FIG. 4 is a left-side perspective view thereof;

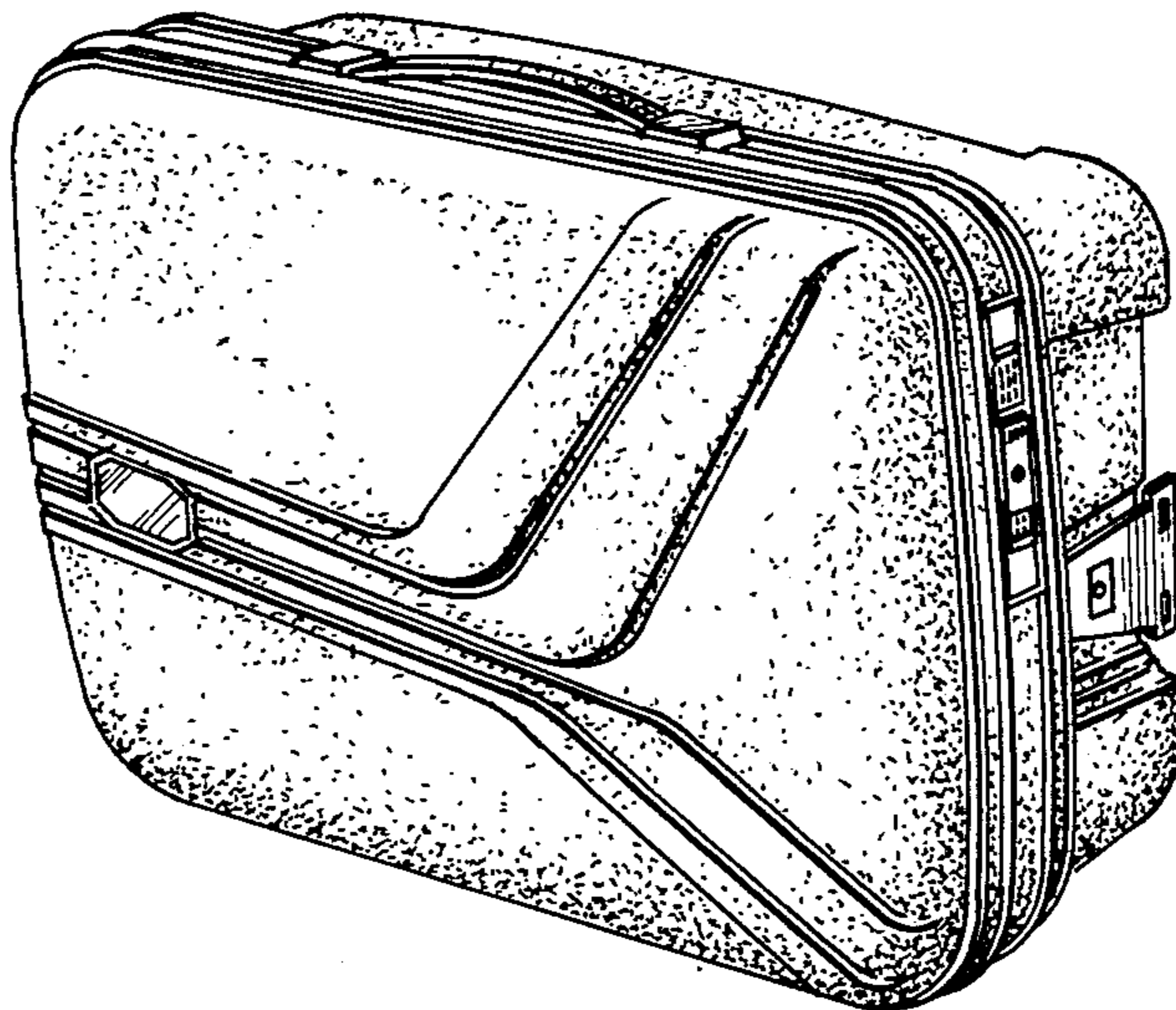
FIG. 5 