The ornamental design for the bowl, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bowl showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof in which the raised interior bottom wall which is visible through the transparent side wall has been omitted for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken in the direction of cutting plane 4—4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken in the direction of cutting plane 5—5 of FIG. 1.
