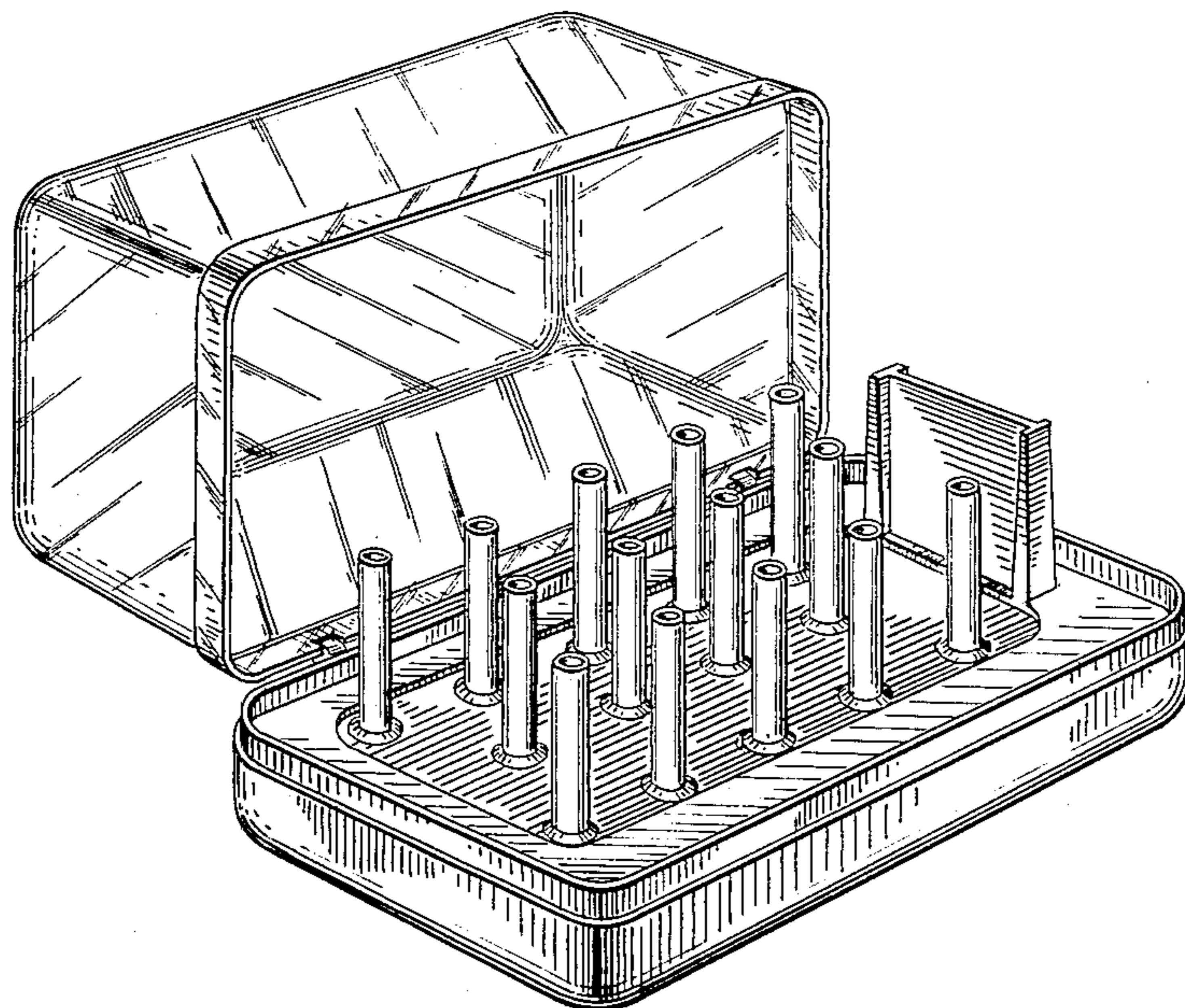

The ornamental design for a hair setter, