The ornamental design for a combined bottle and cap,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a combined bottle and cap embodying our new design, the opposite side being substantially the same in appearance;

FIG. 2 is a view looking from the right of FIG. 1, the opposite side being substantially the same in appearance;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary view of a portion of FIG. 3;

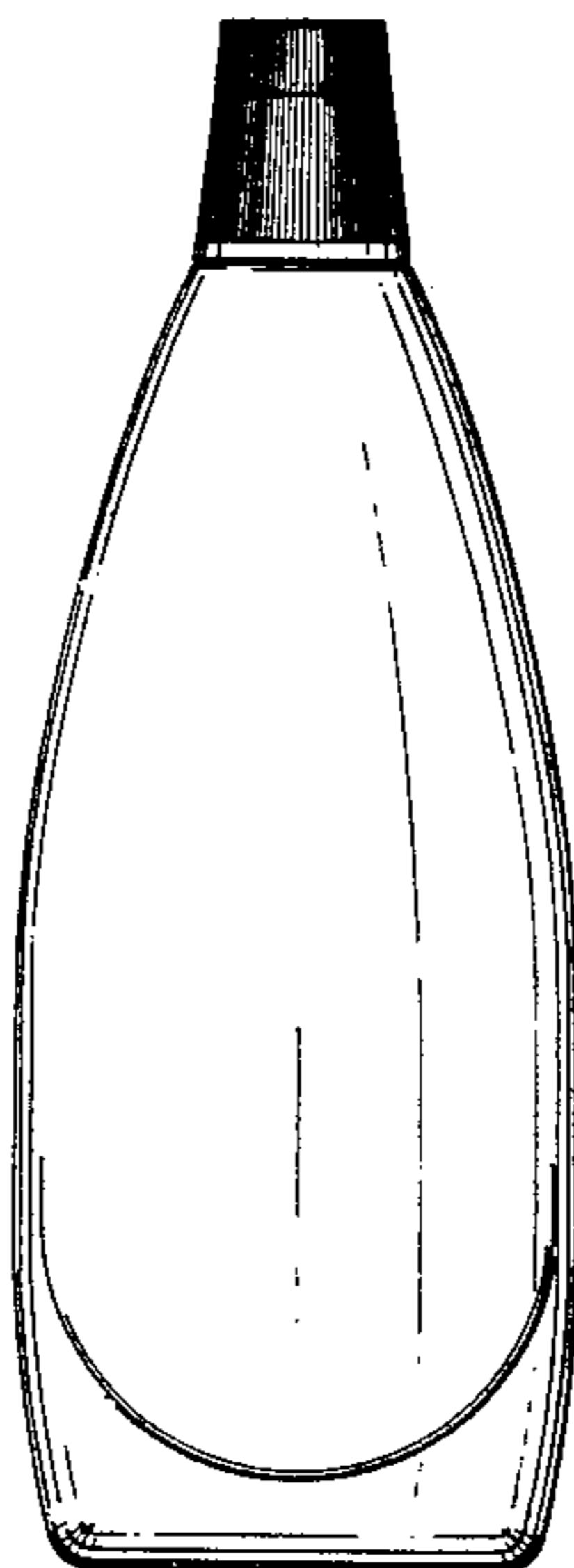
FIG. 5 is an elevational view with the cap removed;

FIG. 6 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken on the line 9—9 of FIG. 5.



