DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a jar or similar article
showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side sub-
stantially the same in appearance; and
FIG. 5 is an elevational view looking from the right of
FIG. 4, the opposite side being substantially the same in
appearance.

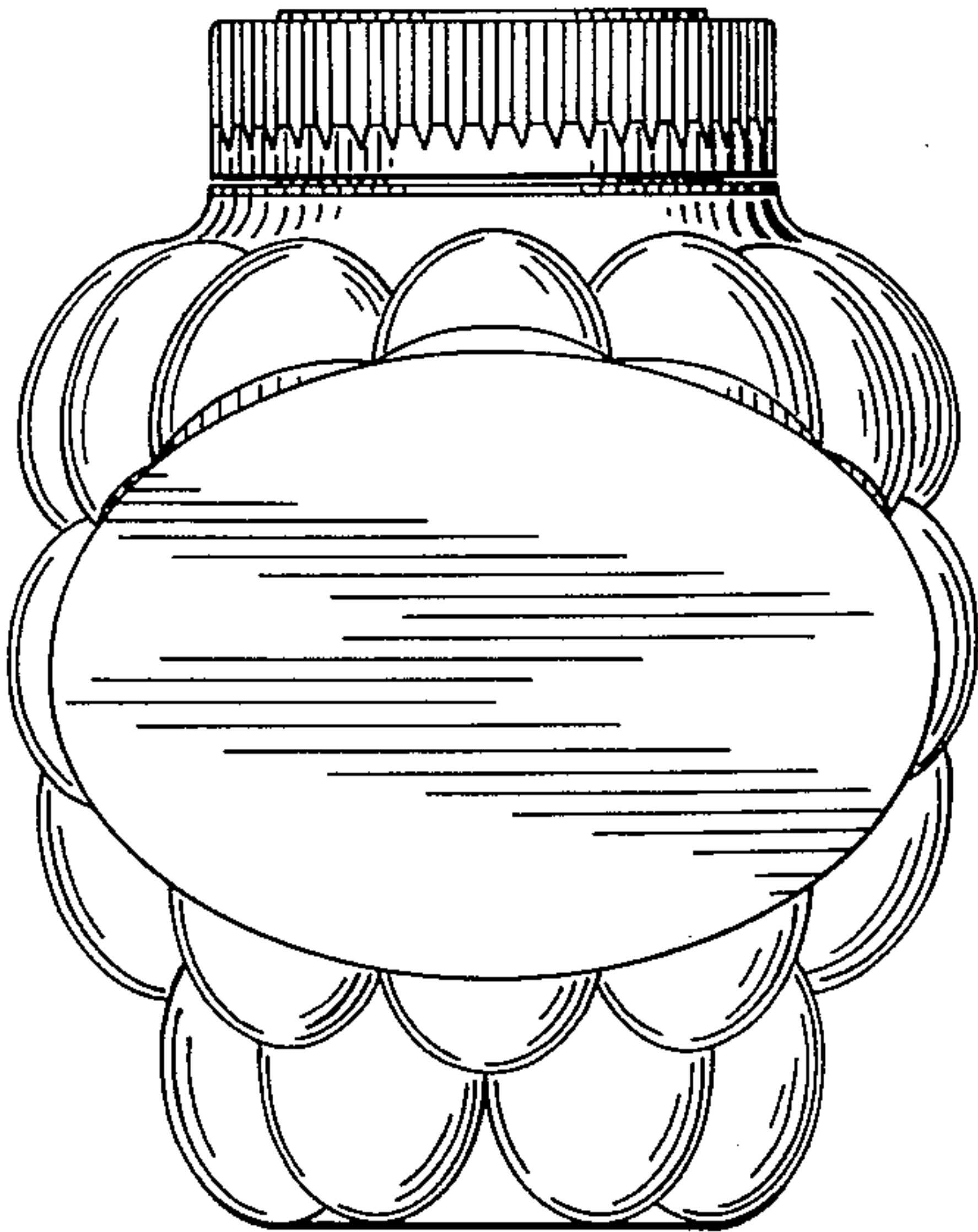

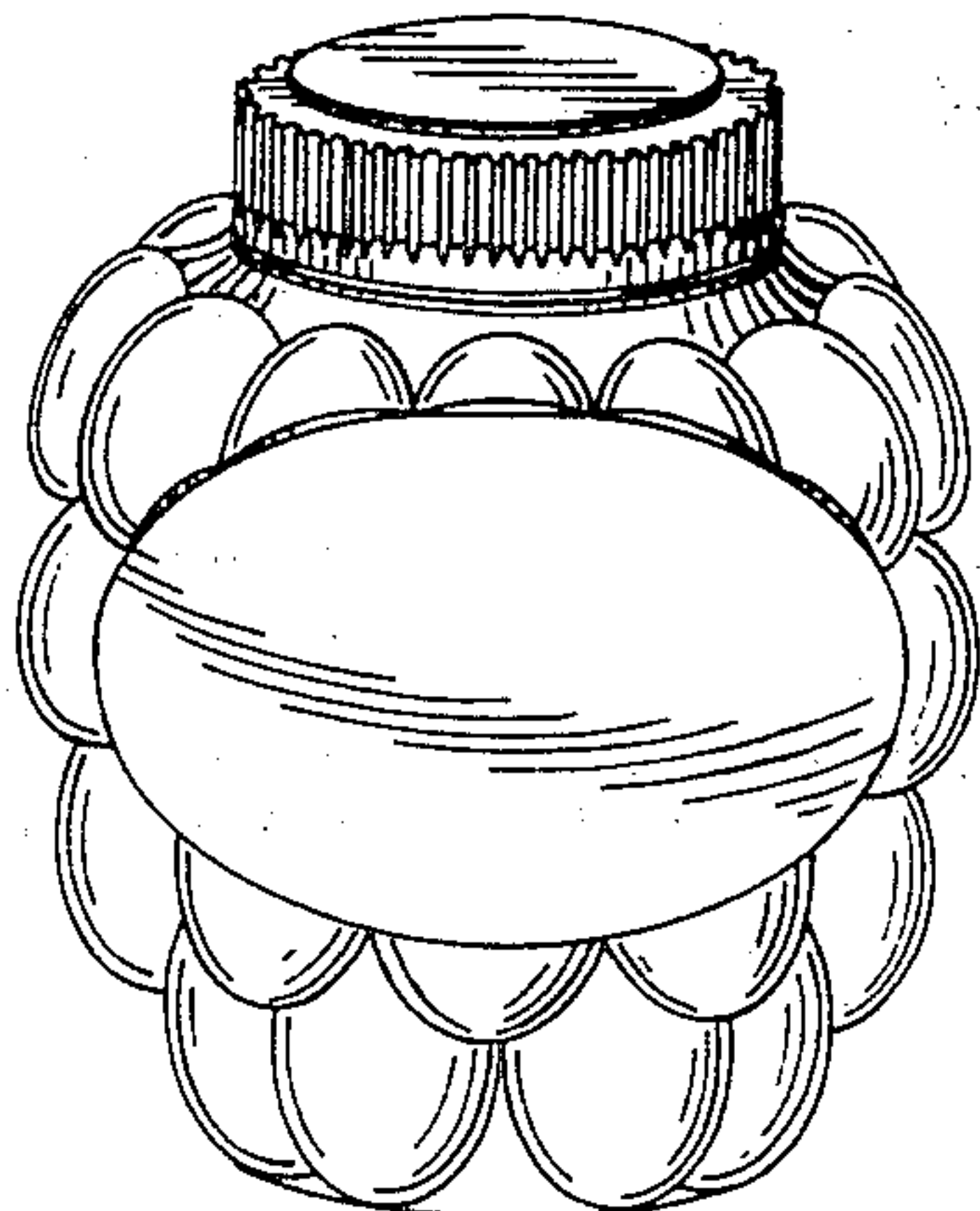