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

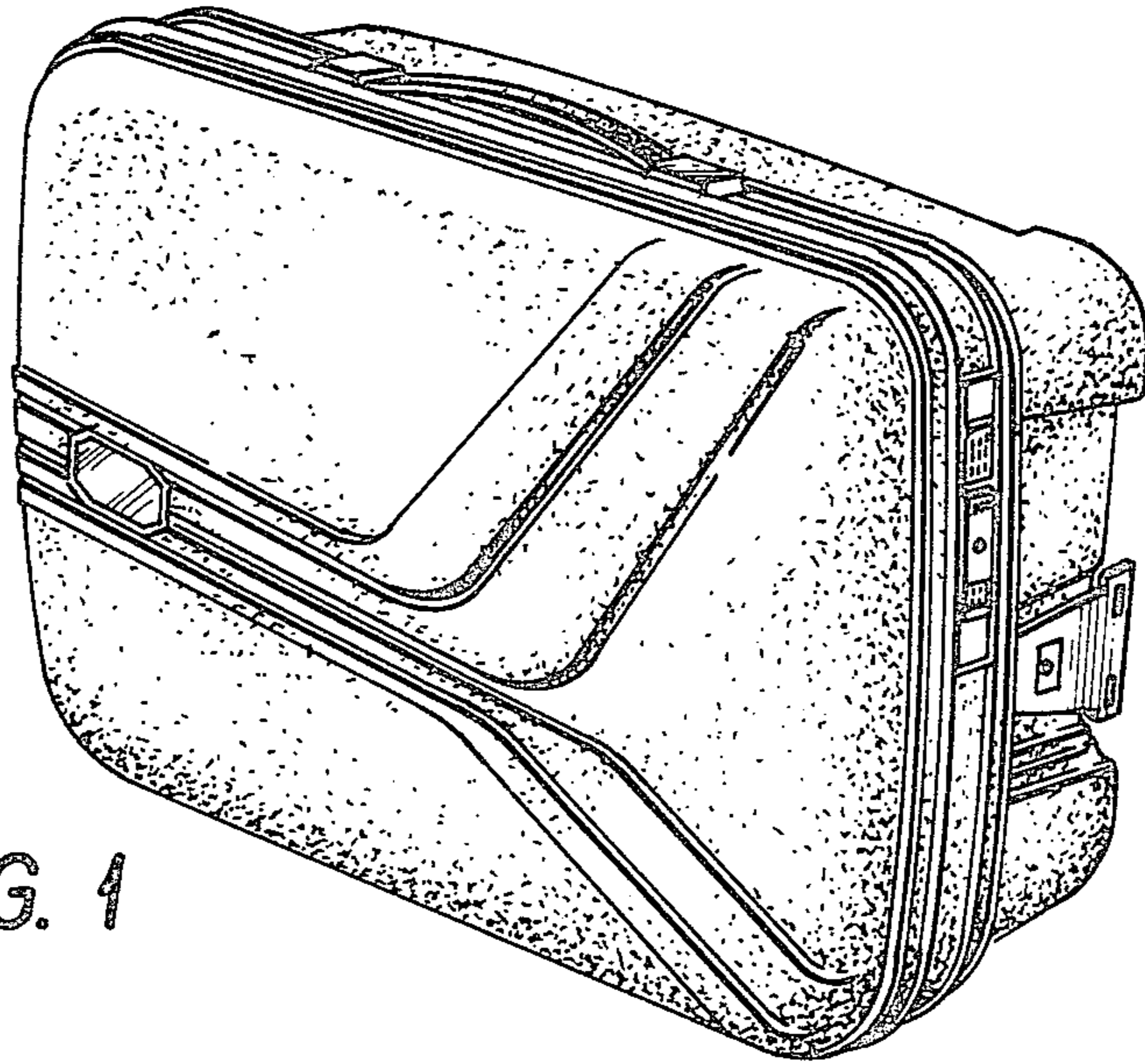

