FIG. 2 illustrates a rear perspective view thereof.

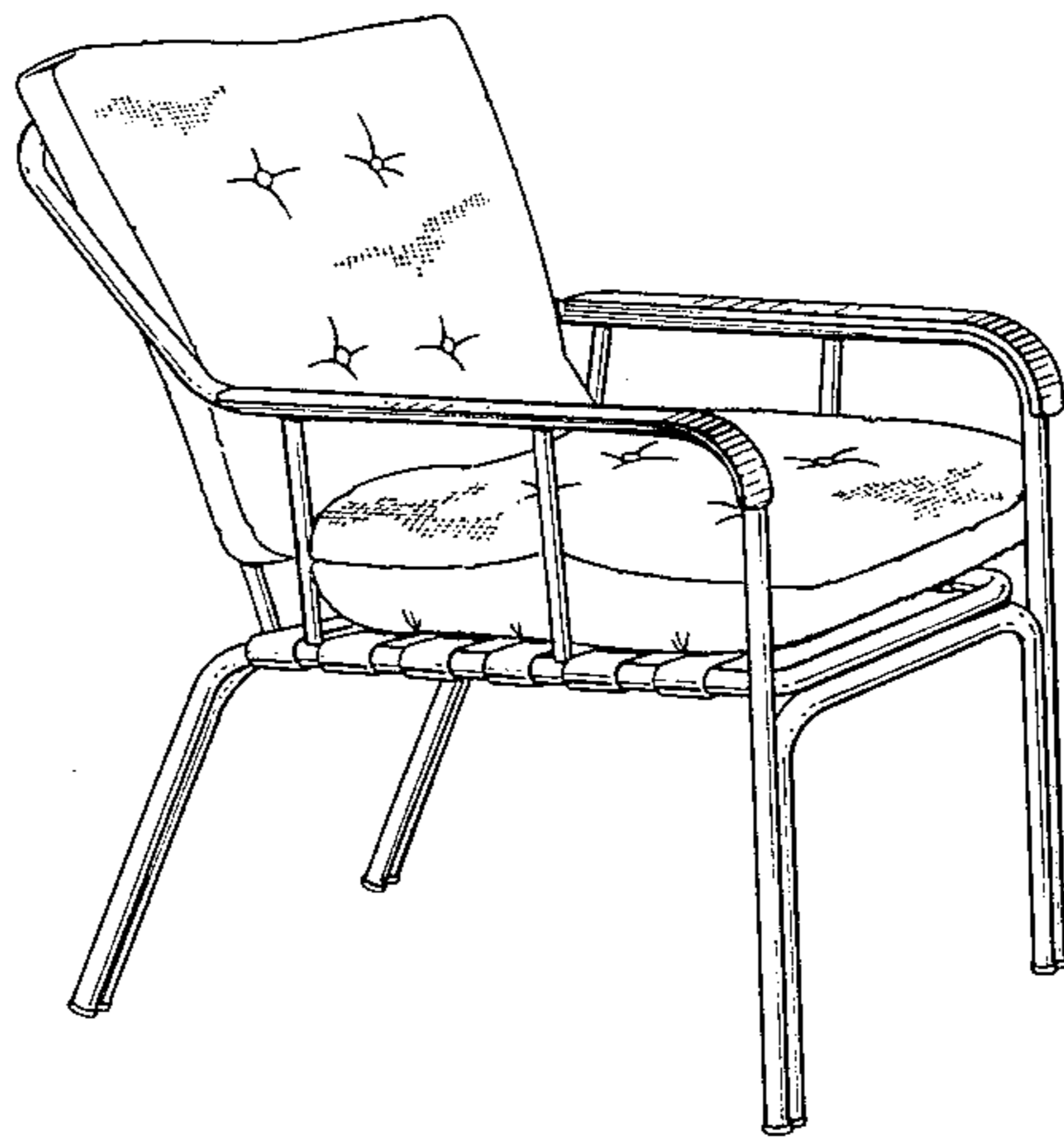

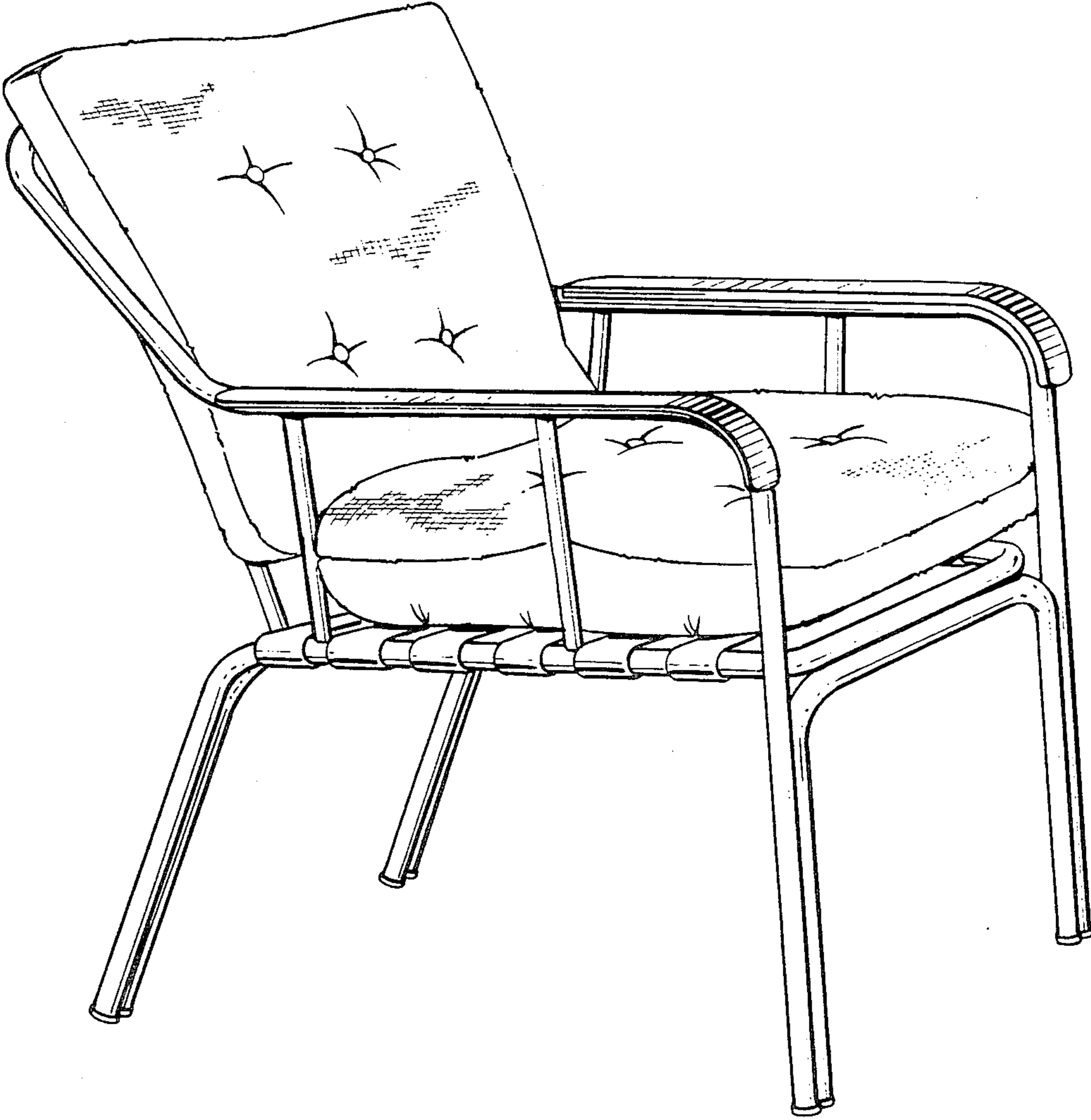
