The ornamental design for toy motorcycle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy motorcycle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

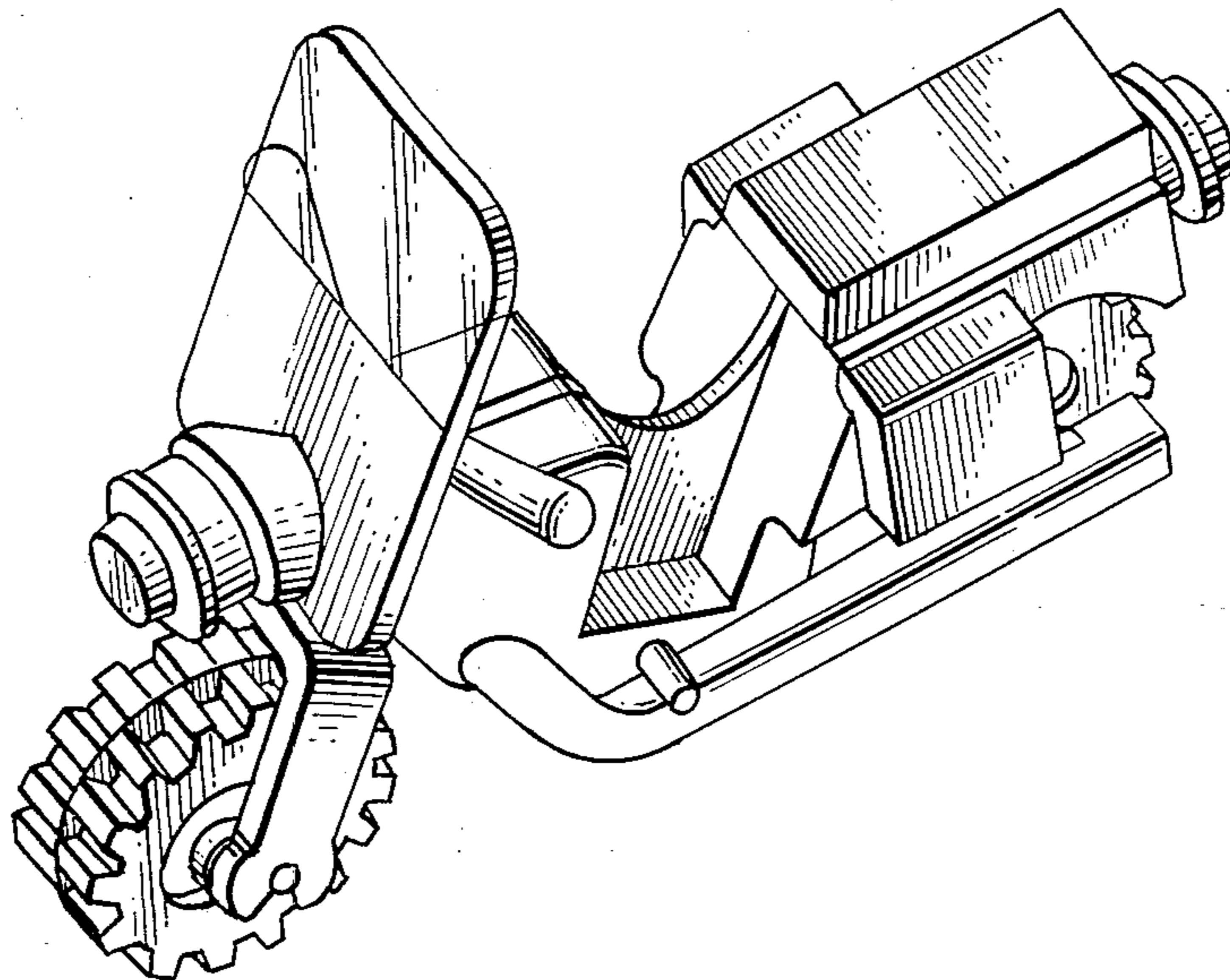

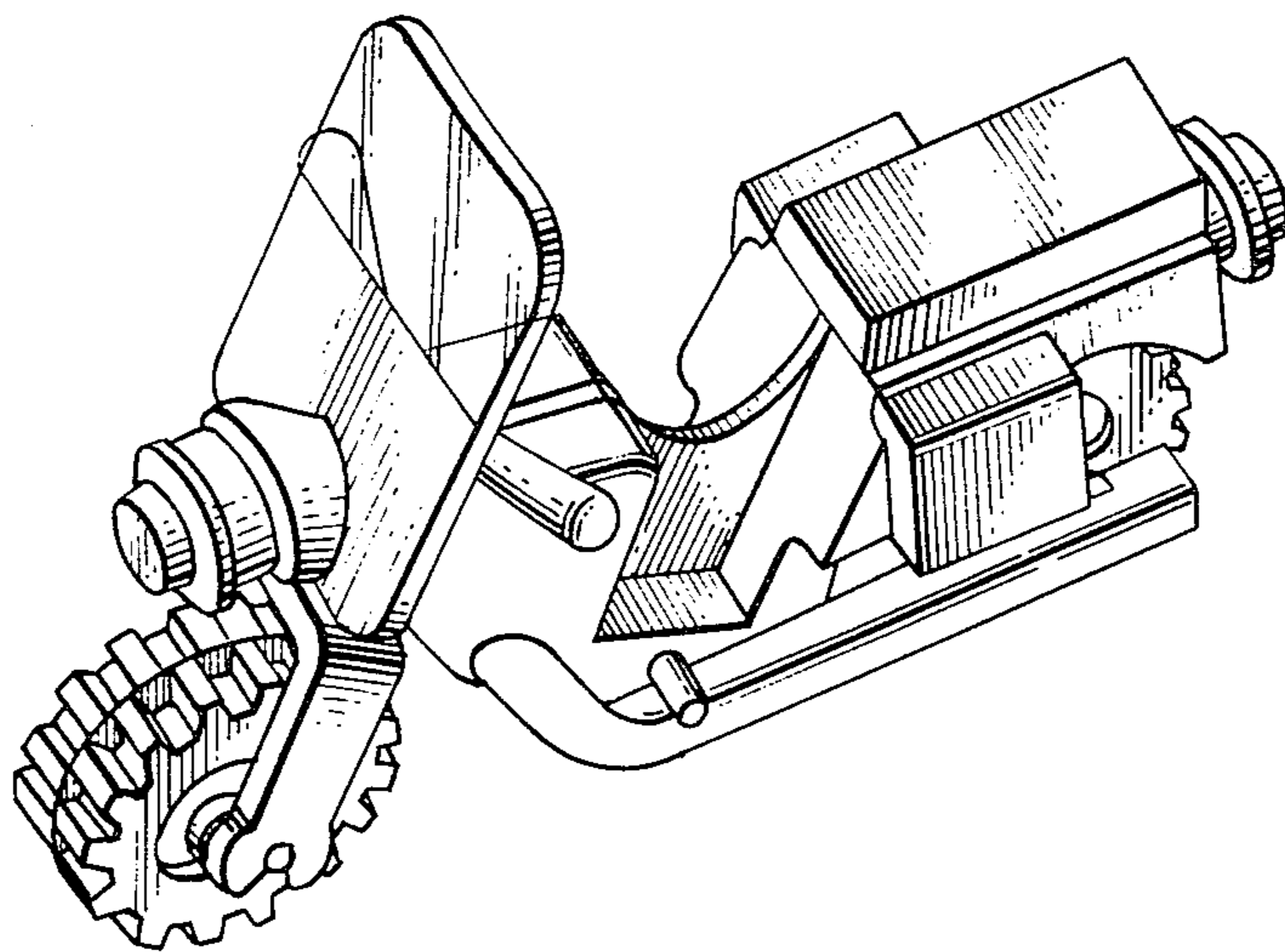