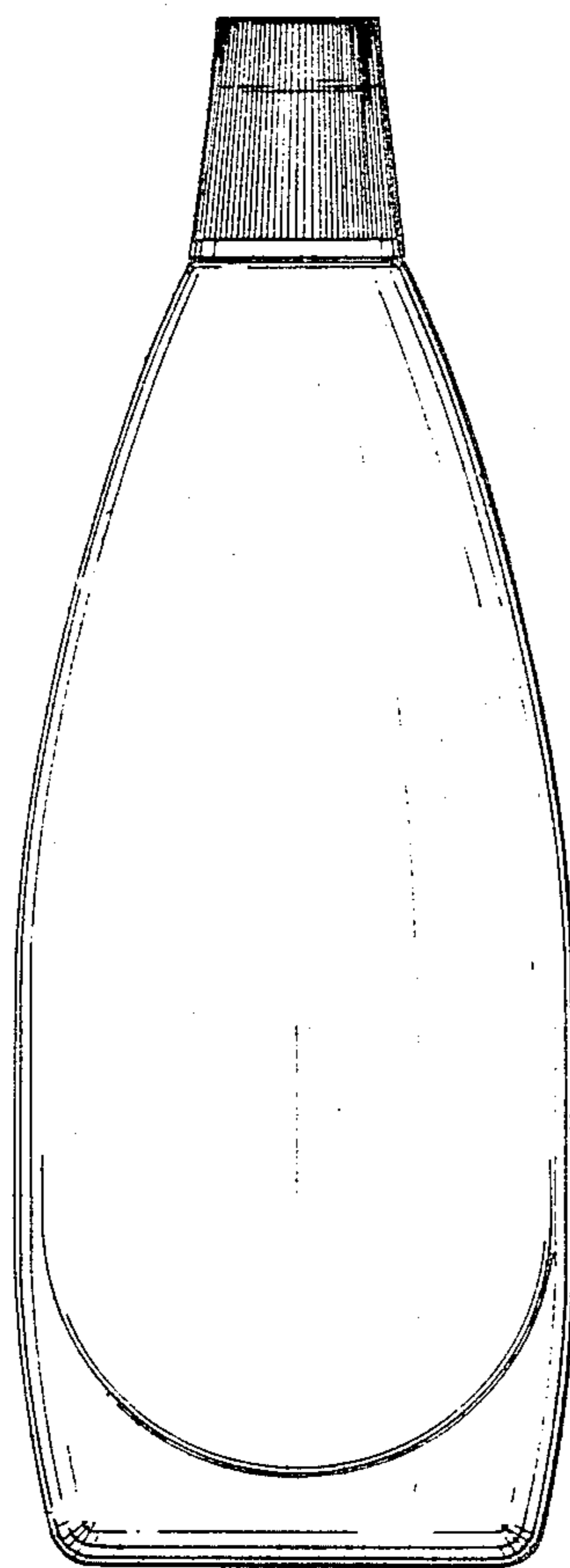

