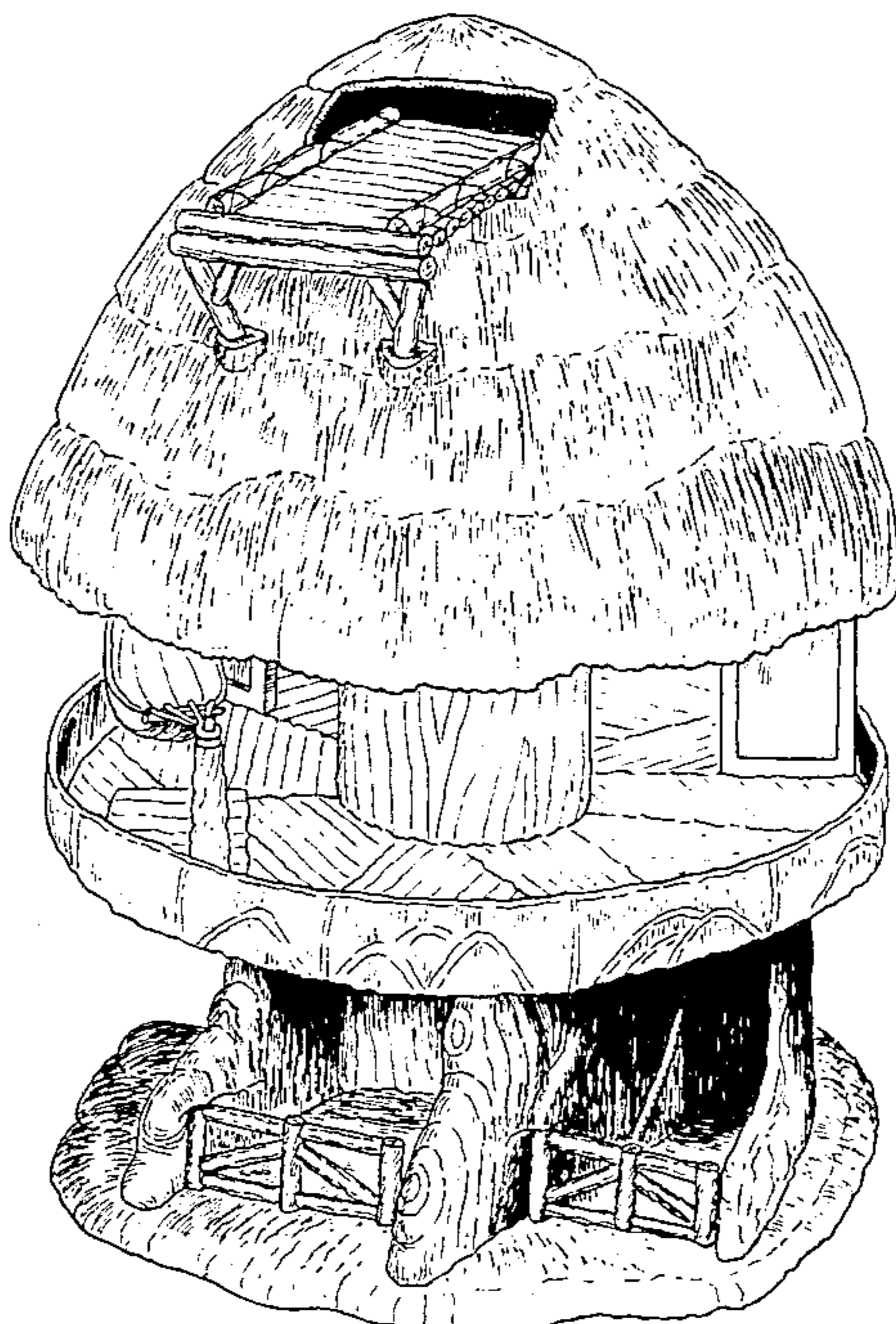

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy doll house, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy doll house, showing my new design in an open condition;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the right of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the left of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, showing the toy doll house in a closed condition.



