FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a casserole showing my new design;

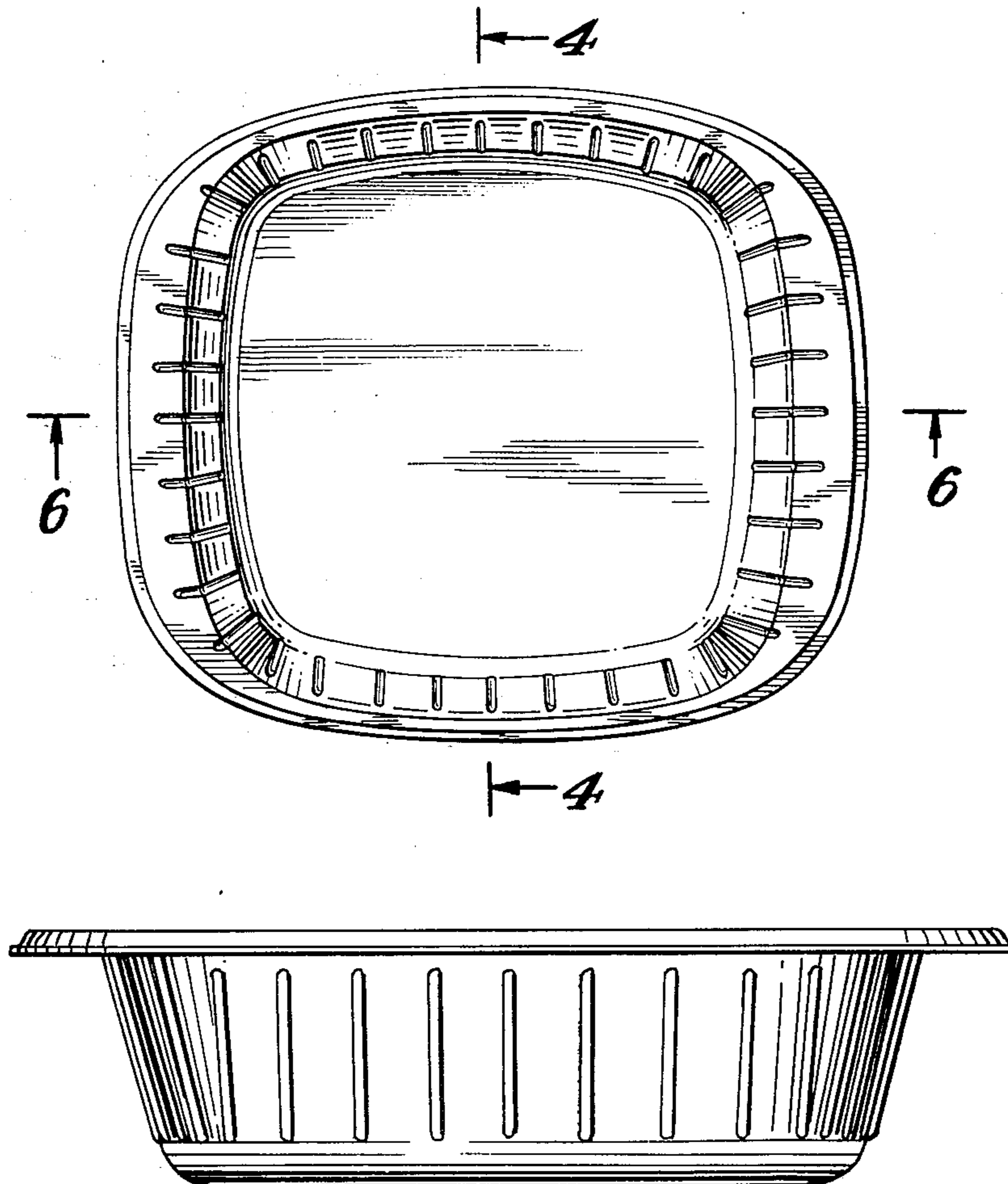
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view thereof taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1.



