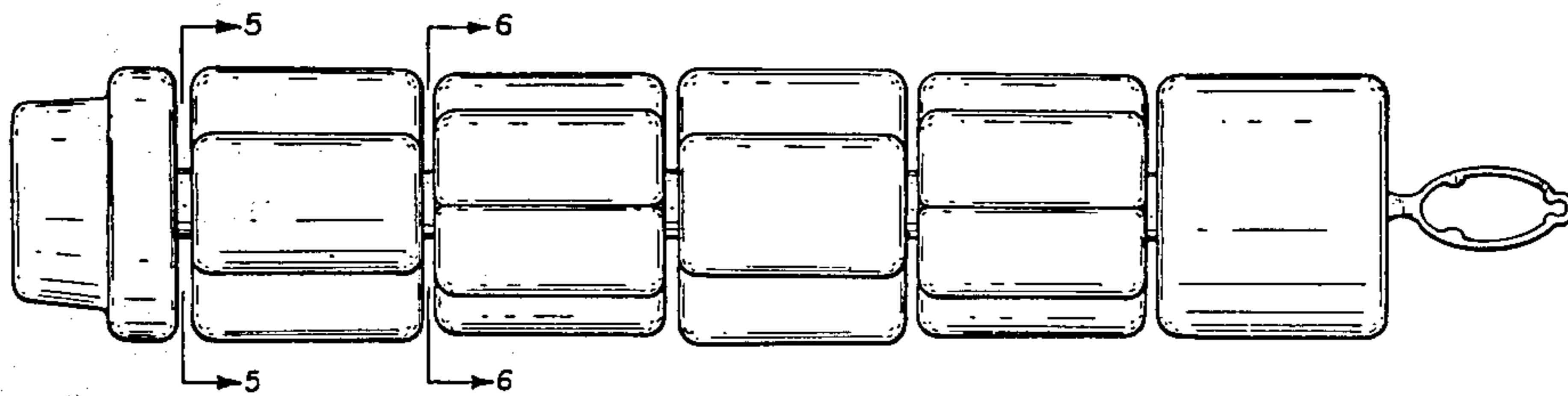

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for stringing beads, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a stringing bead toy showing my new design, the bottom plan view being substantially identical;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being substantially identical;  
