DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined light and speaker housing for emergency vehicles showing my new design;

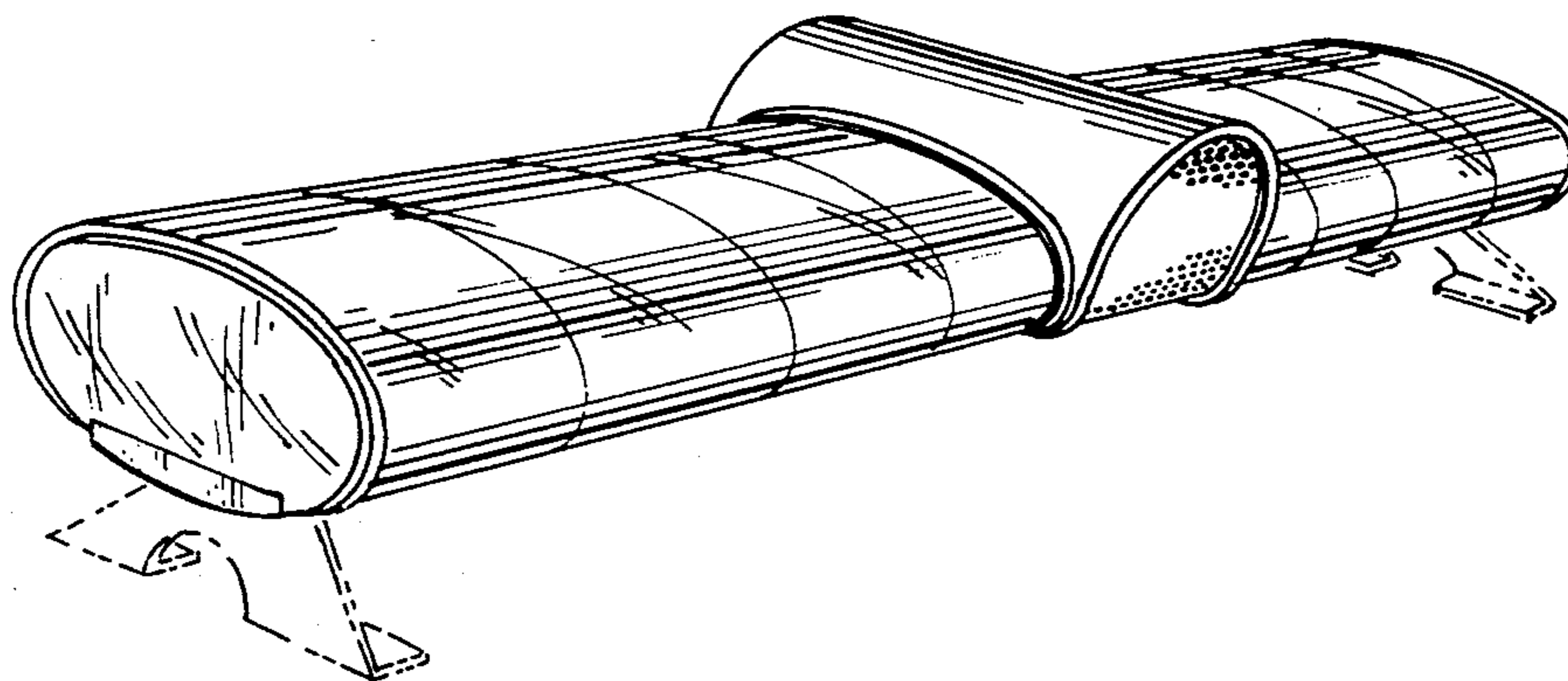
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;

The vehicle mounting elements are shown in broken lines in FIG. 1 for illustrative purposes only.



