The ornamental design for a pair of sunglasses or the like, substantially as shown and described.

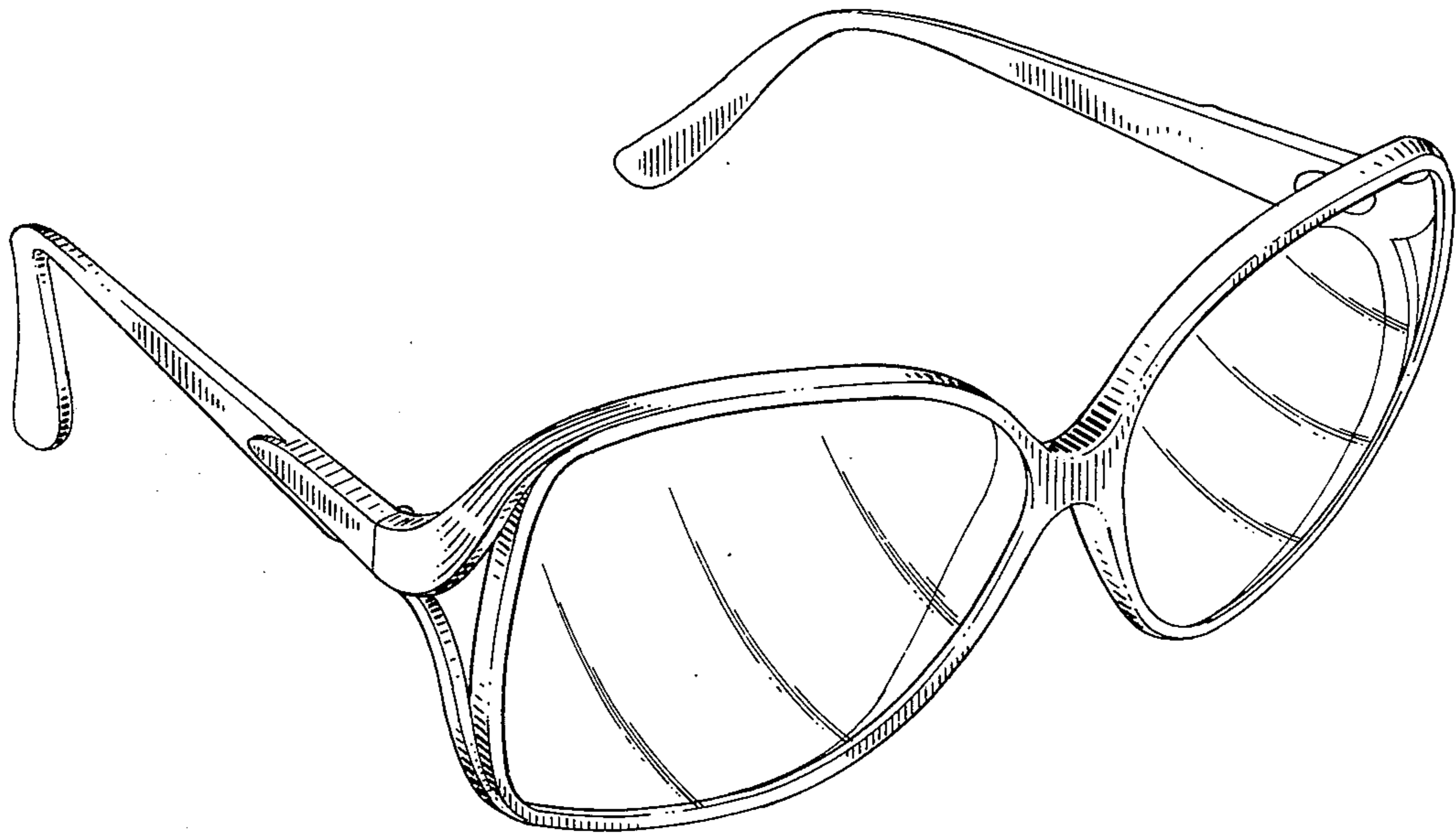
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a right front perspective view thereof.