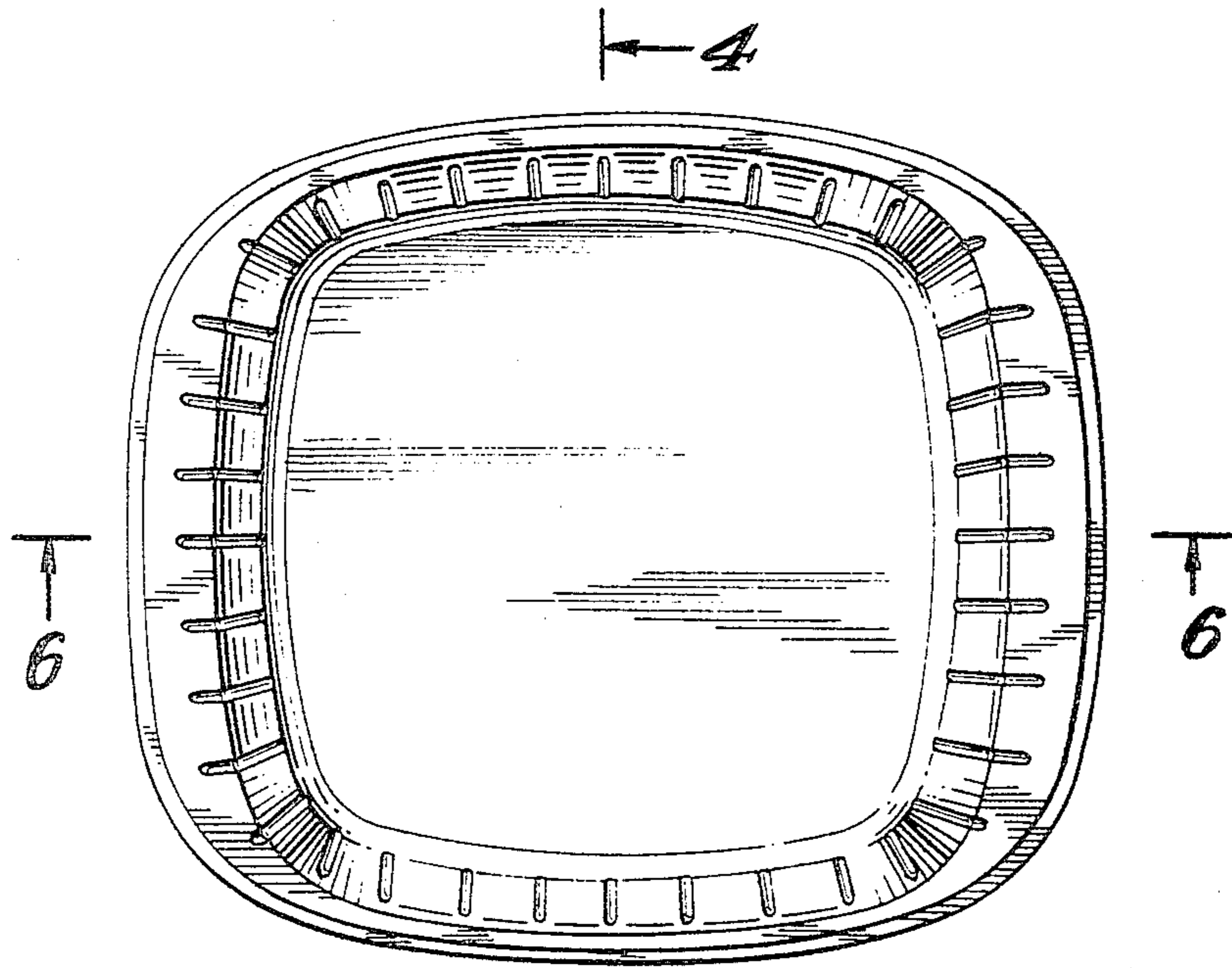

