[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for pair of cushioned seals for eyecups of swimmers' goggles, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pair of cushioned seals for eyecups of swimmer's goggles showing my new design, with the goggles shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a pair of cushioned seals for eyecups of swimmer's goggles showing only one seal for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof, the view from the bottom being the same; and

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being the same.

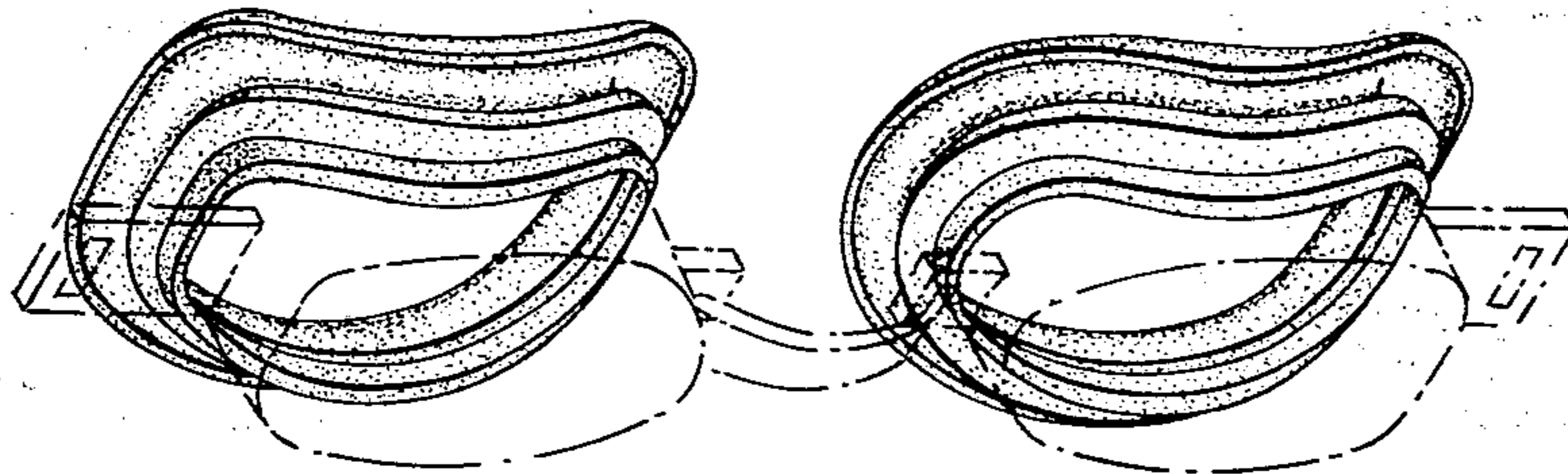

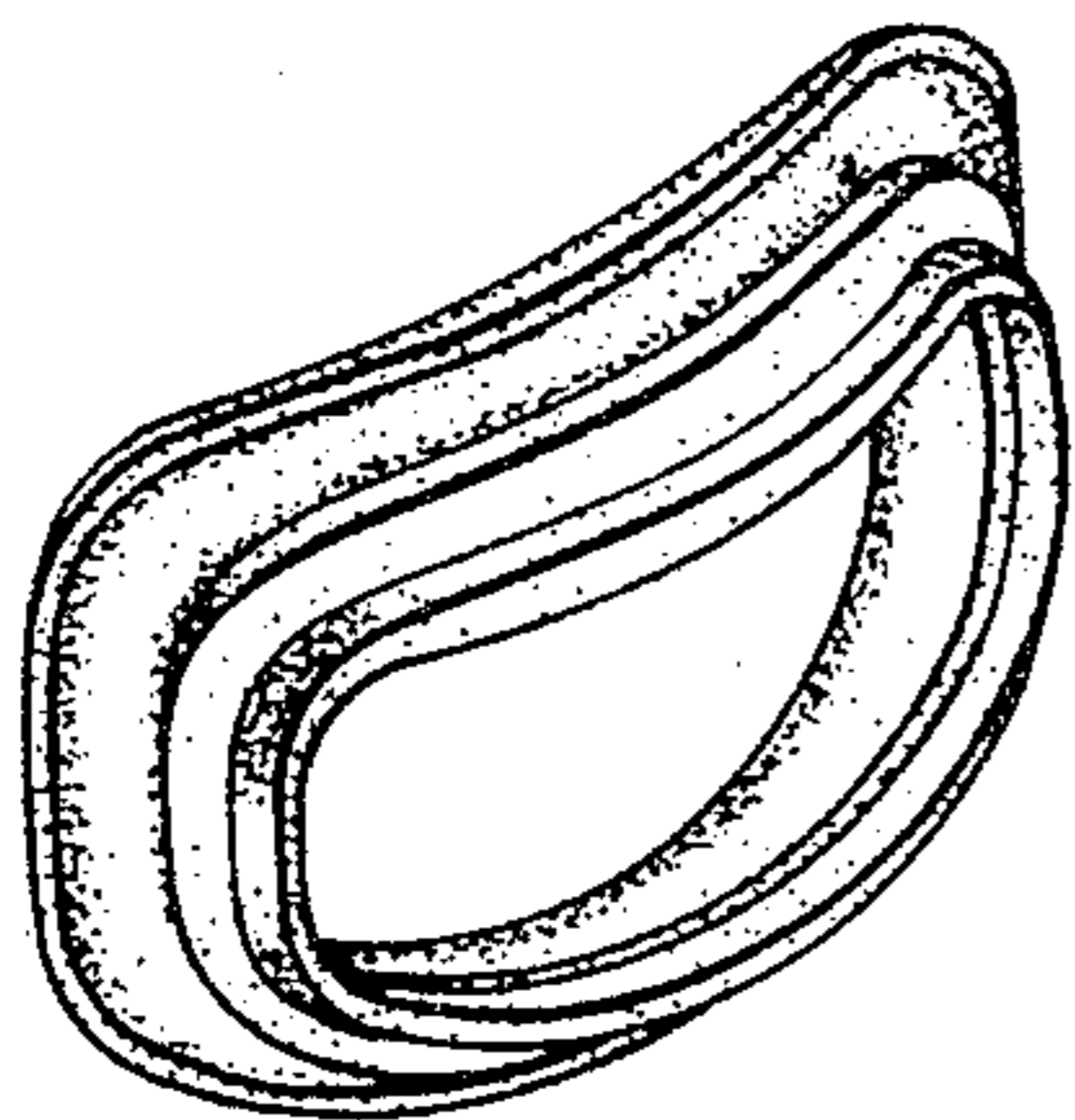

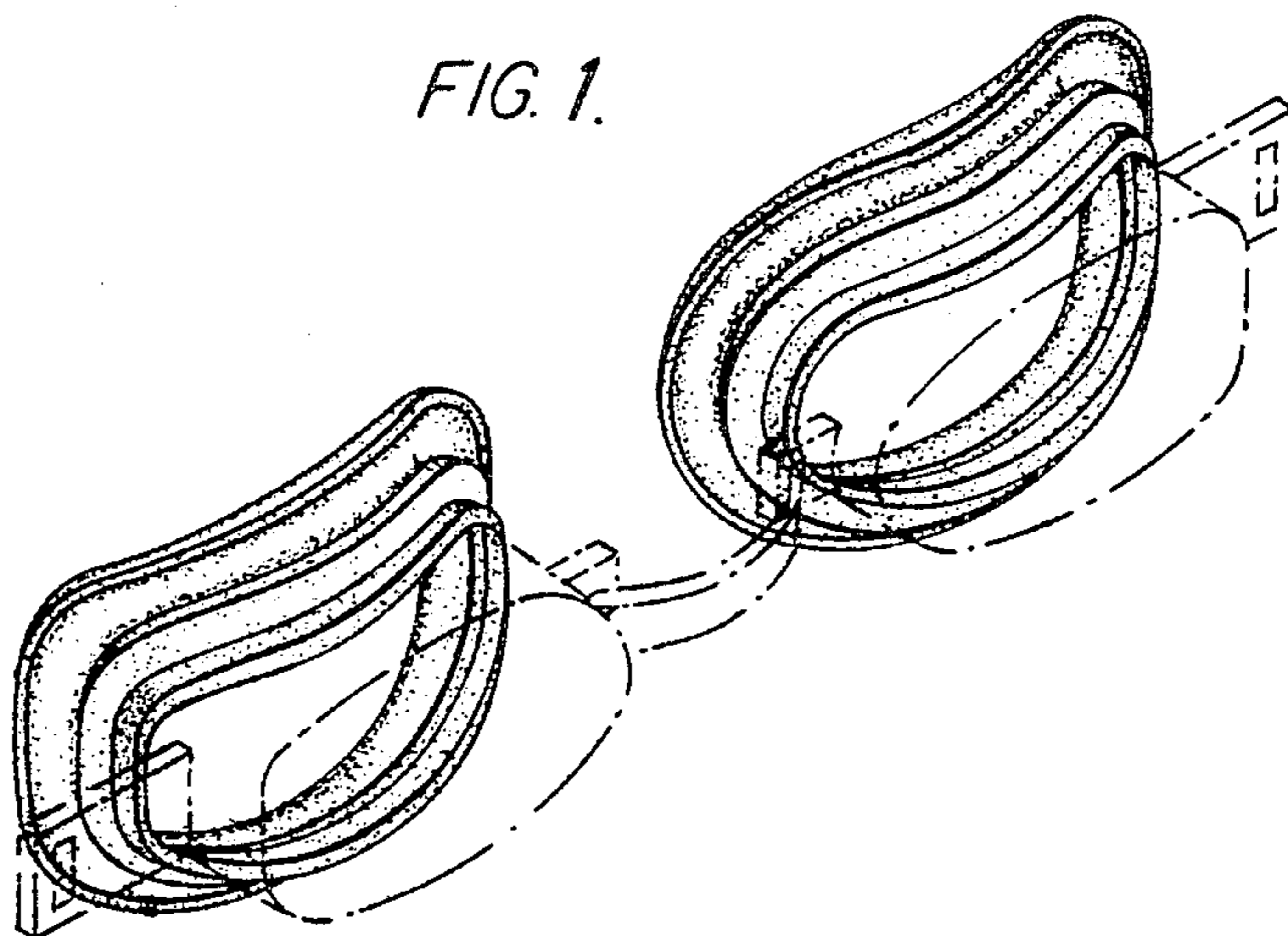

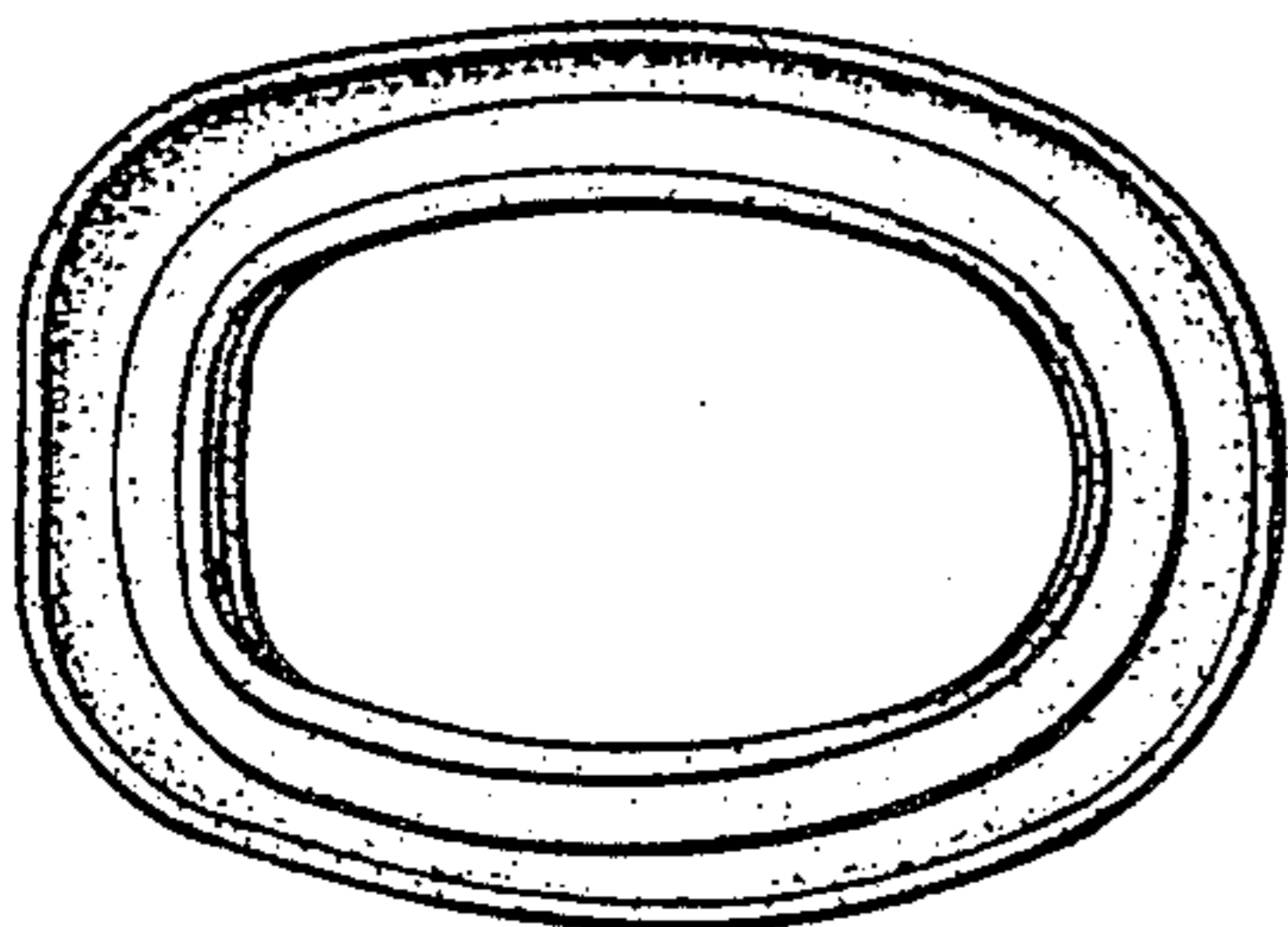

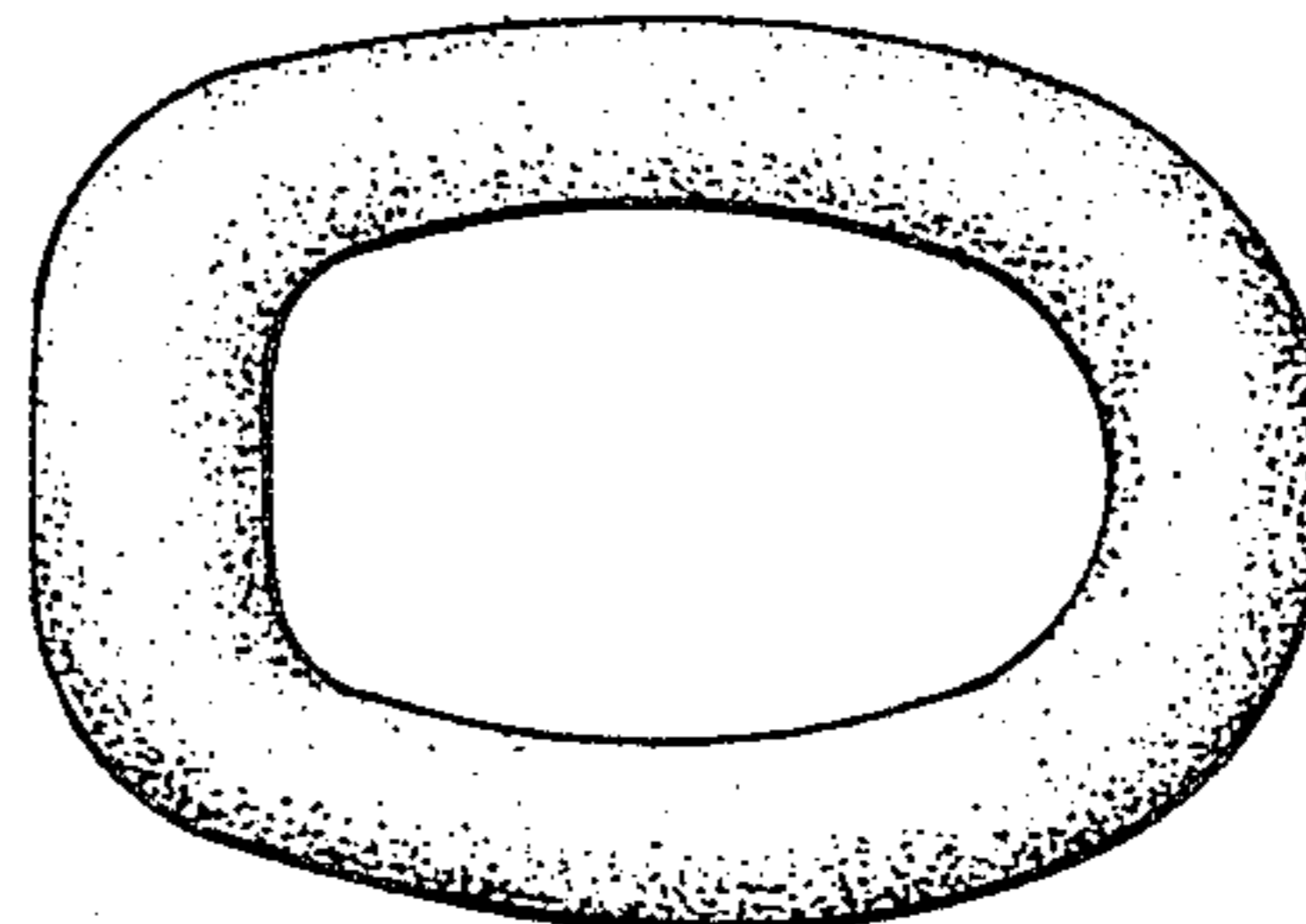