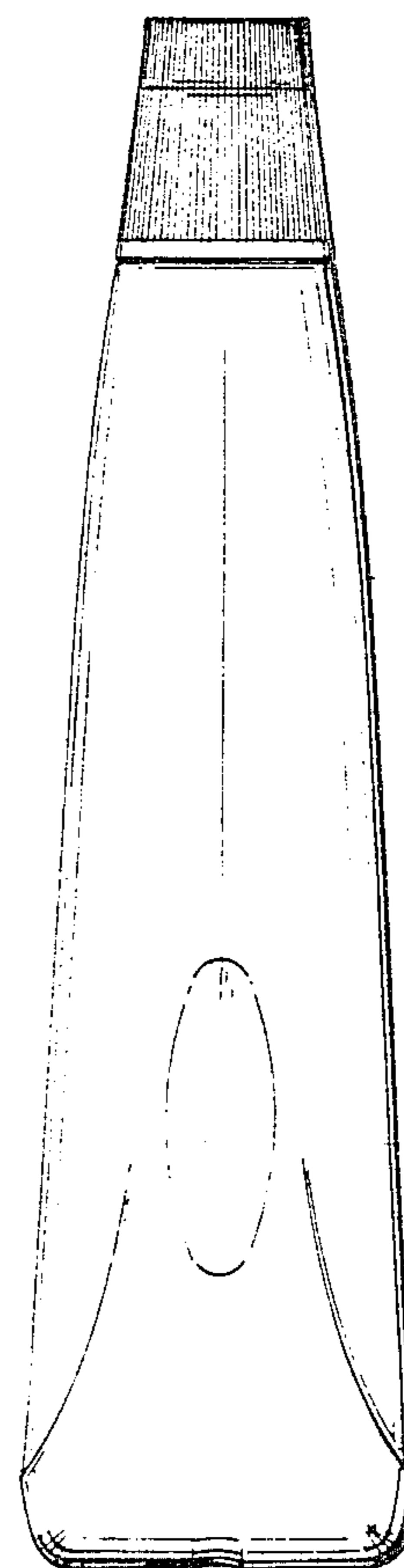

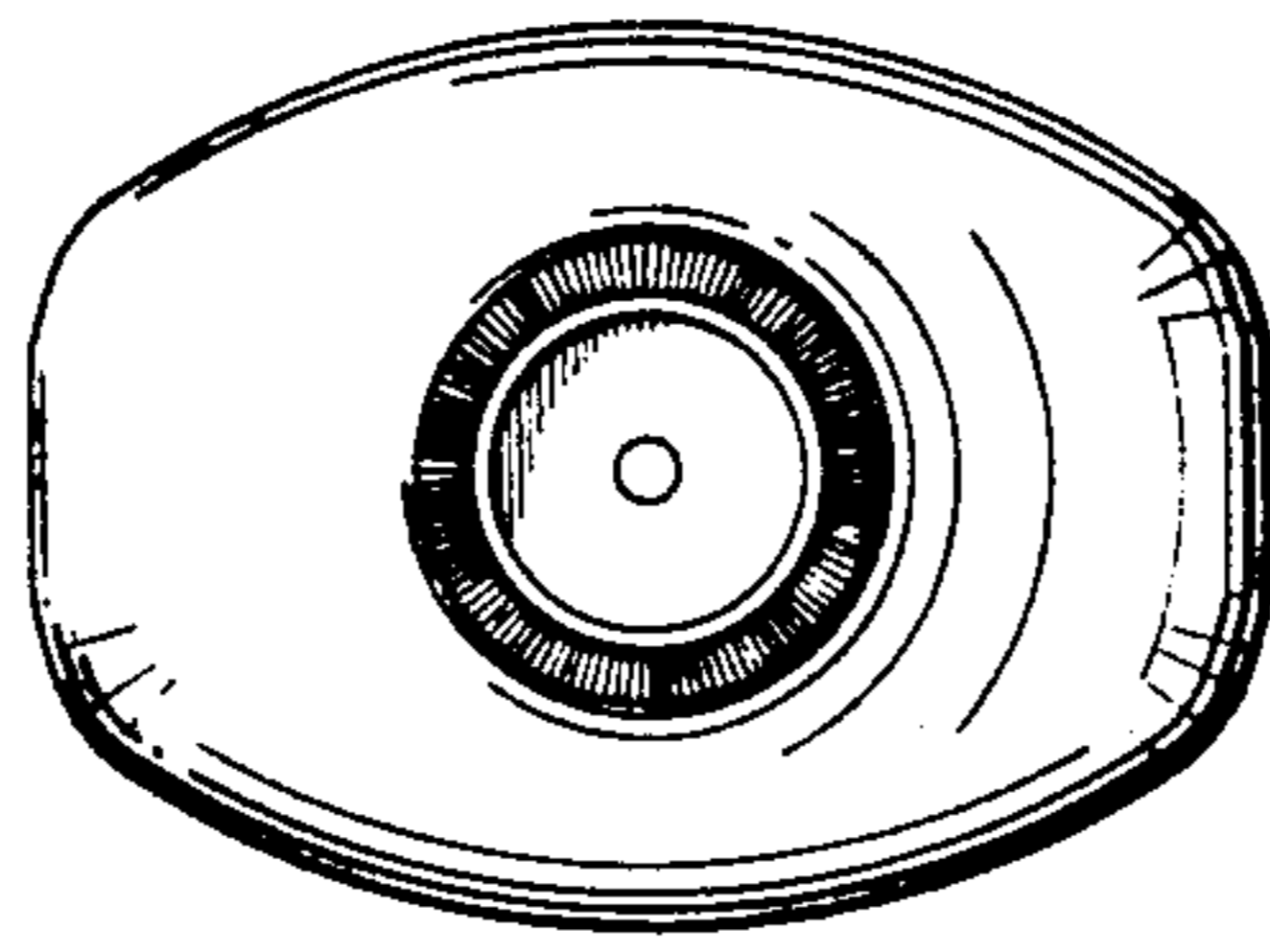