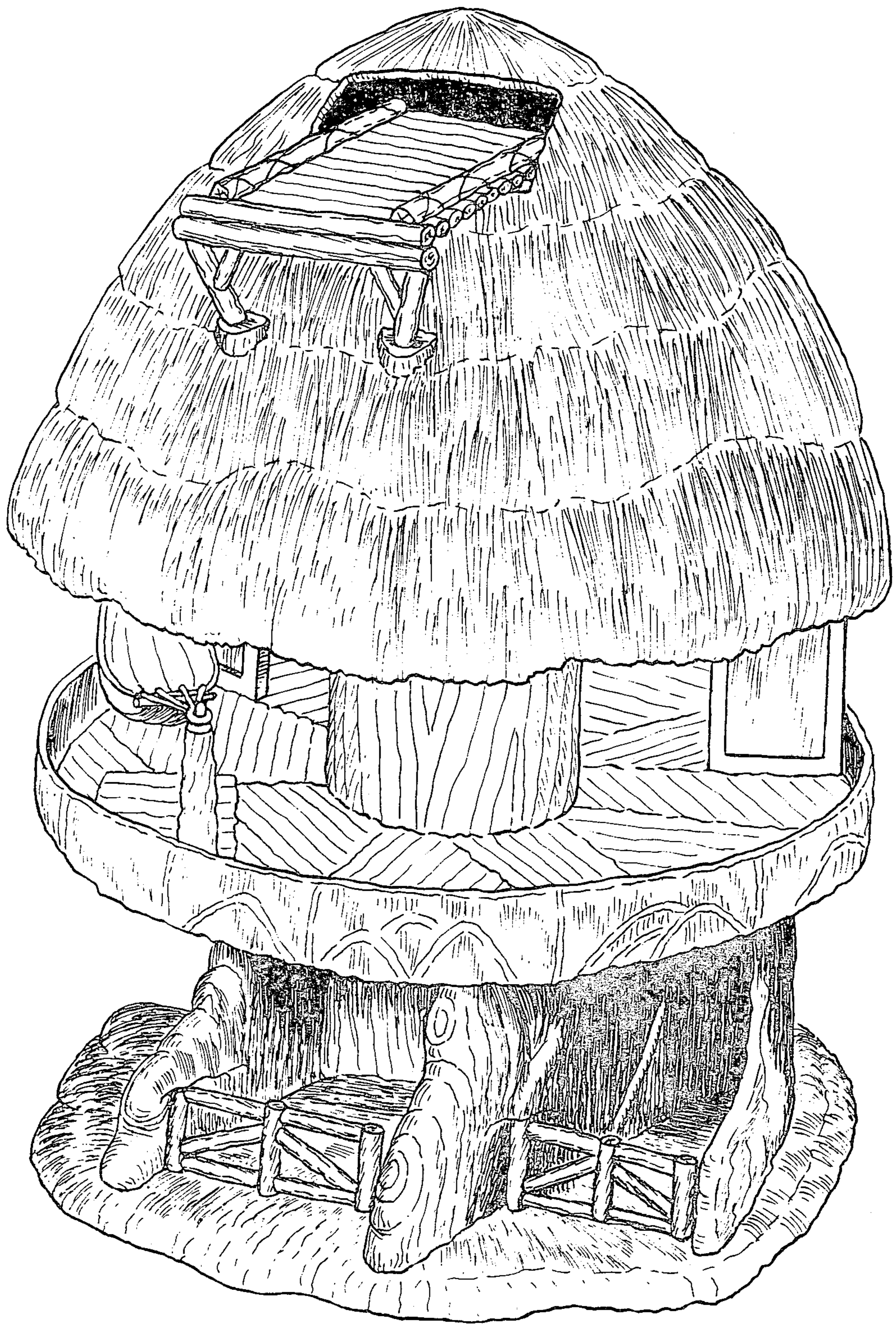
