DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a simulative toy bank showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.

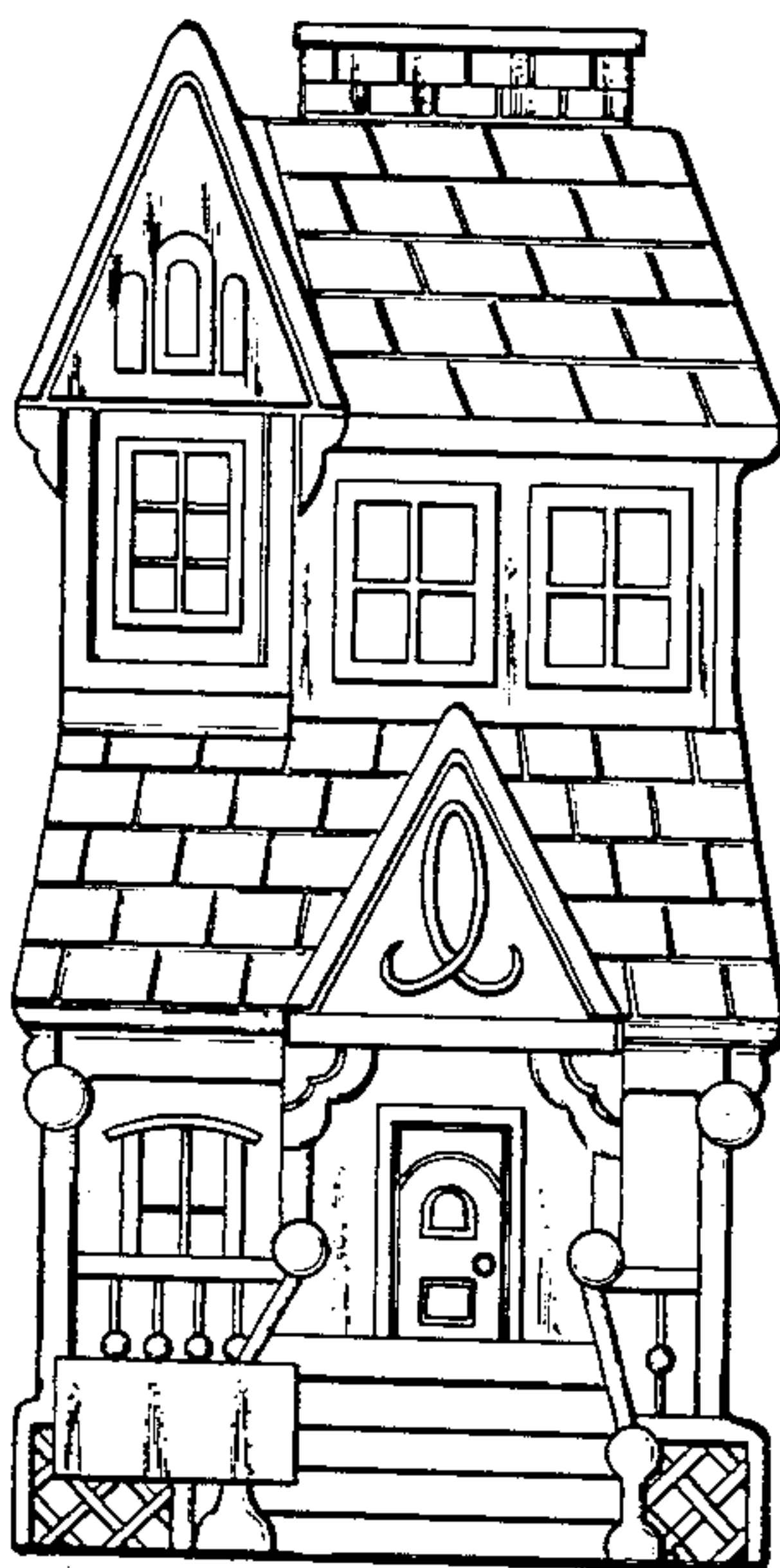

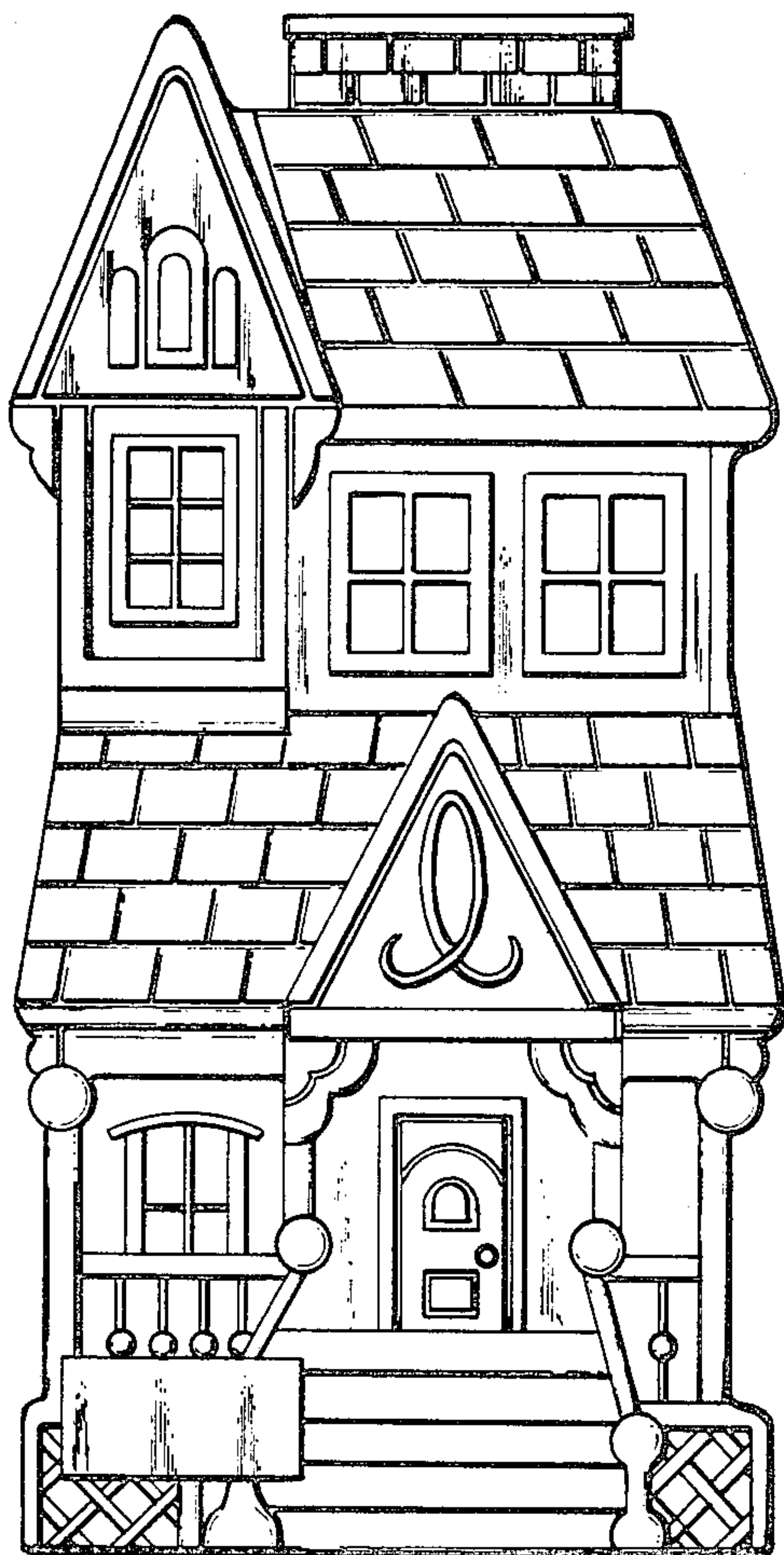