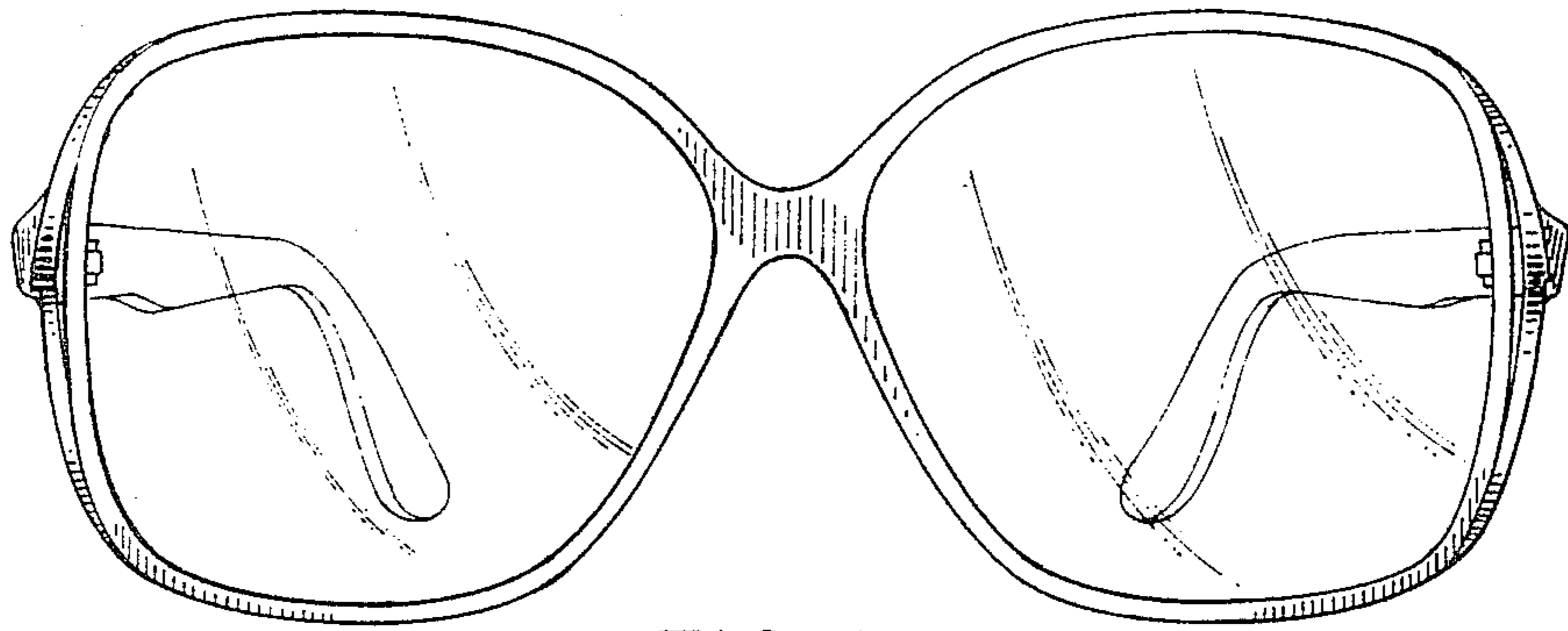

