[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a flute and piccolo player's lyre, substantially as described and shown.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view.

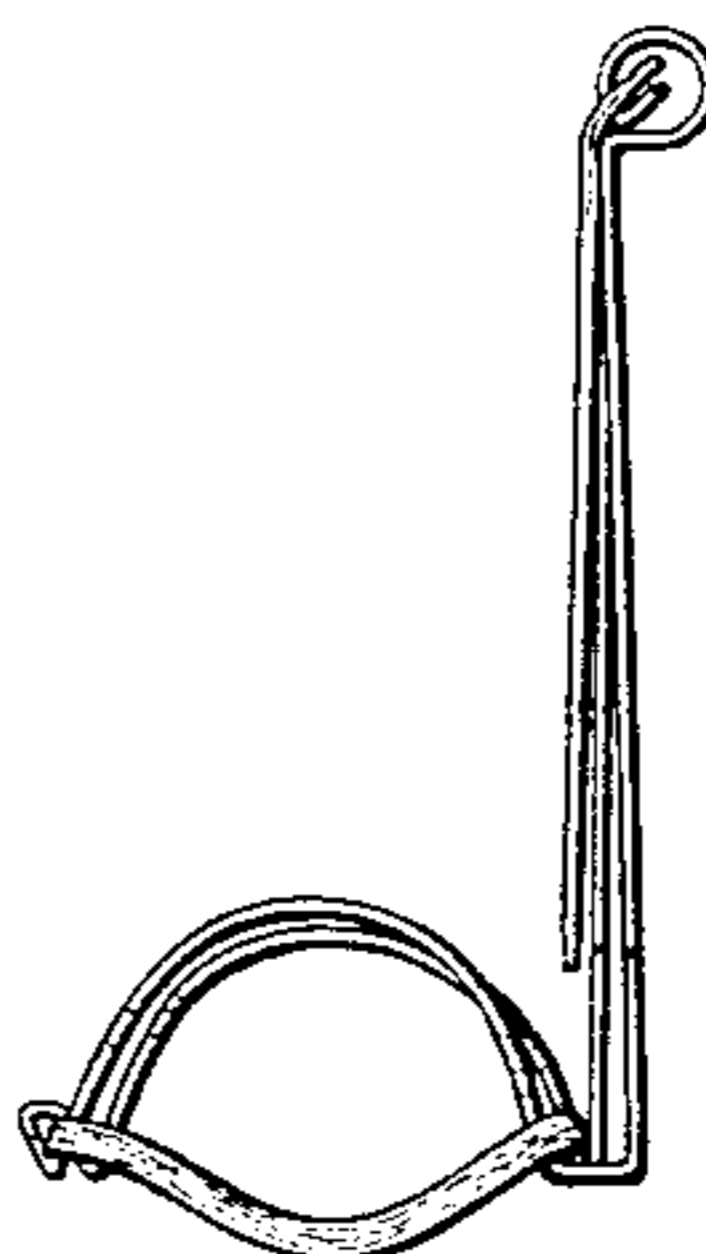
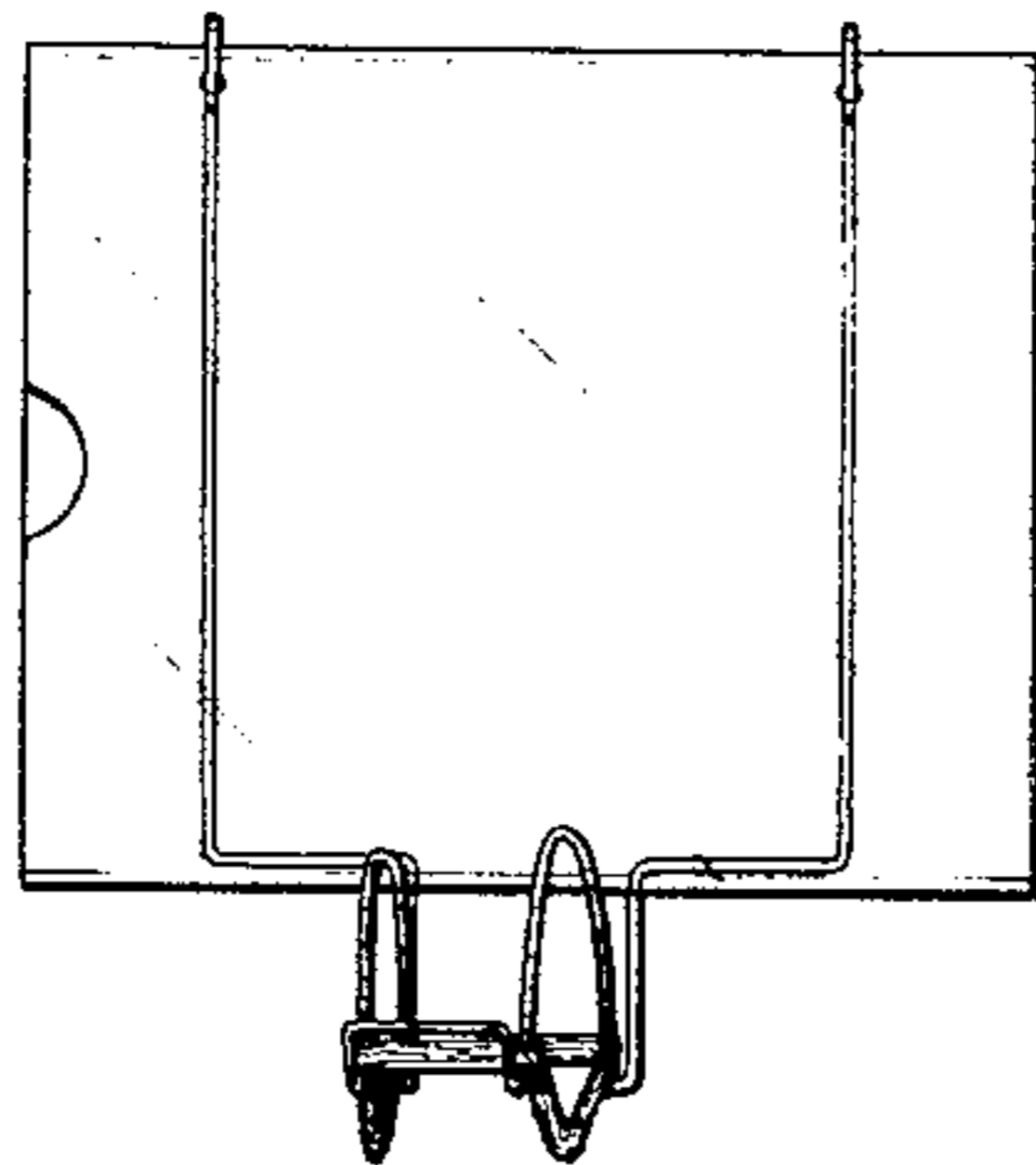