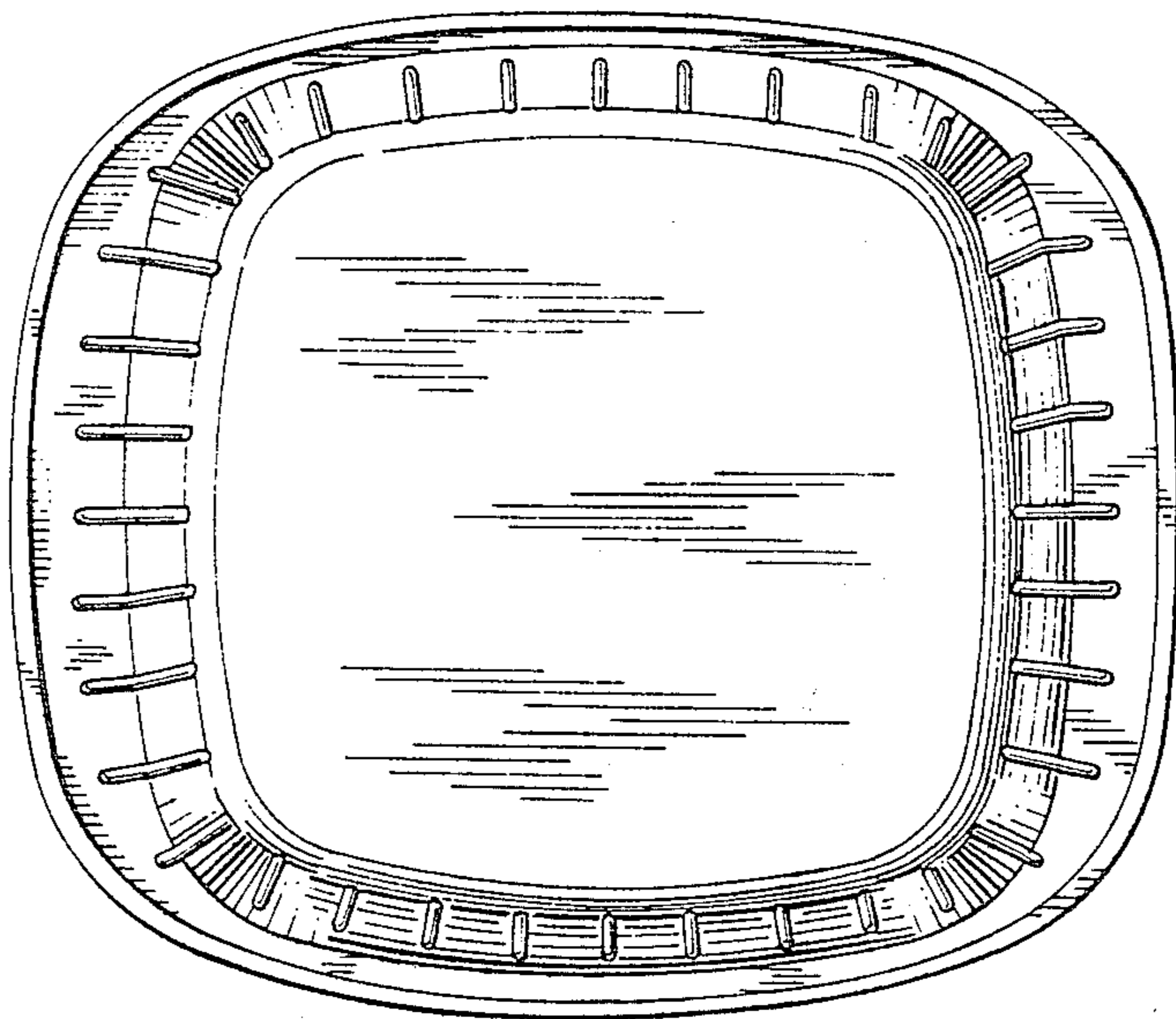

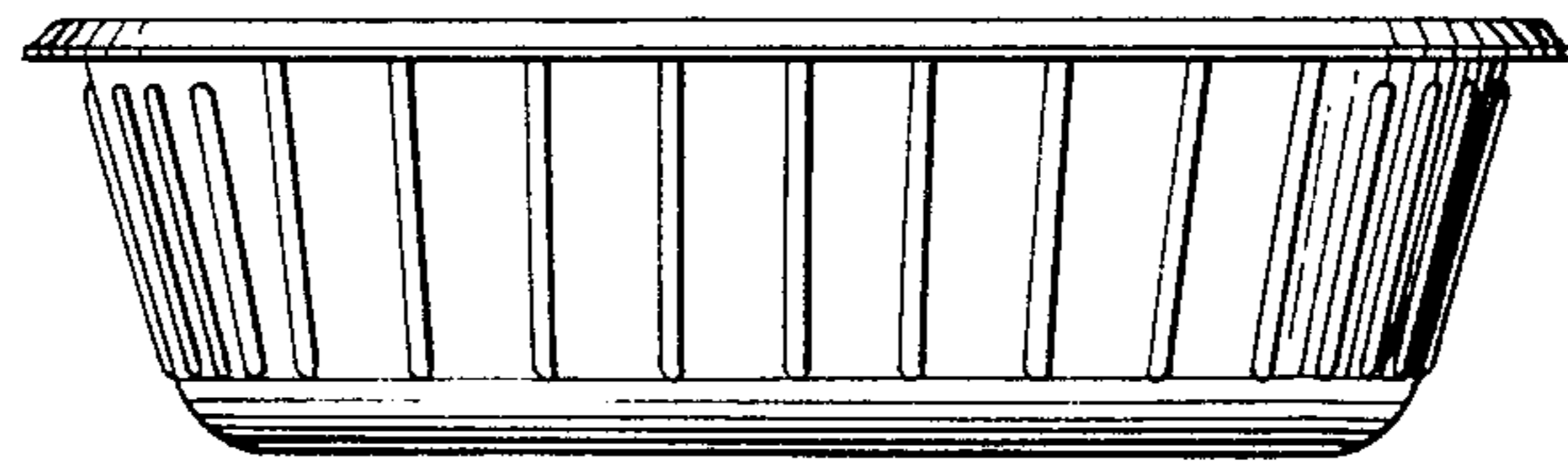

