The ornamental design for a carrying case for a hair curler, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a carrying case for a hair curler showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side being a mirror image; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

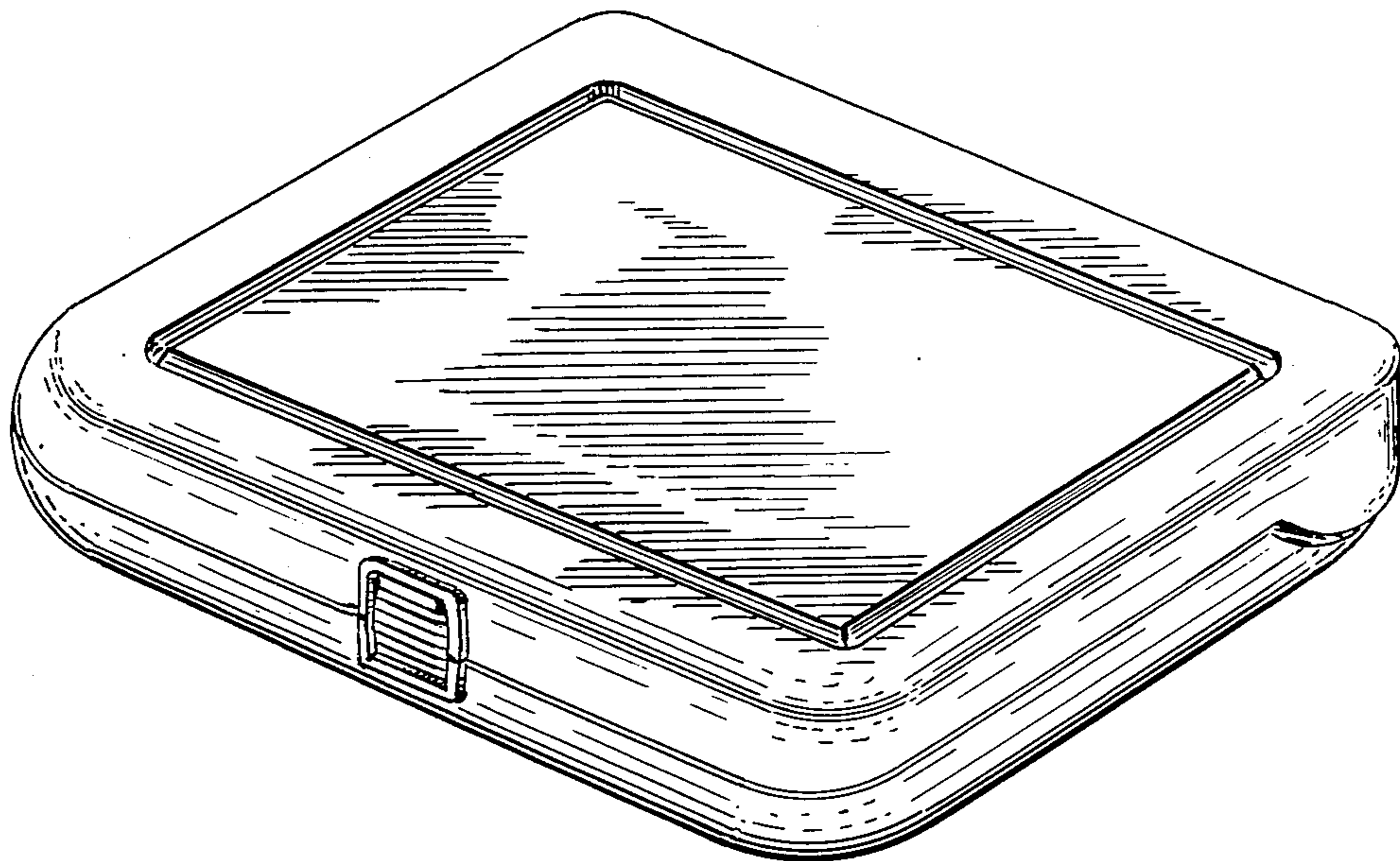

