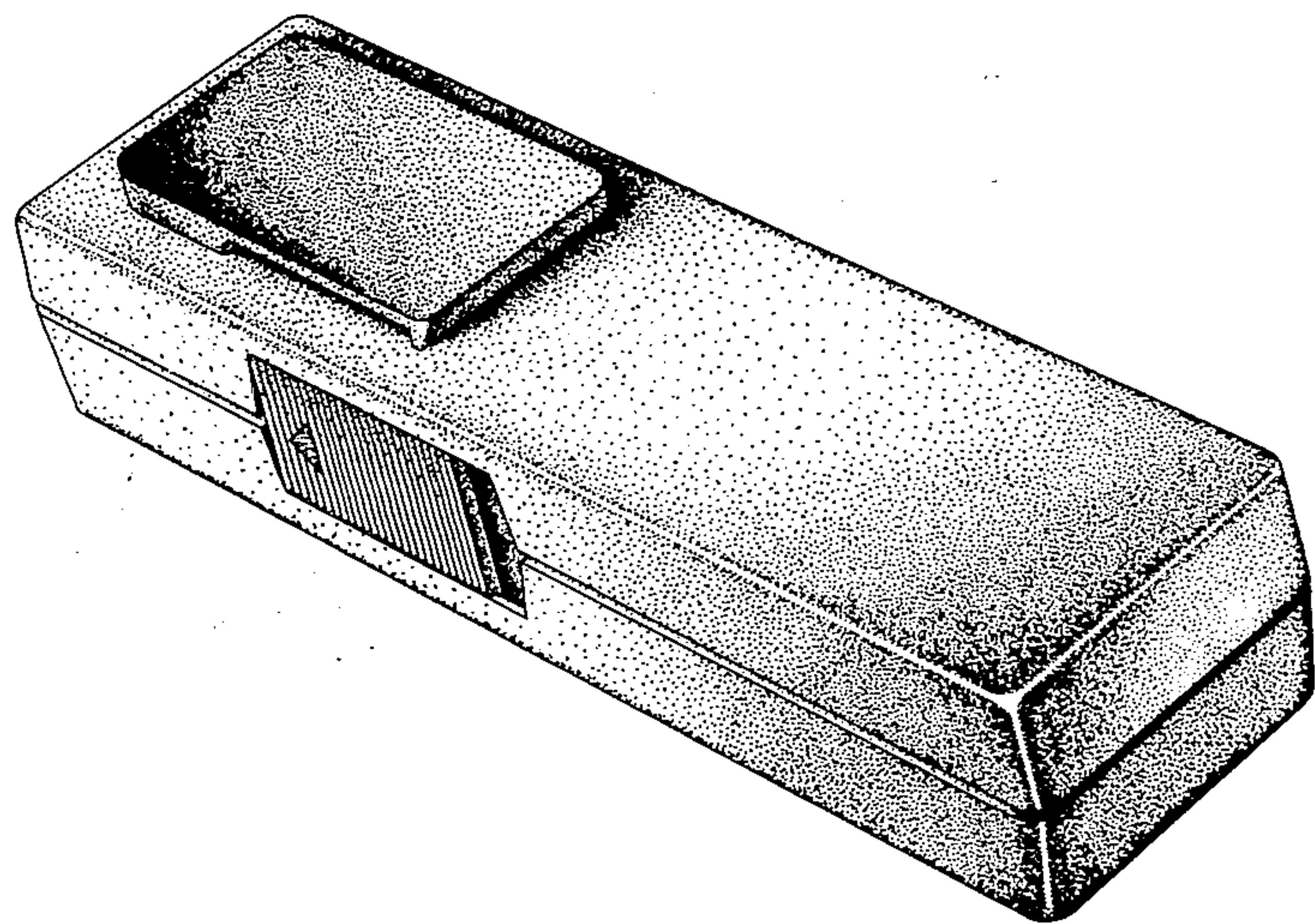

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear, bottom, and right side perspective view