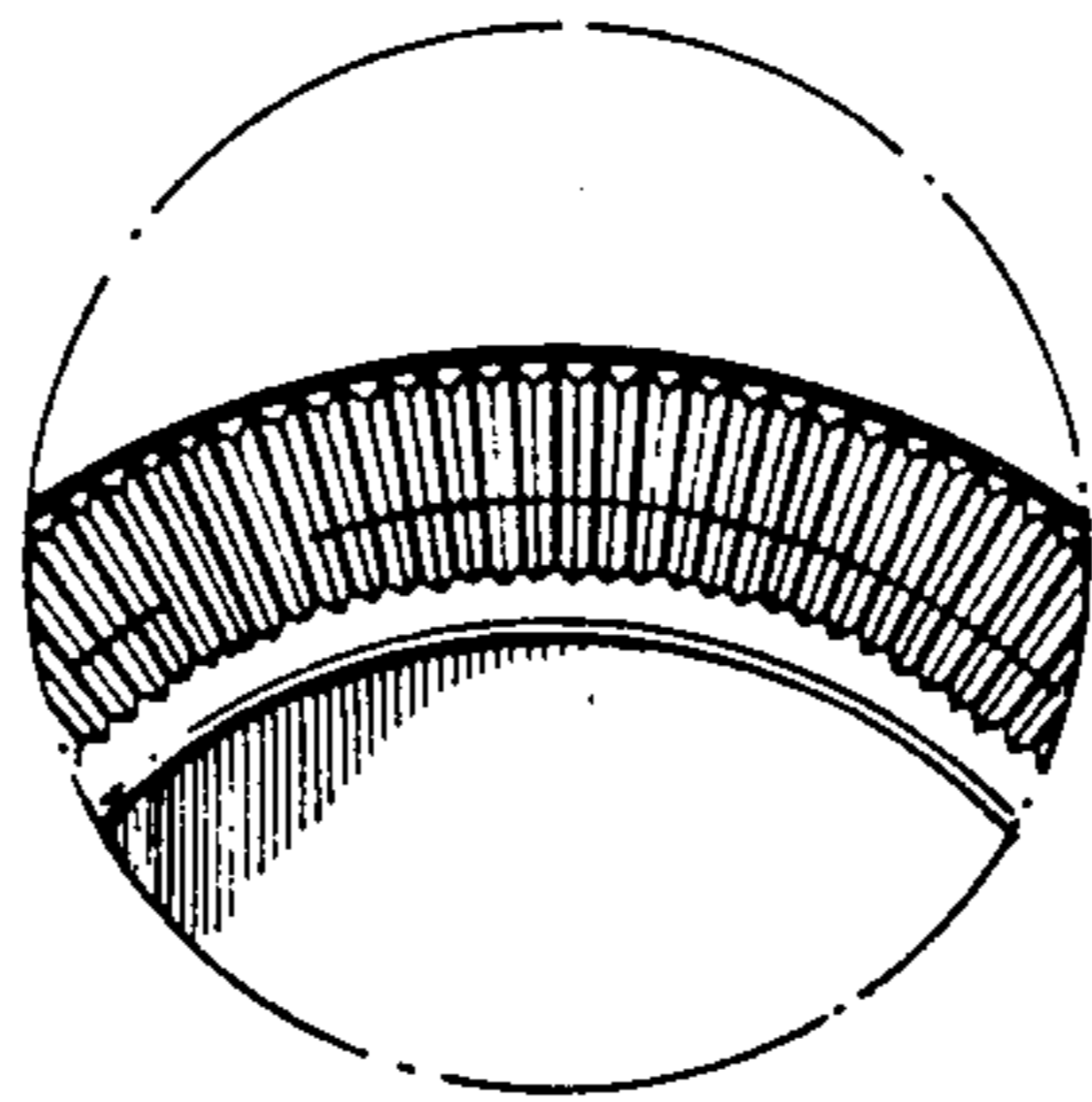