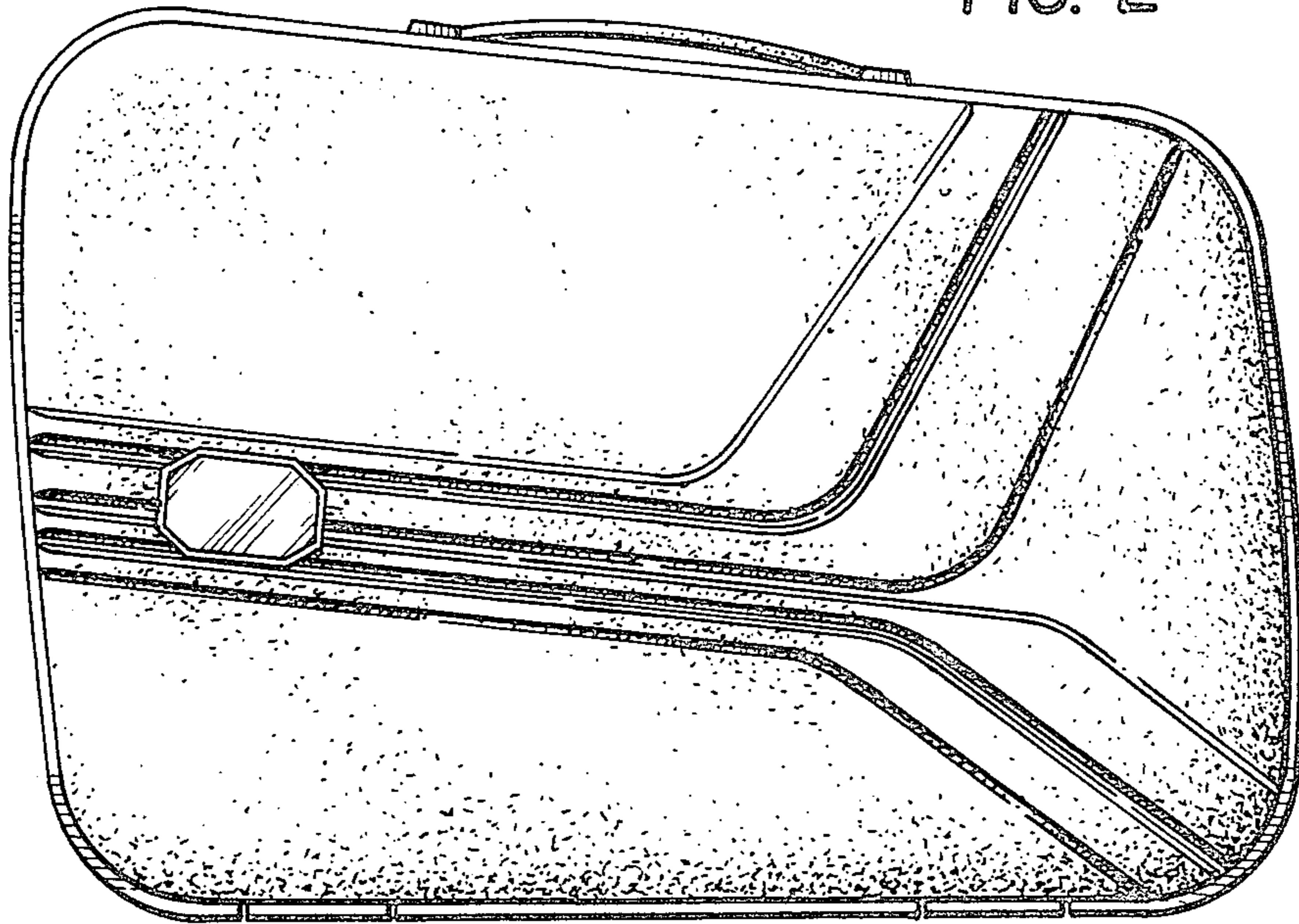

