**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a motorcycle light indicator, showing my new design, a portion of the support bracket being omitted as not forming a part of the present design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

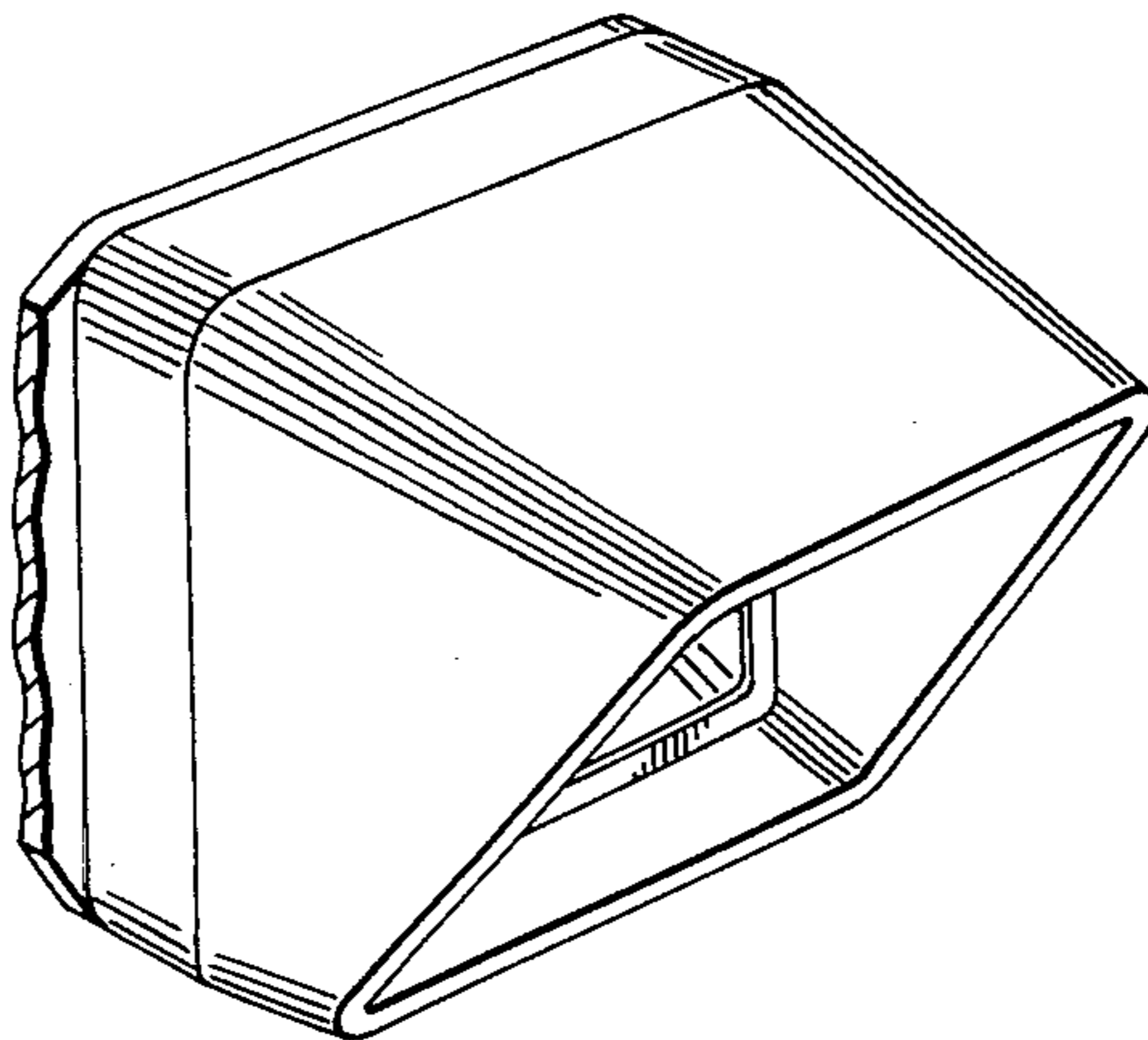