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hair setter showing my new design in open position;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the hair setter in closed position with the power cord broken away for ease of illustration;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



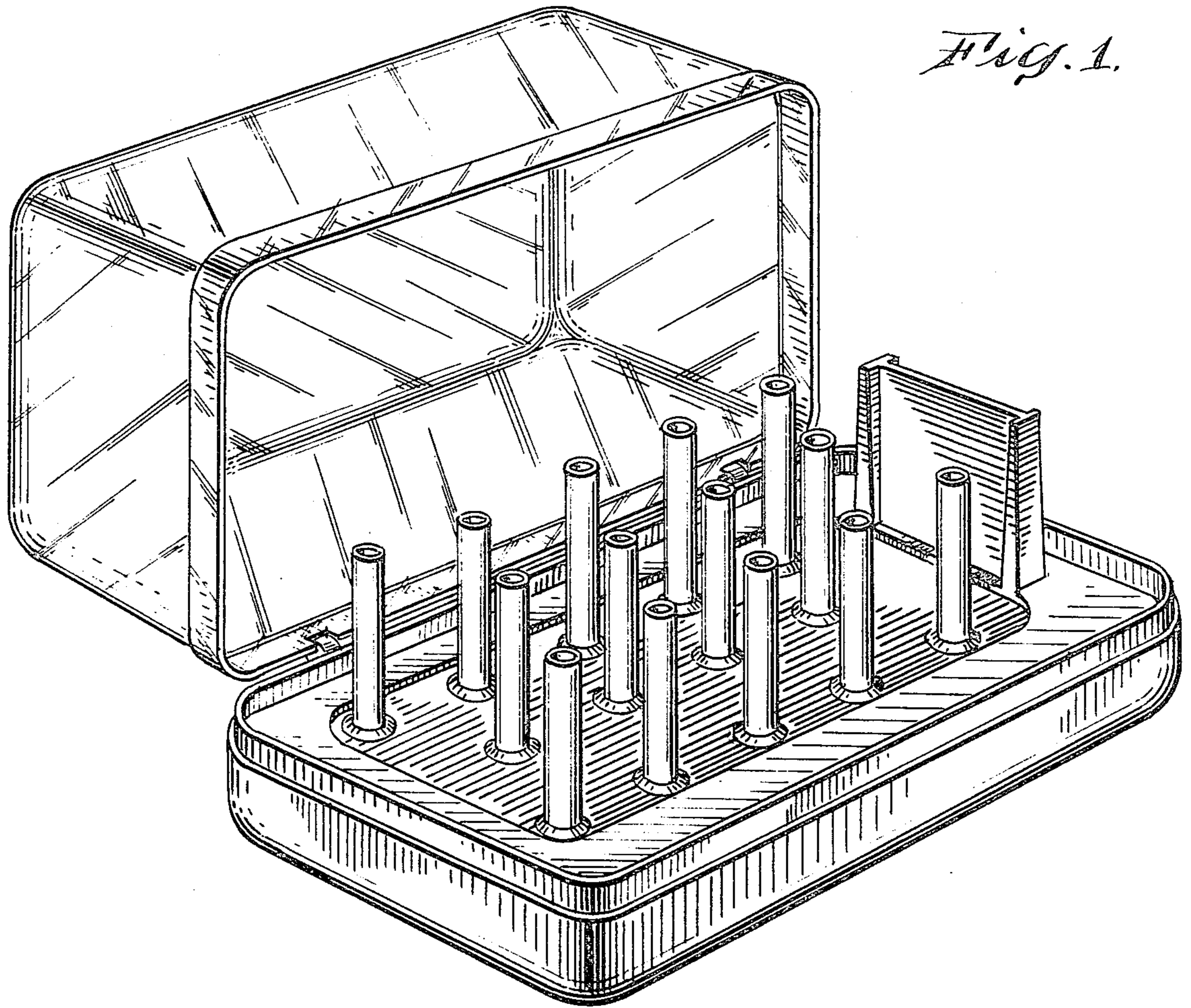

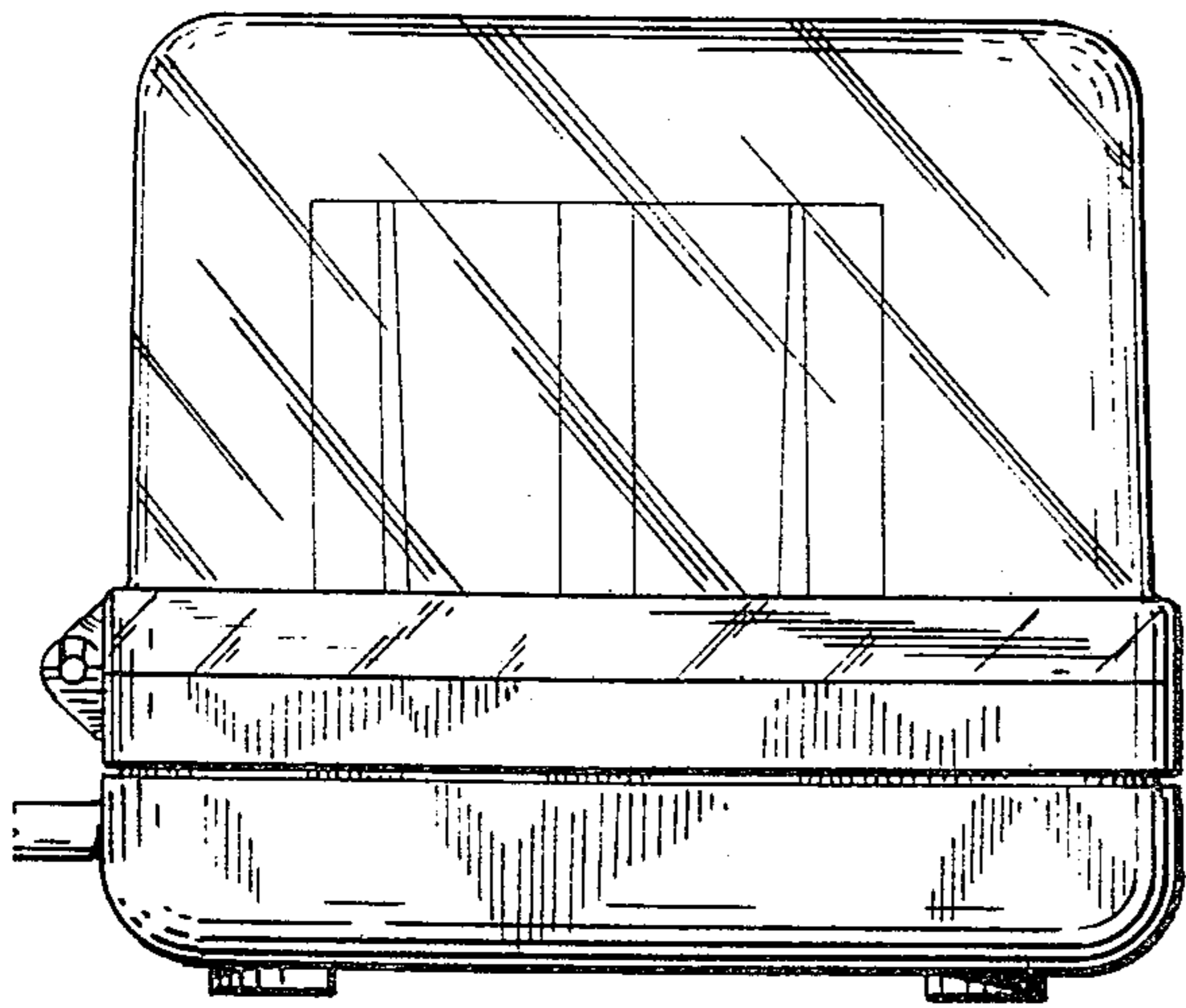