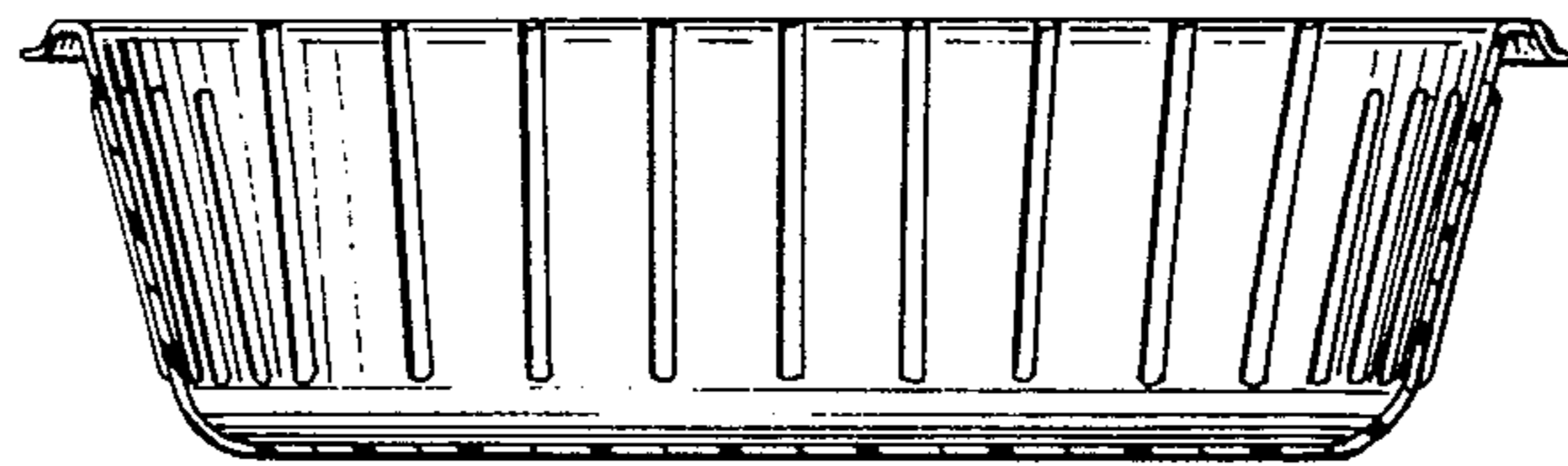