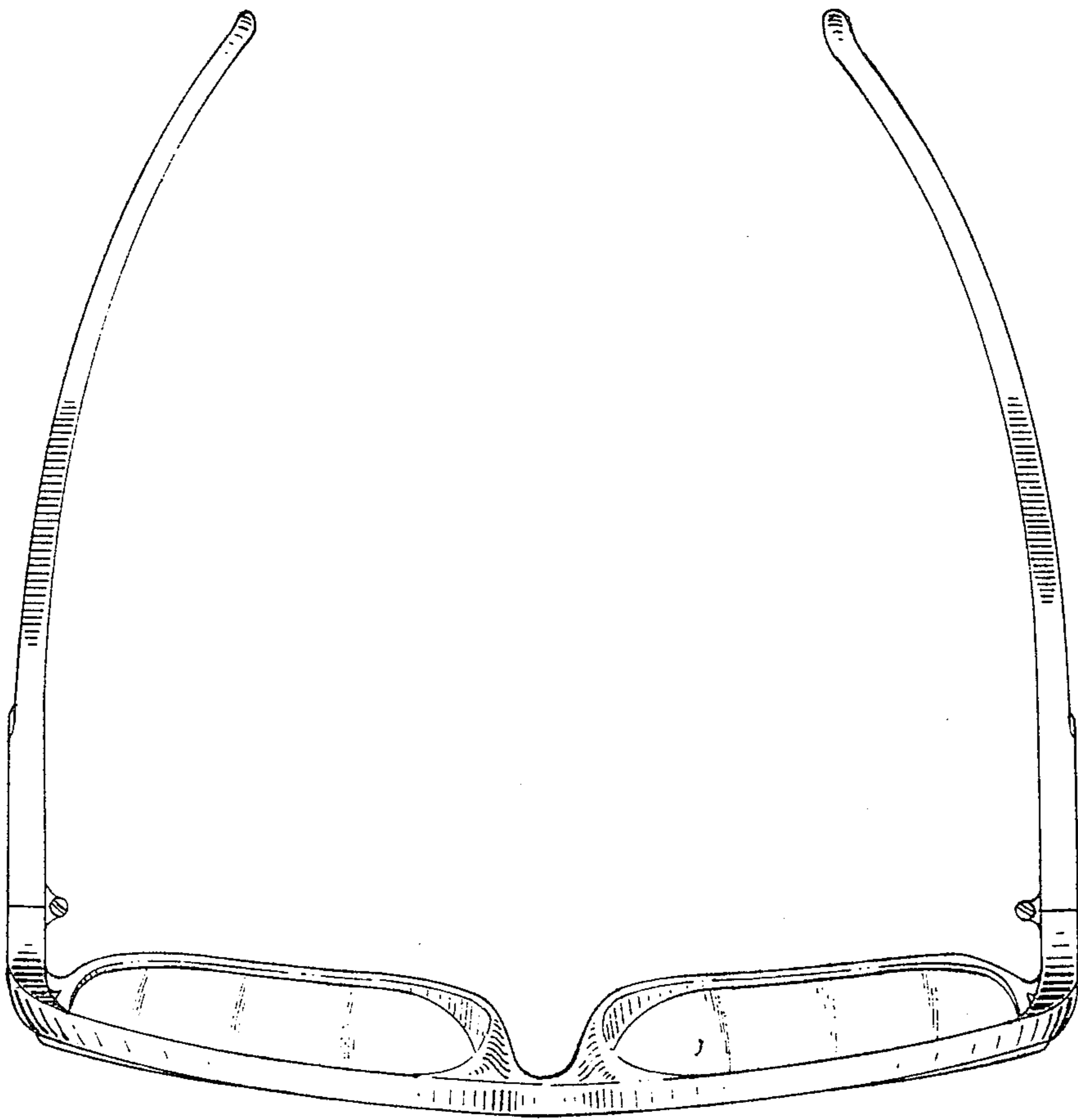

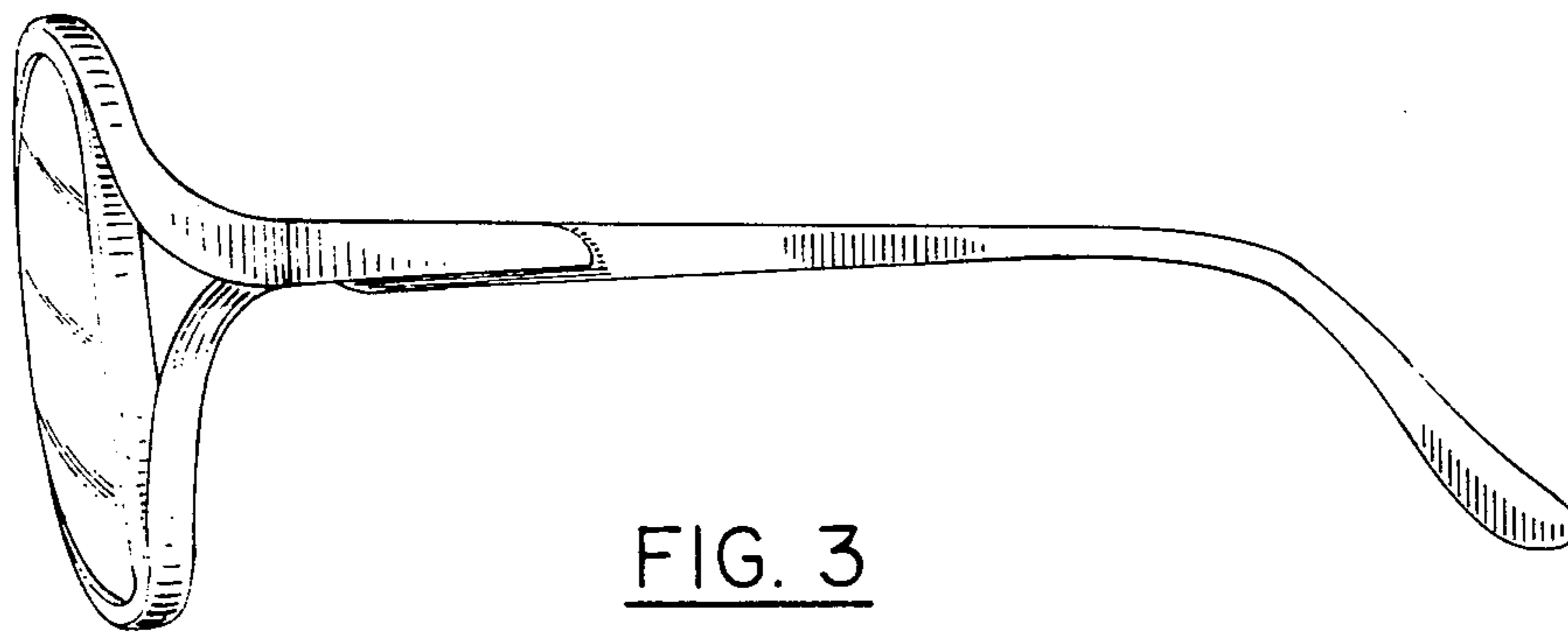