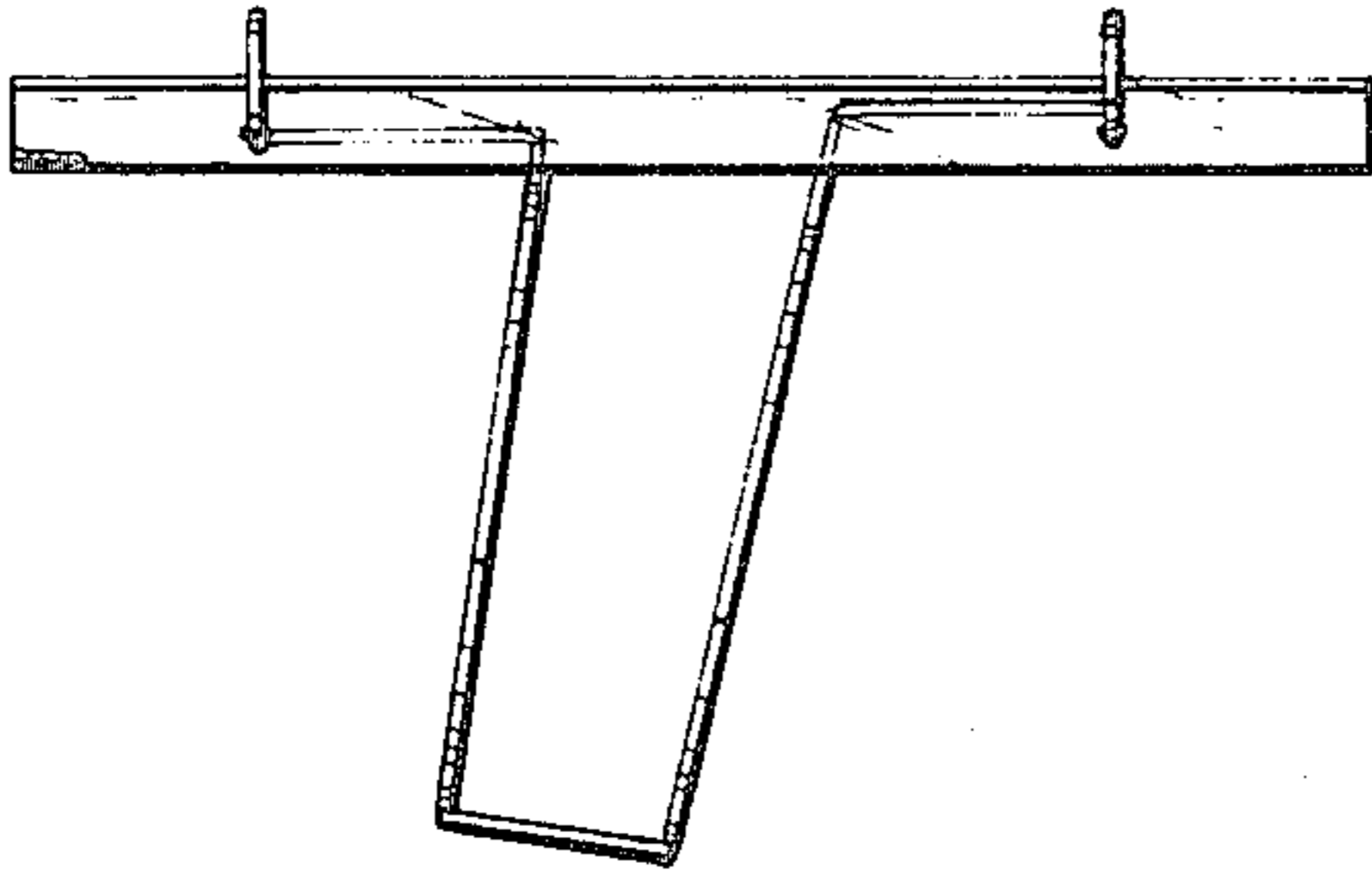

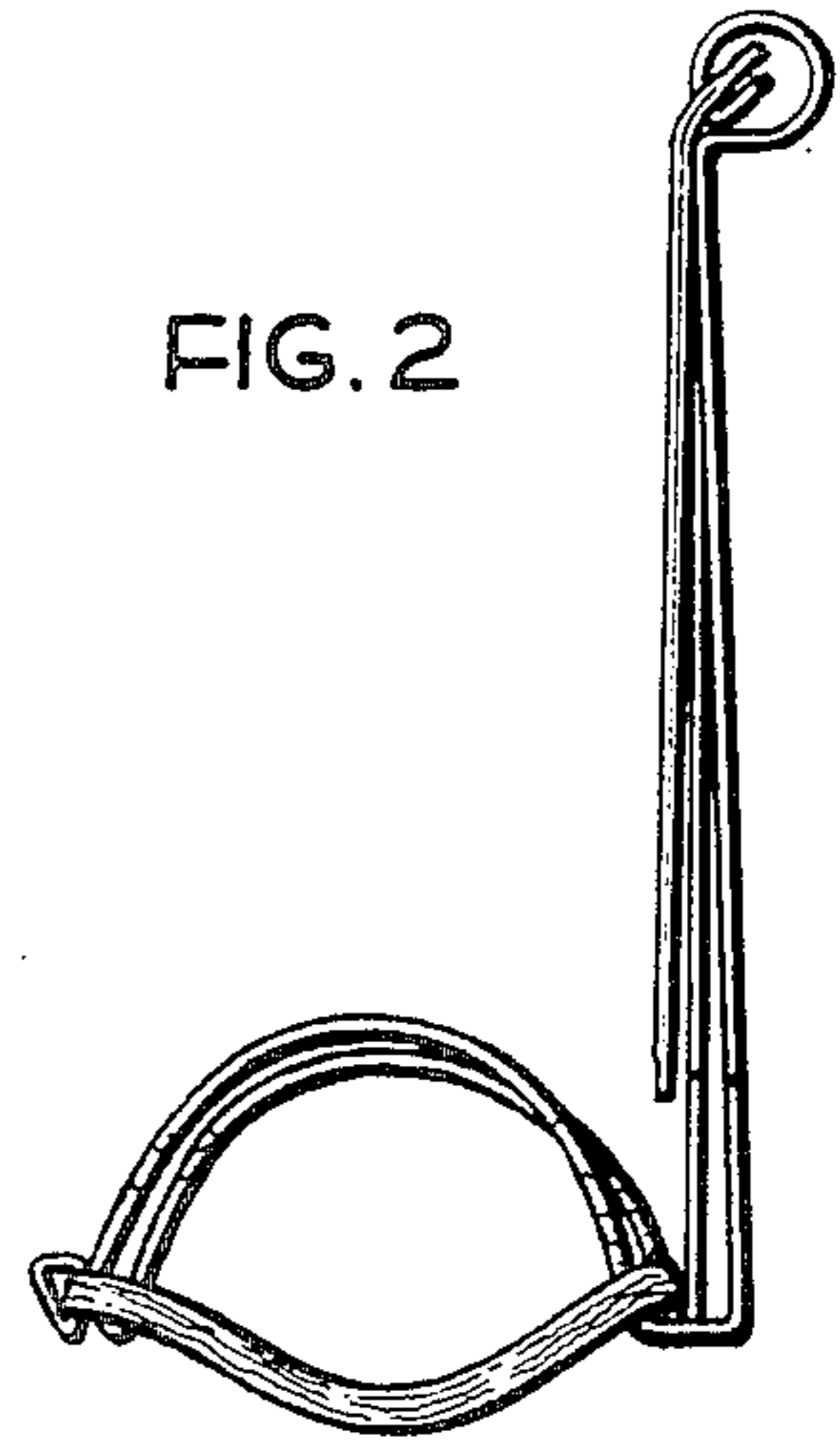