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a sectional view thereof taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1 thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a sectional view thereof taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1 thereof.



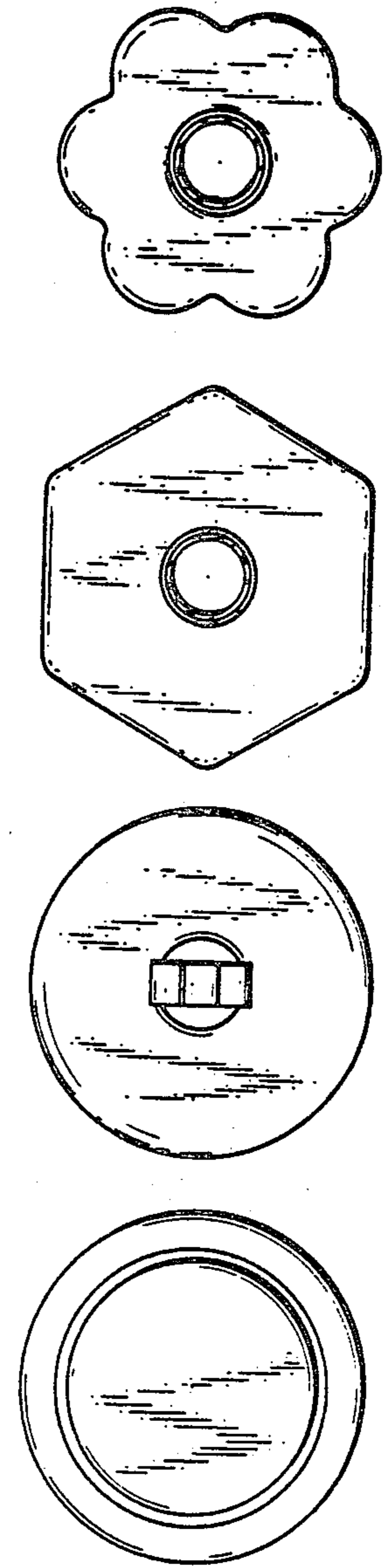
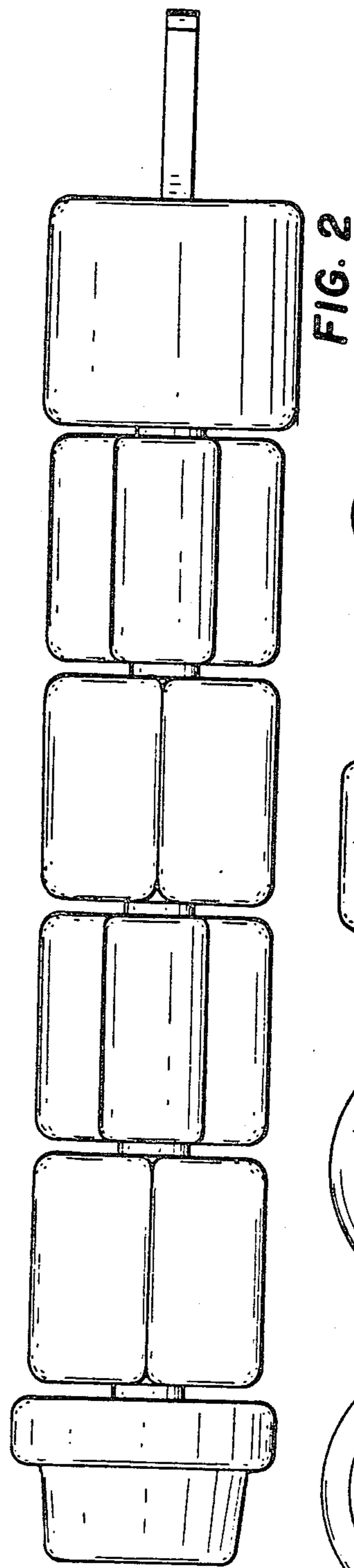
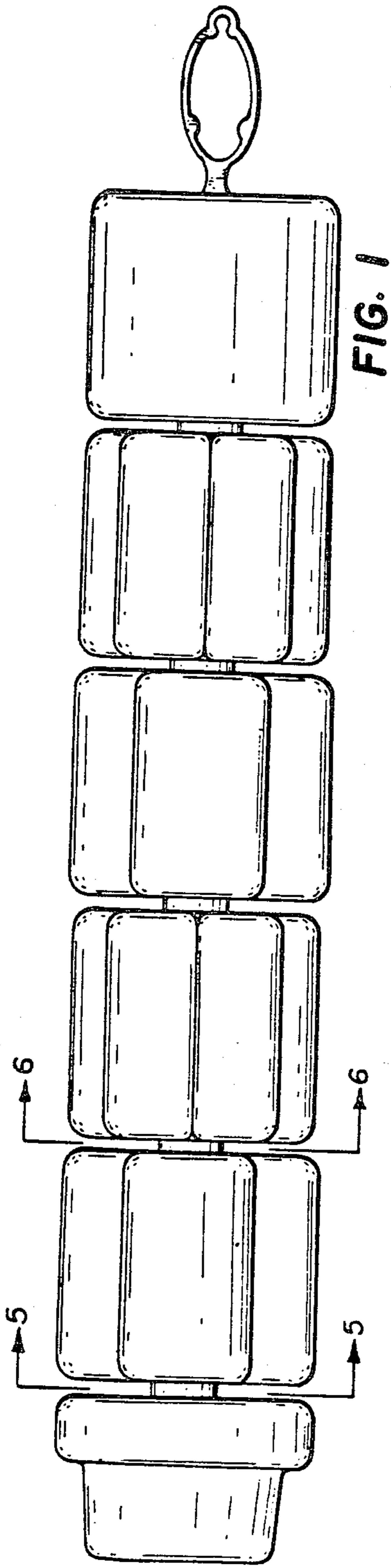