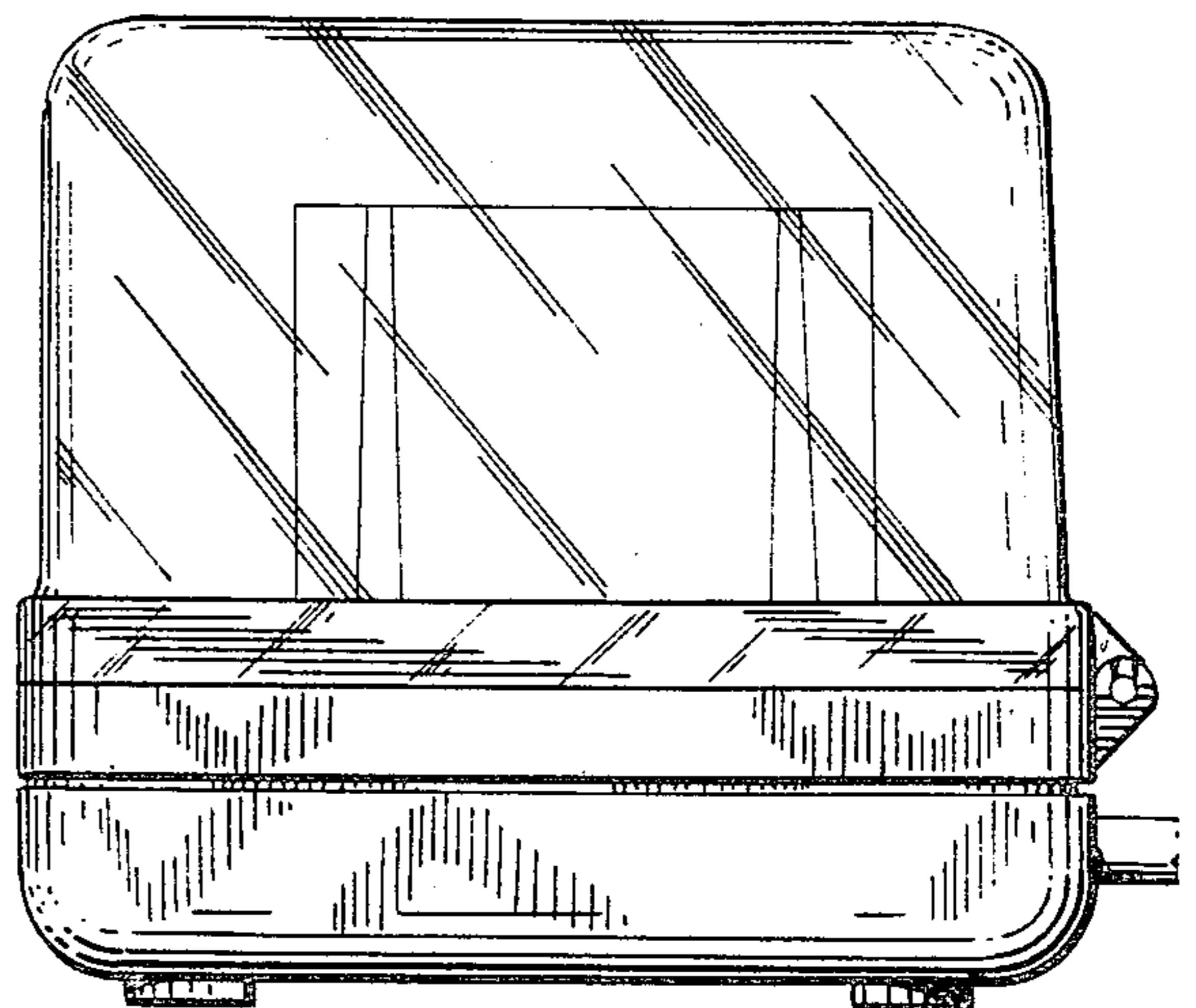

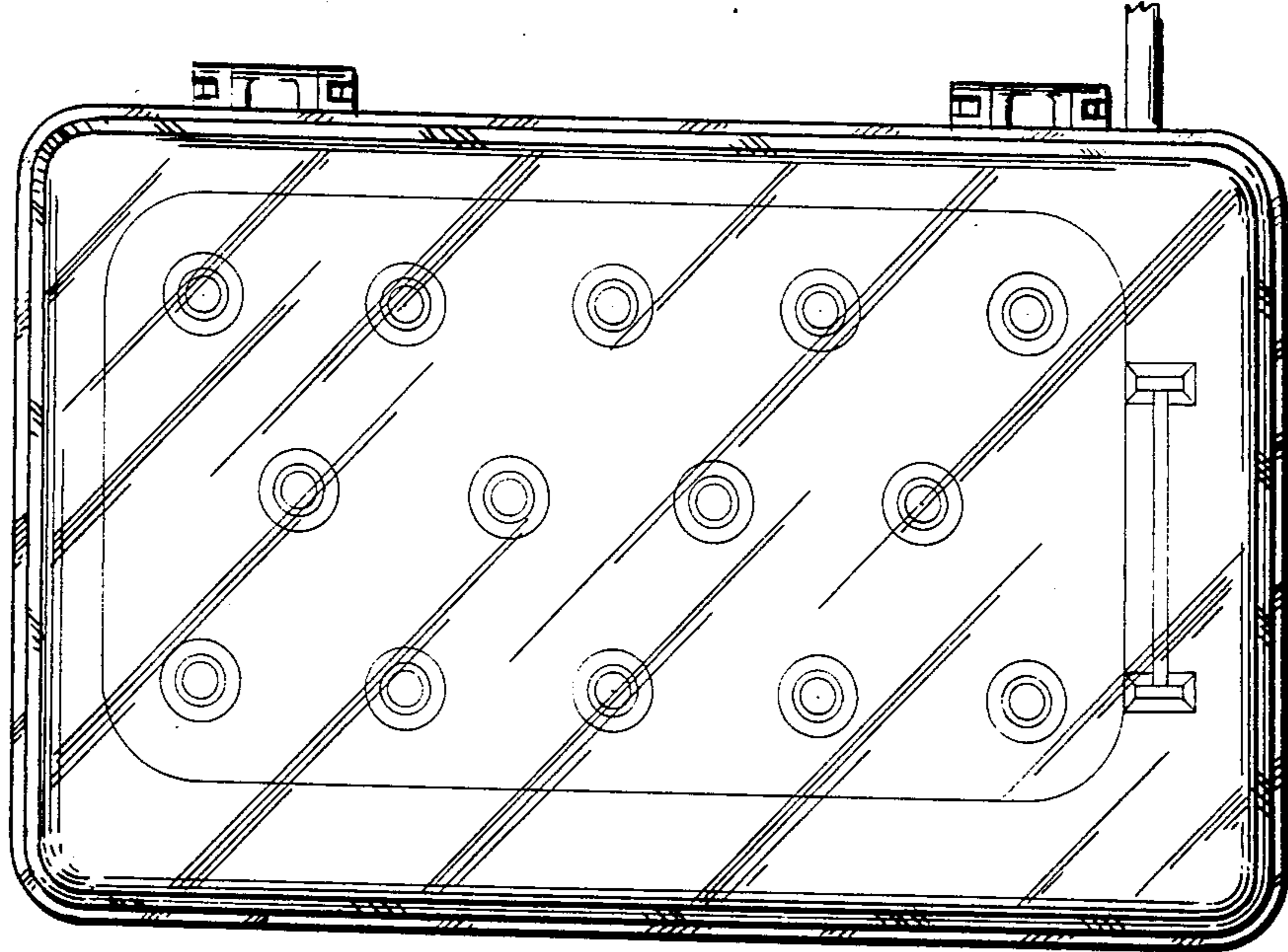

