[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a soft-sided wheeled suitcase, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a soft-sided wheeled suitcase showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof and showing the detachable pull strap connection; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

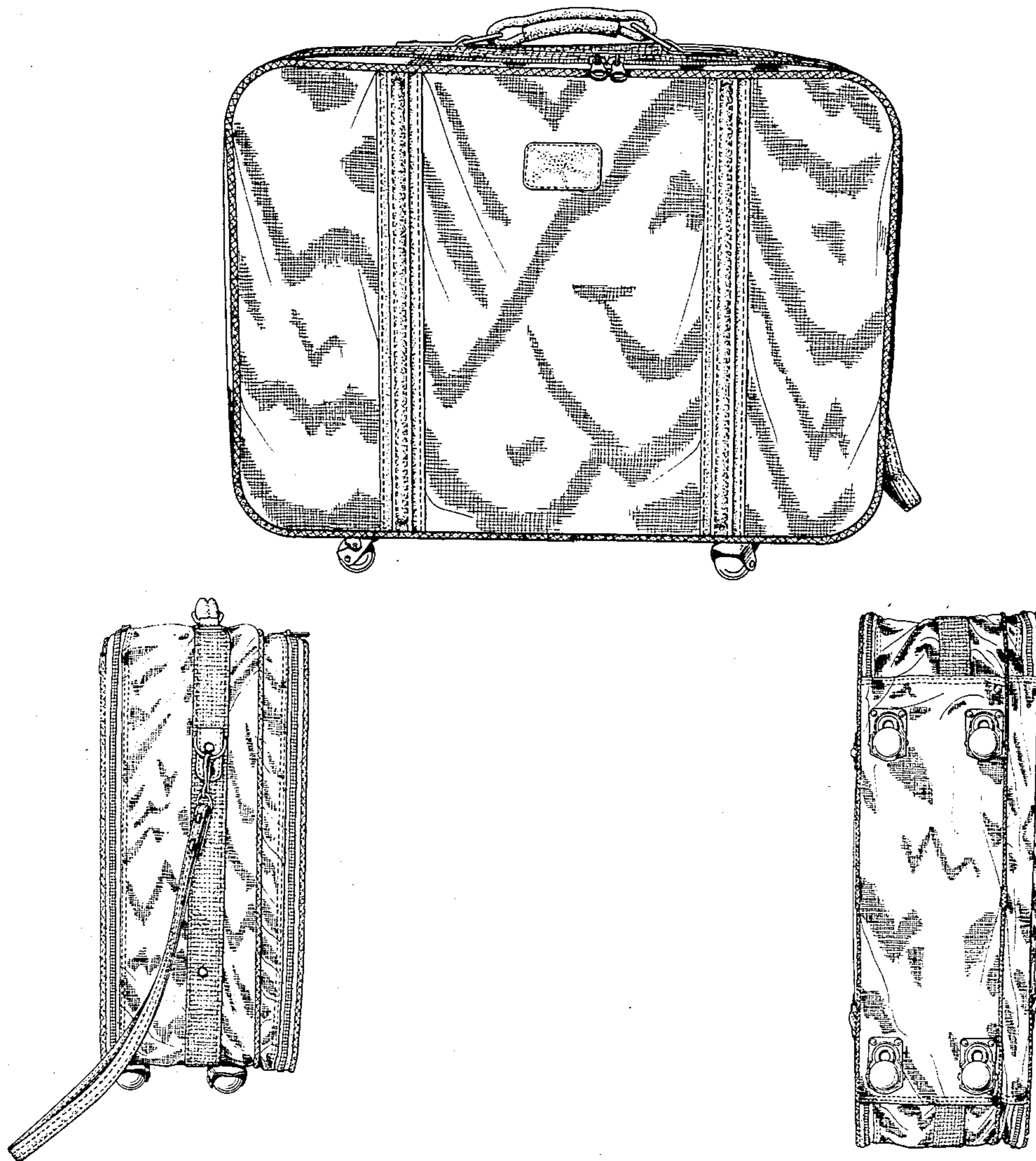

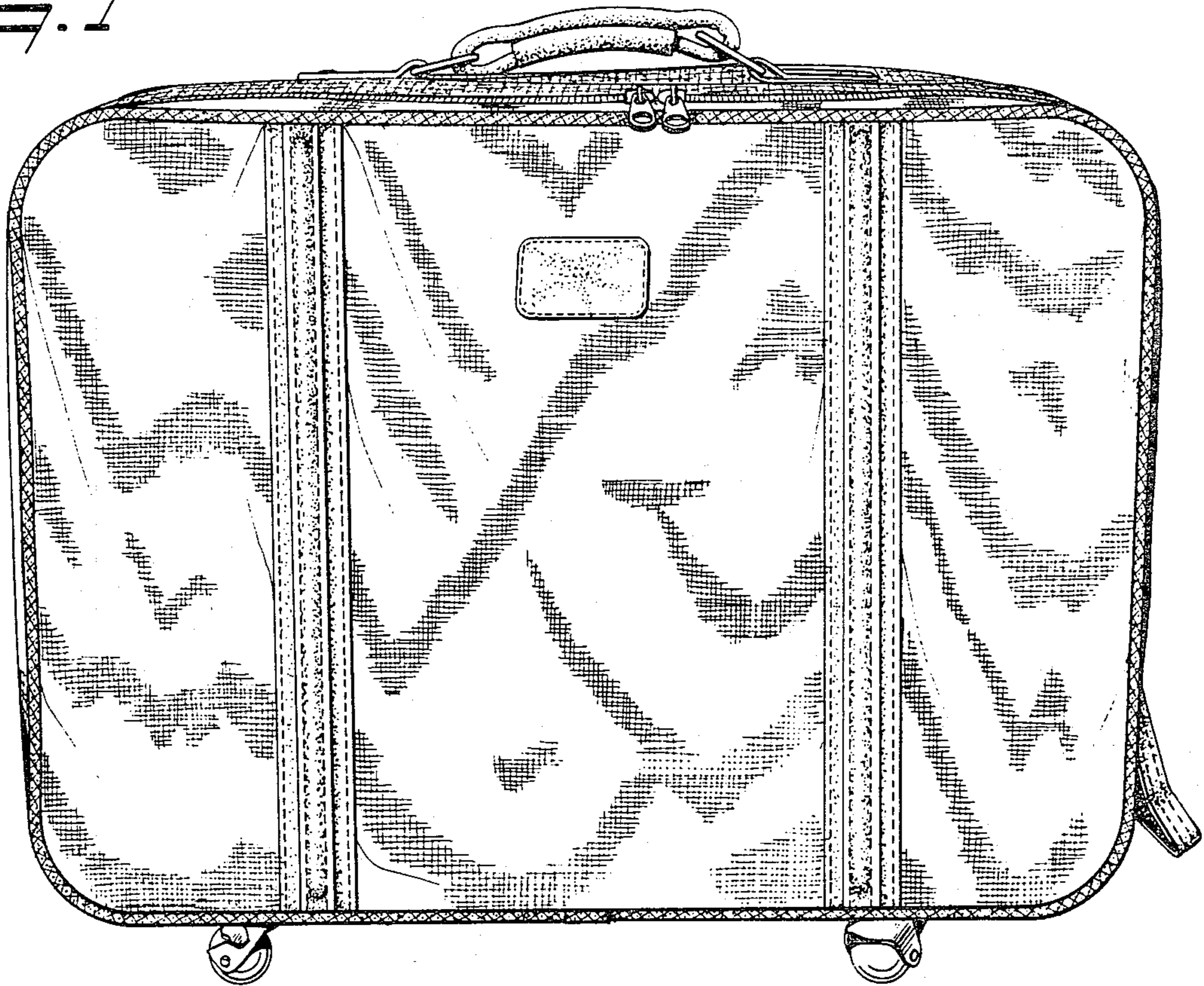