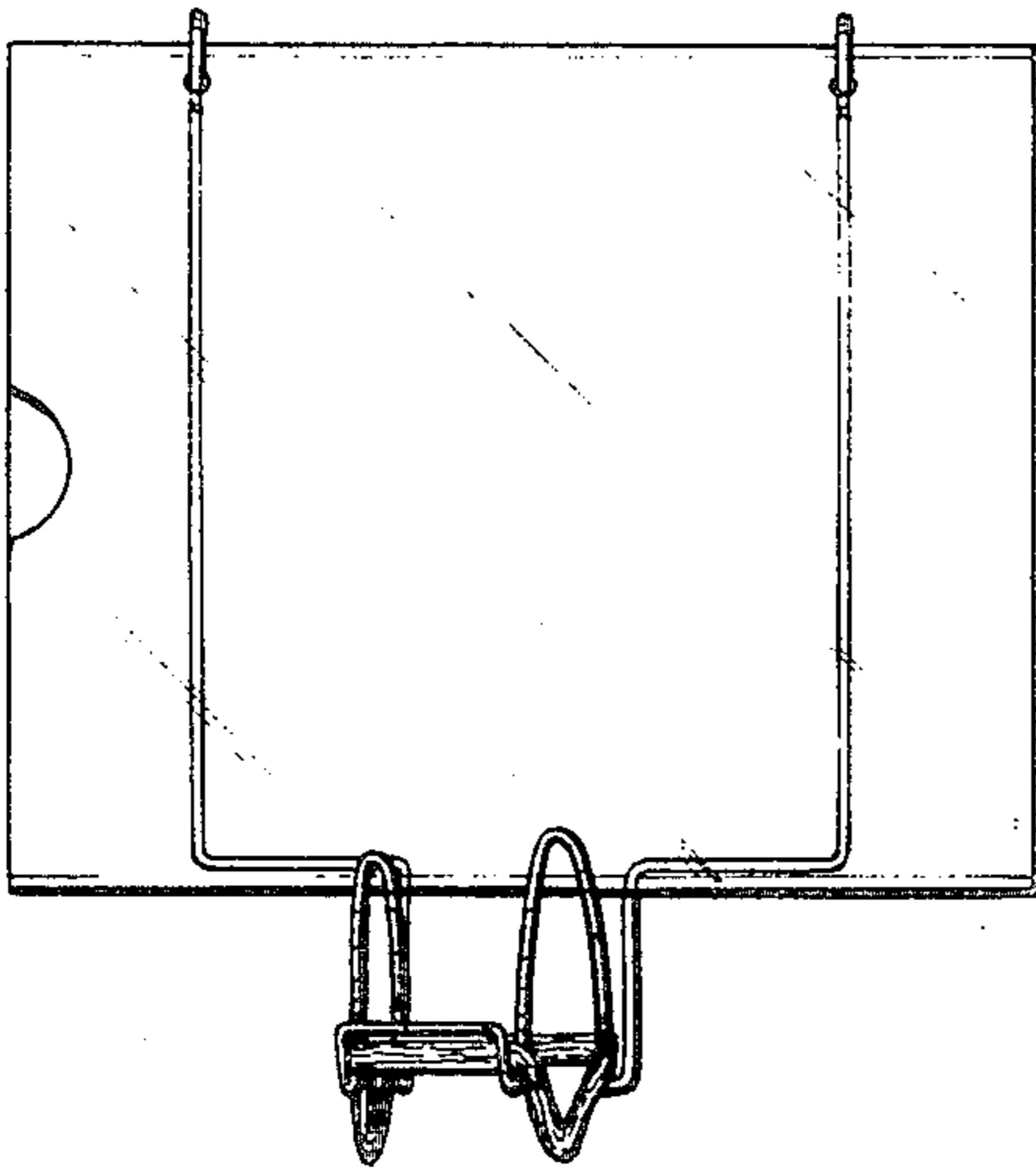

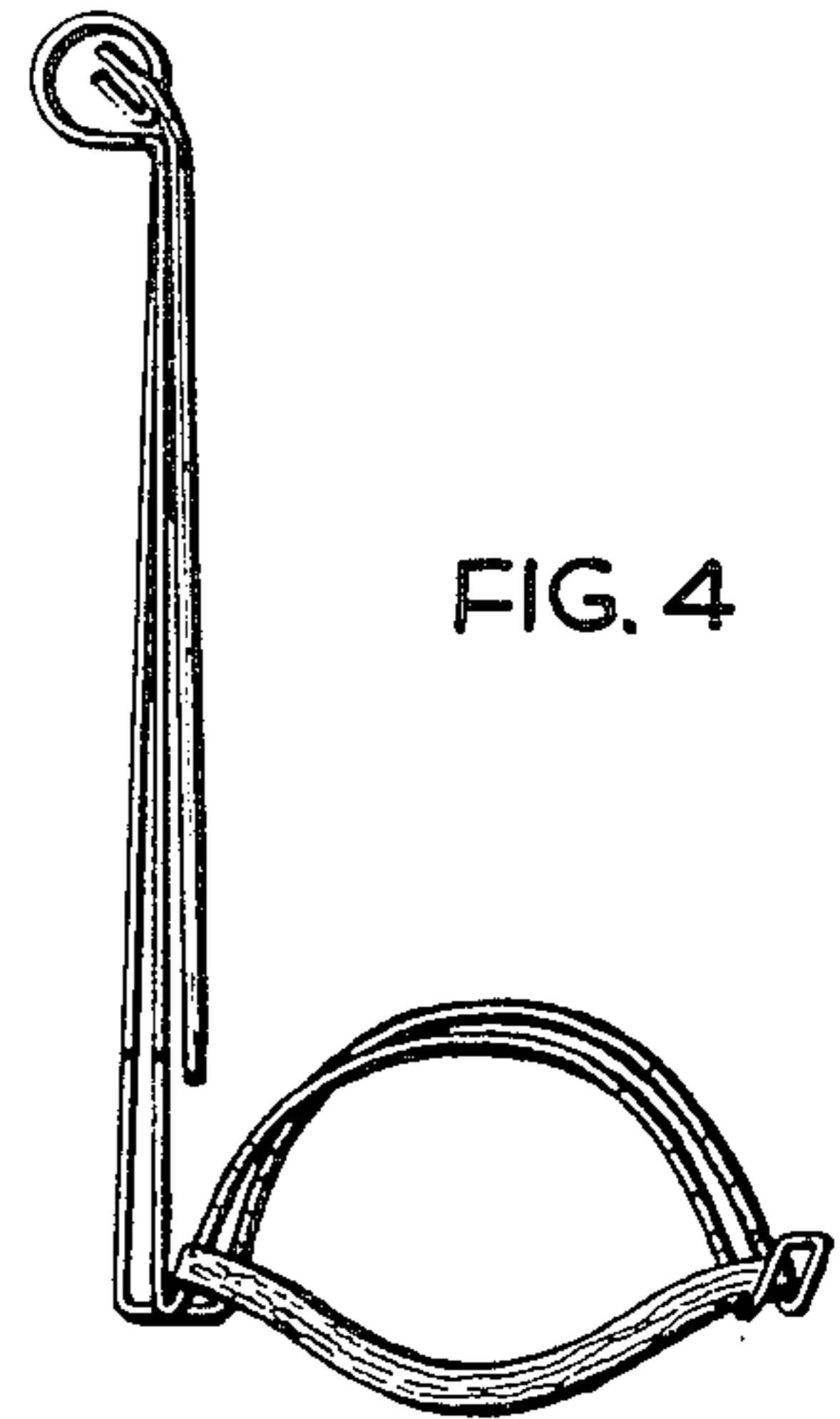