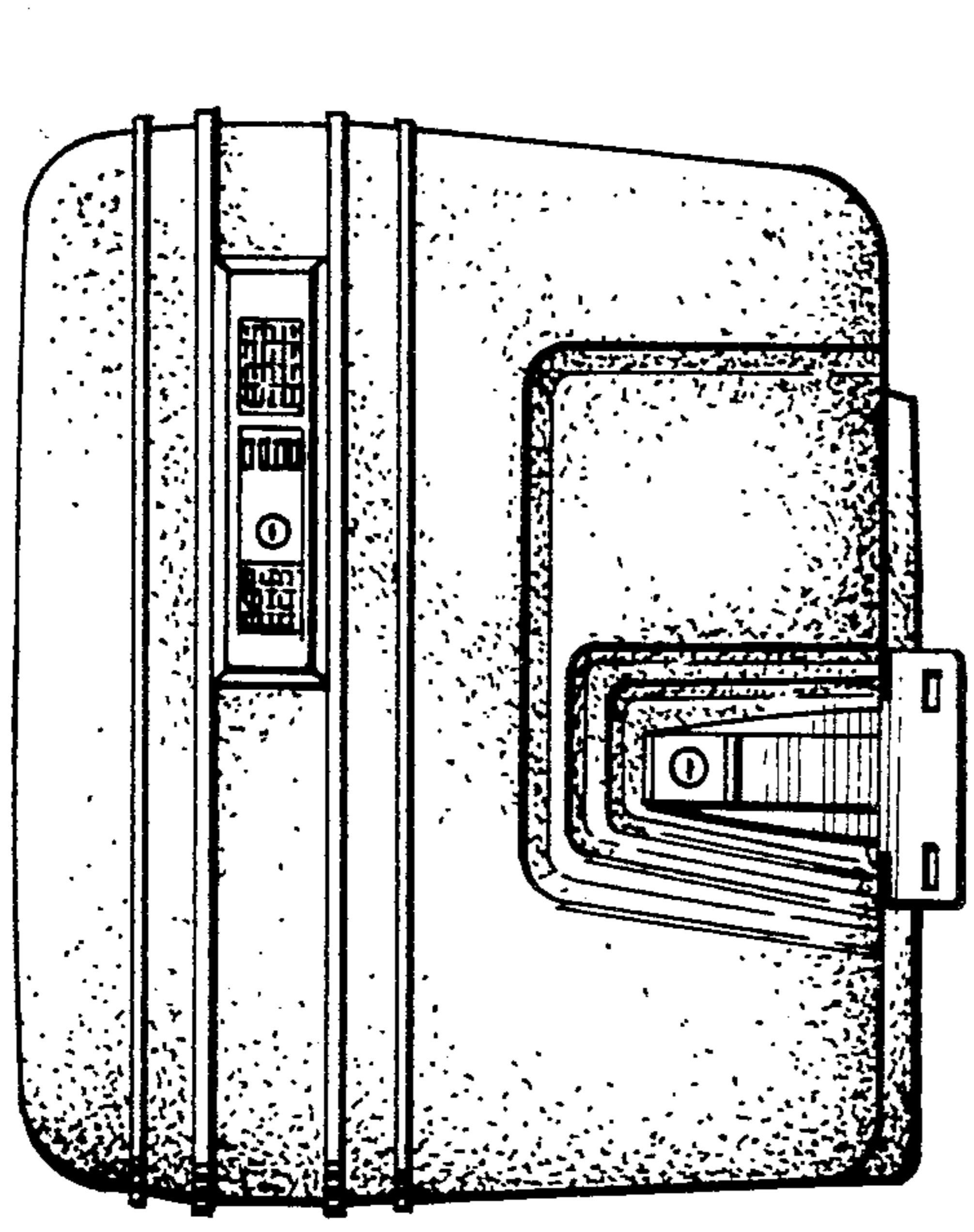