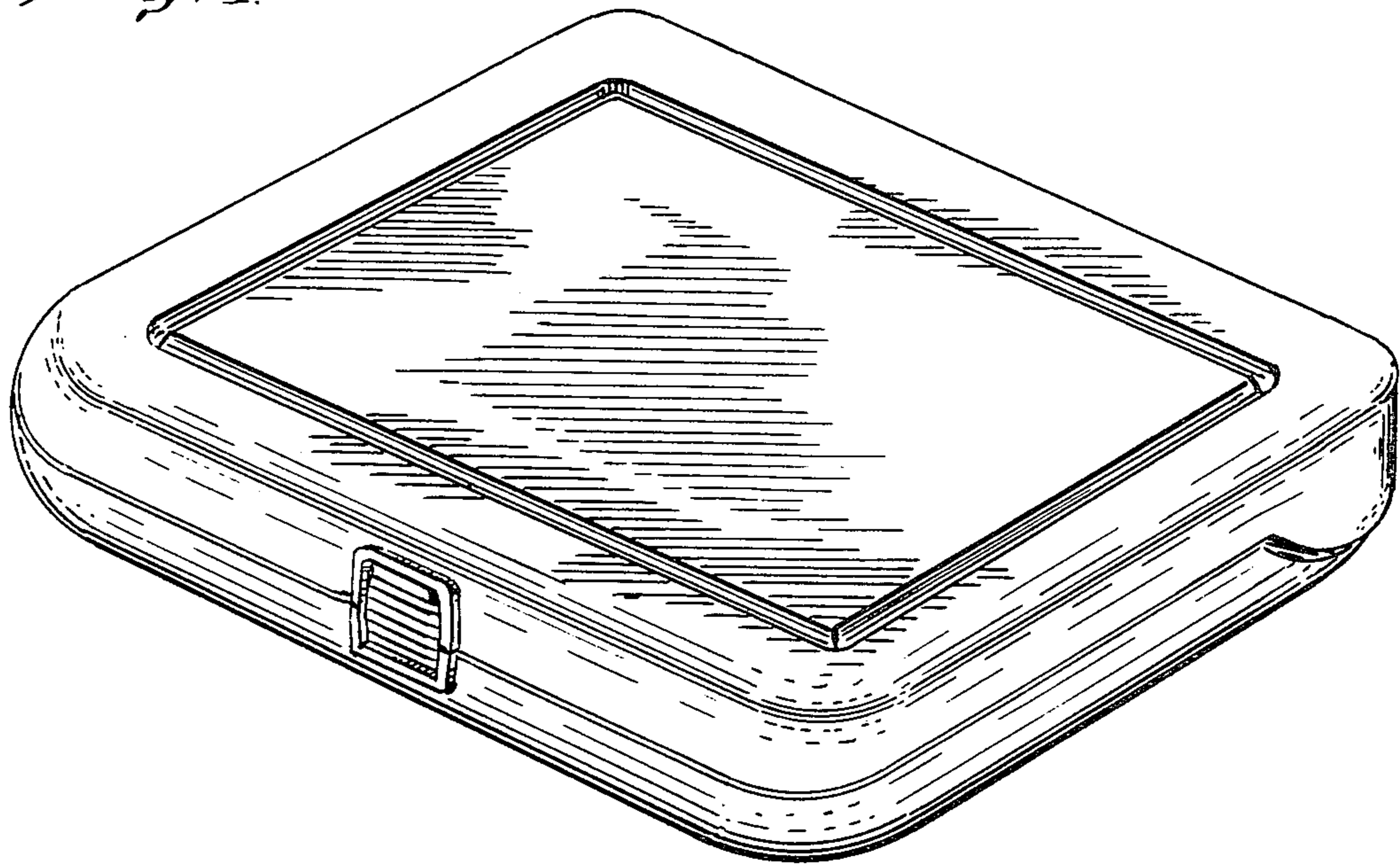
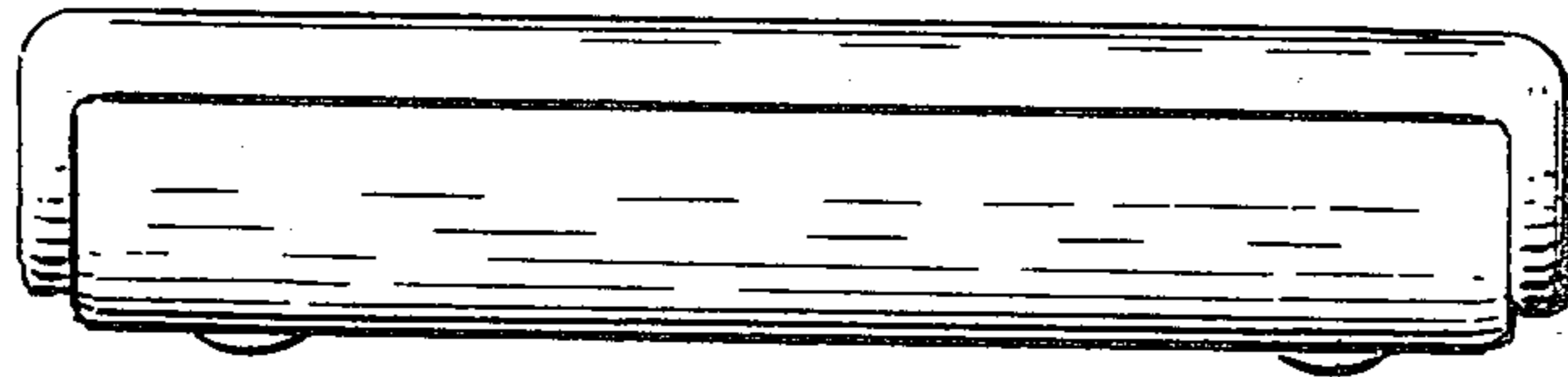

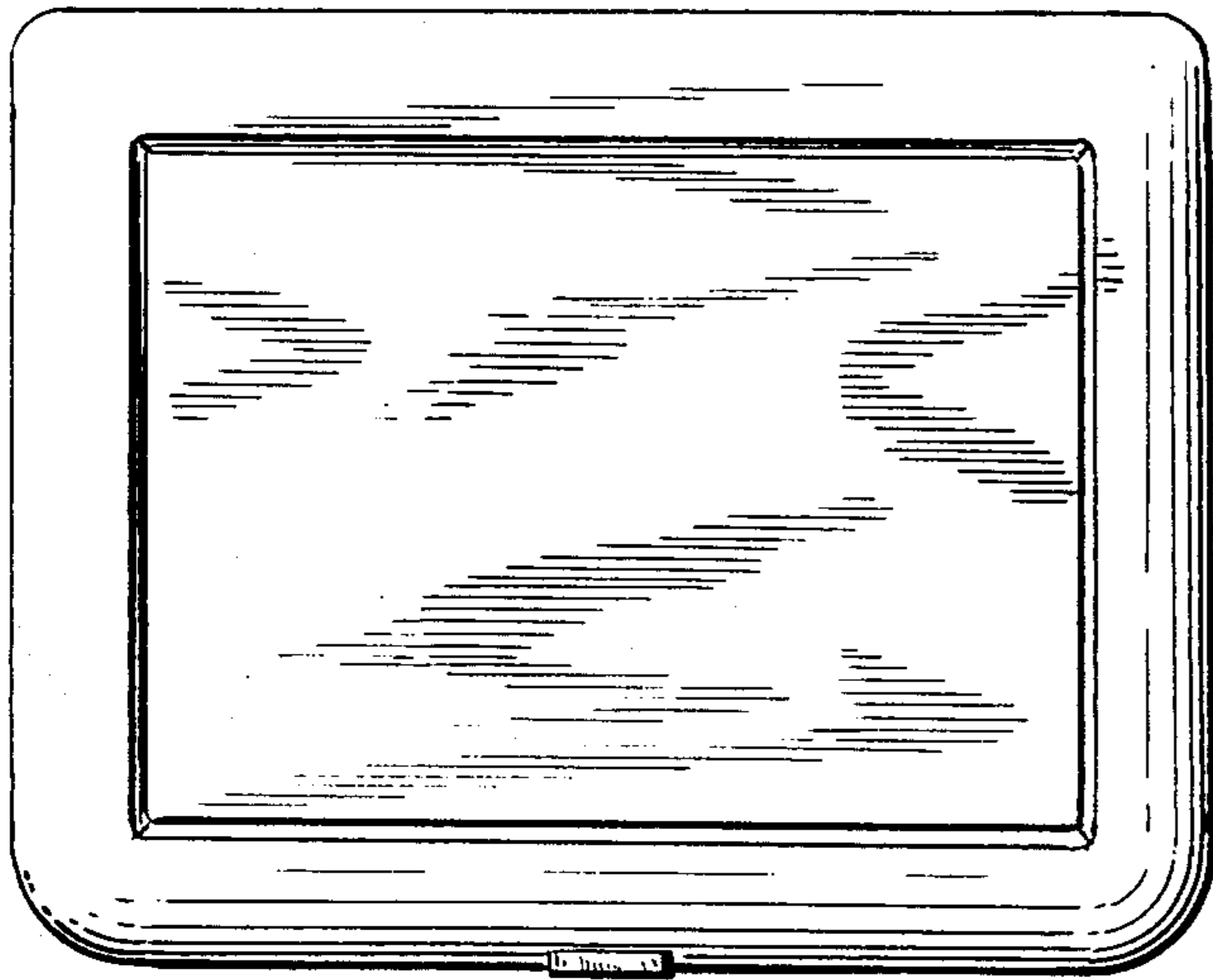