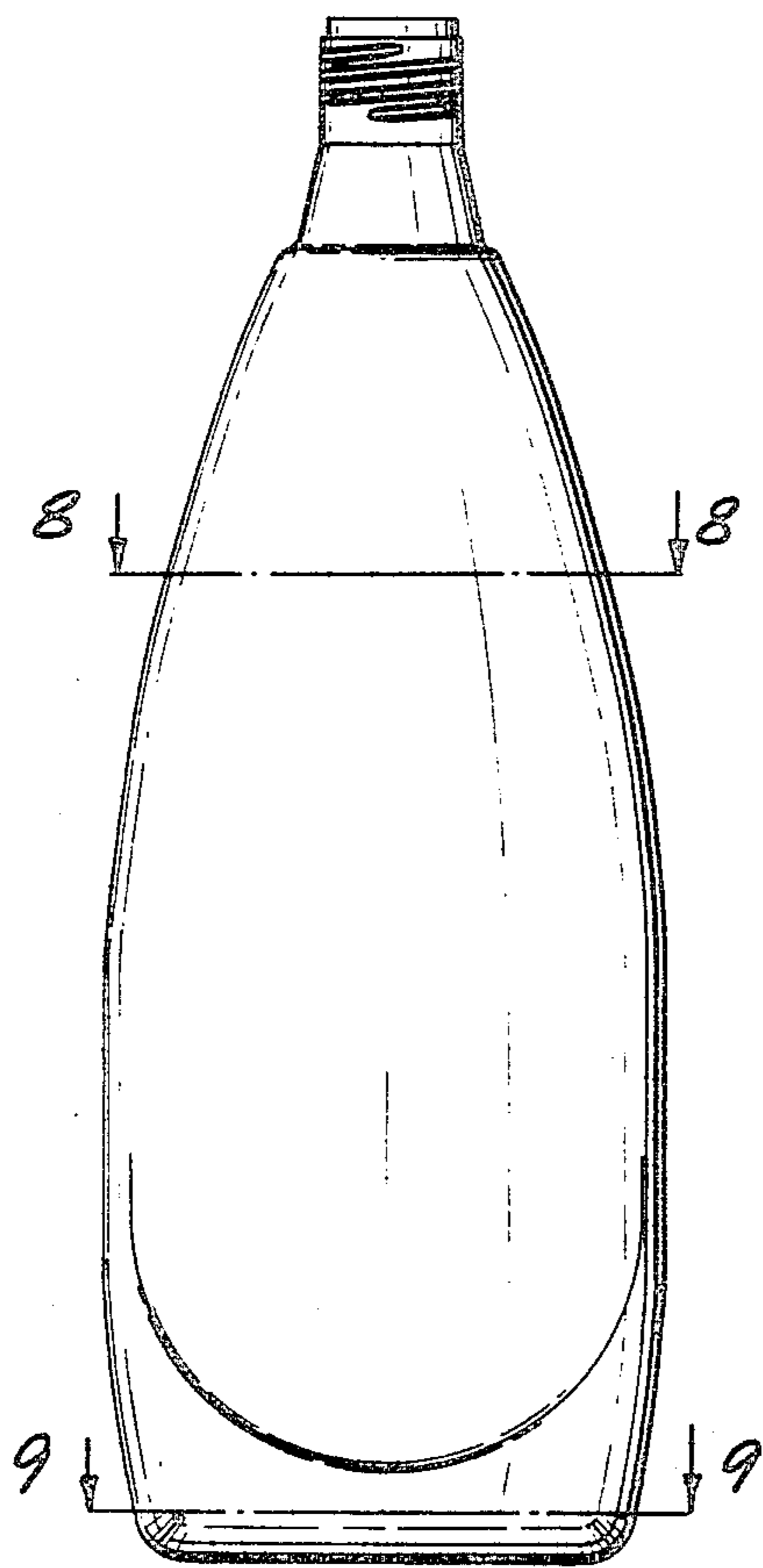

