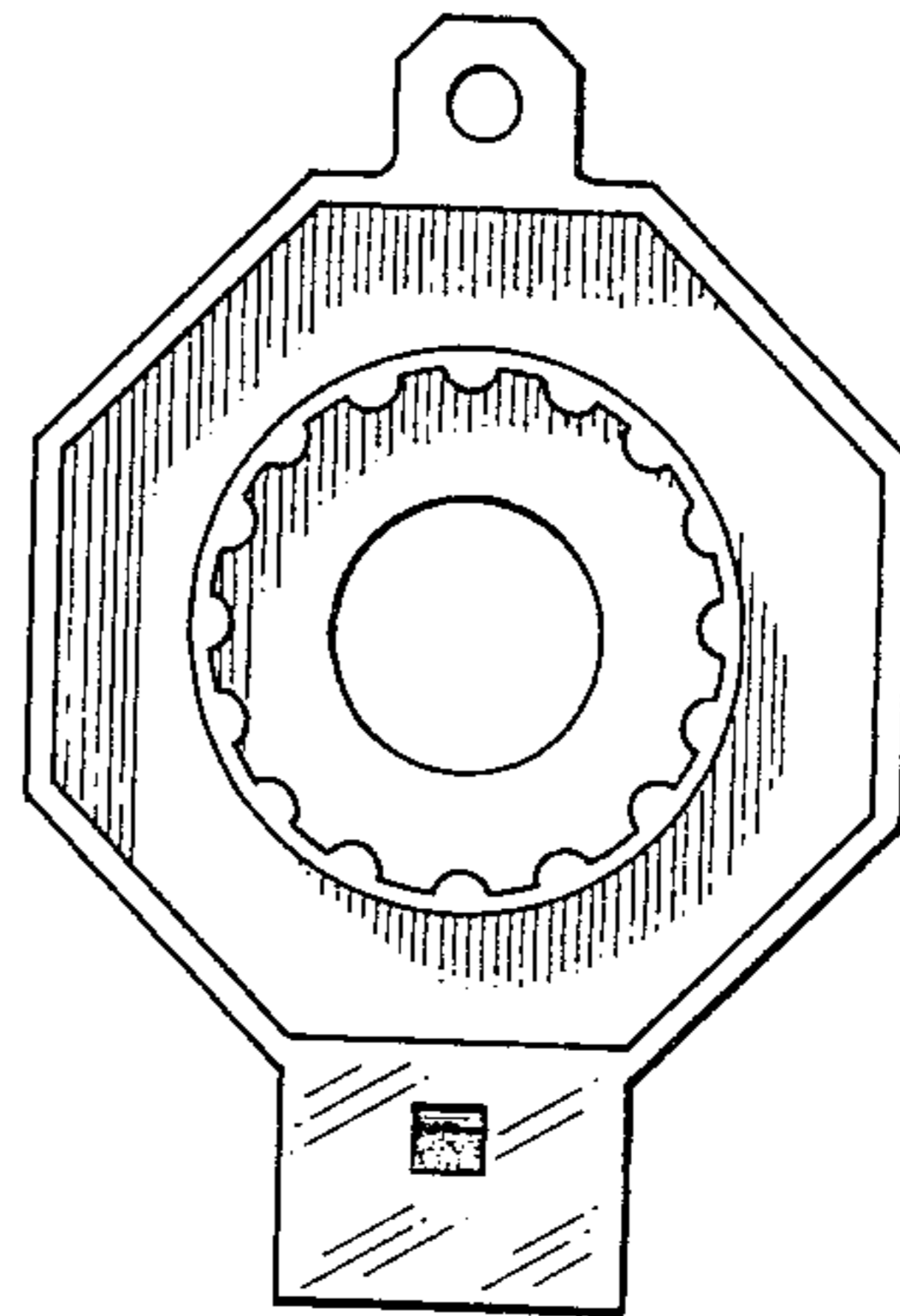
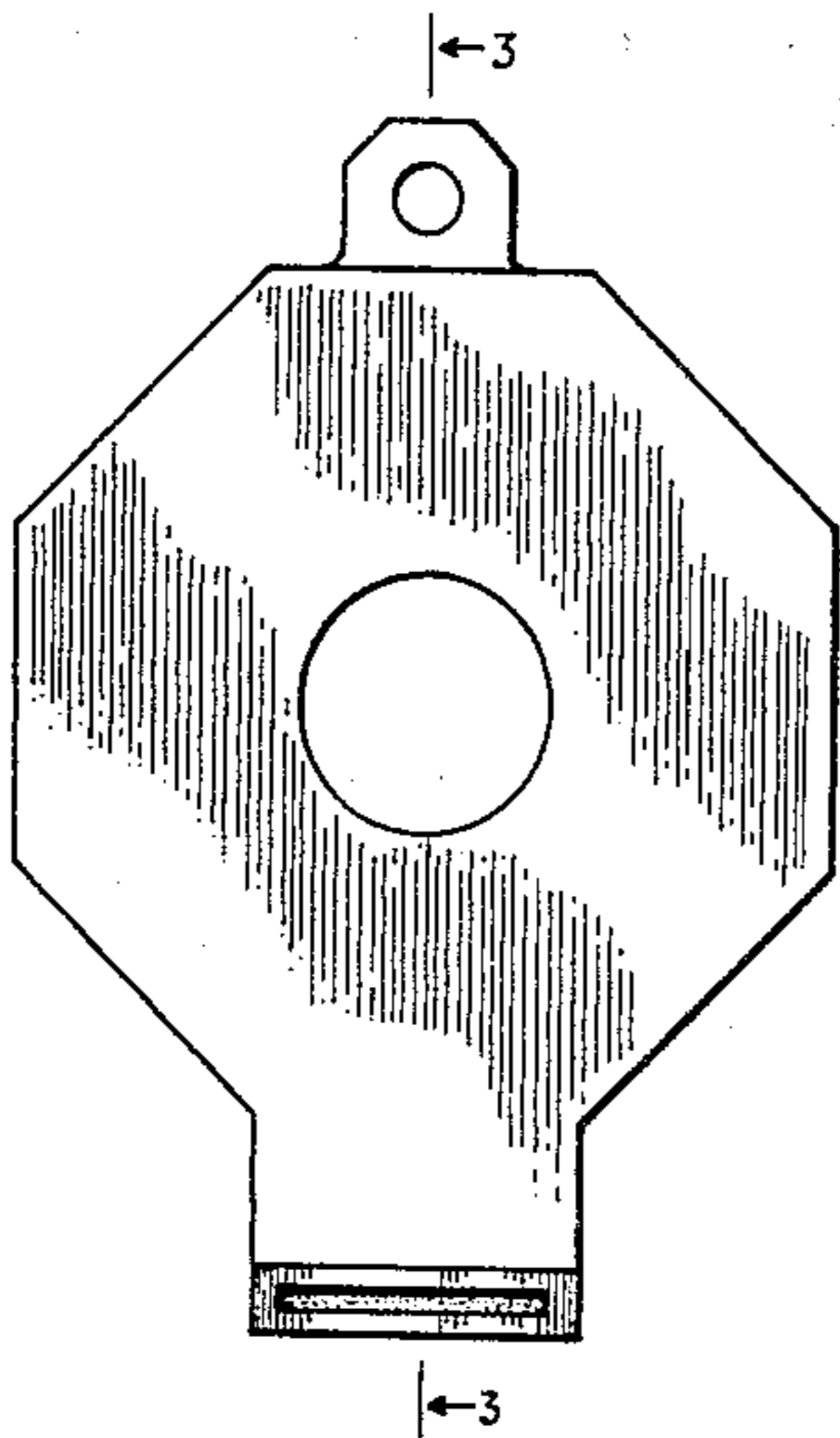

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined bottle and tab can opener, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined bottle and tab-can opener showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 1.



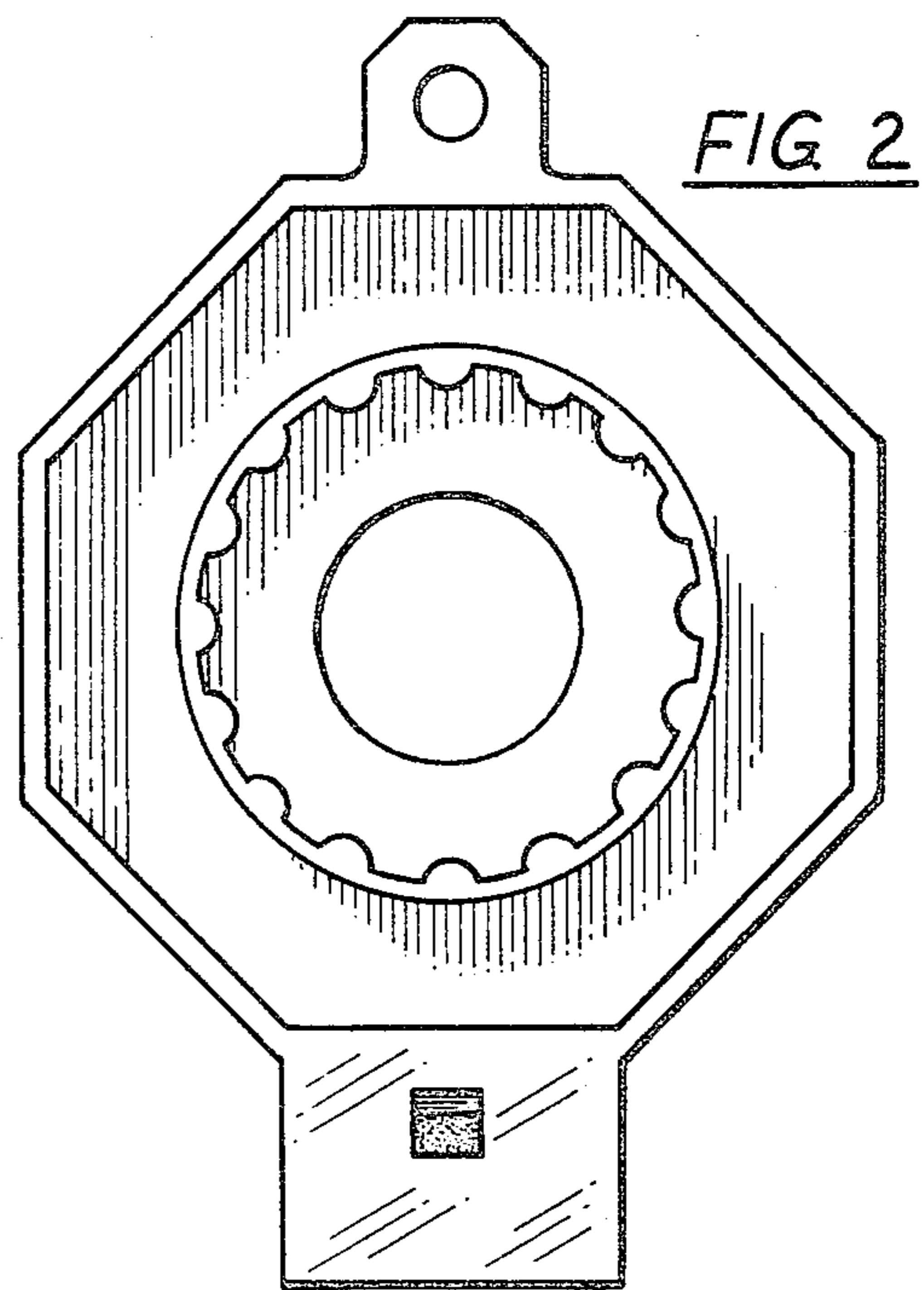