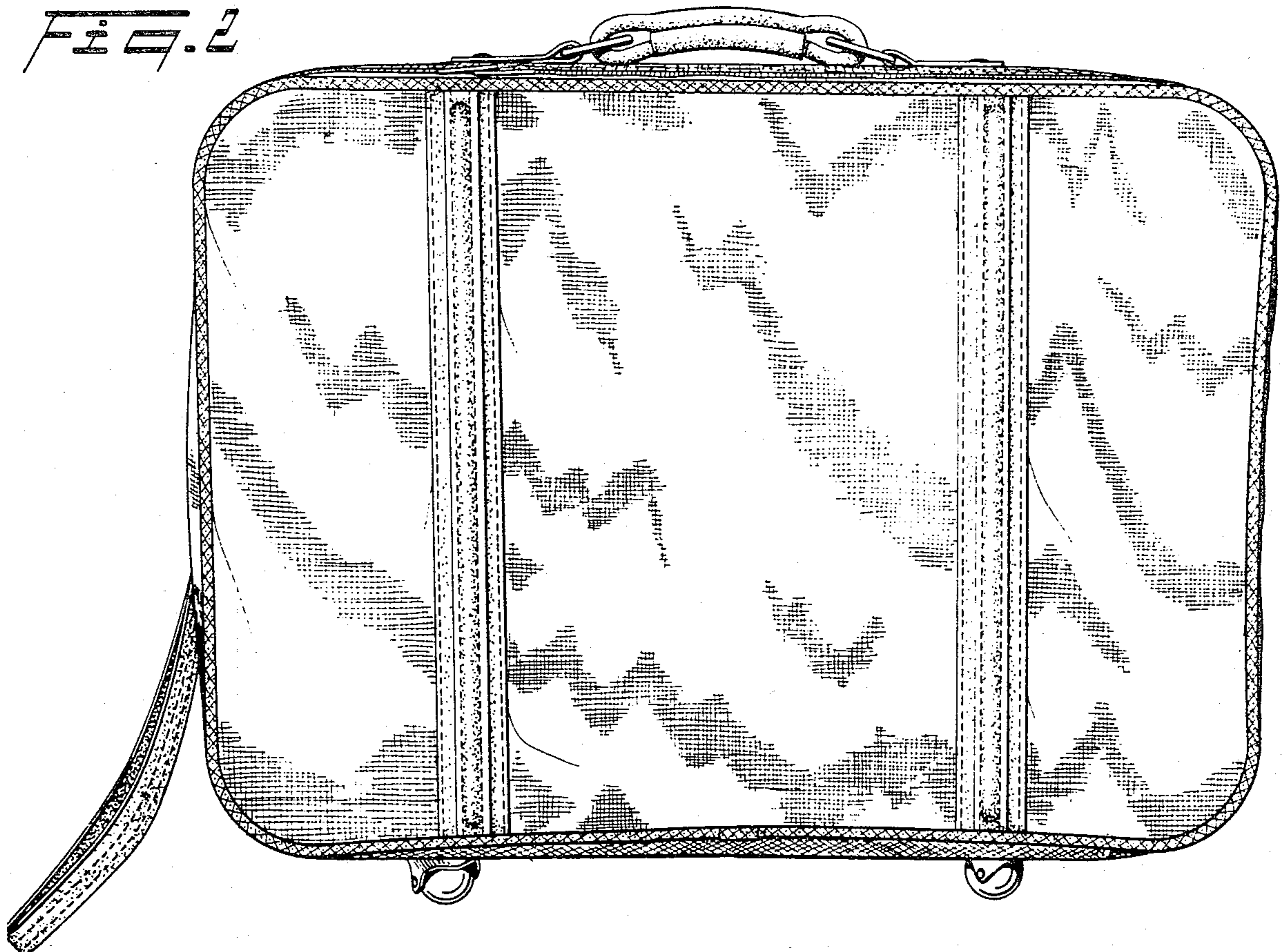

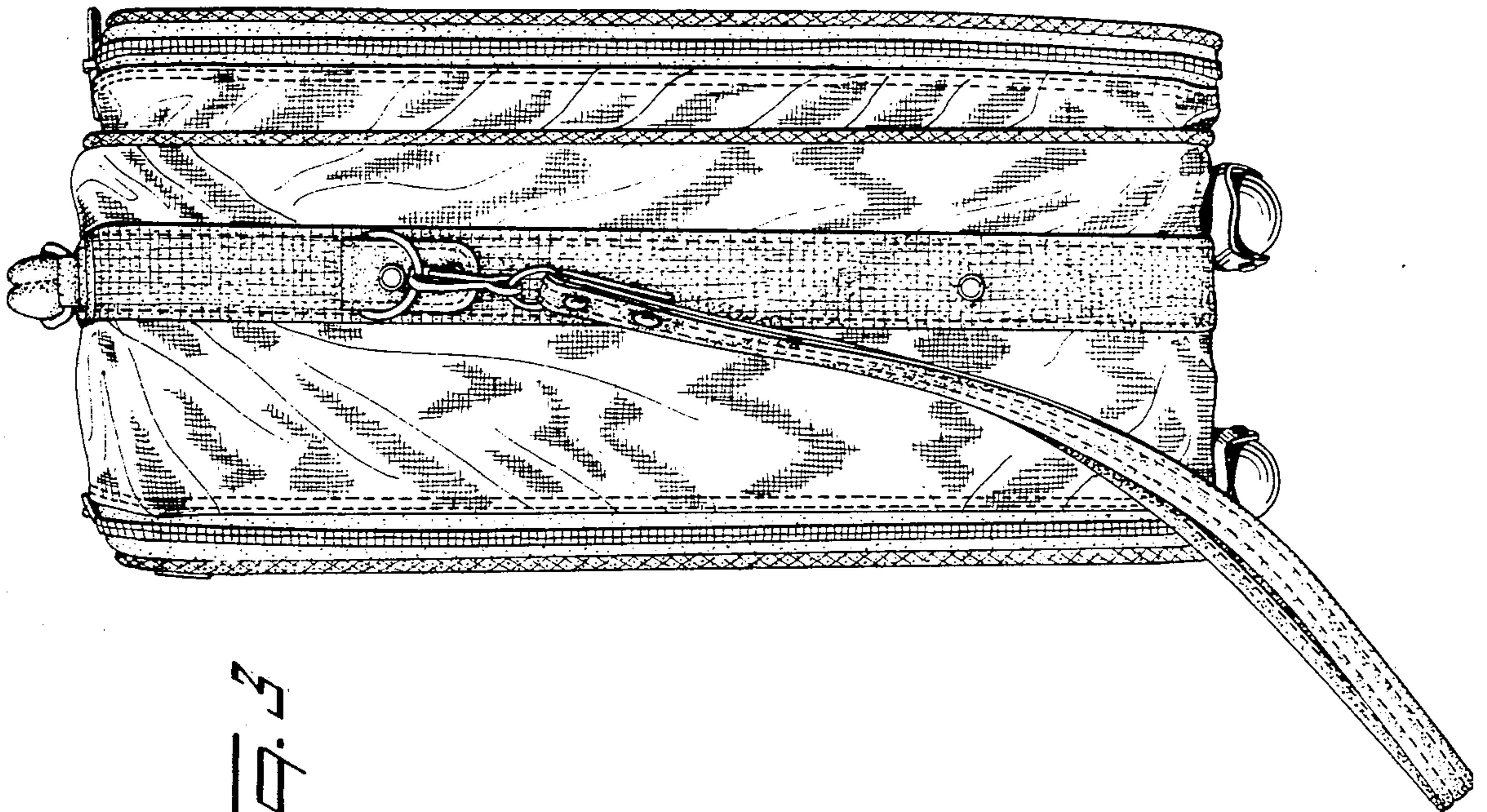
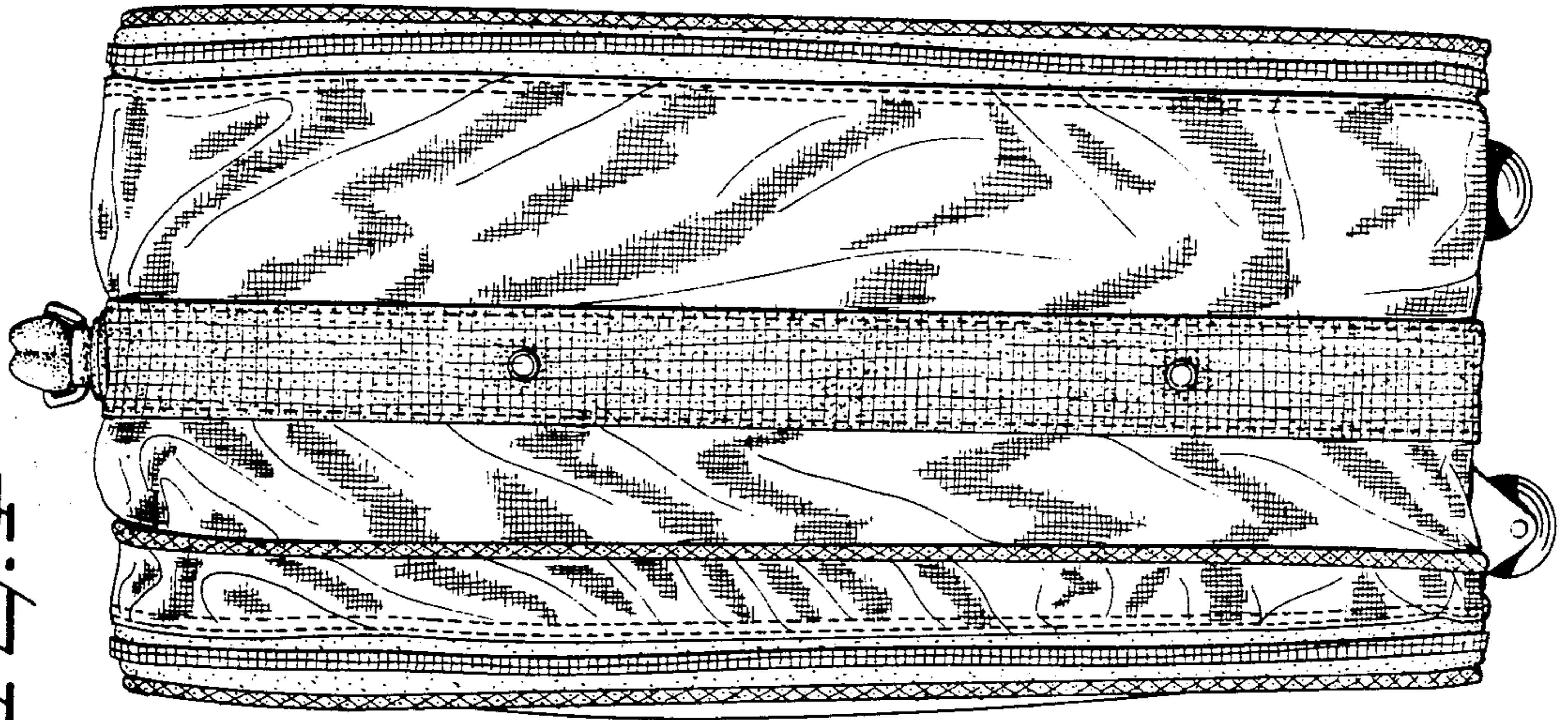