of a portable transmitter, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear, top and left side perspective view
thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



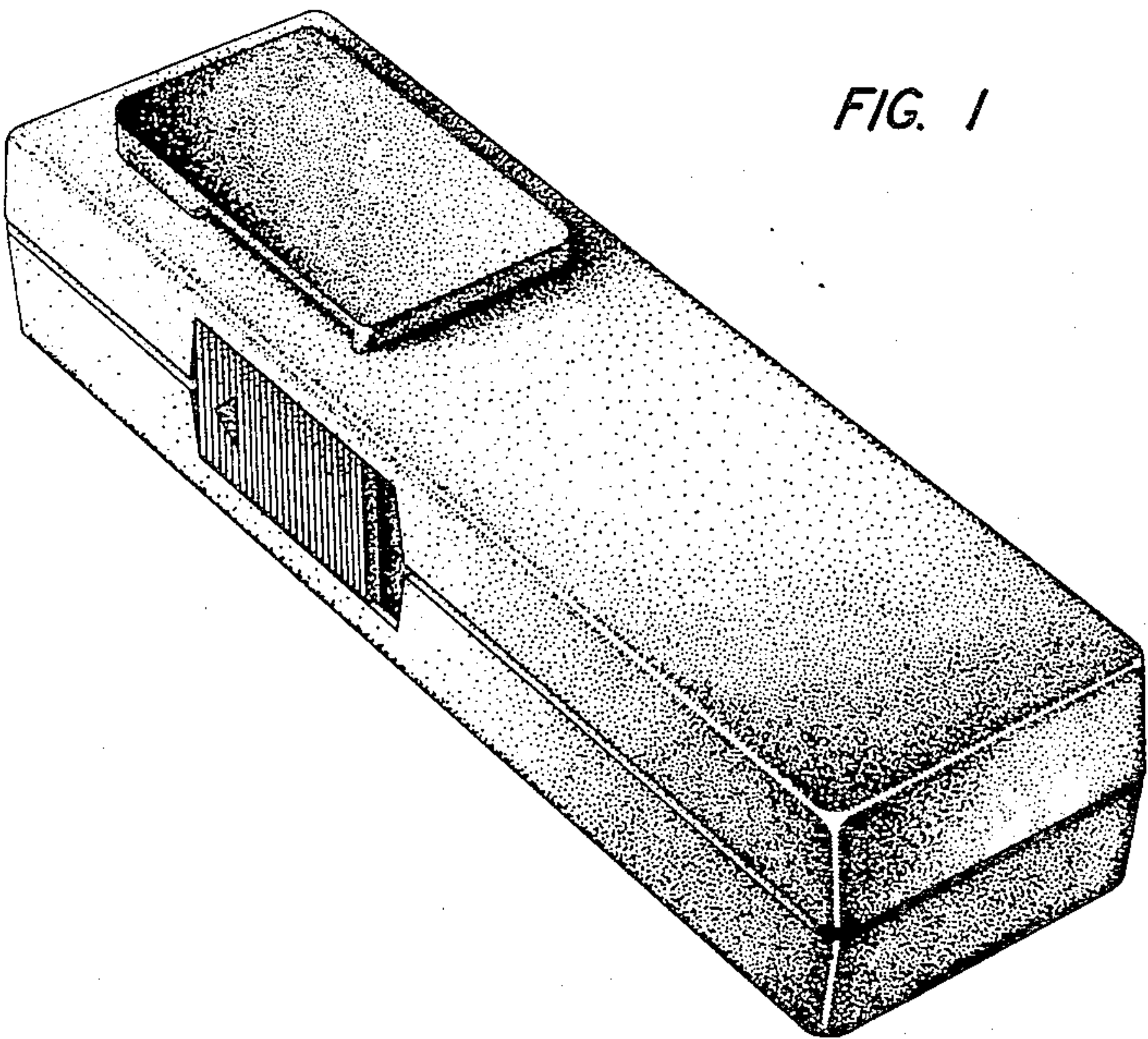

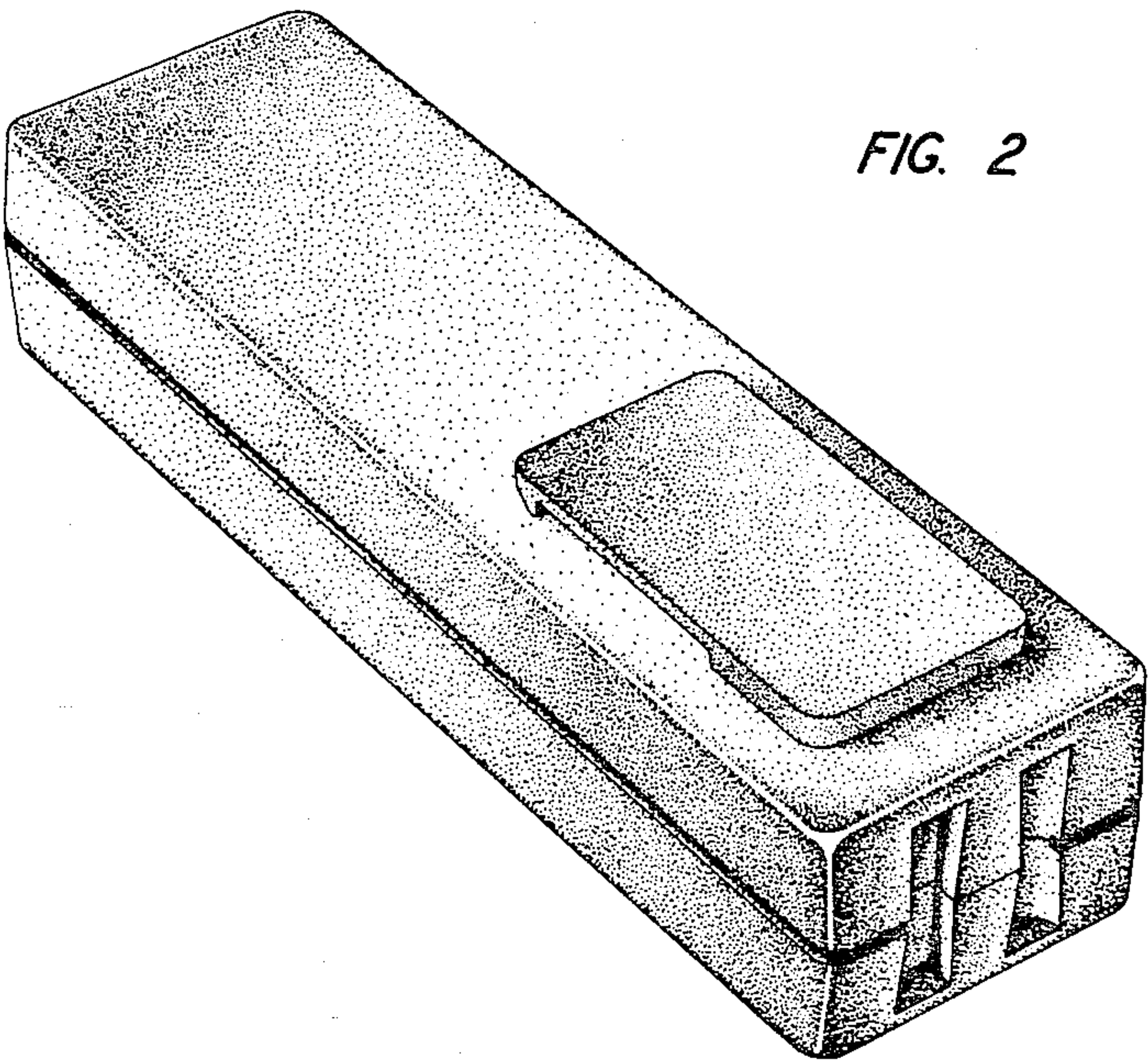