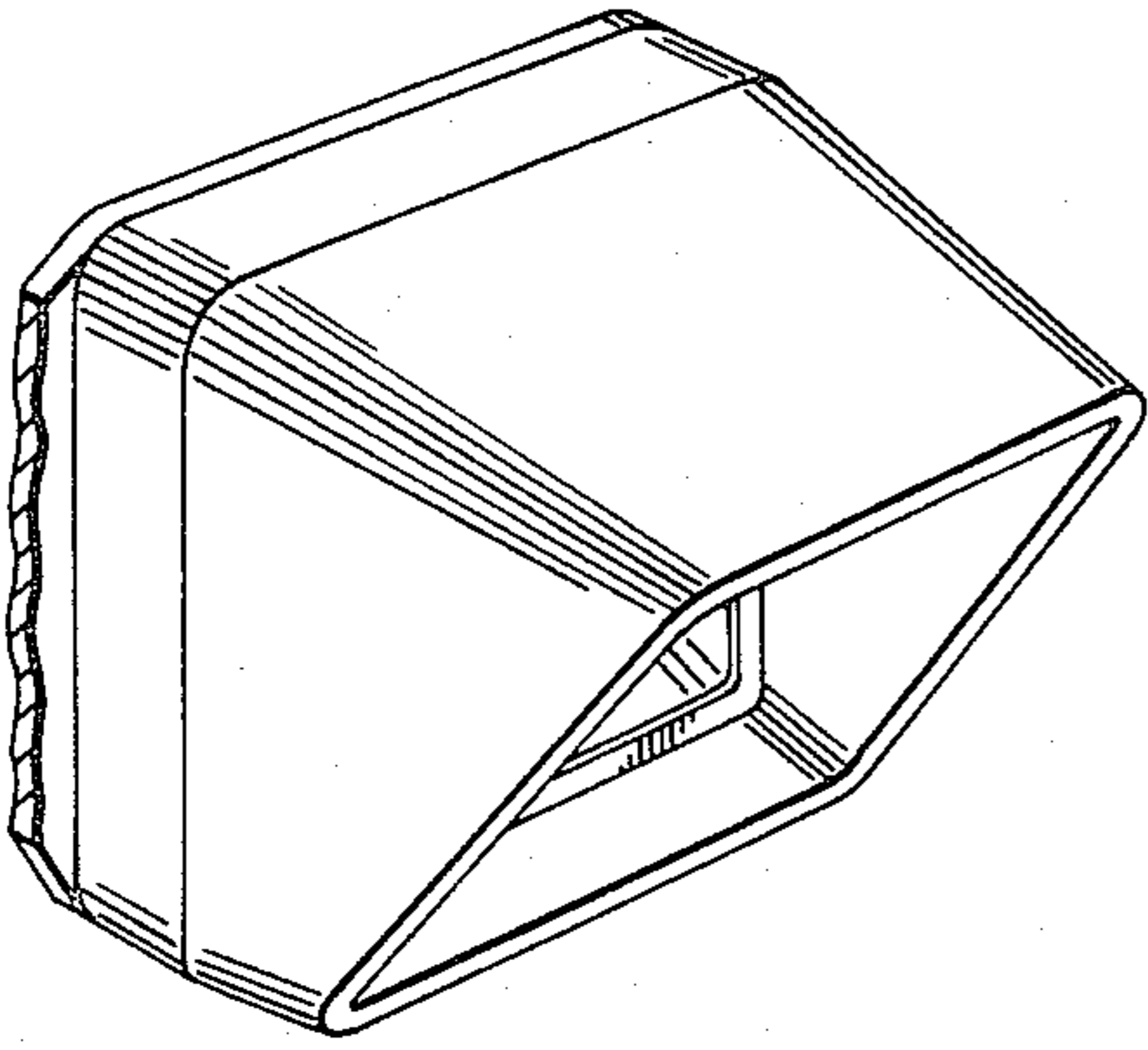

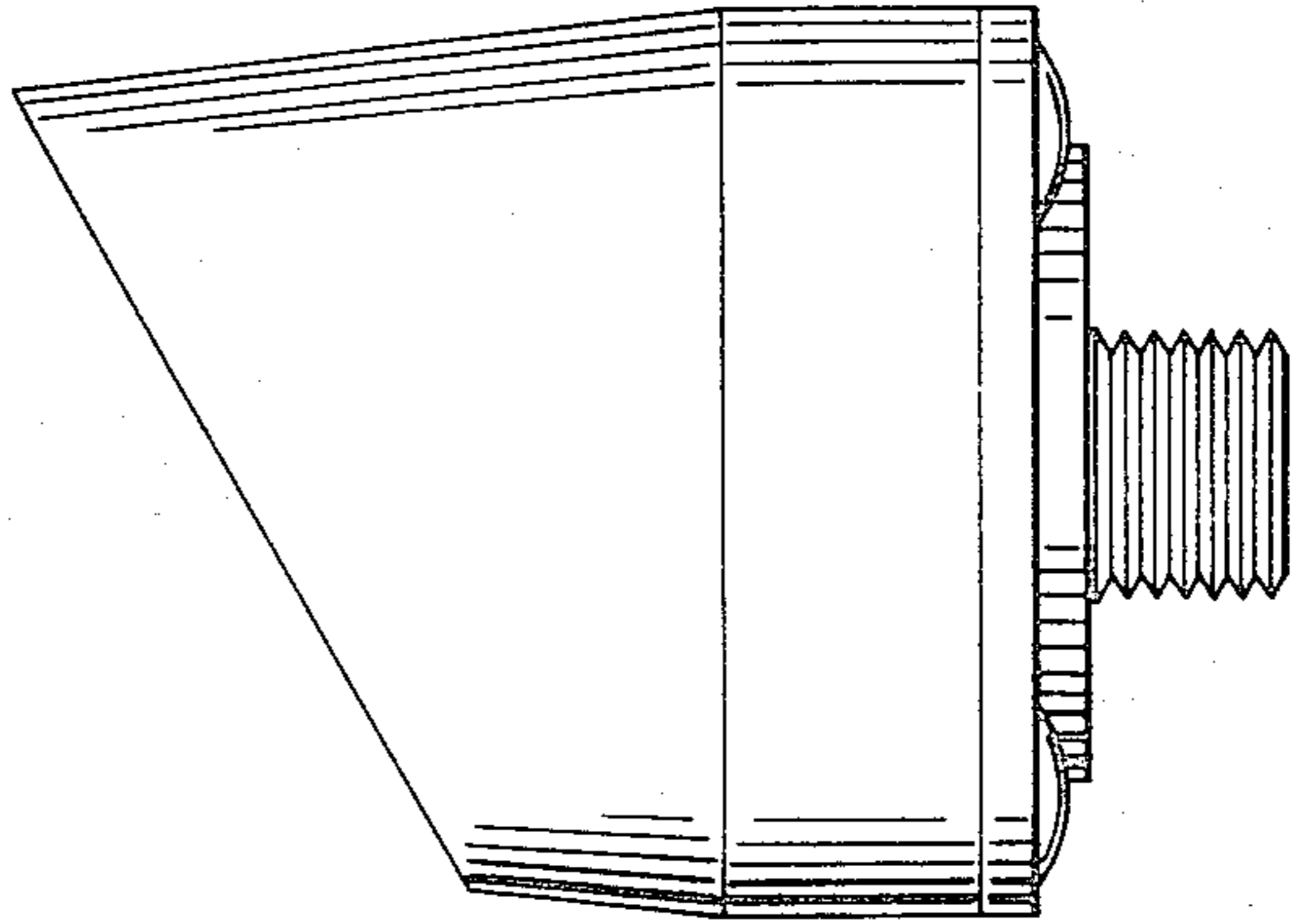

