The ornamental design for a boat hull, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a boat hull showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a starboard elevational view thereof, the port elevational view being a mirror image of FIG. 2;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bow elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a stern elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along plane VI—VI in FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along plane VII—VII in FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along plane VIII—VIII

in FIG. 2;
FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken along plane IX—IX in

FIG. 2; FIG. 10 is a sectional view taken along plane X—X in

FIG. 2; FIG. 11 is a sectional view taken along plane XI—XI in