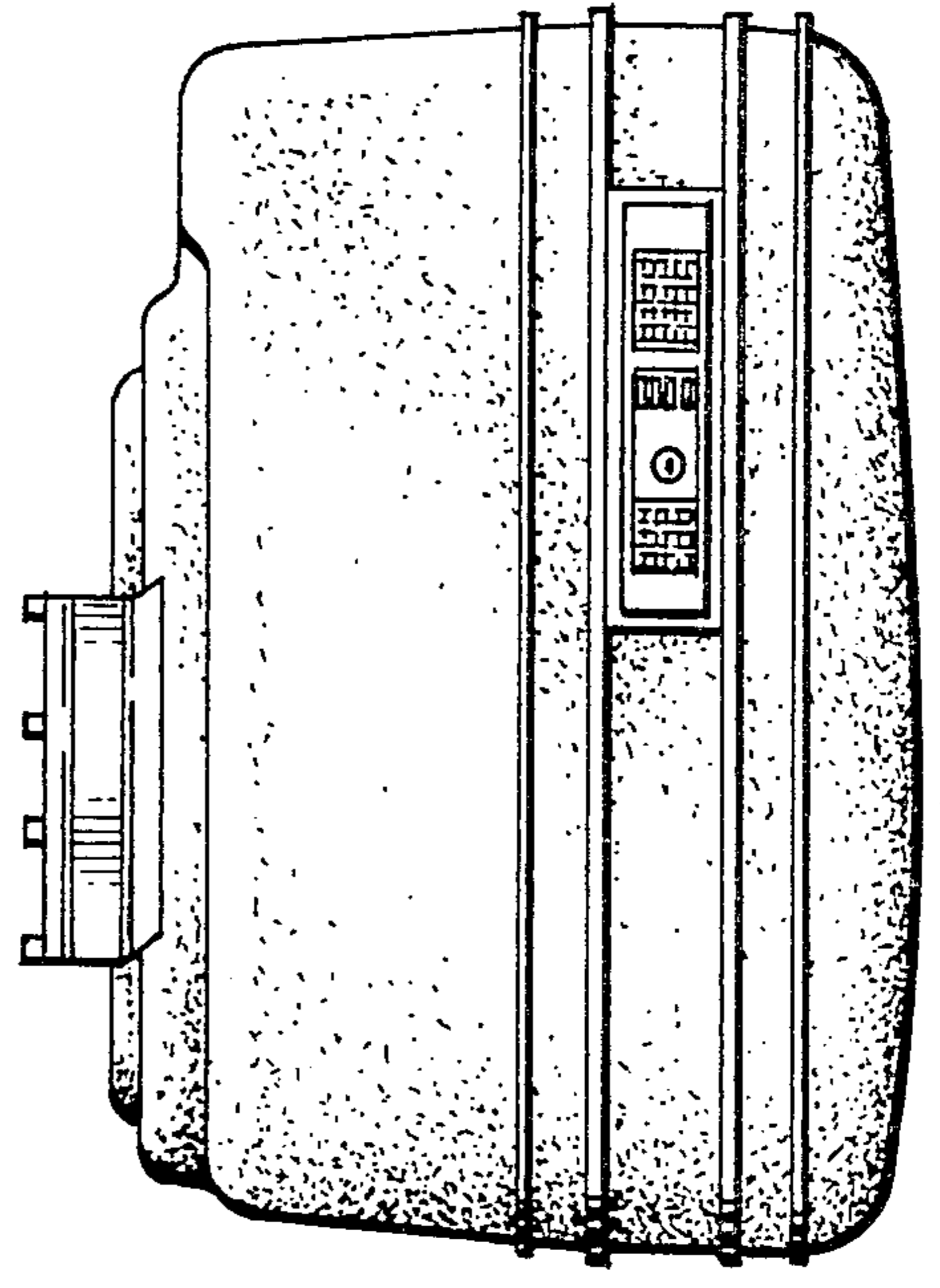

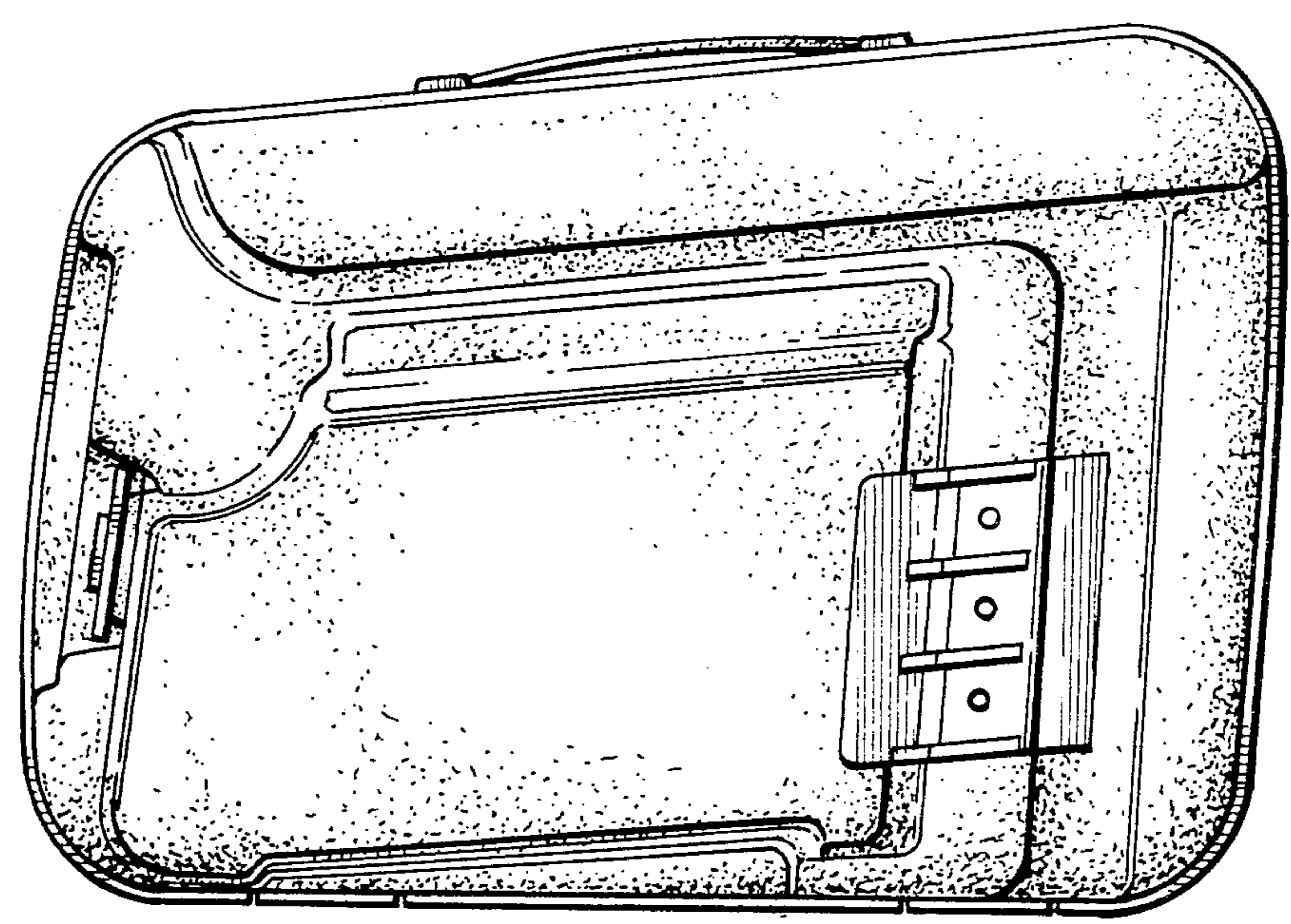