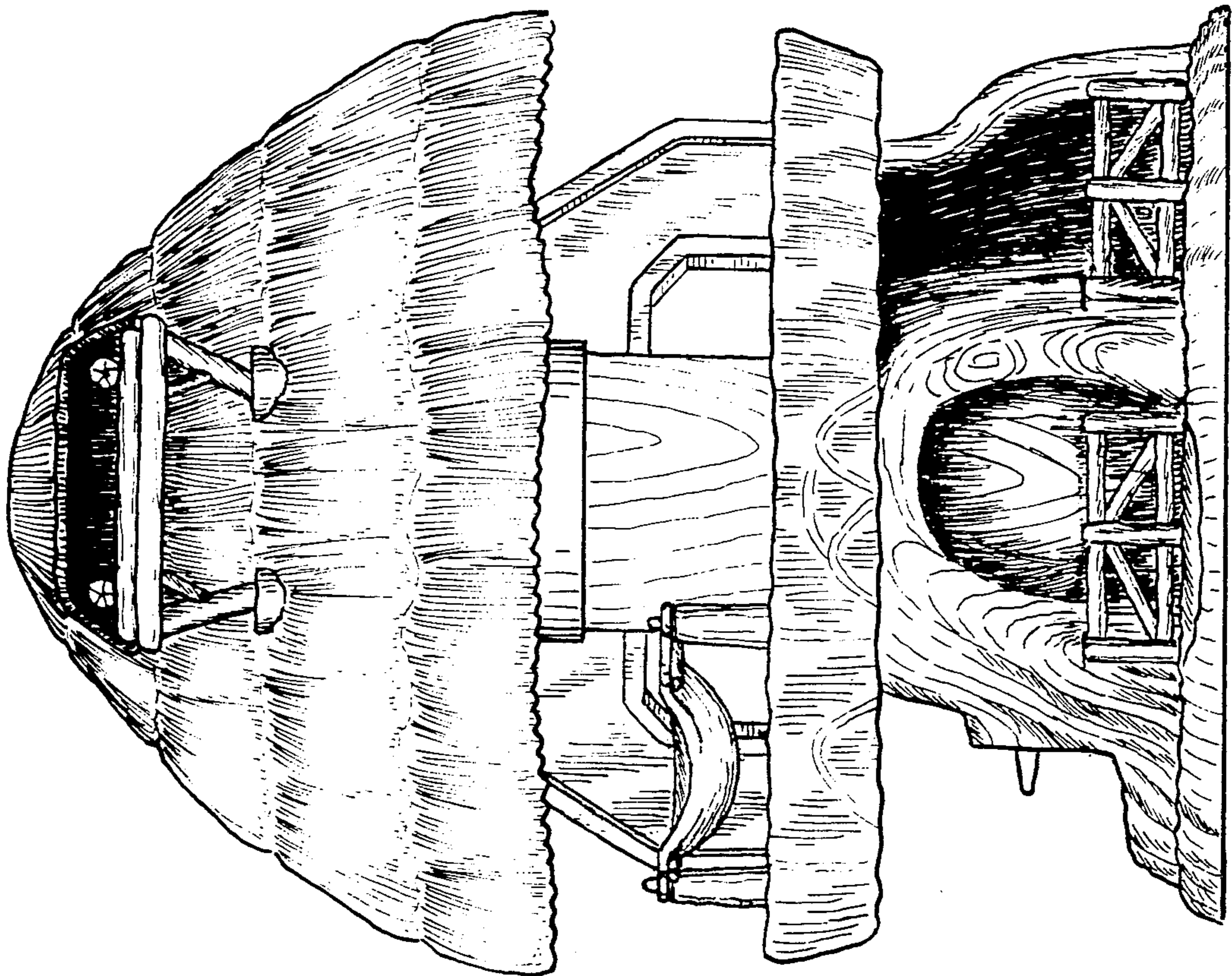