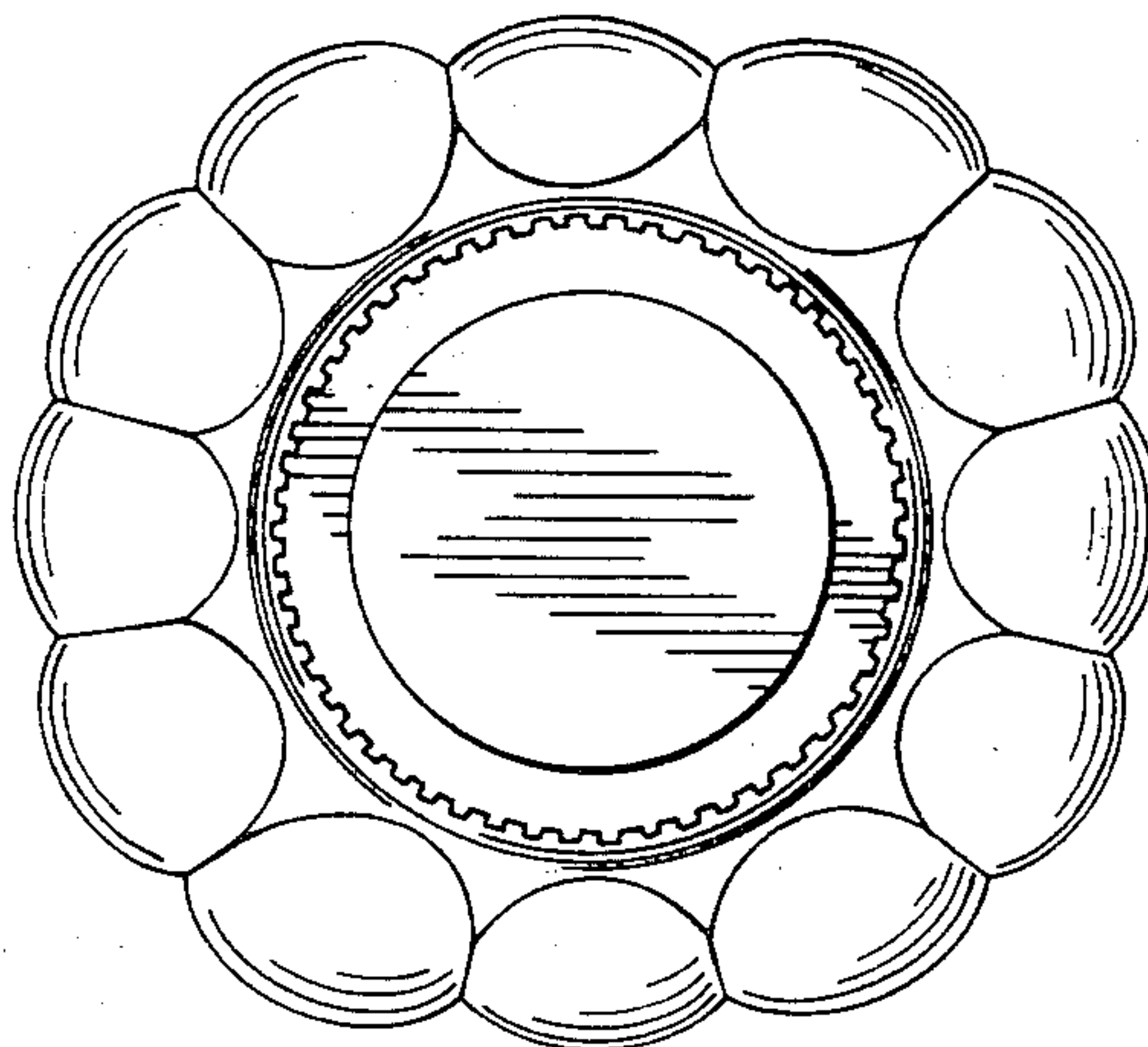

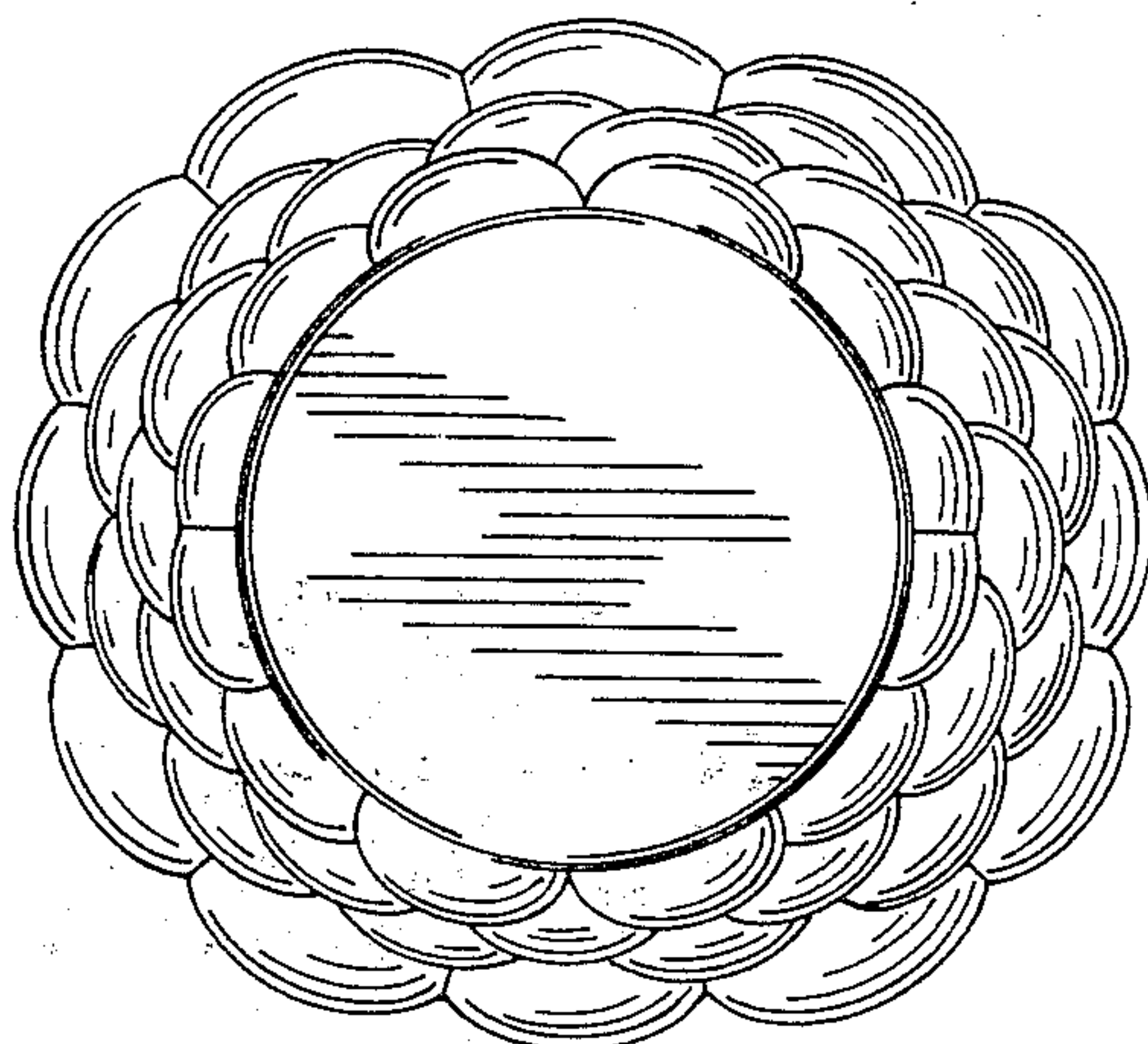

