 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view.

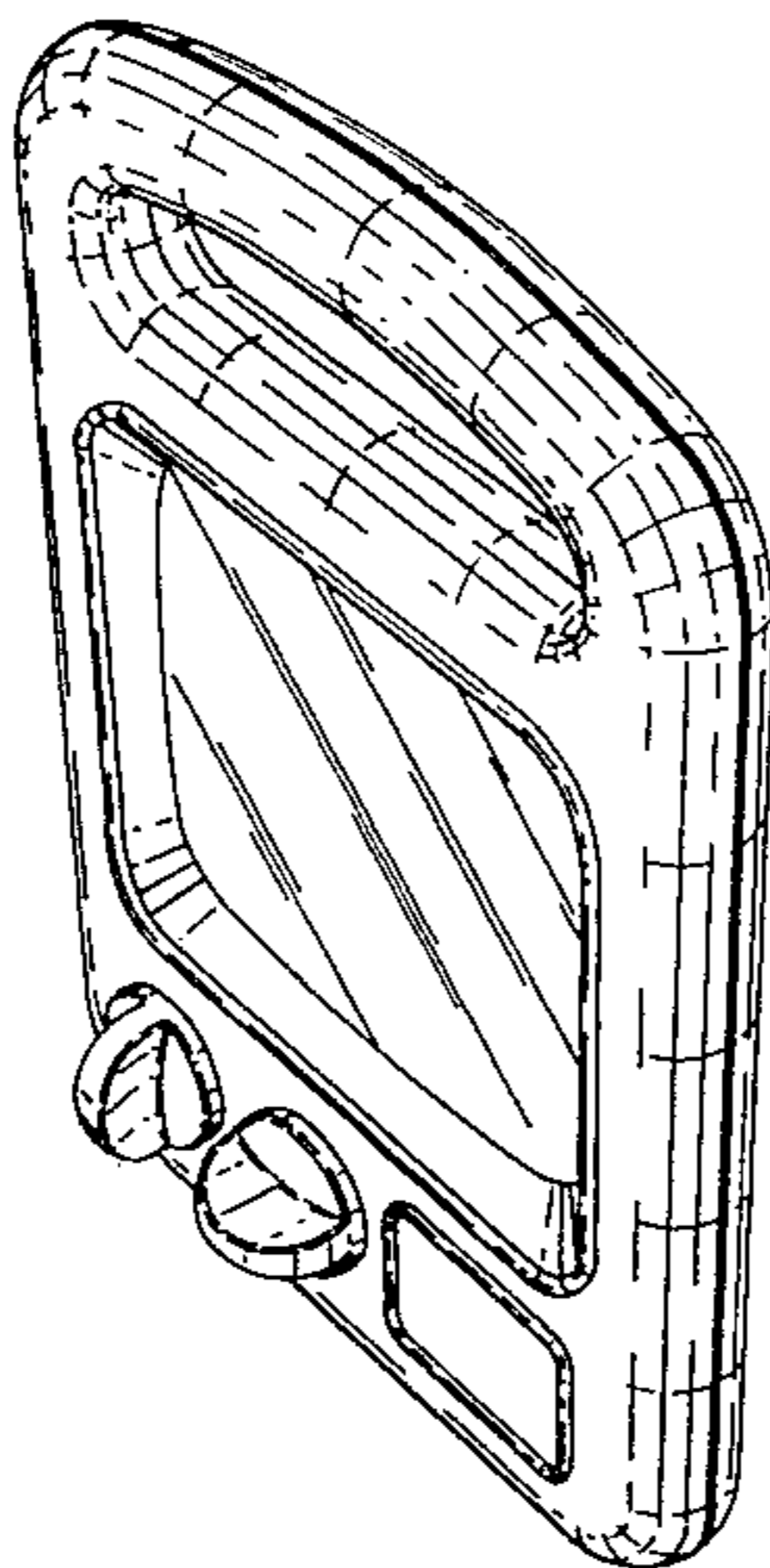

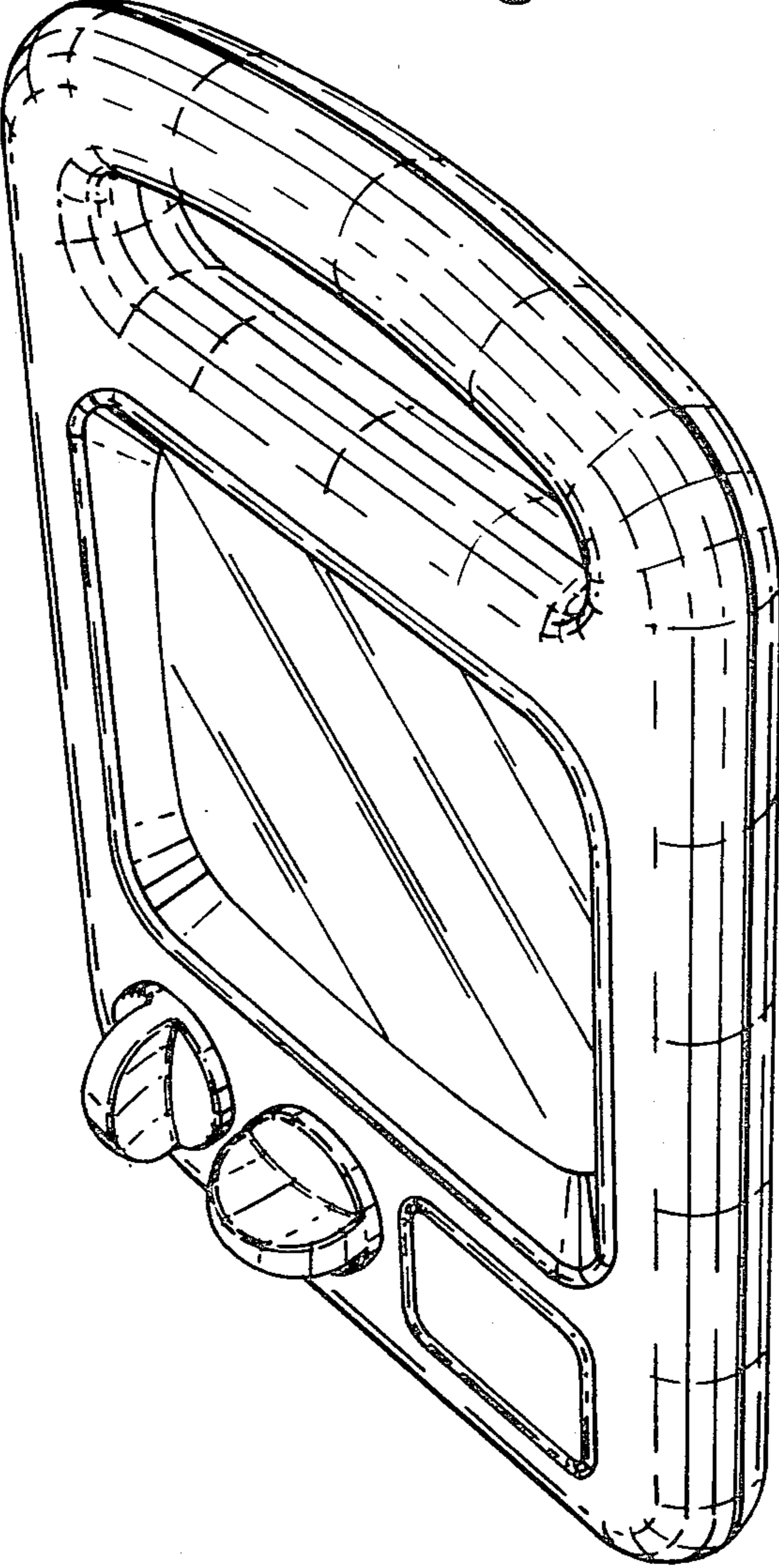