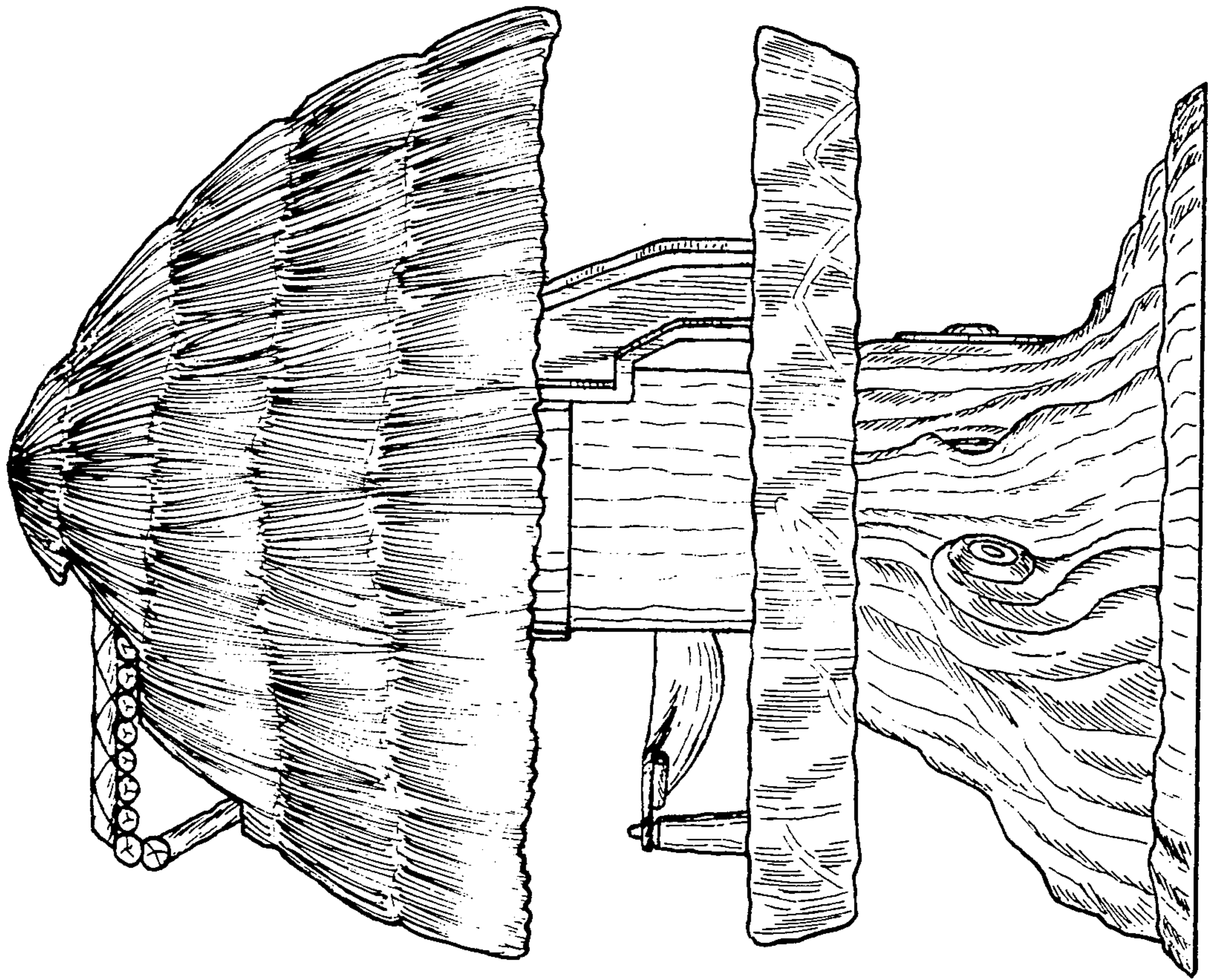