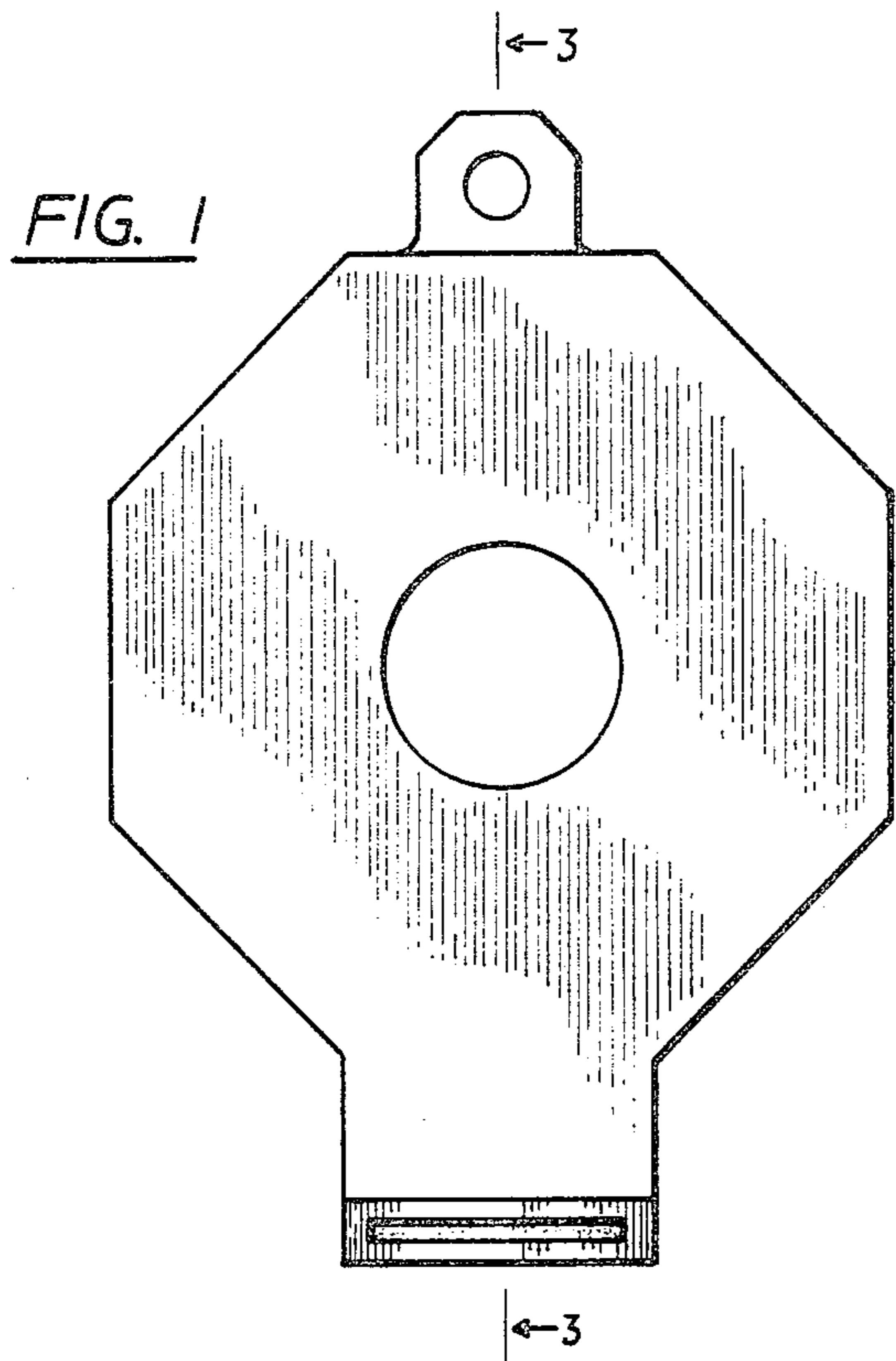

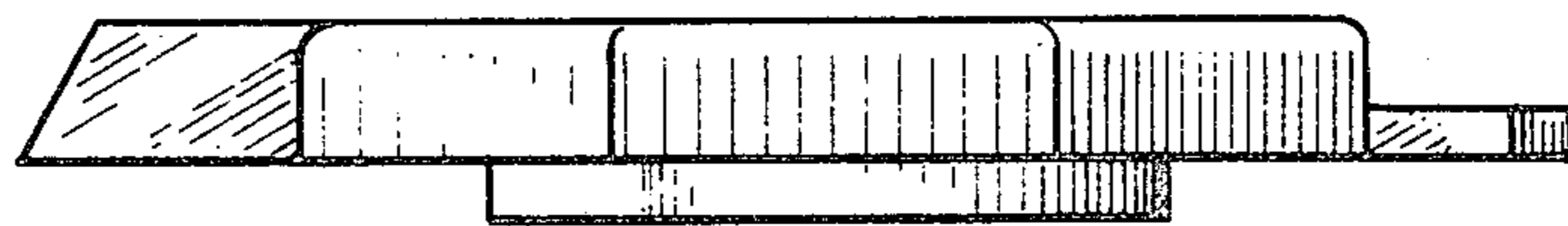

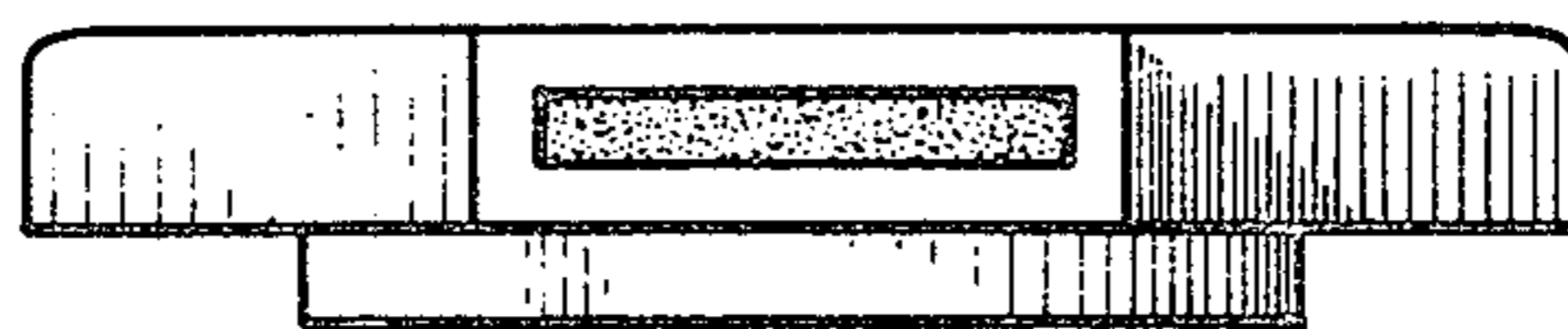