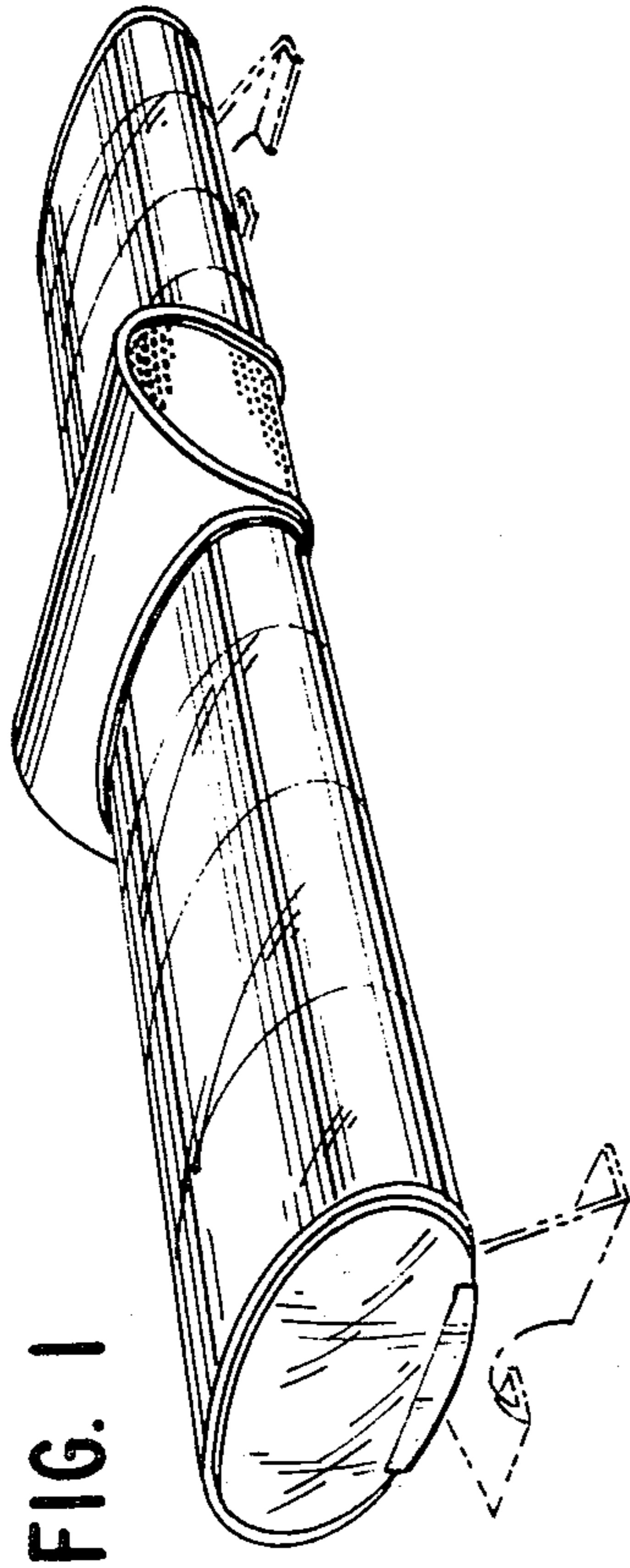

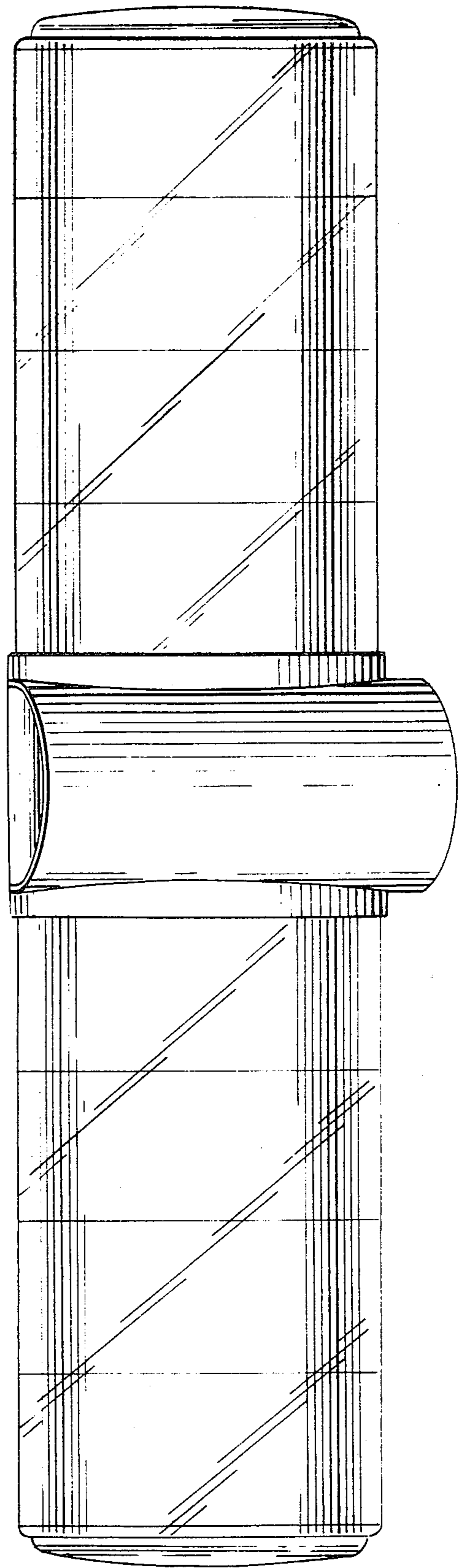