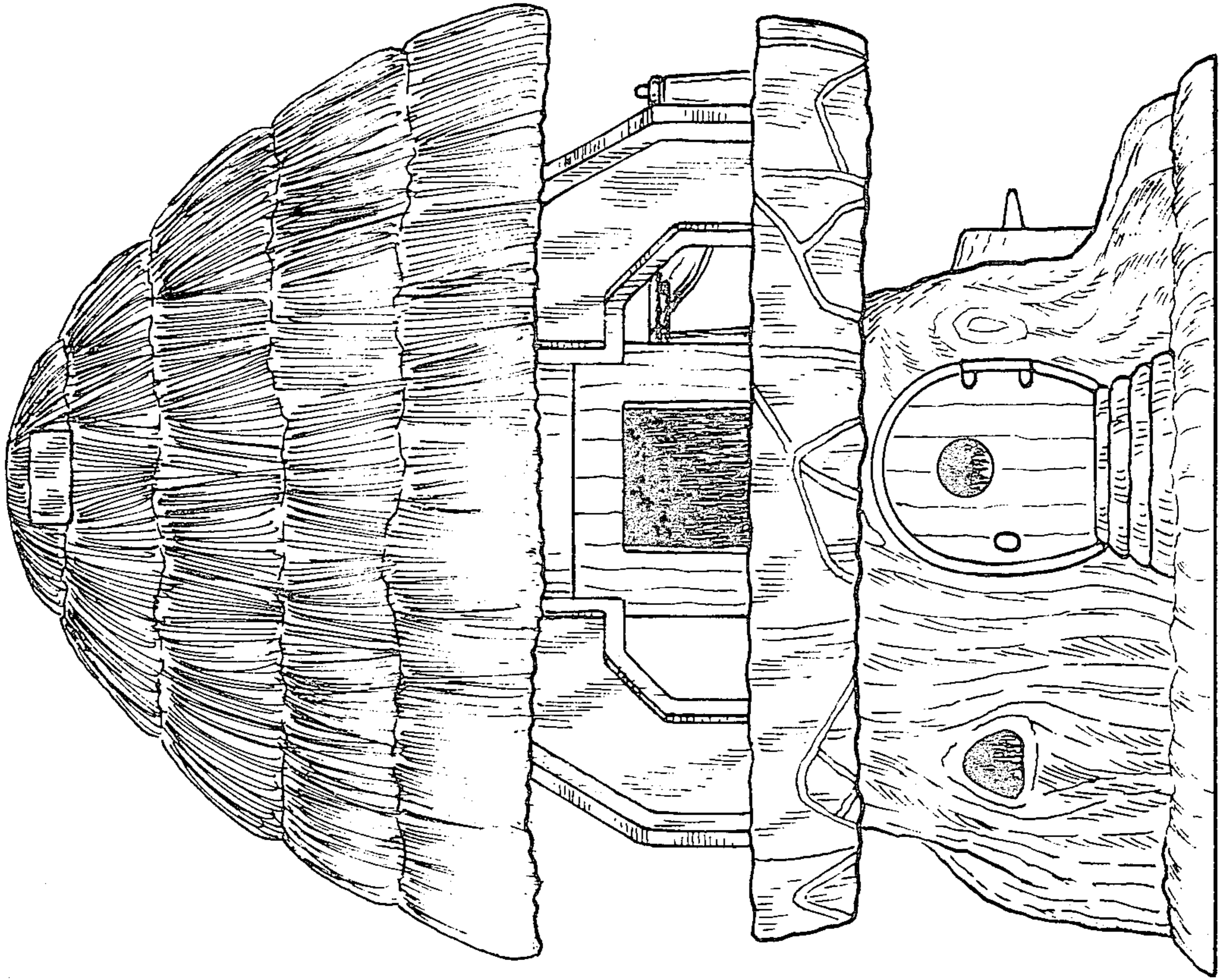

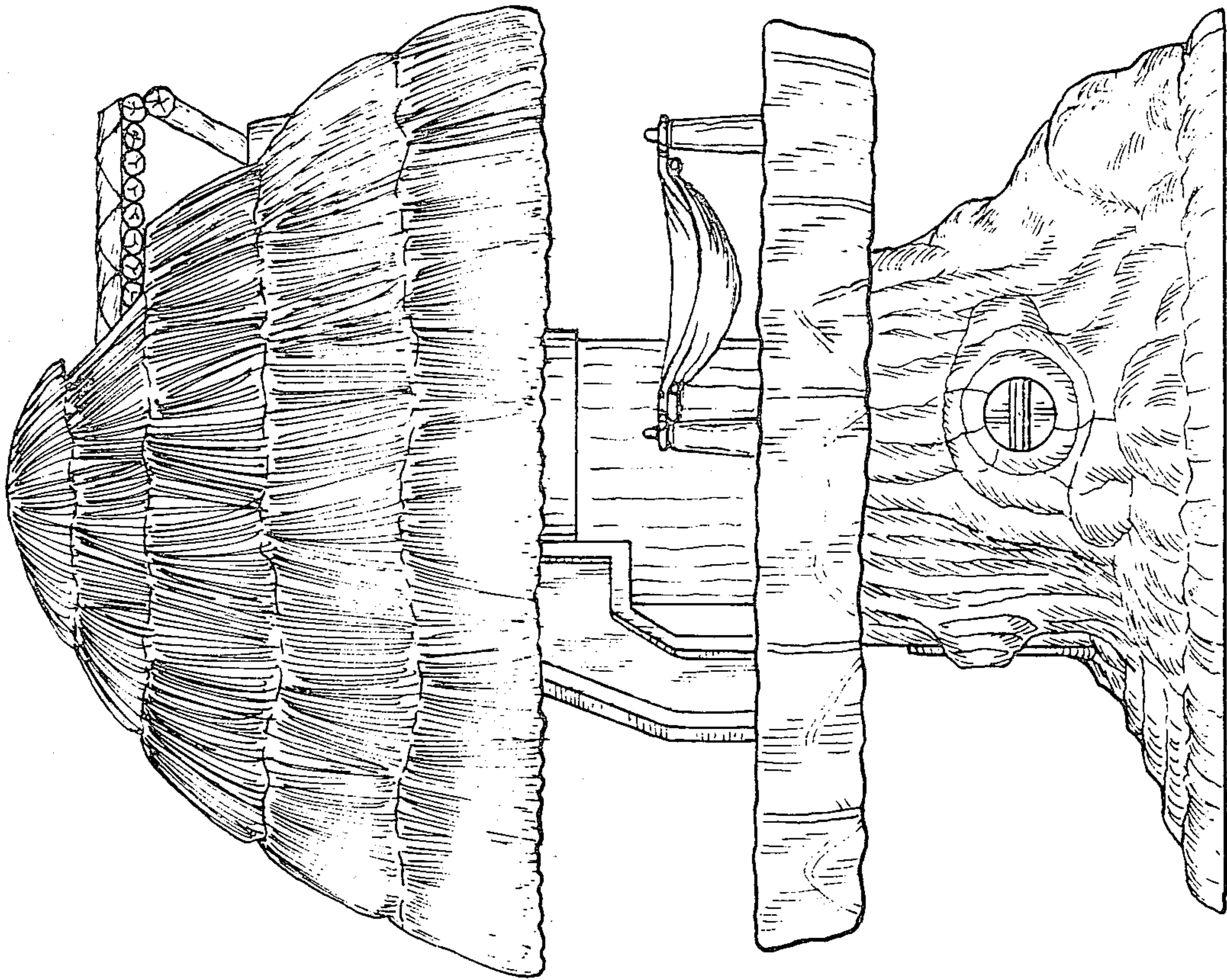

