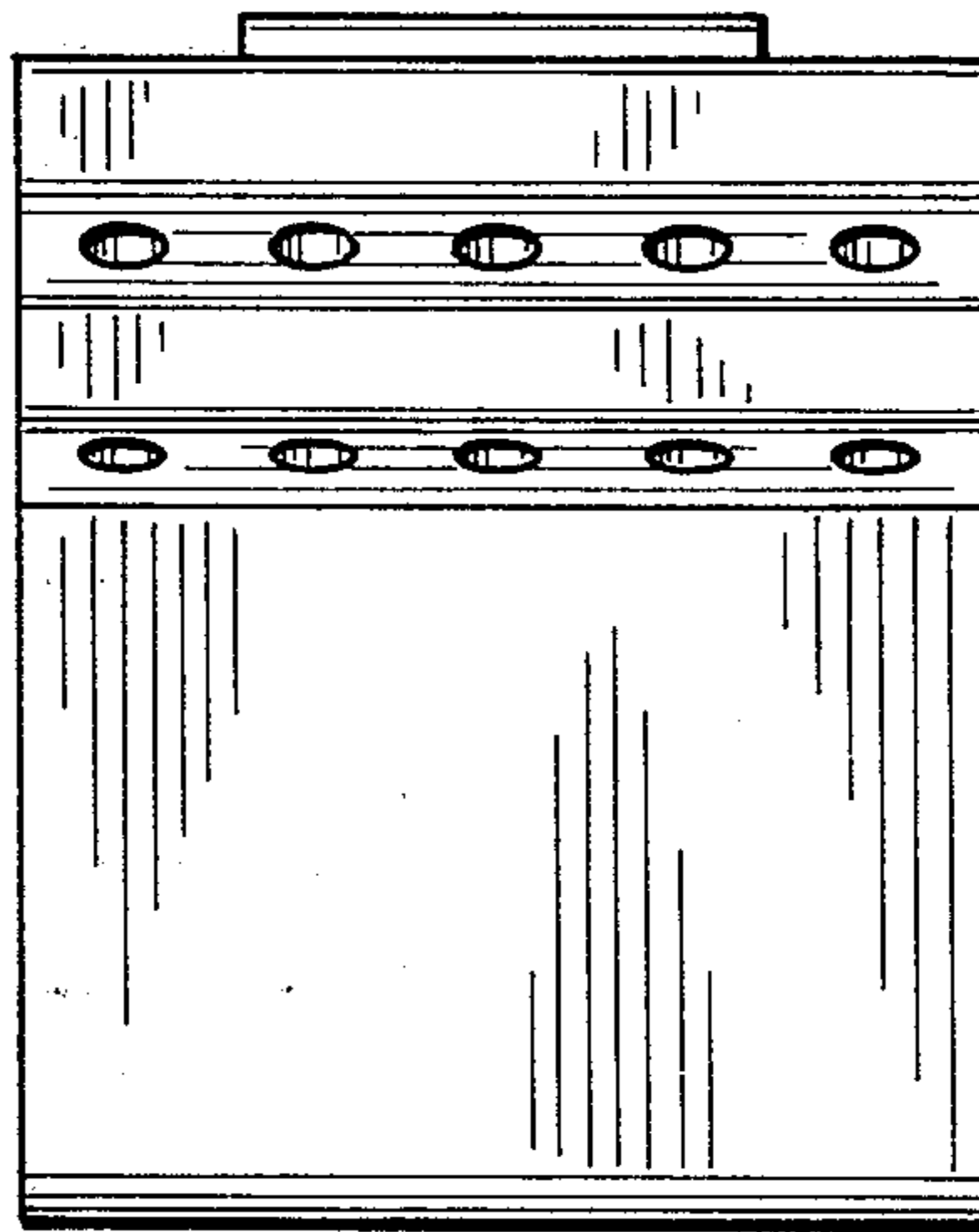

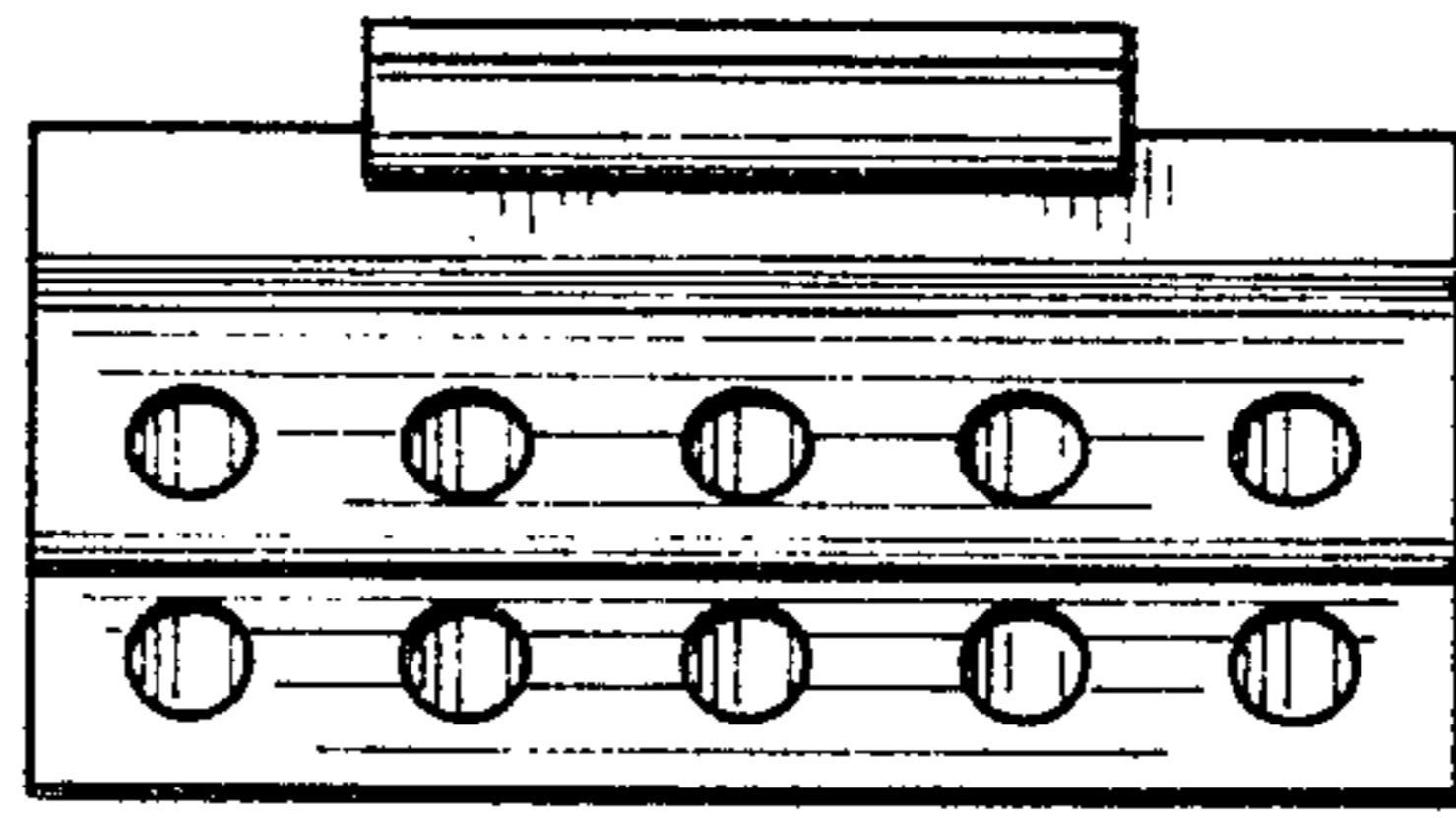
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