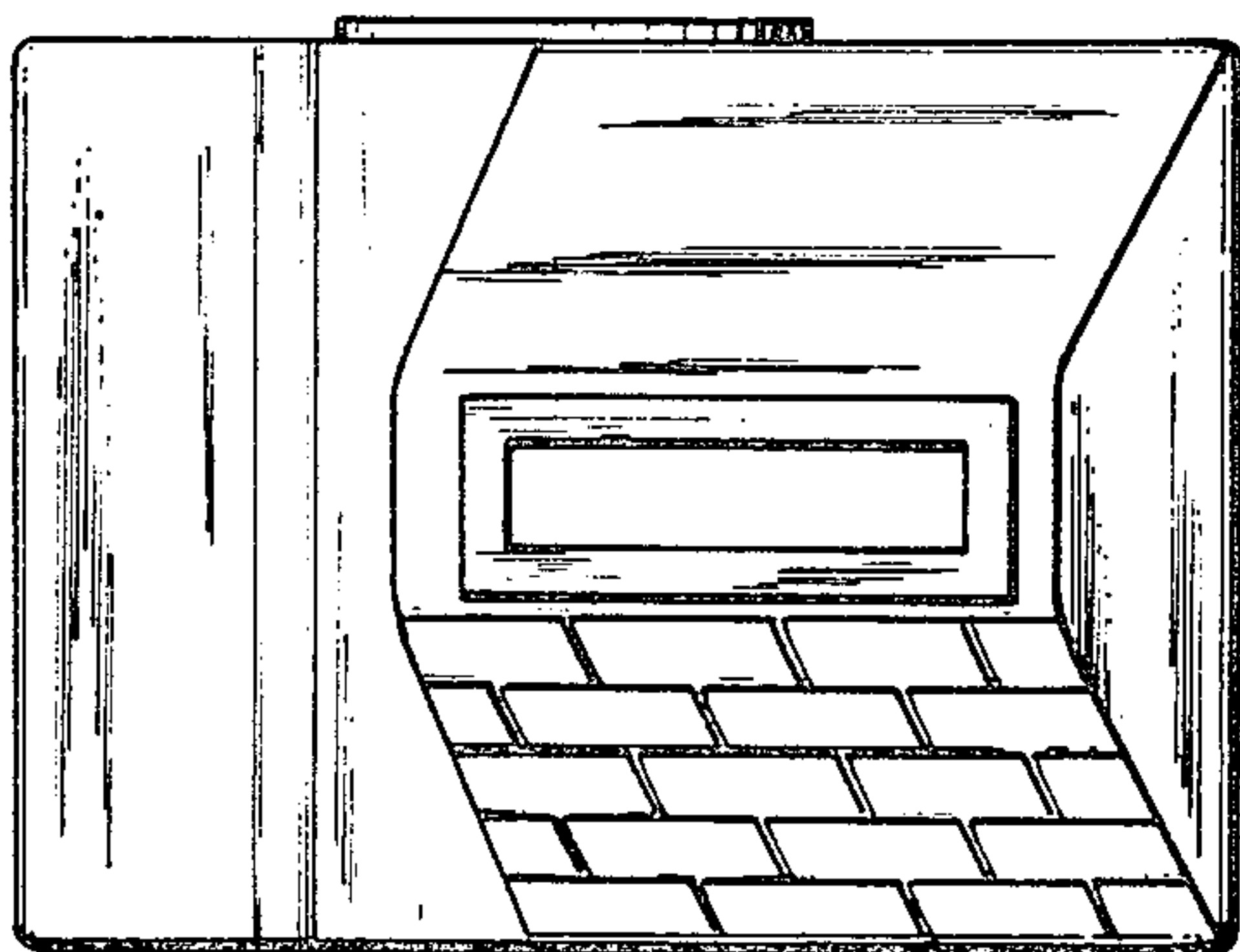
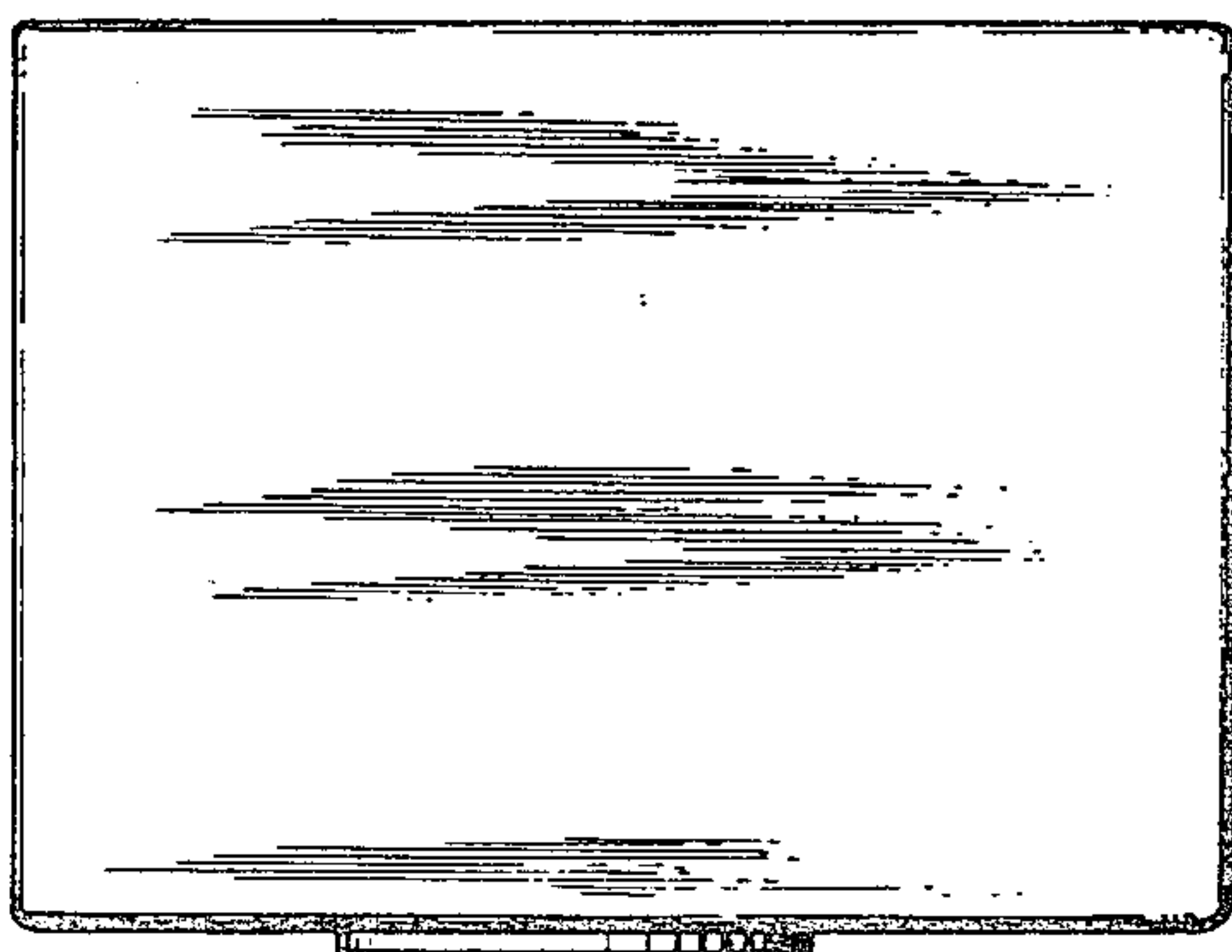