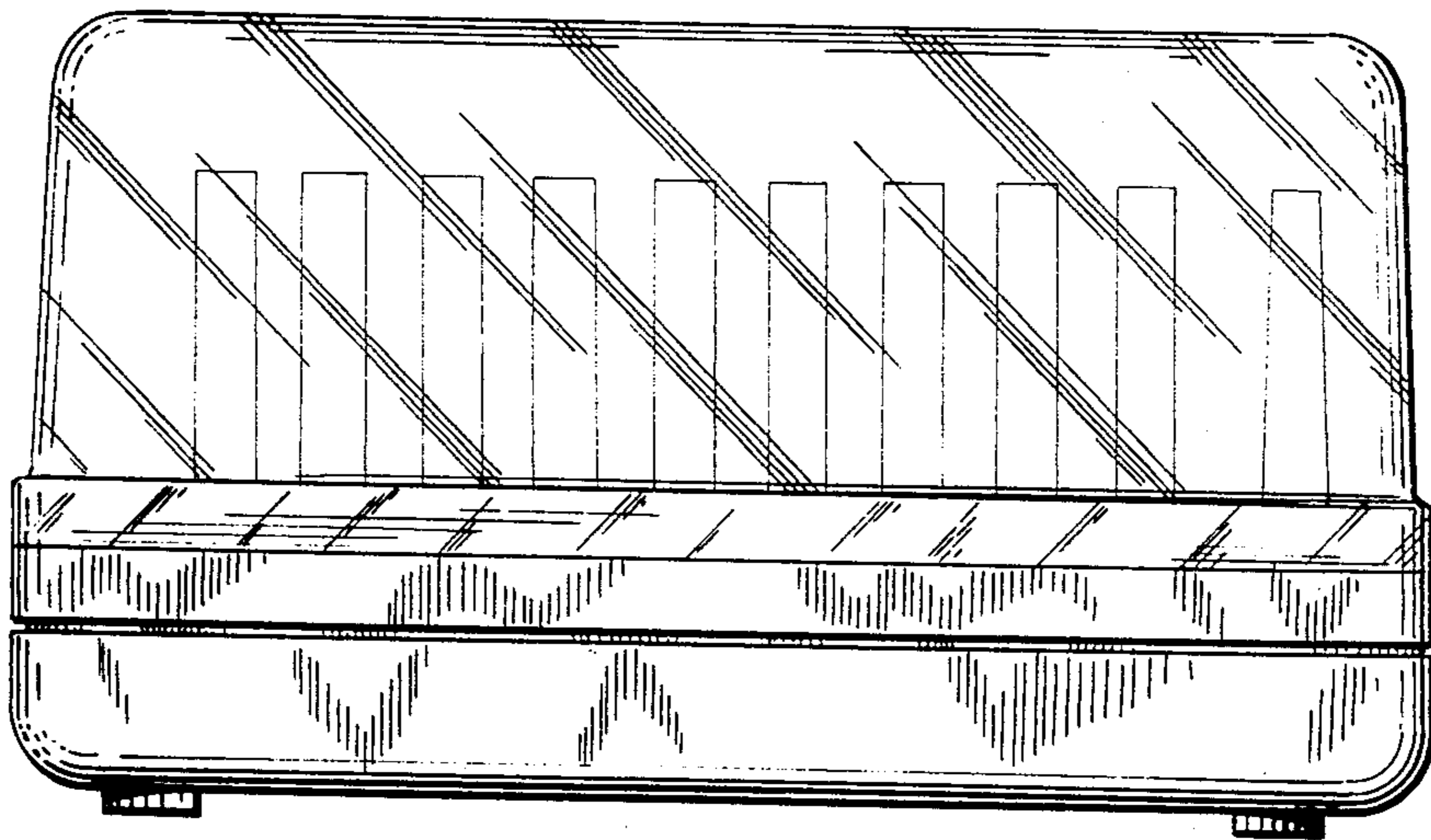

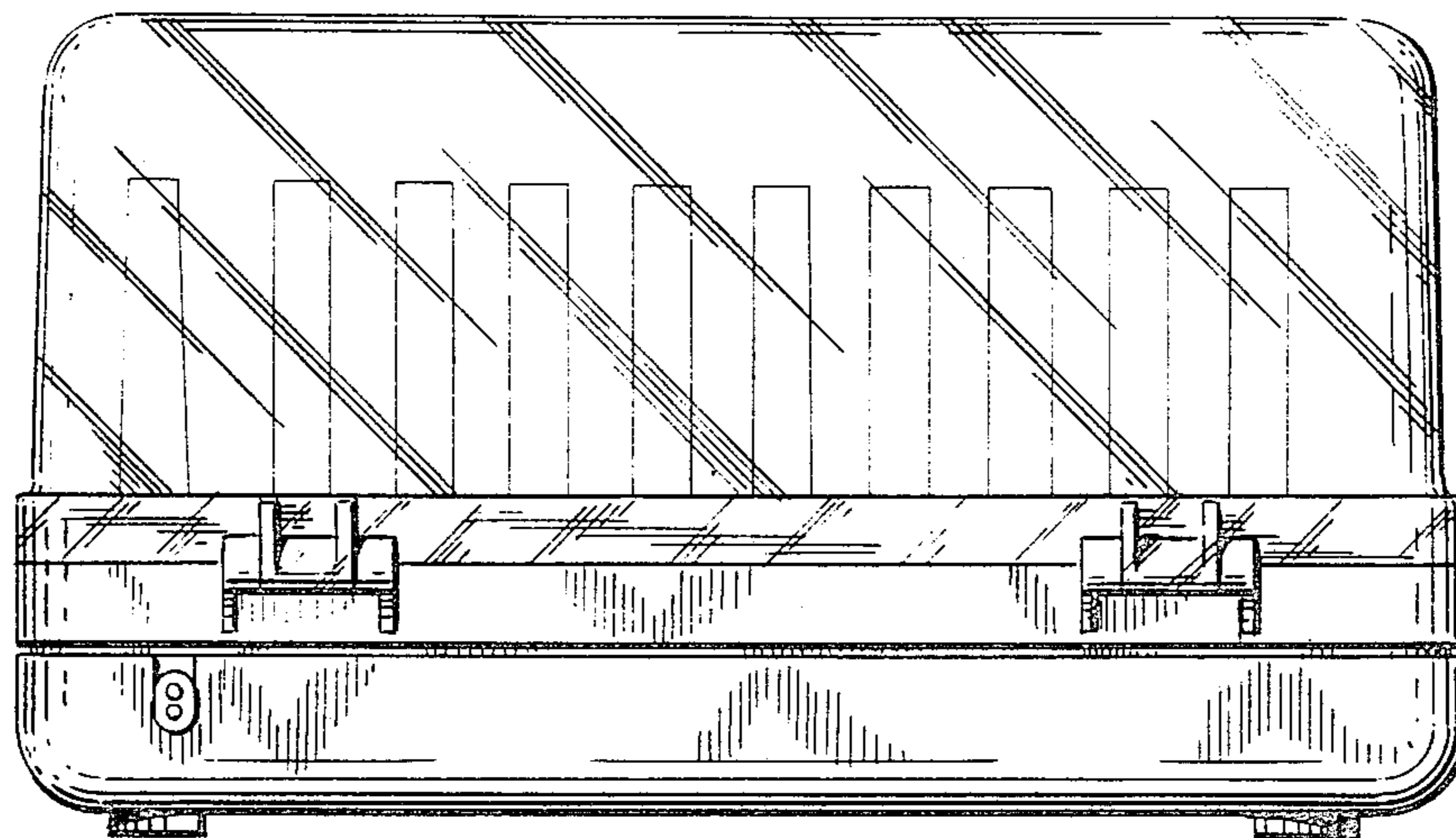