a golf tee hip holder, substantially as shown and described.

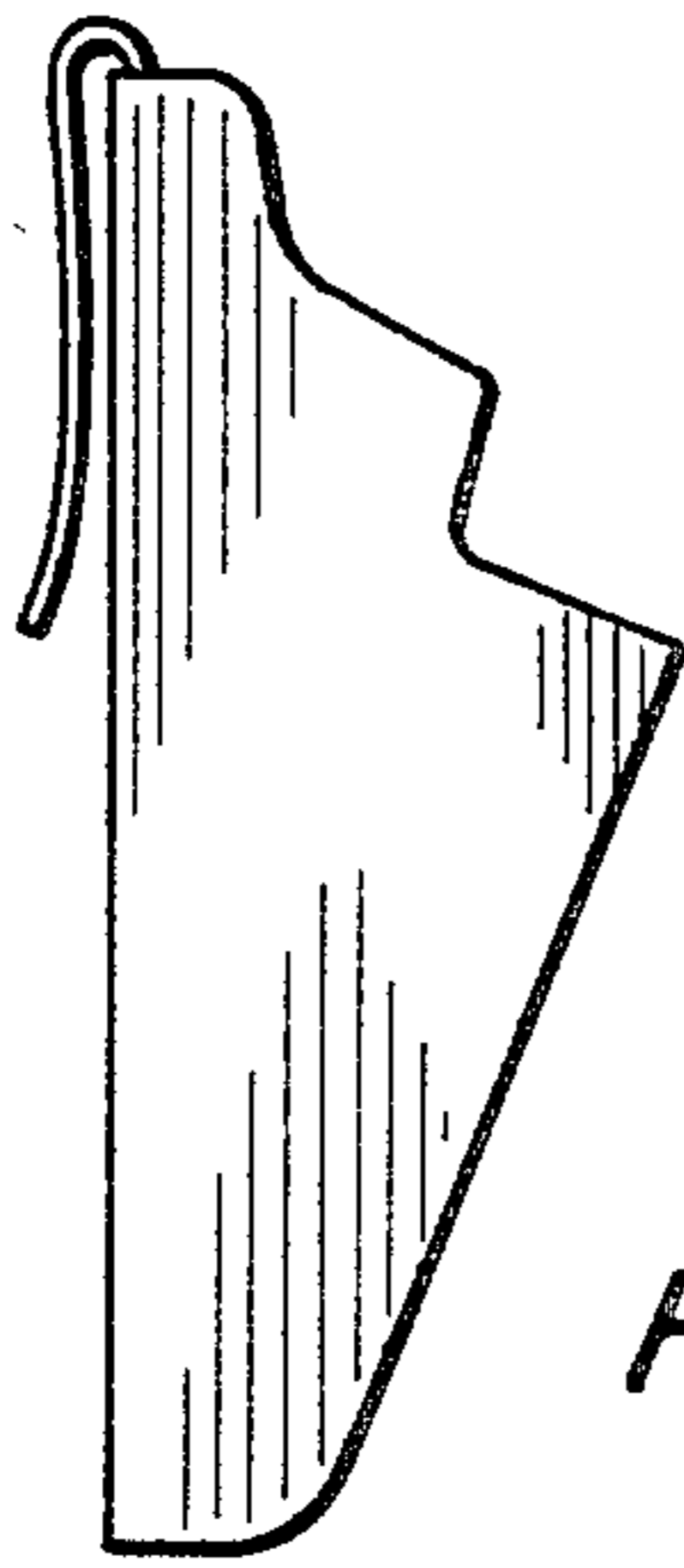