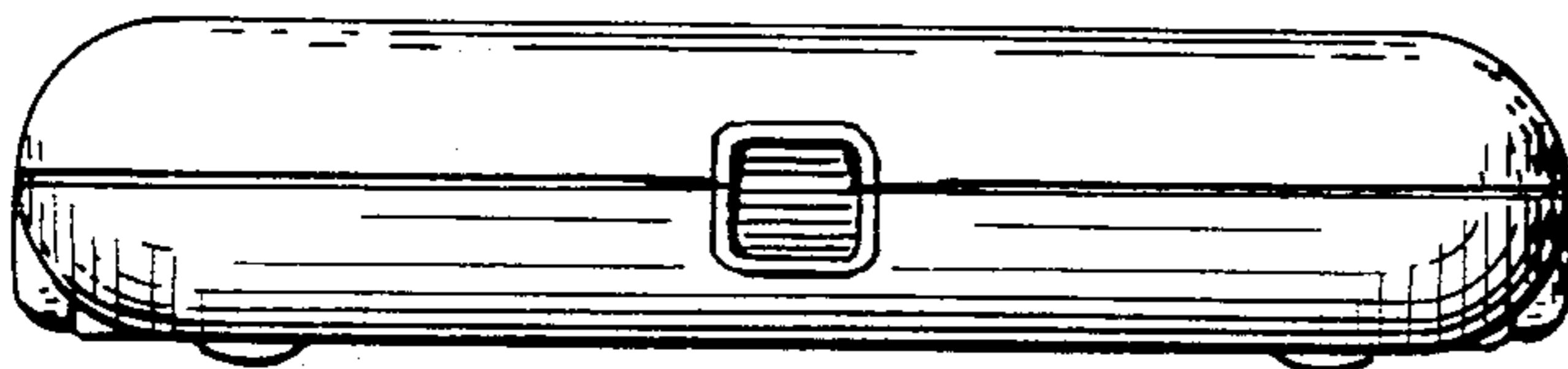

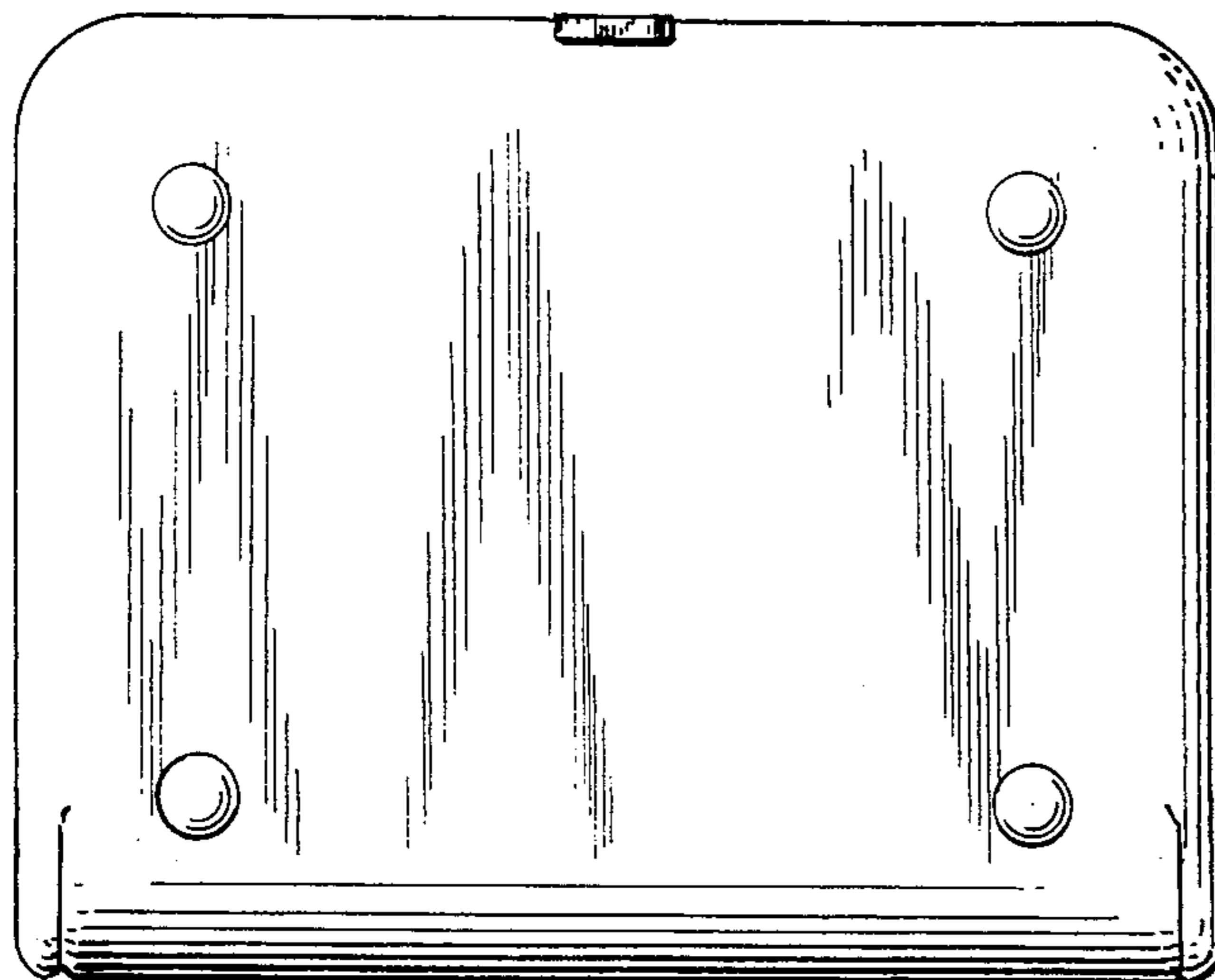
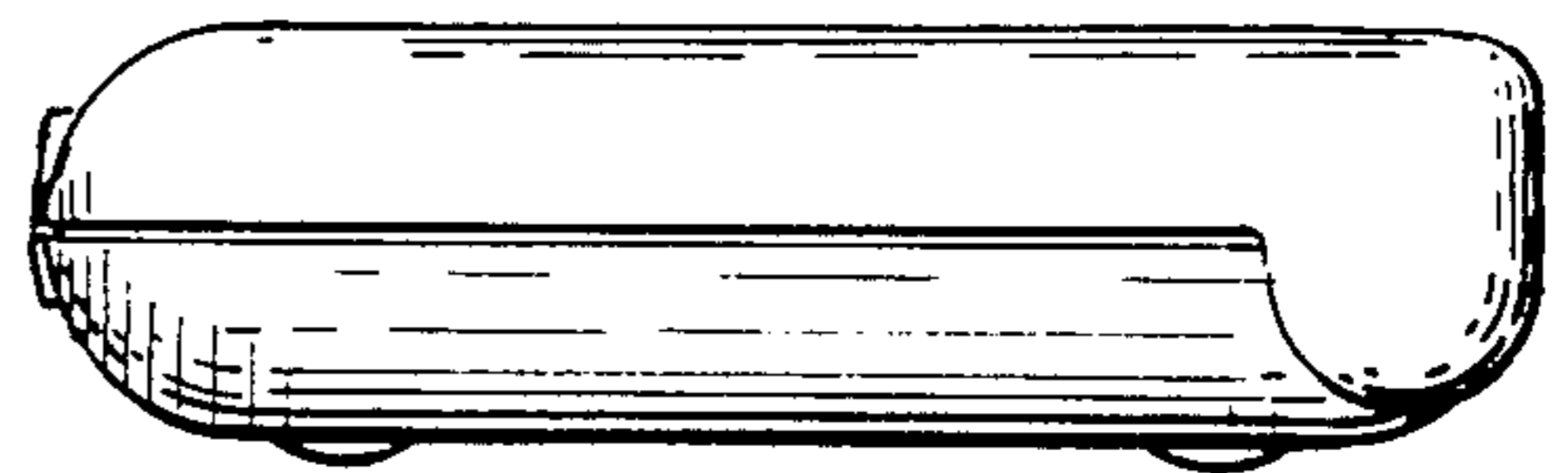