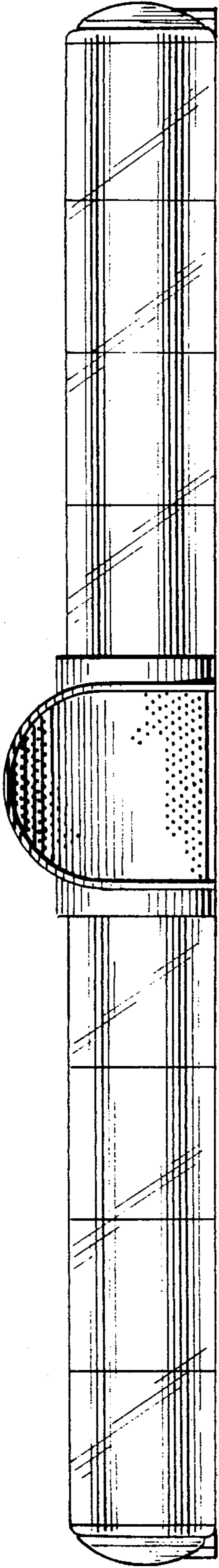

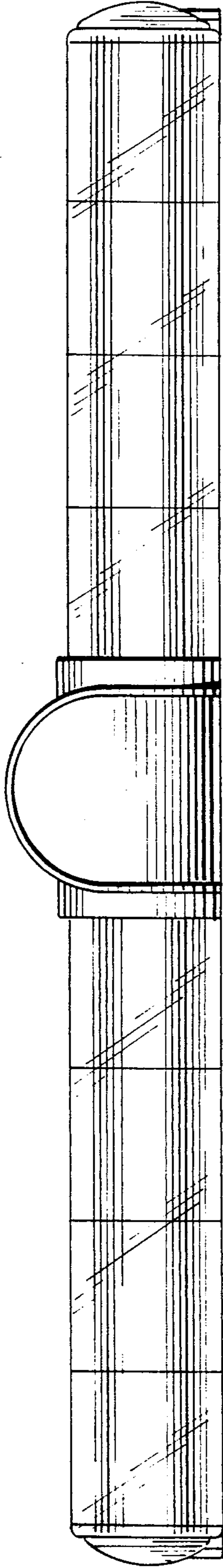