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a golf tee hip holder showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
The conventional golf tees shown in broken lines in FIG. 2 are for illustrative purposes only.

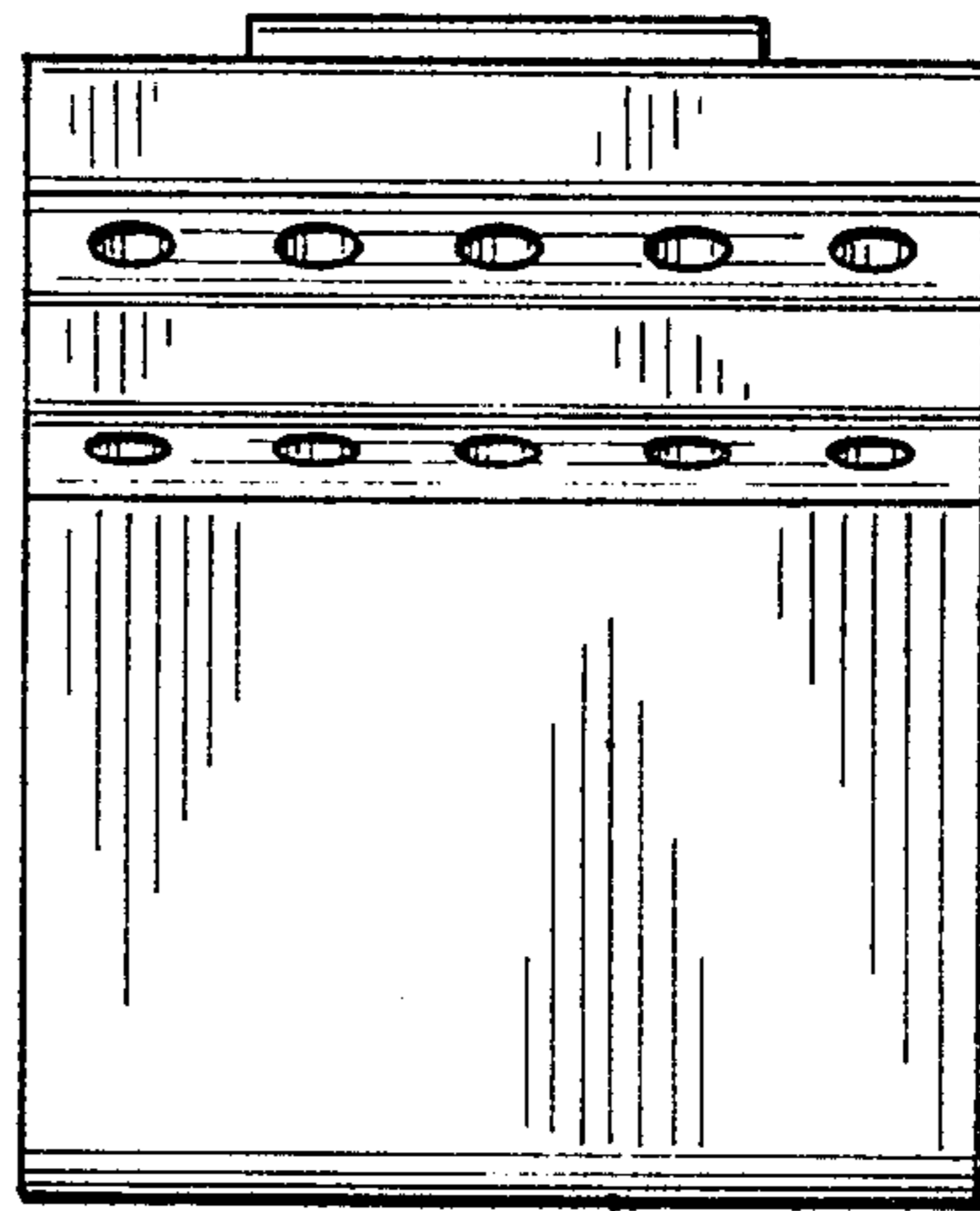




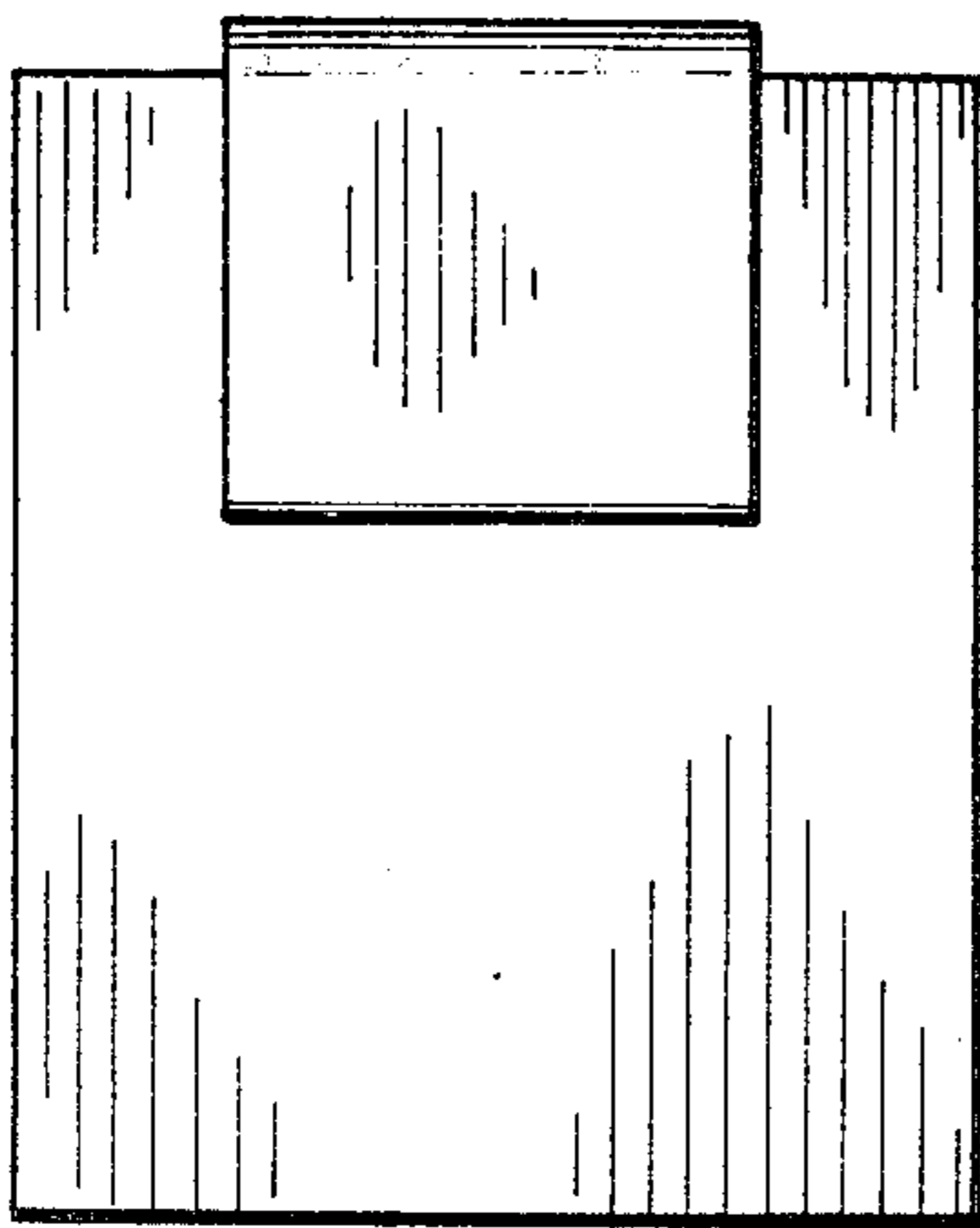

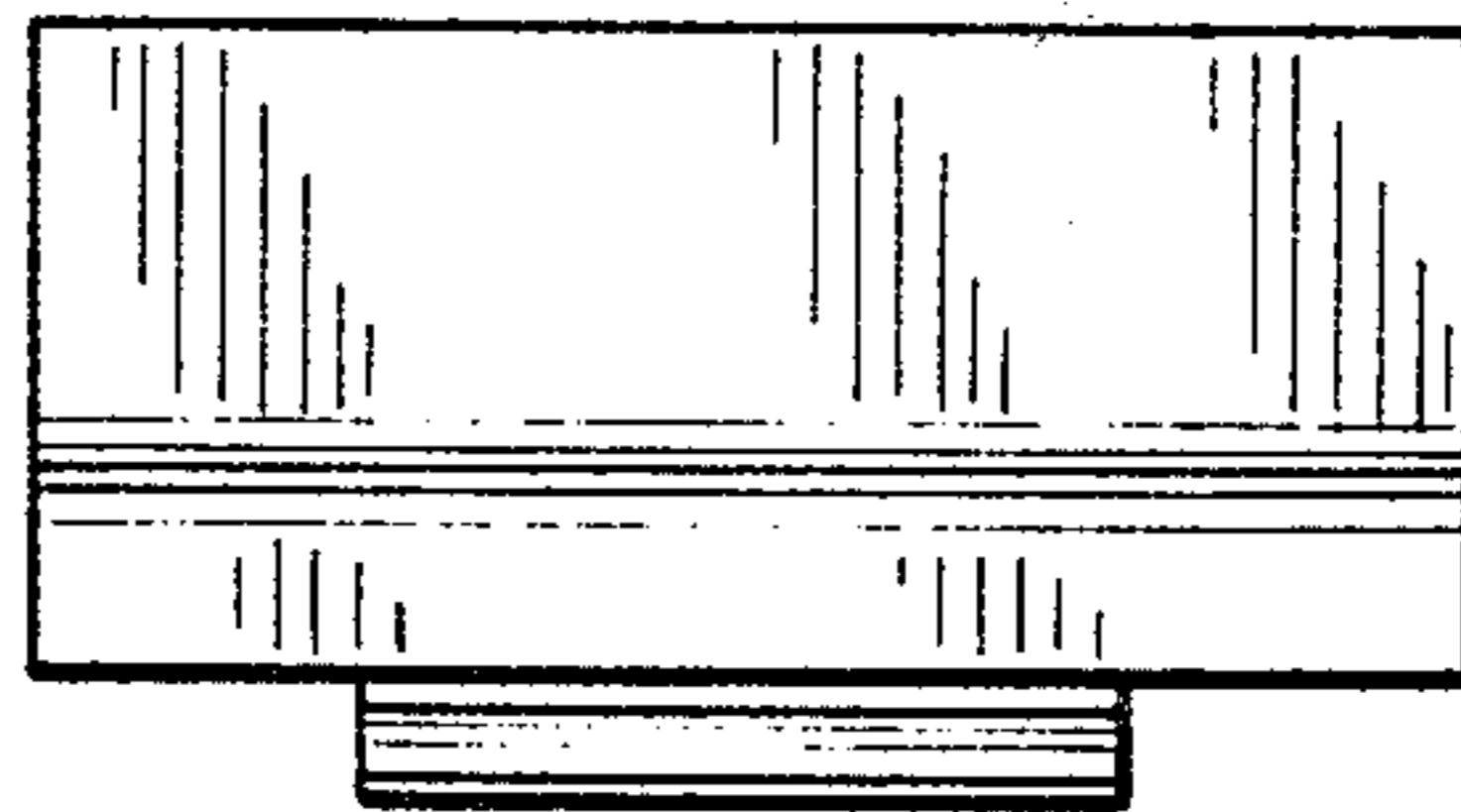