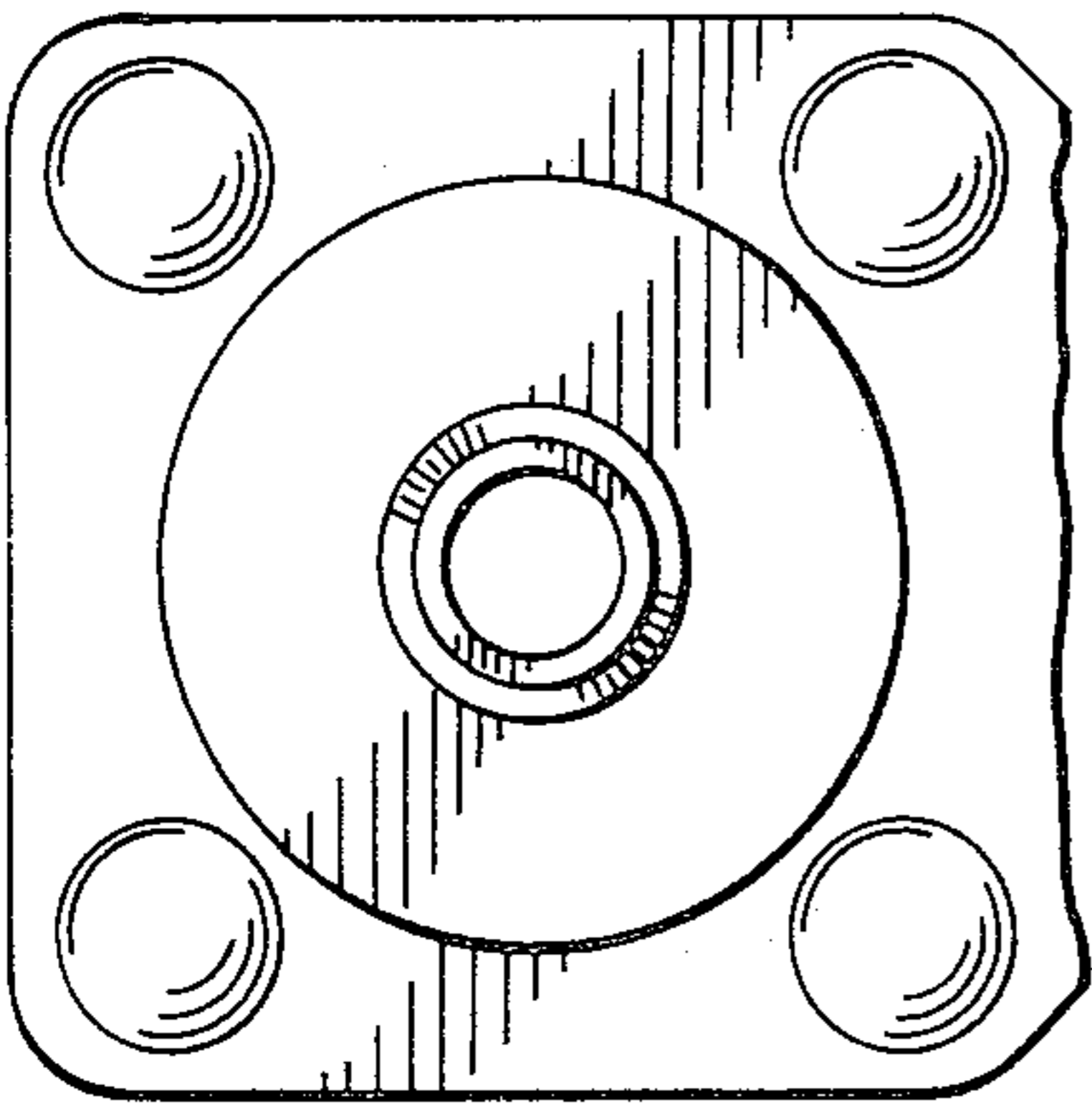

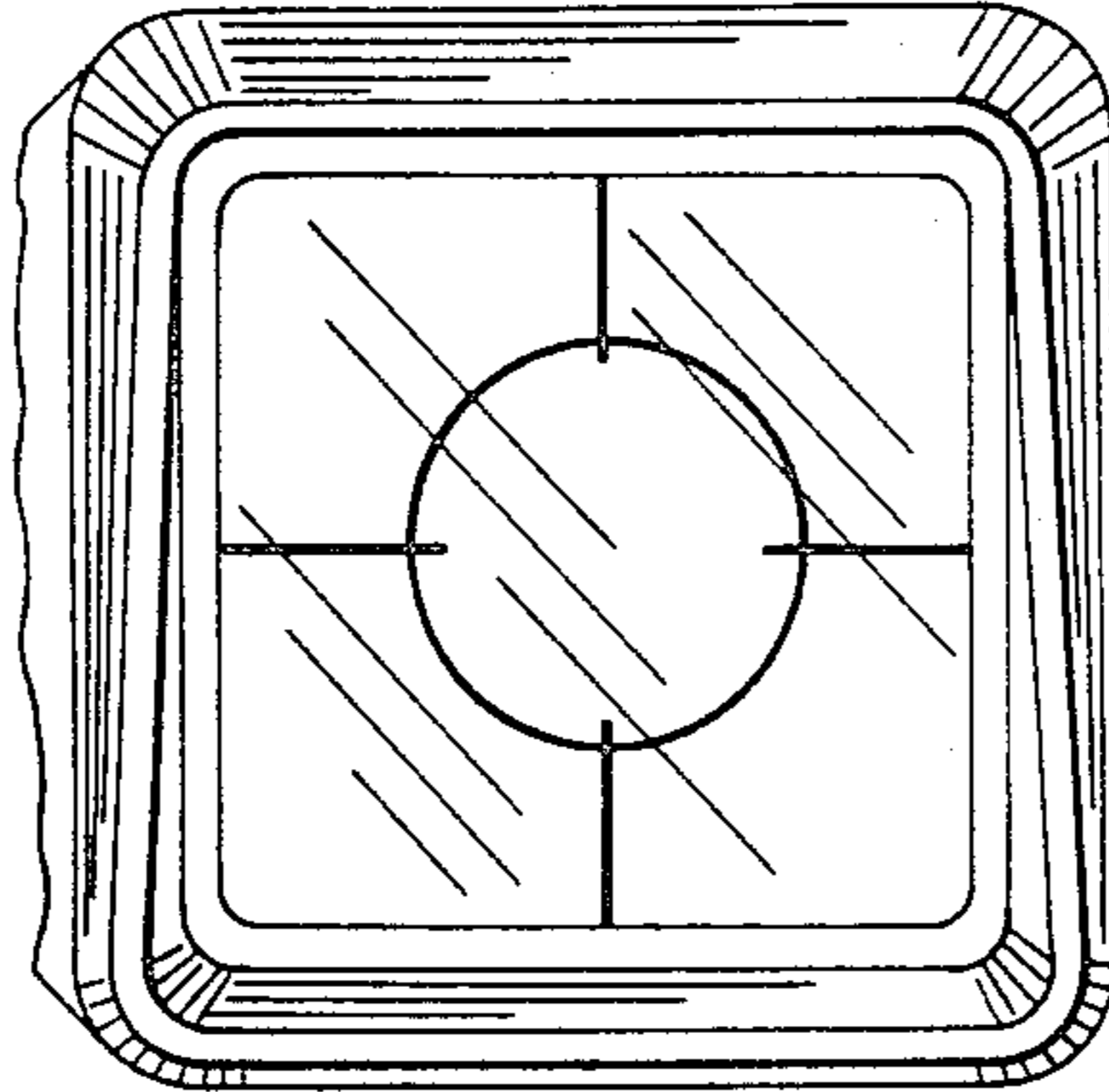