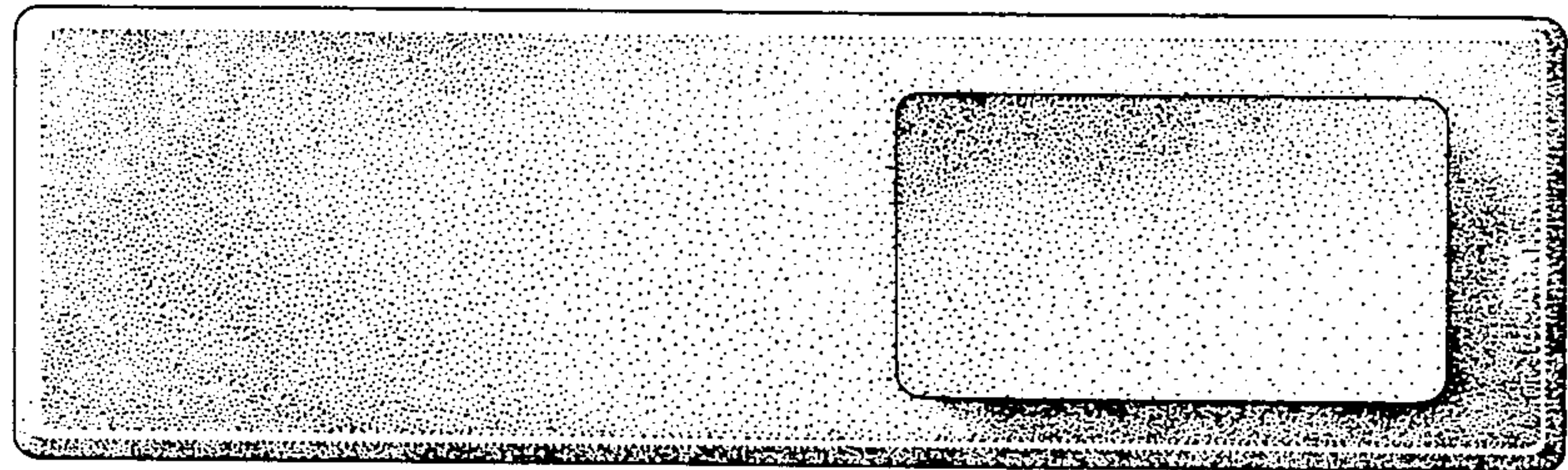

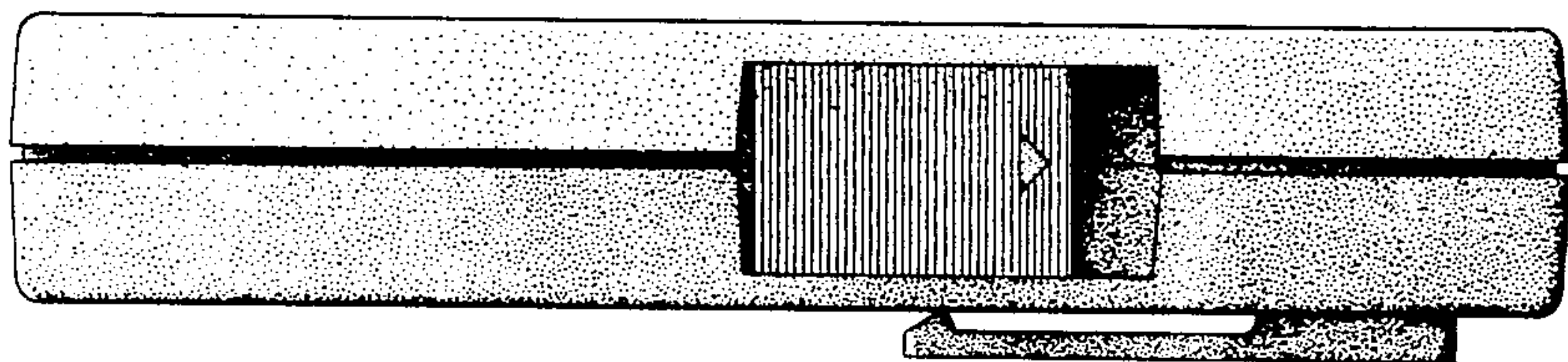

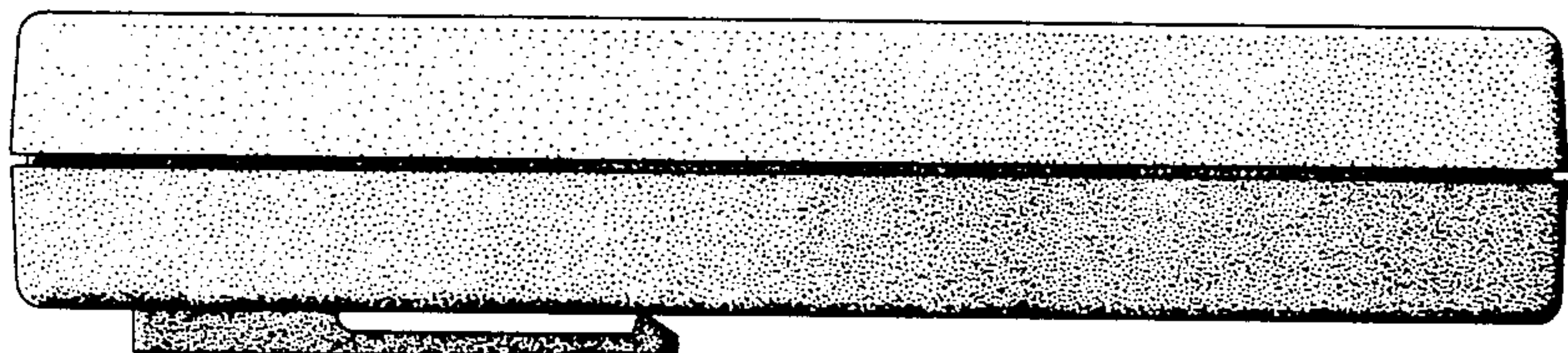
