DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a ball-point pen
showing my new design with the point extended;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof with the point
retracted; and
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left
side being a mirror image thereof.

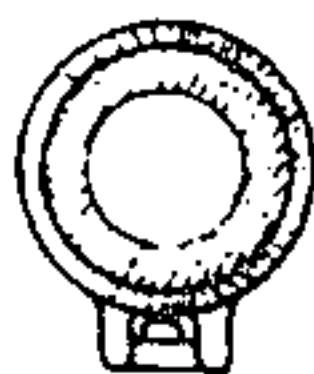

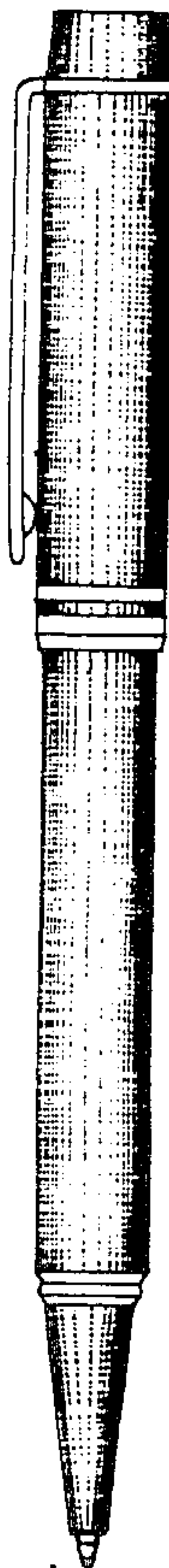