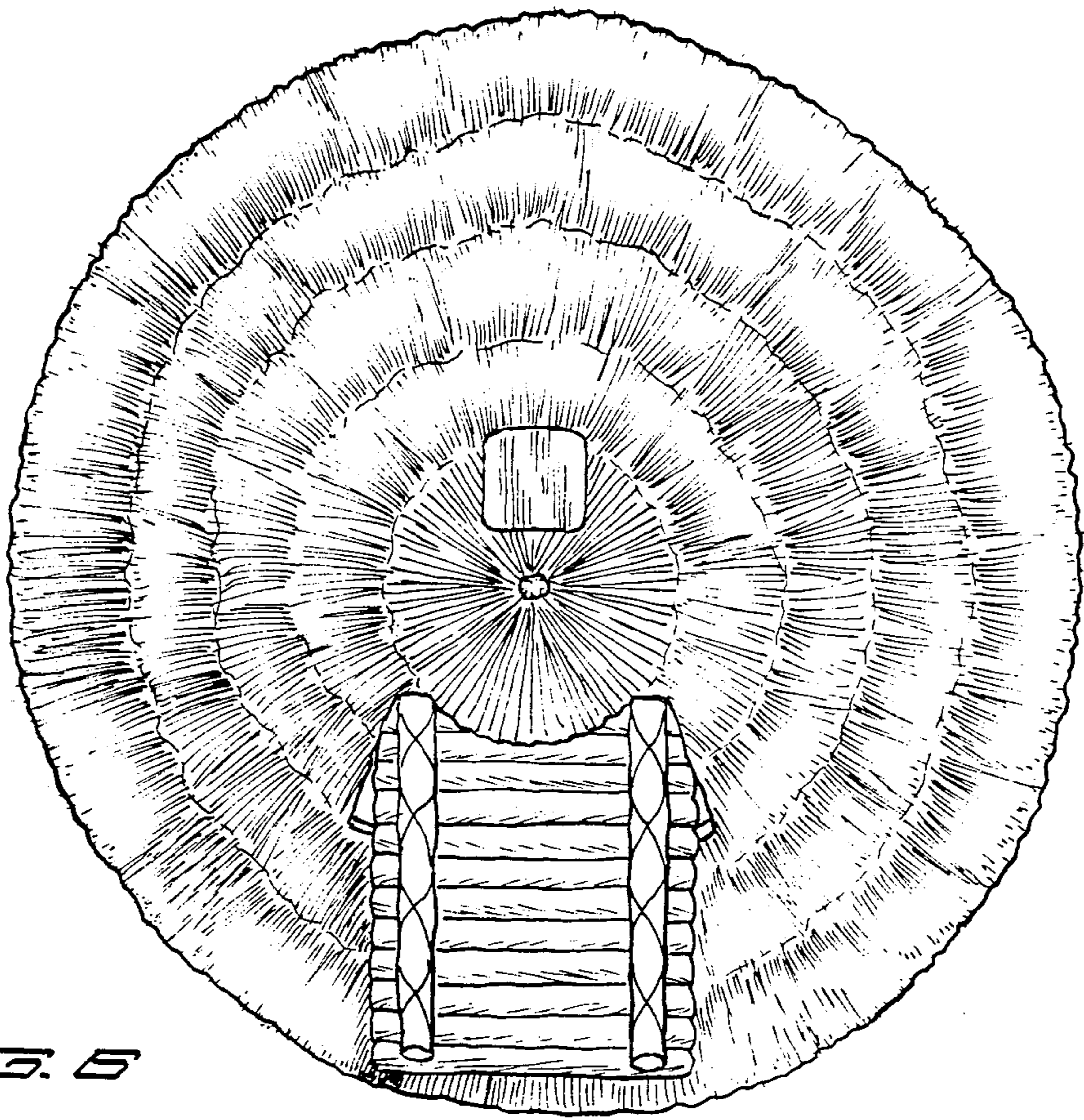