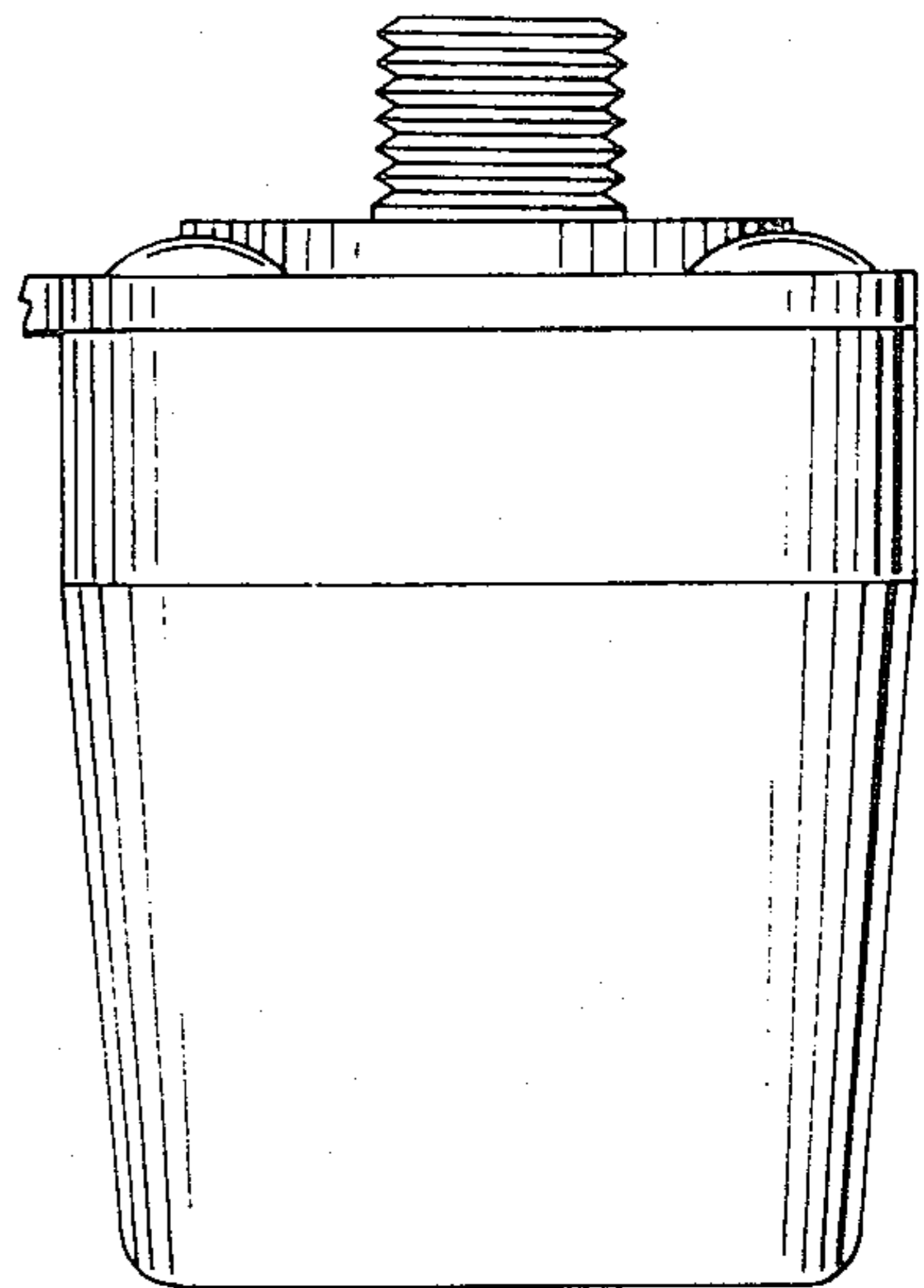

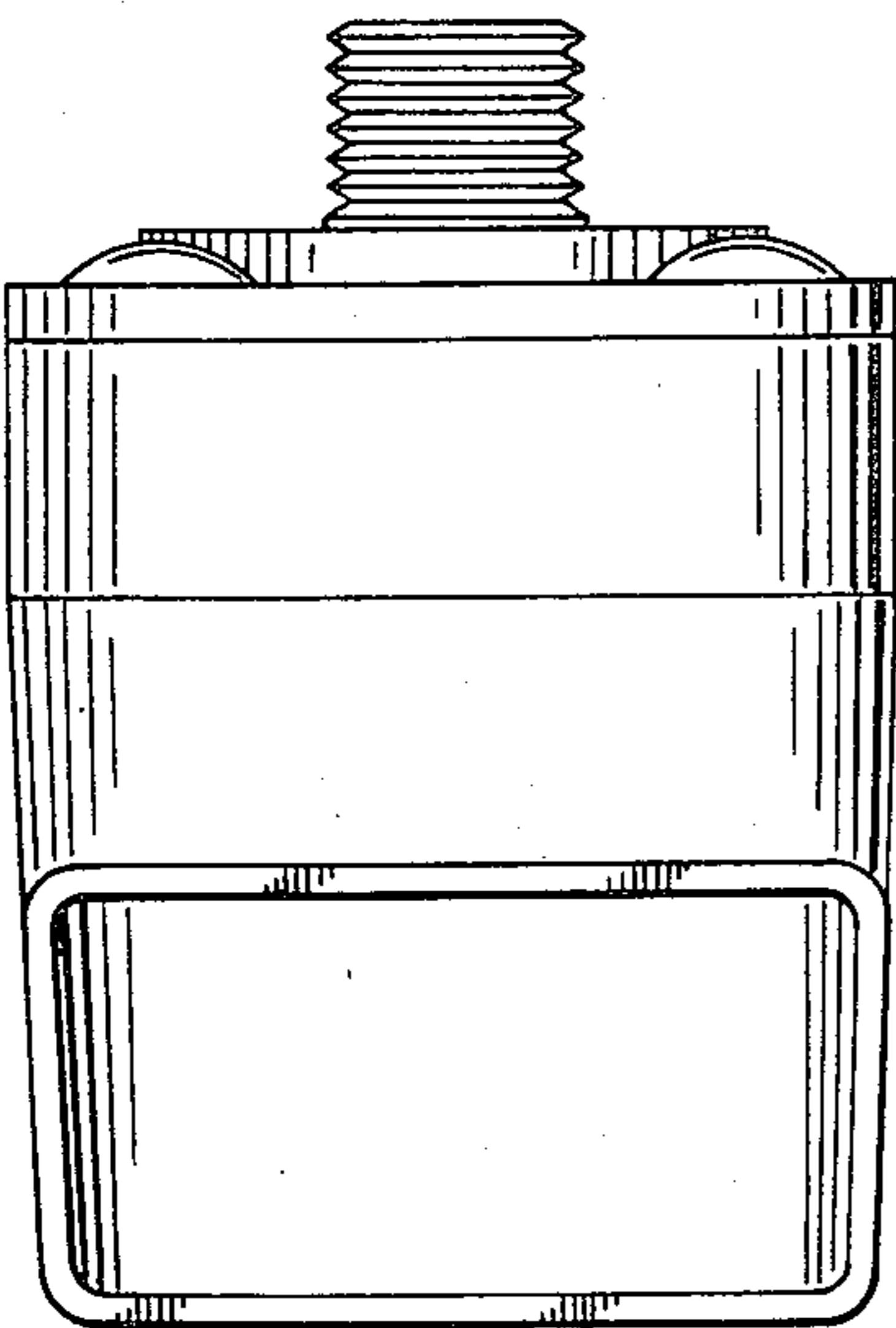