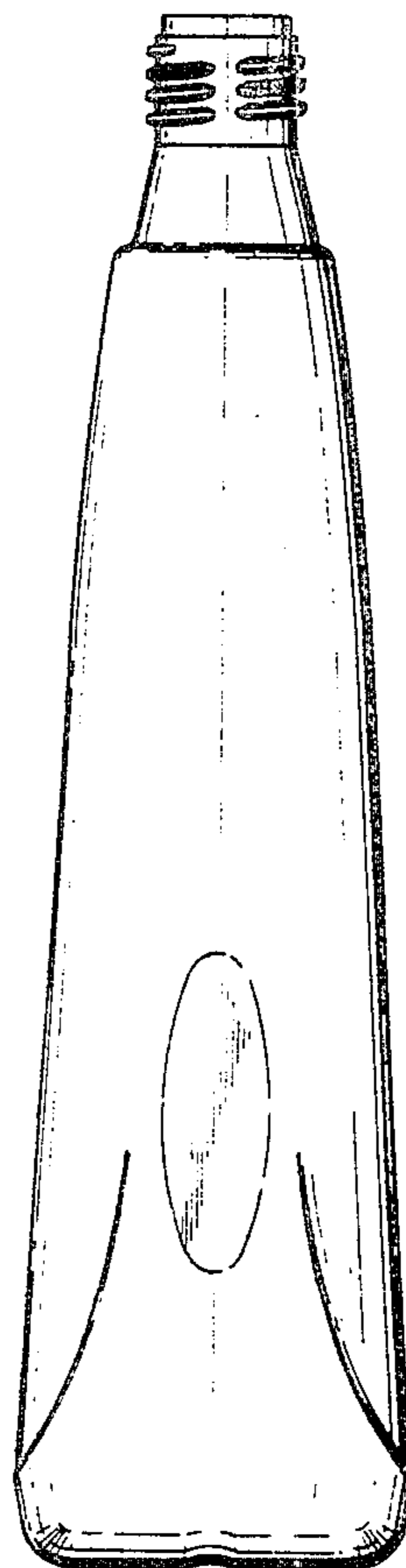

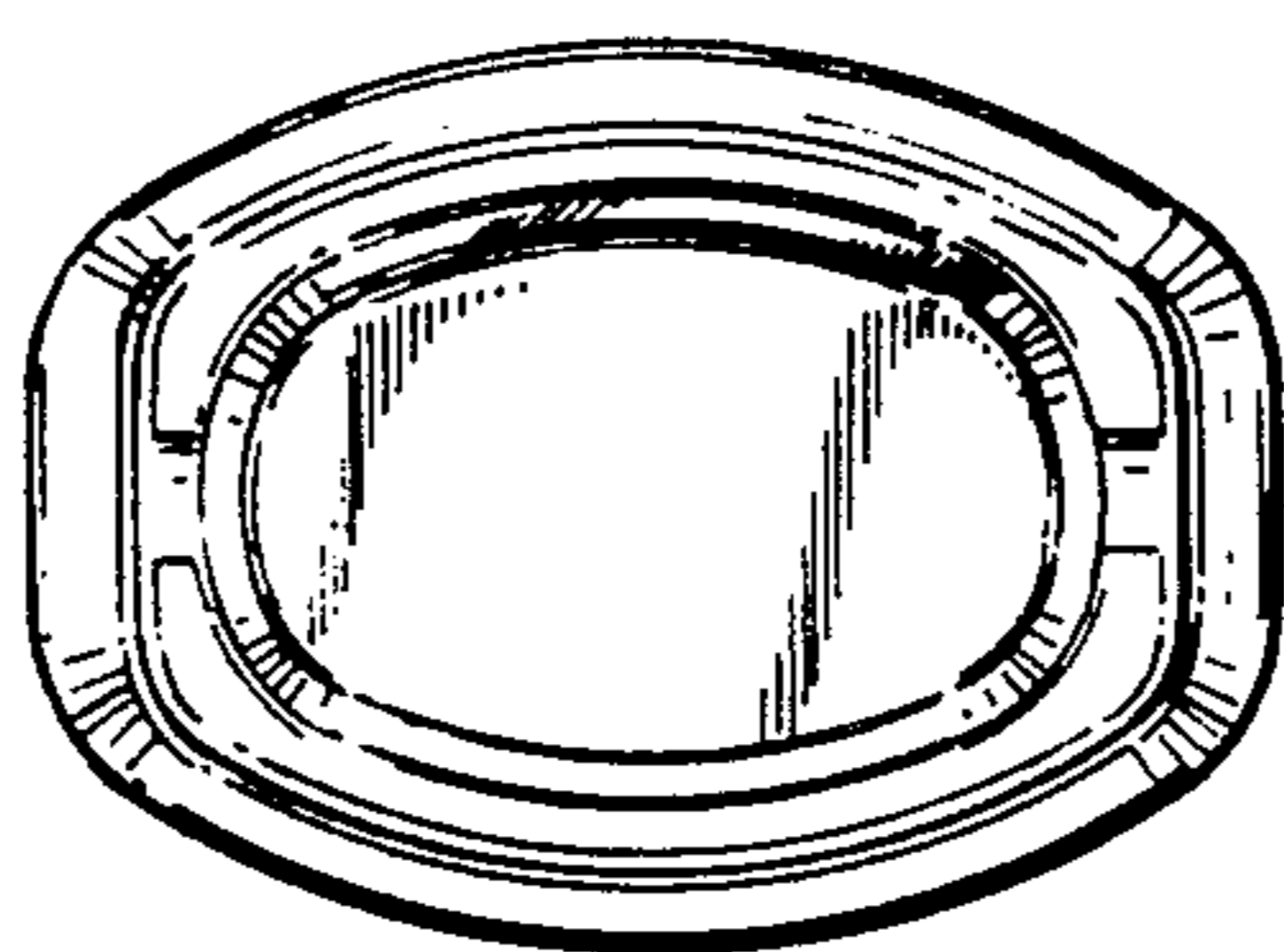

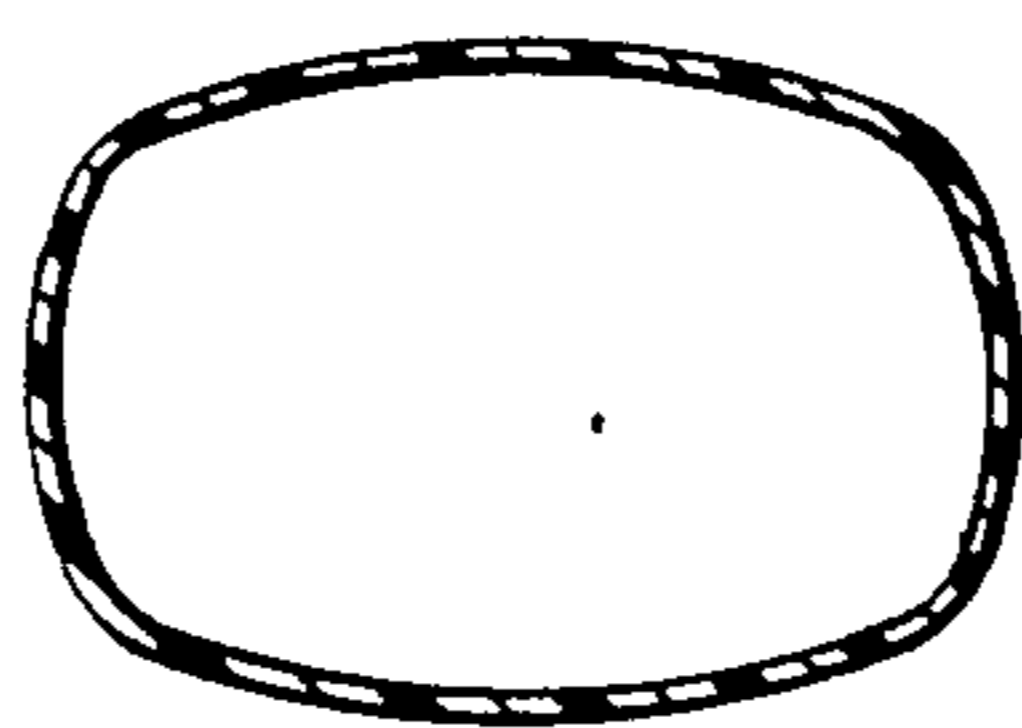