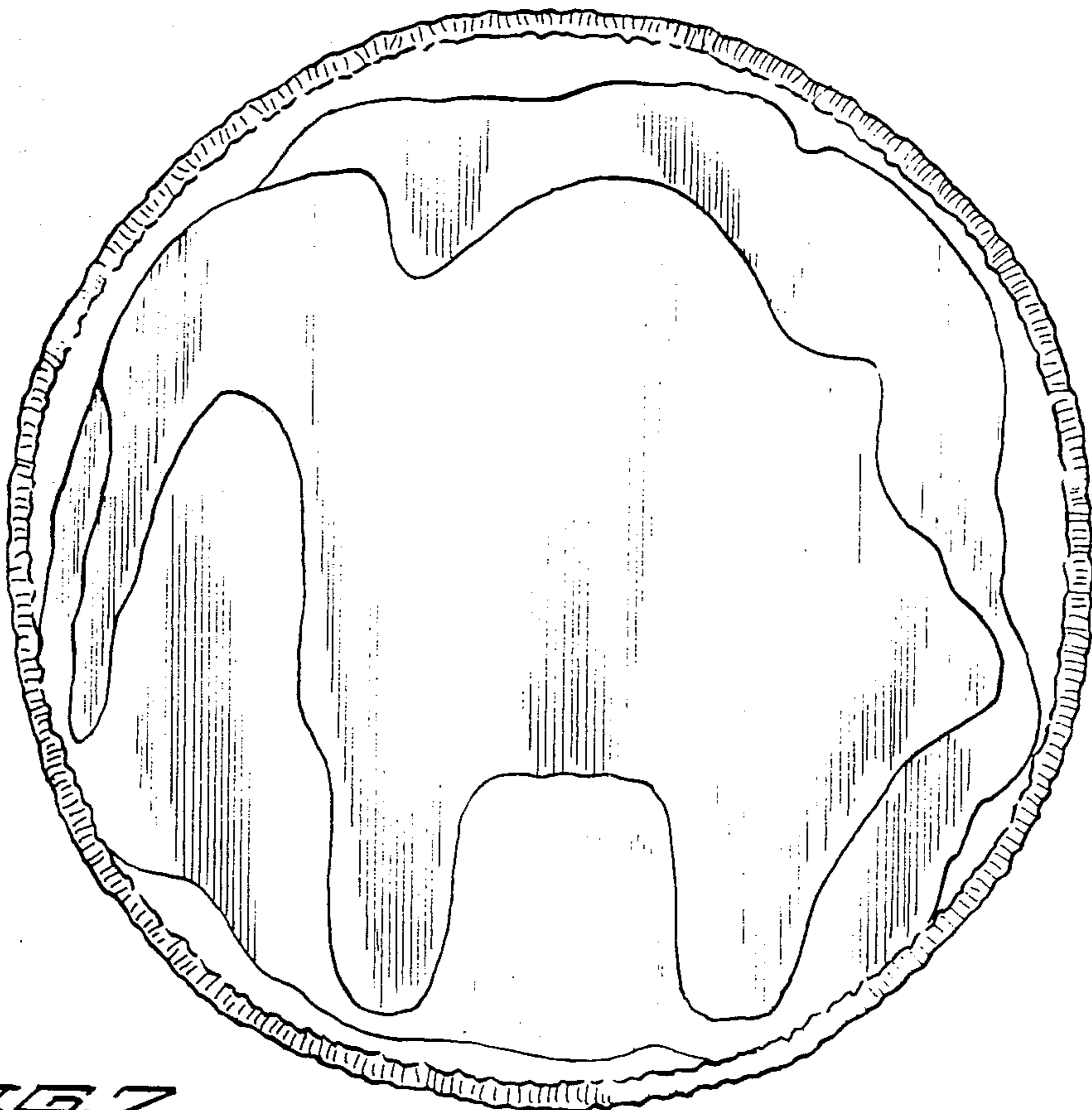