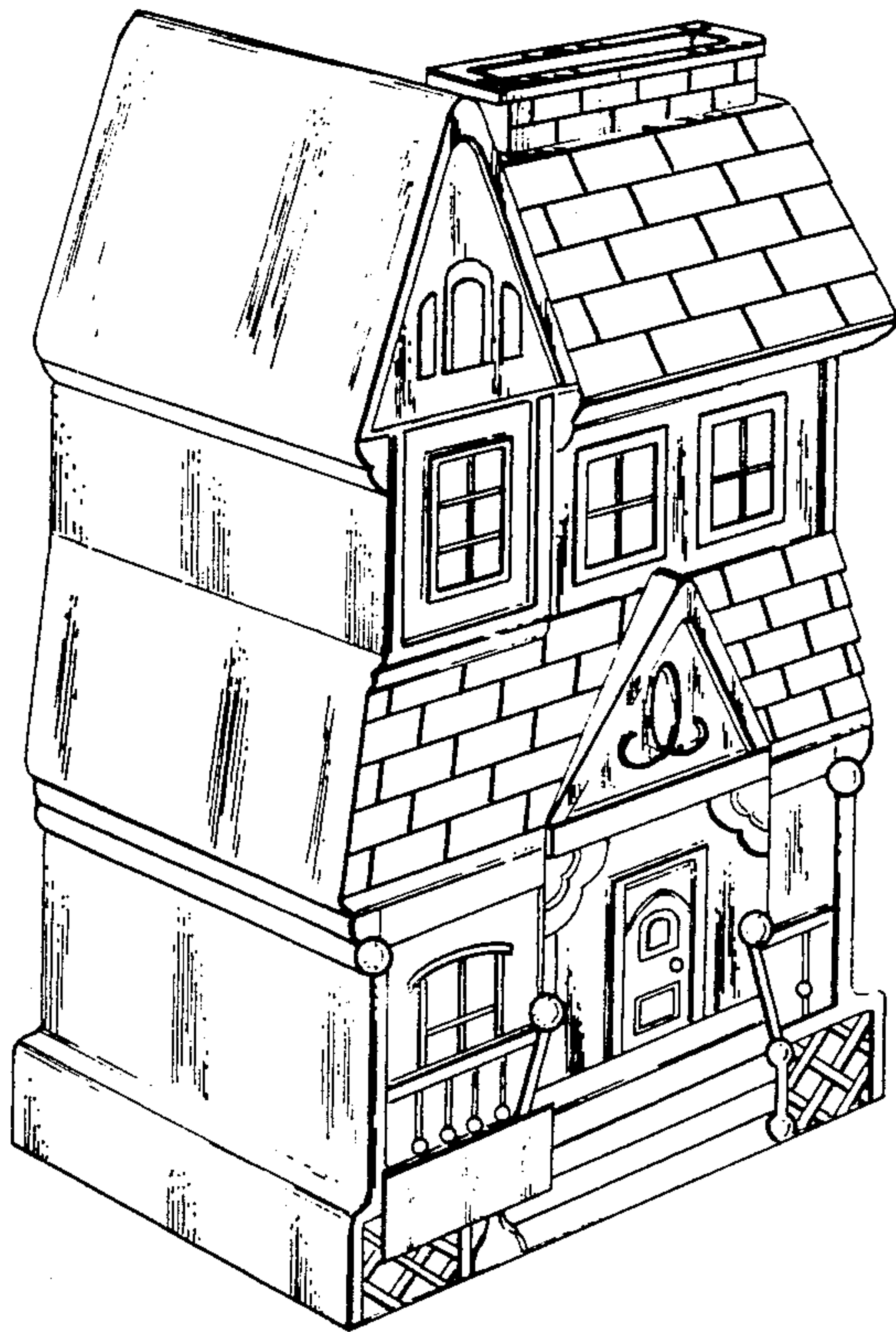

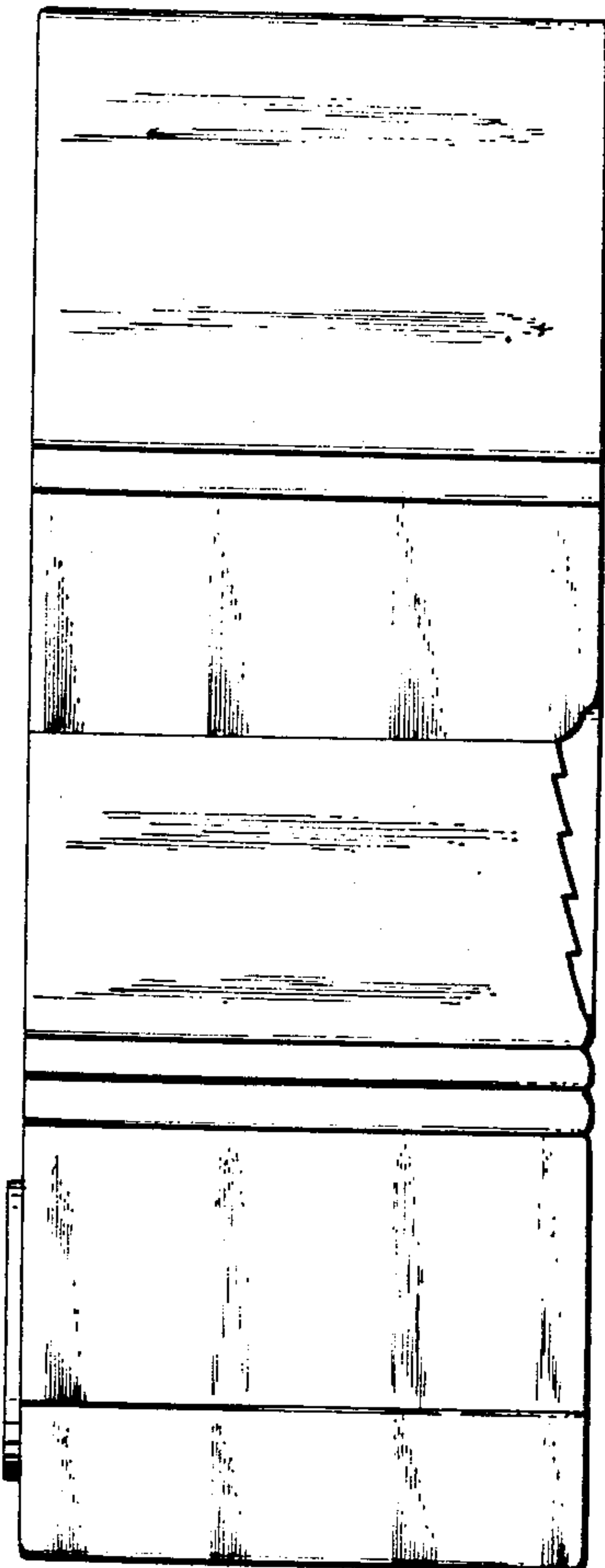