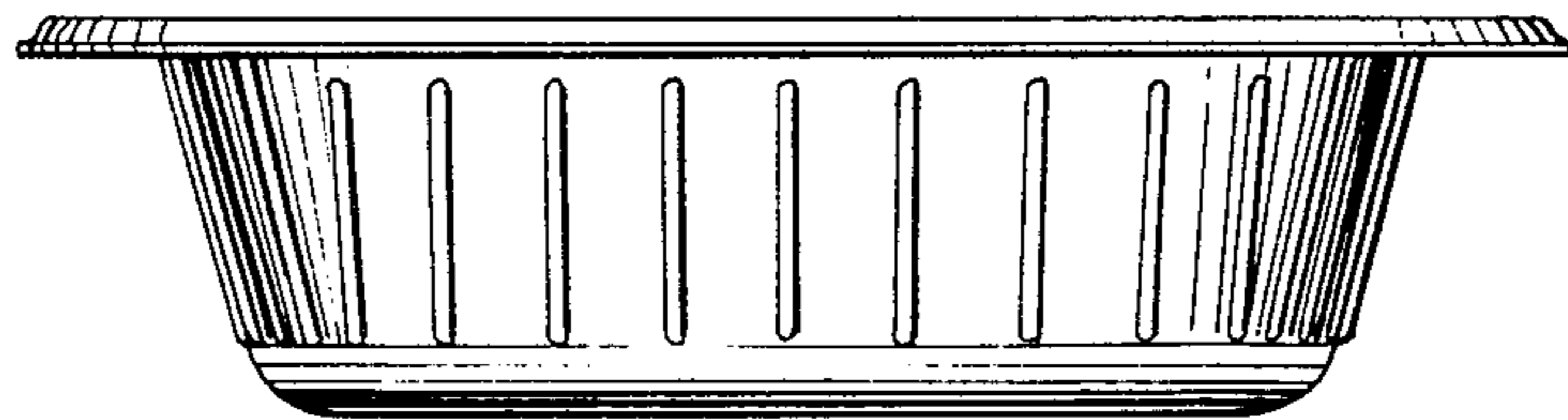

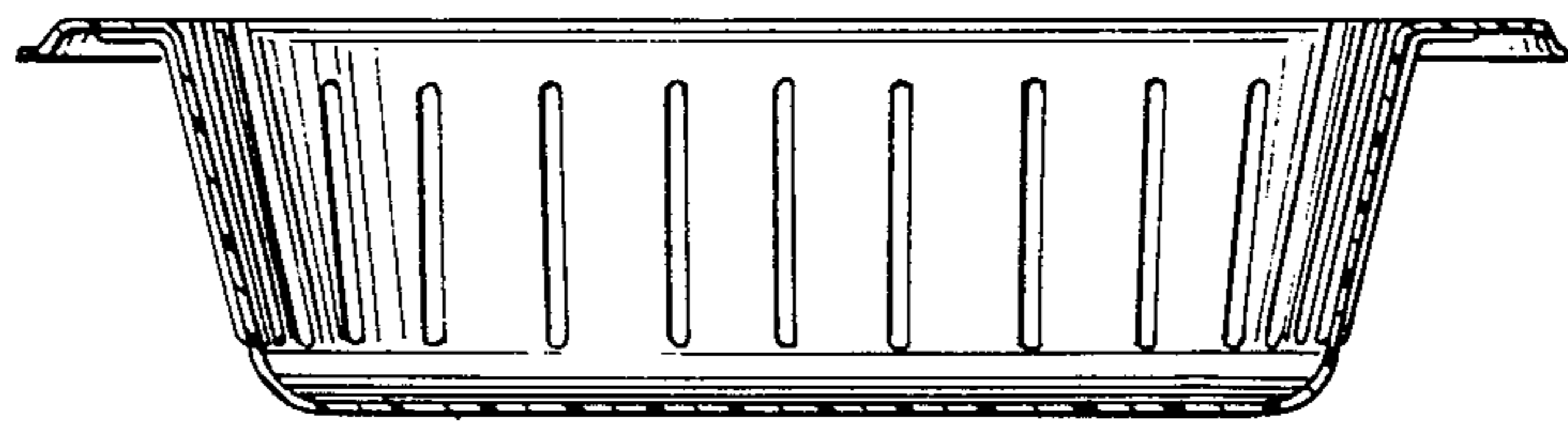