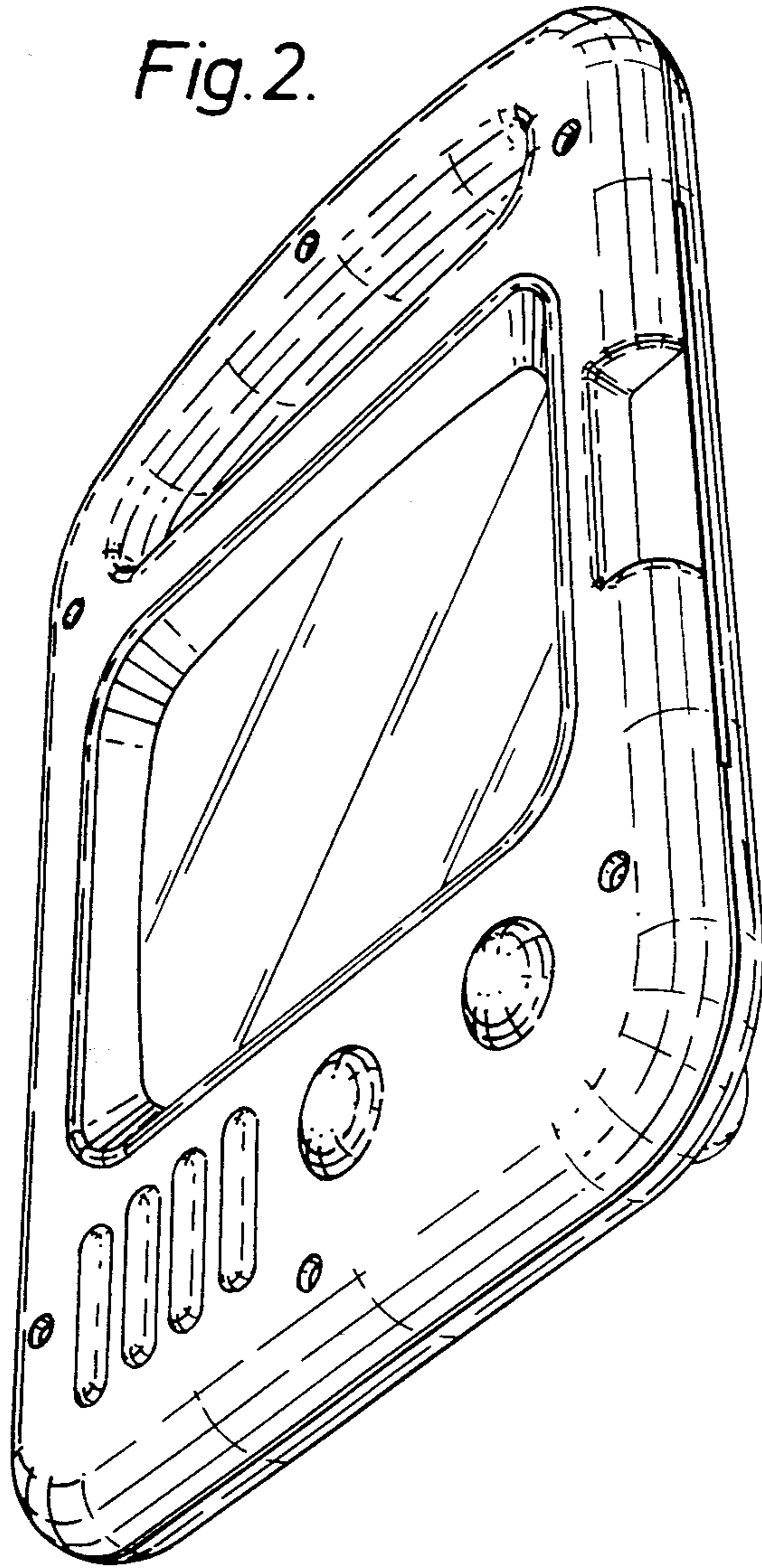
