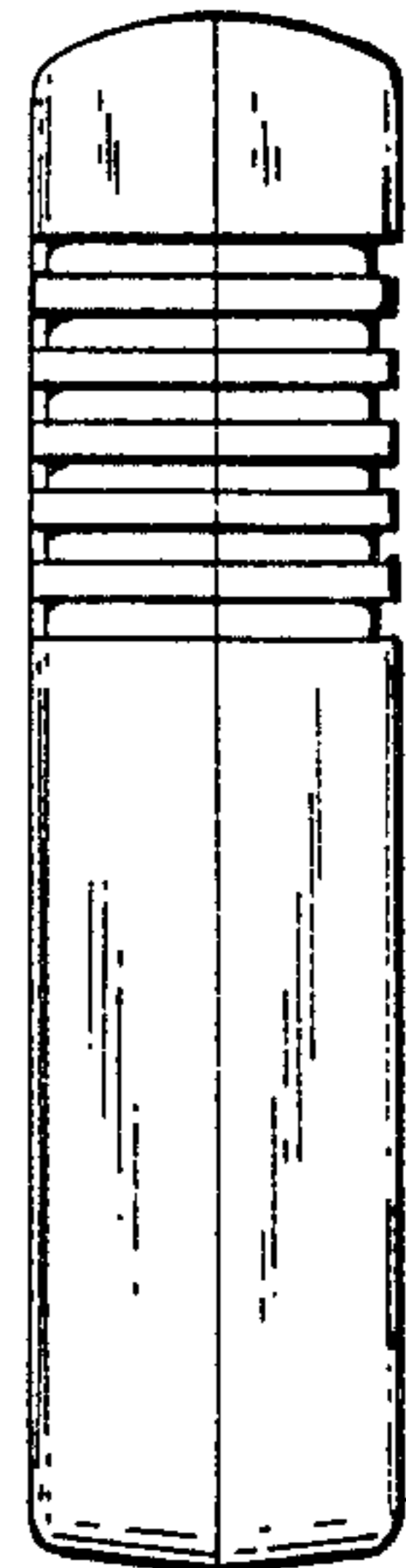

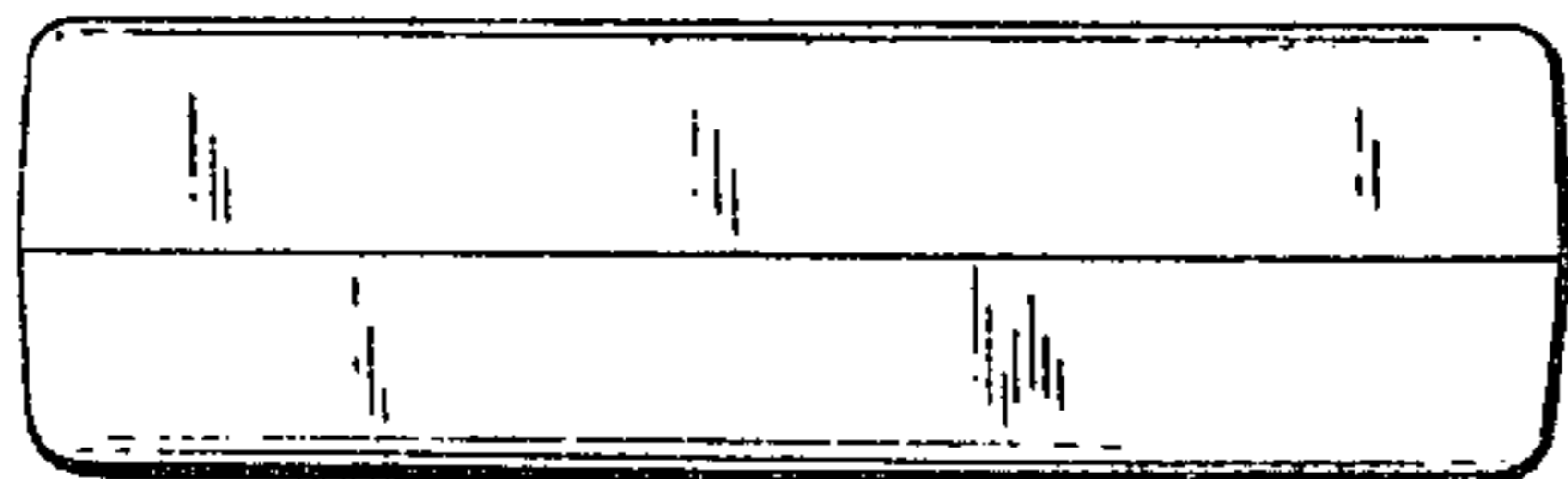

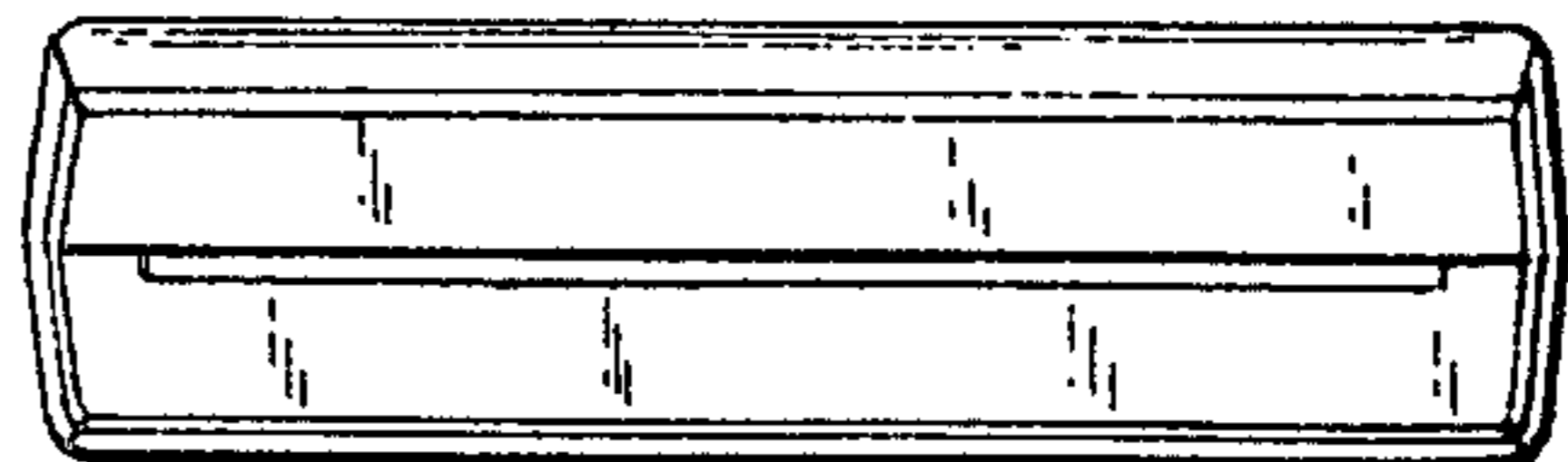