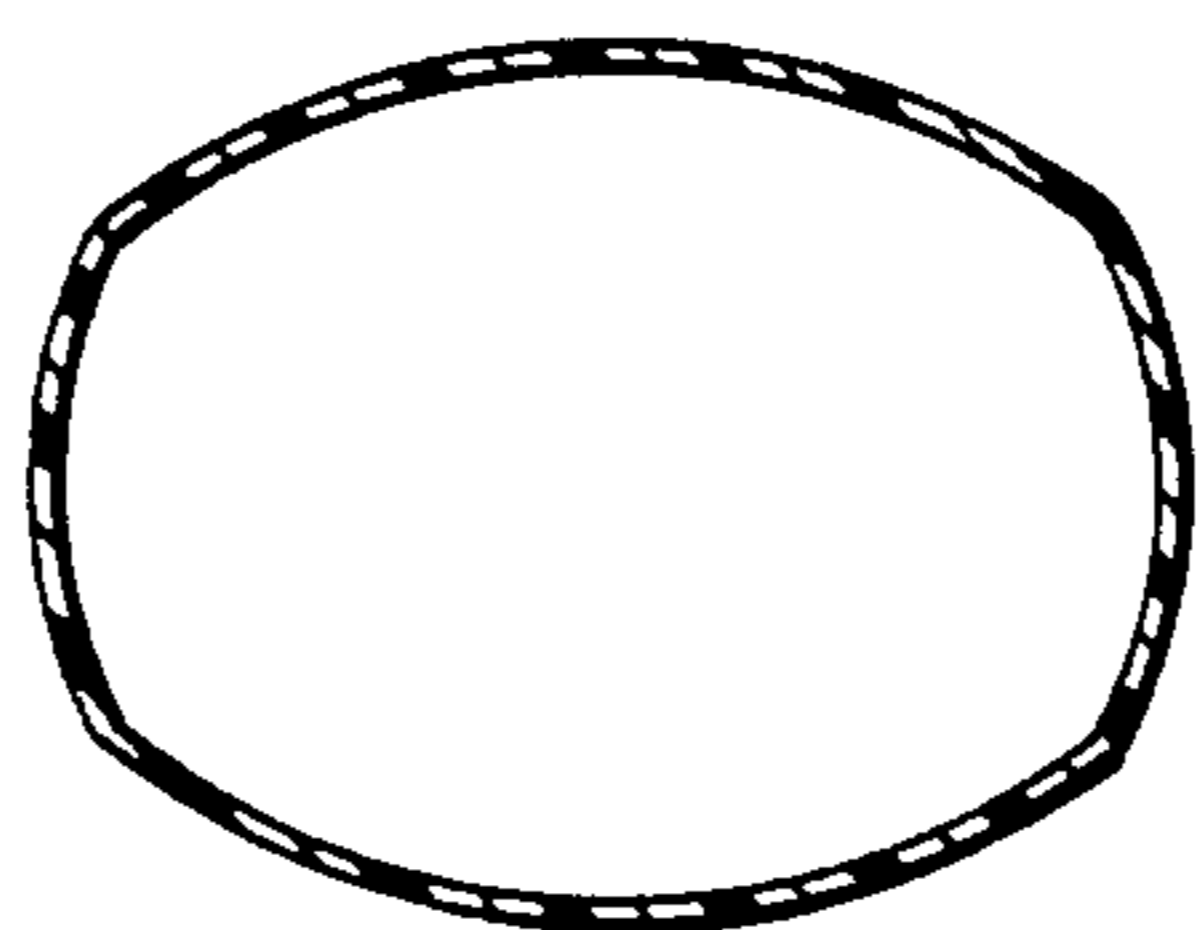