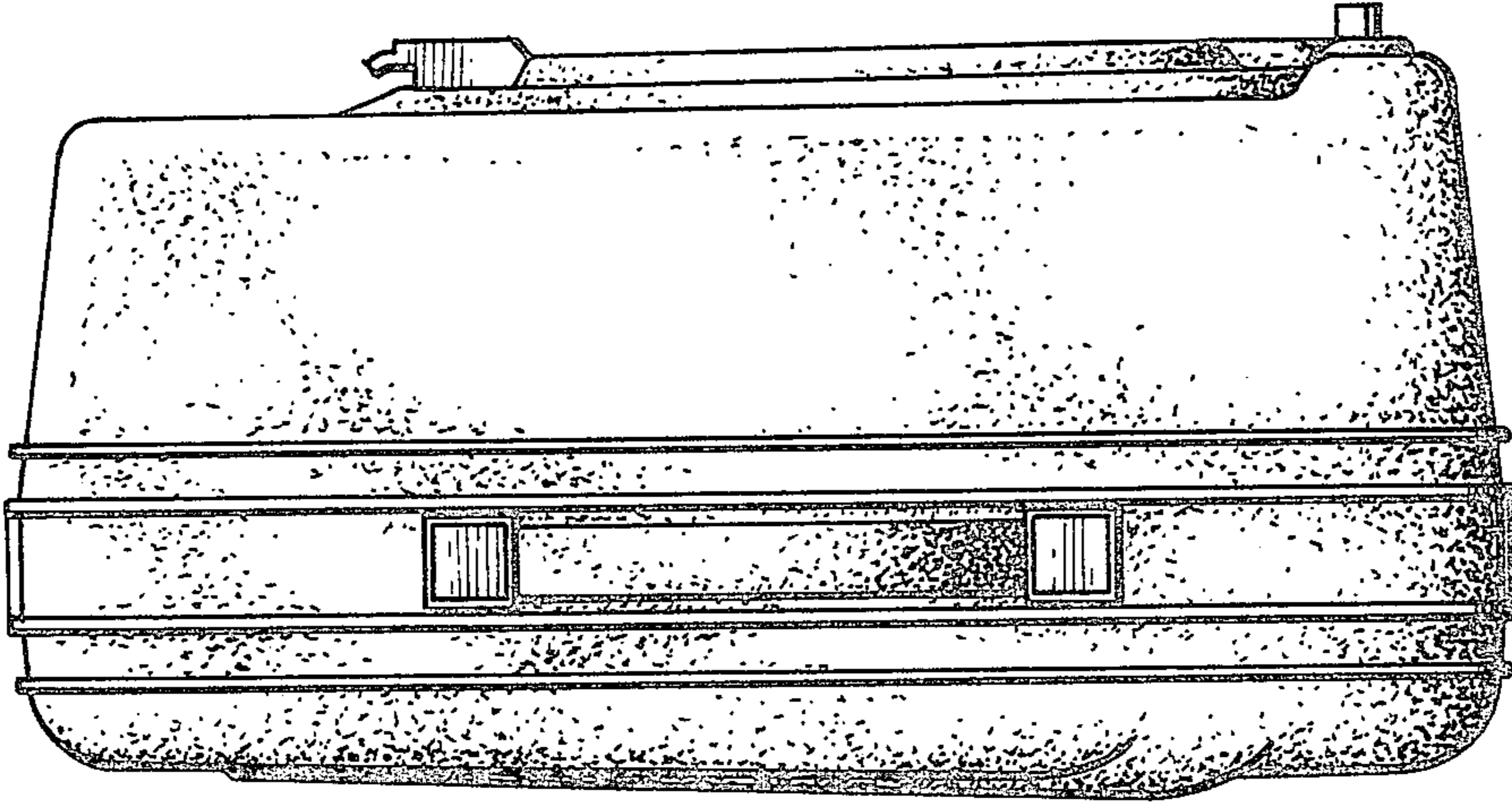