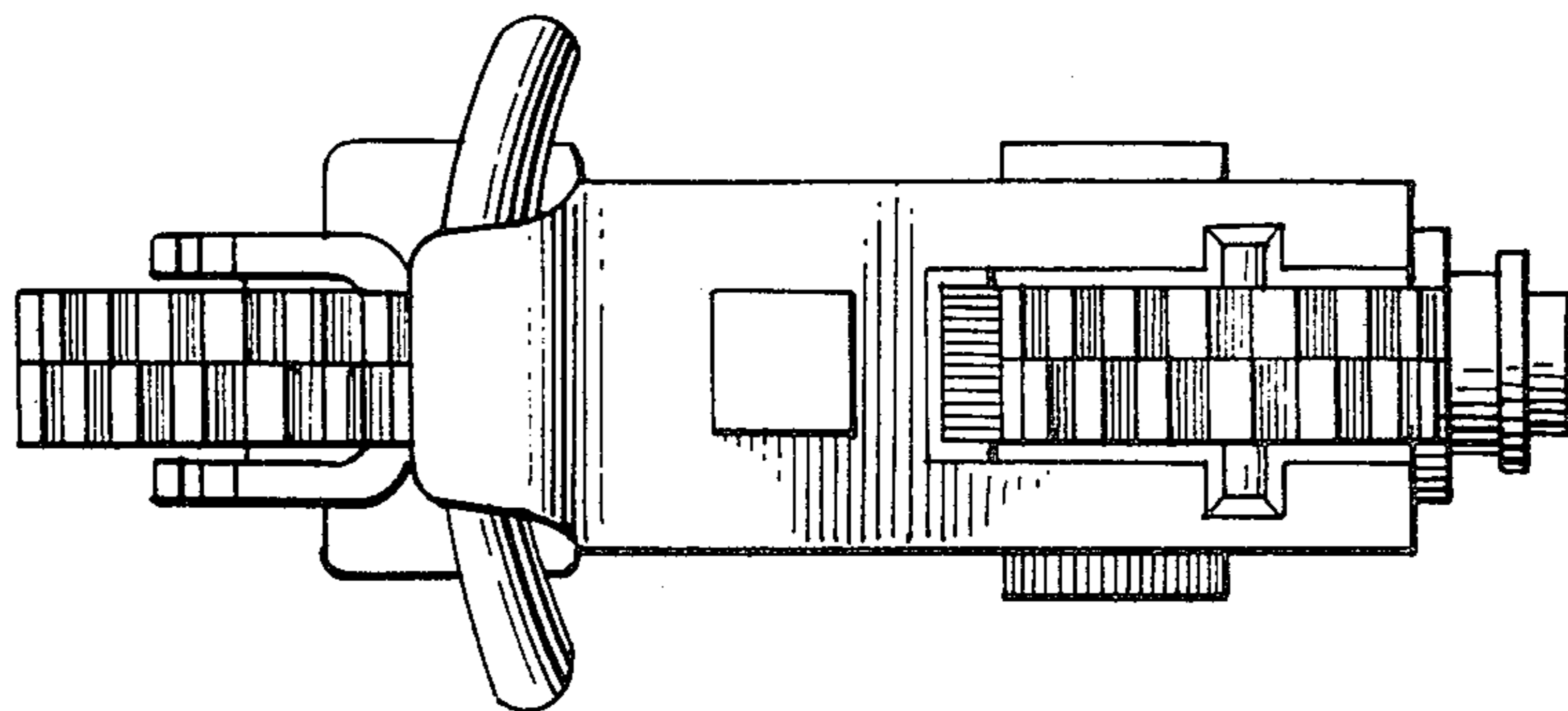

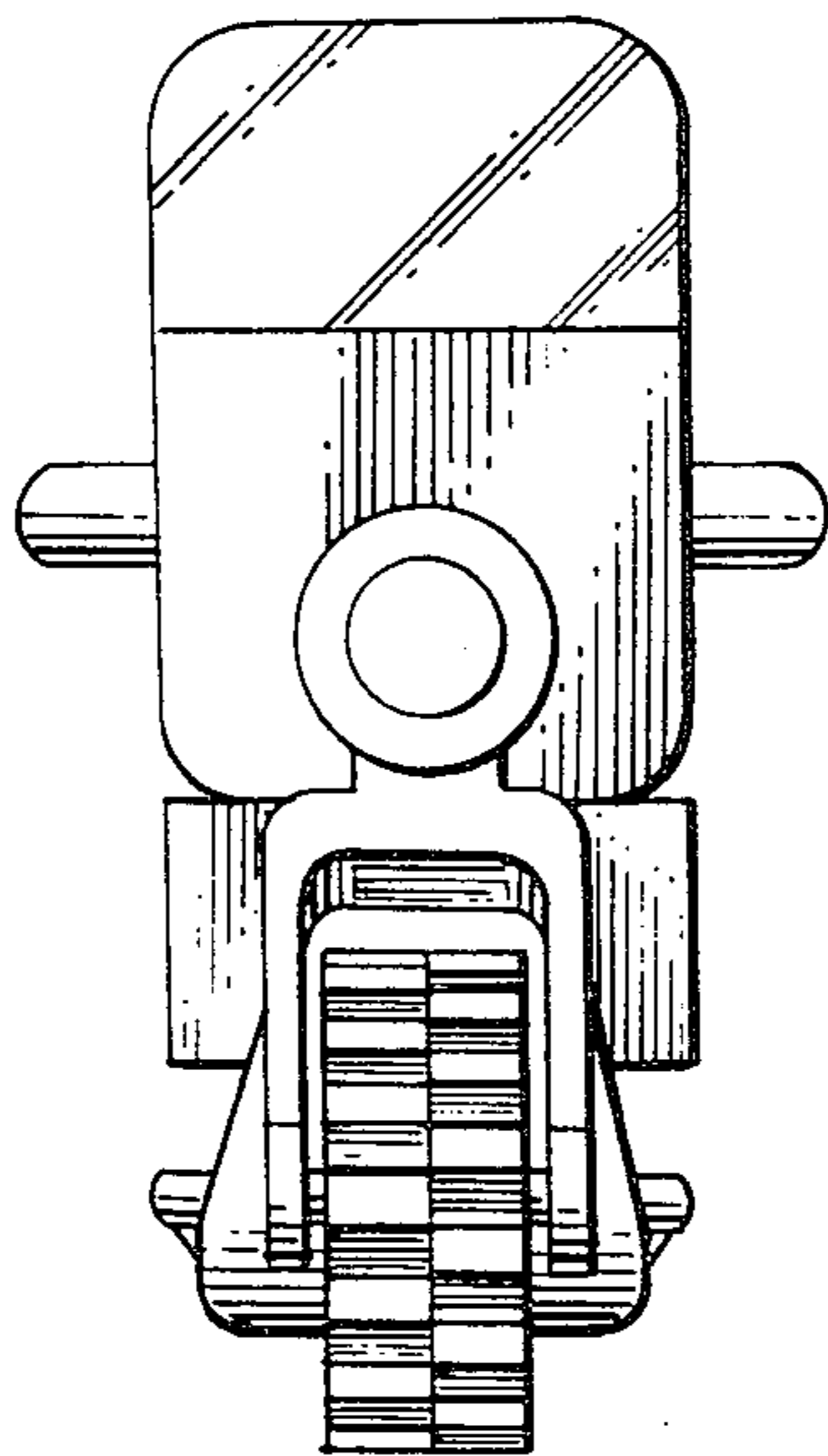