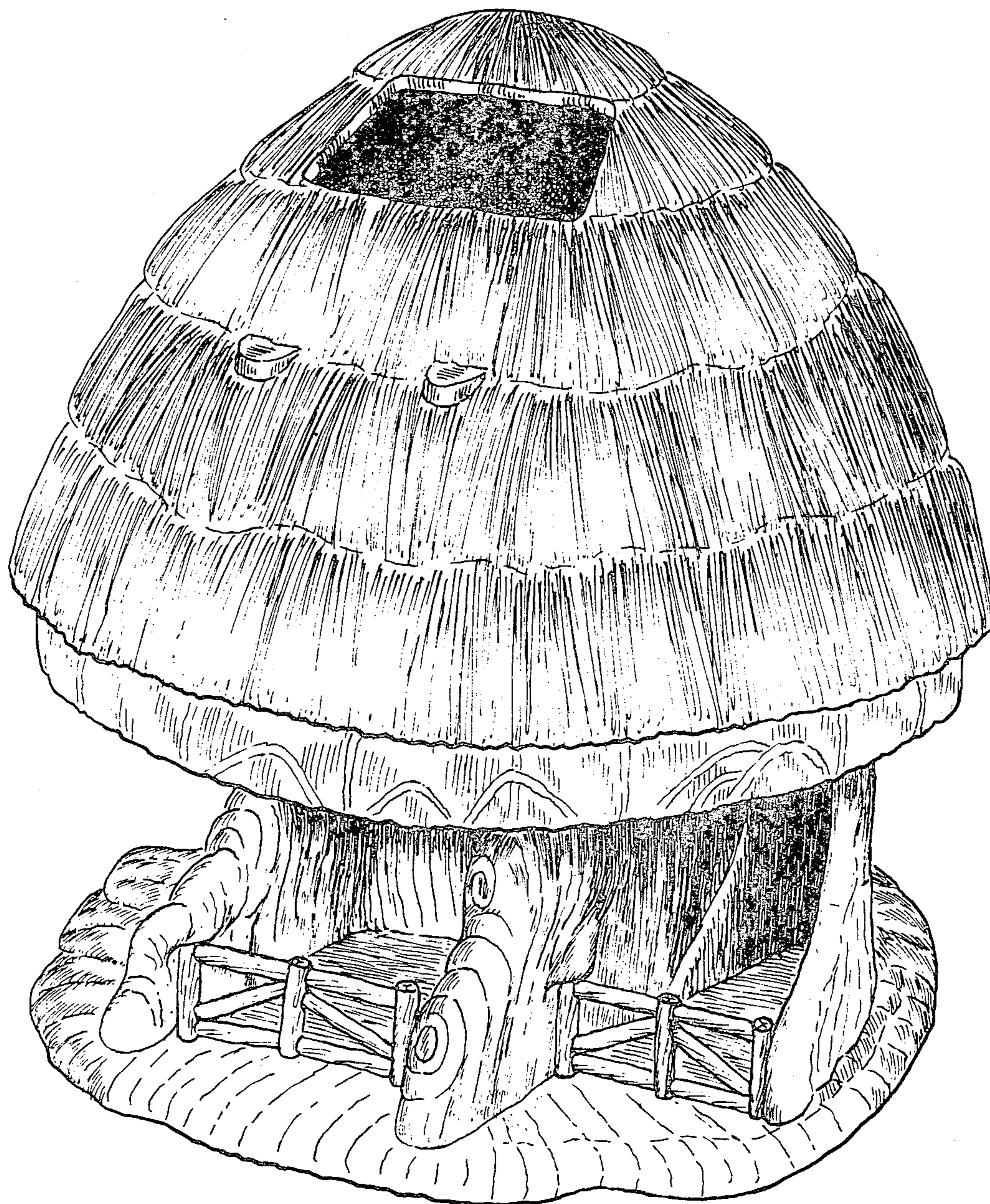