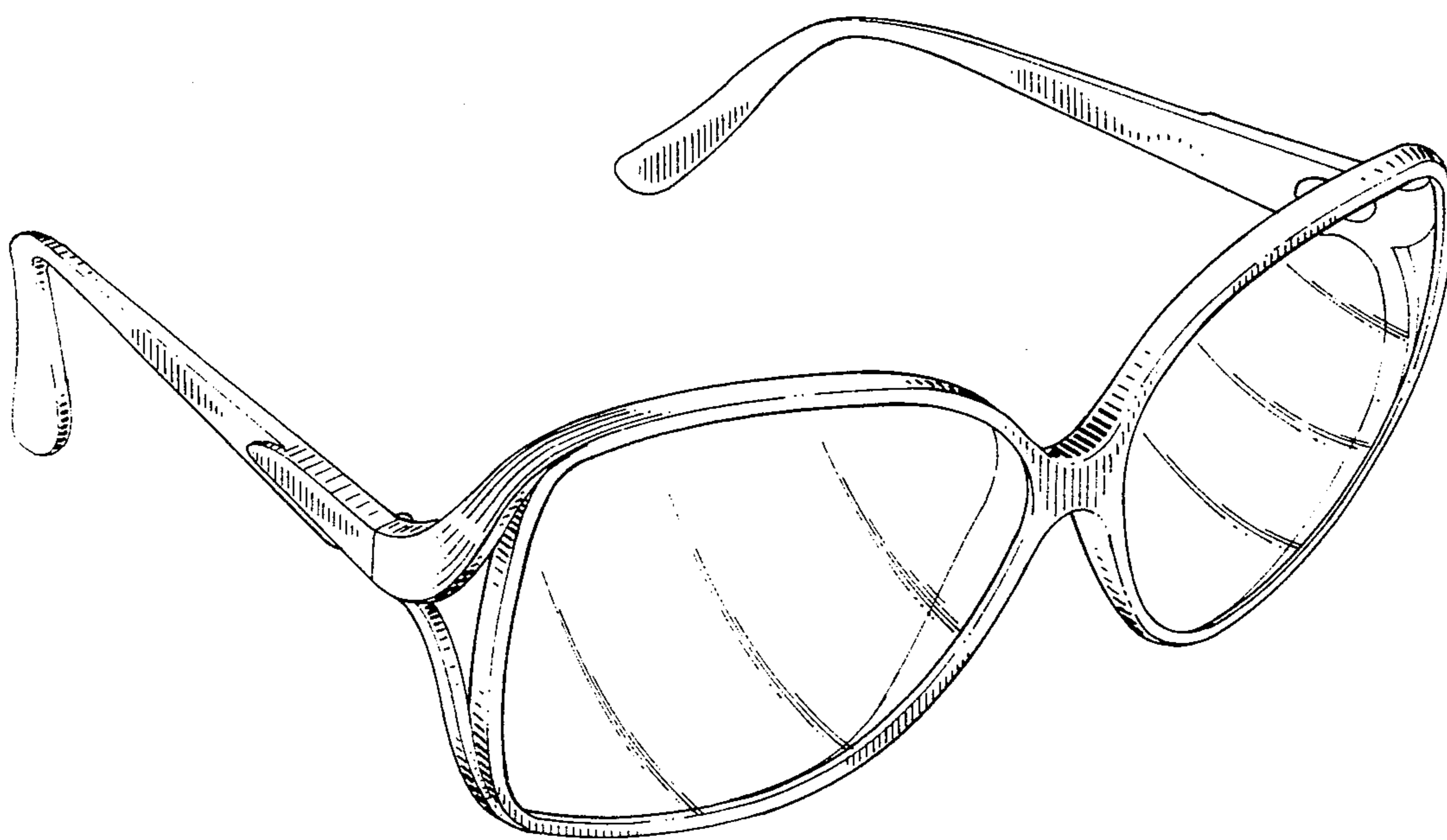