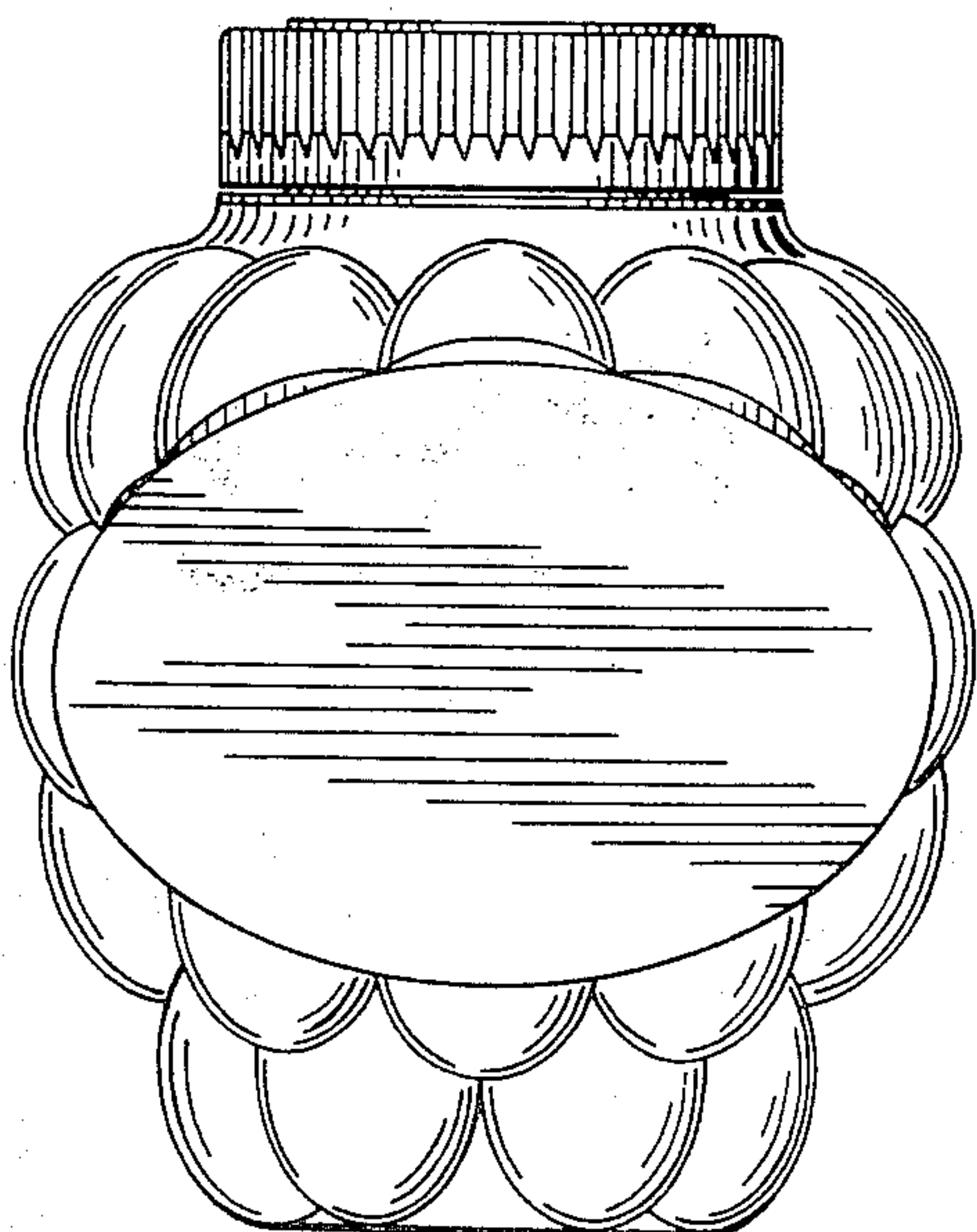
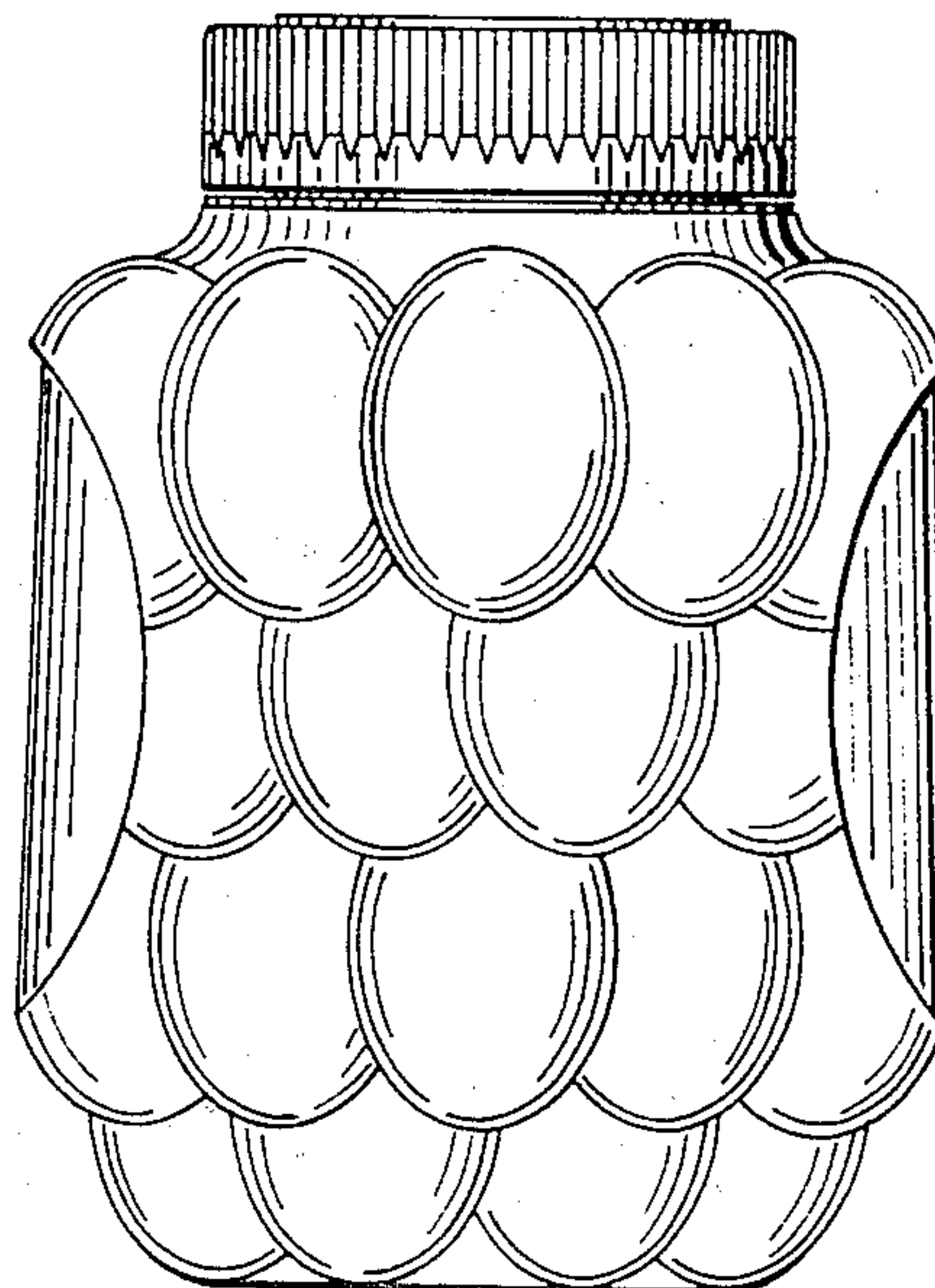