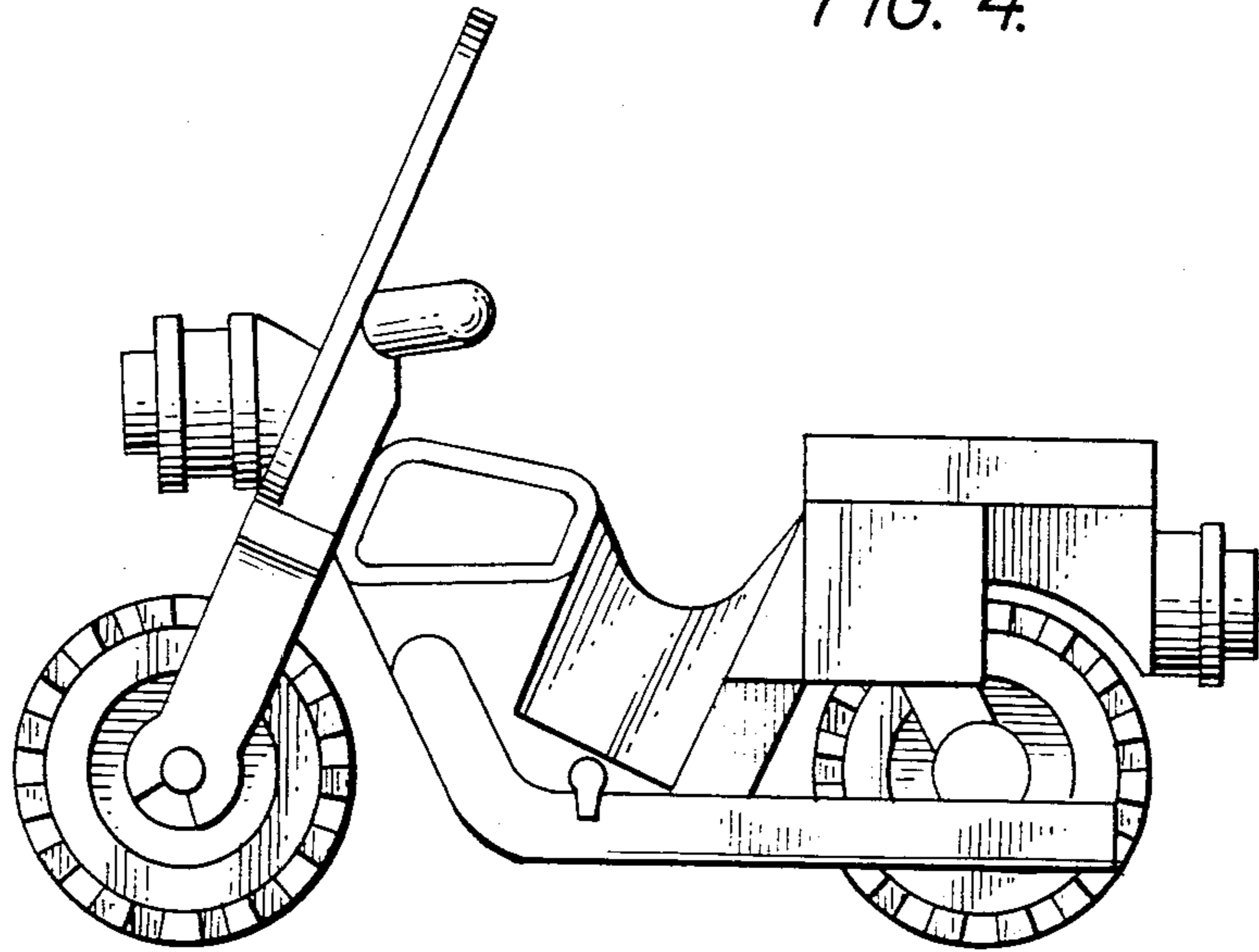

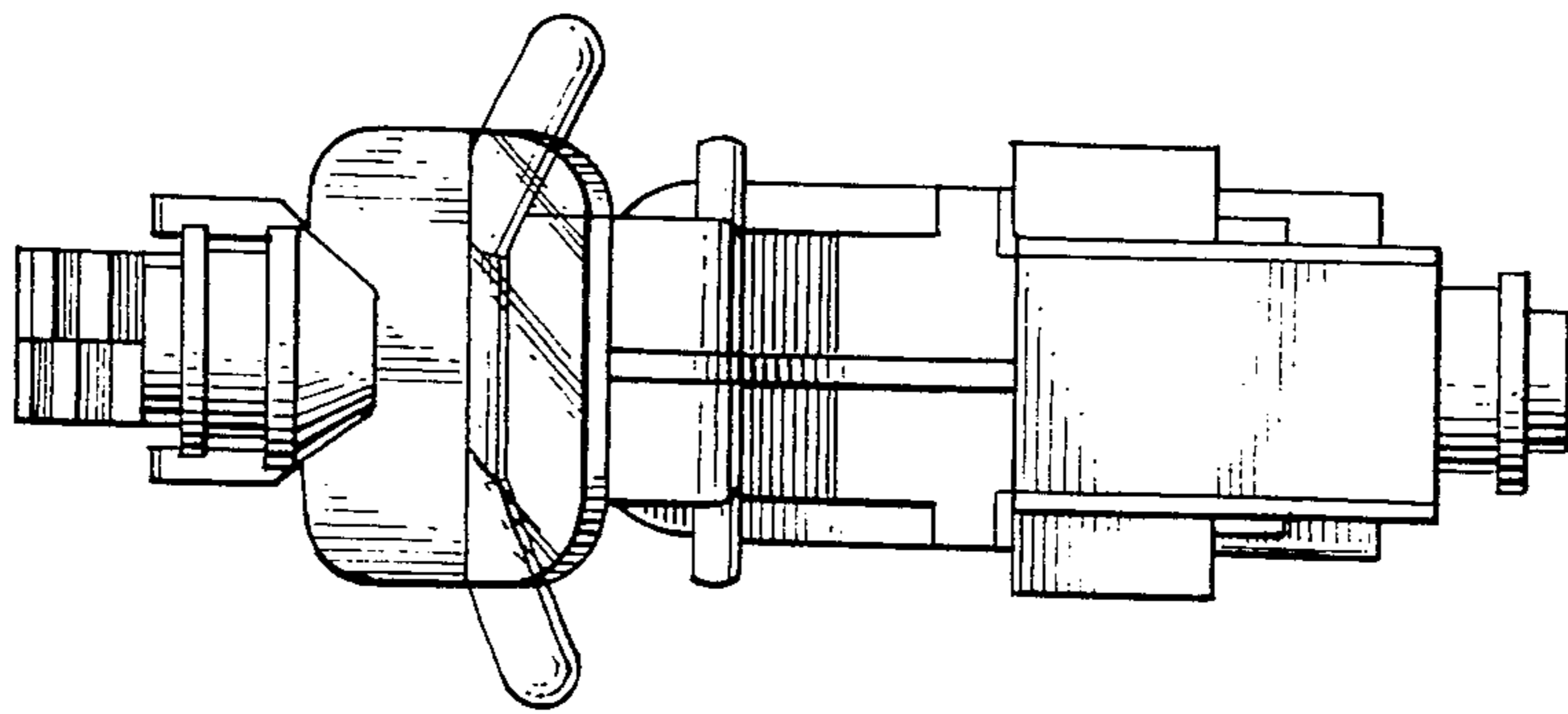
