The ornamental design for a fishing lure, substantially as shown.

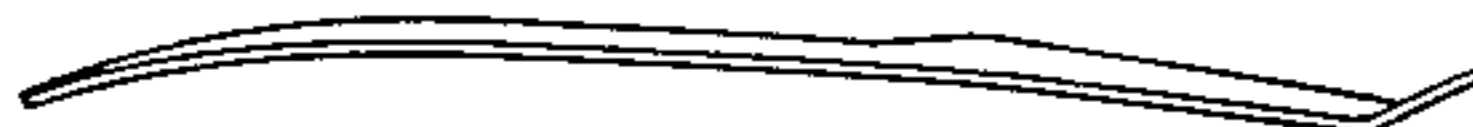
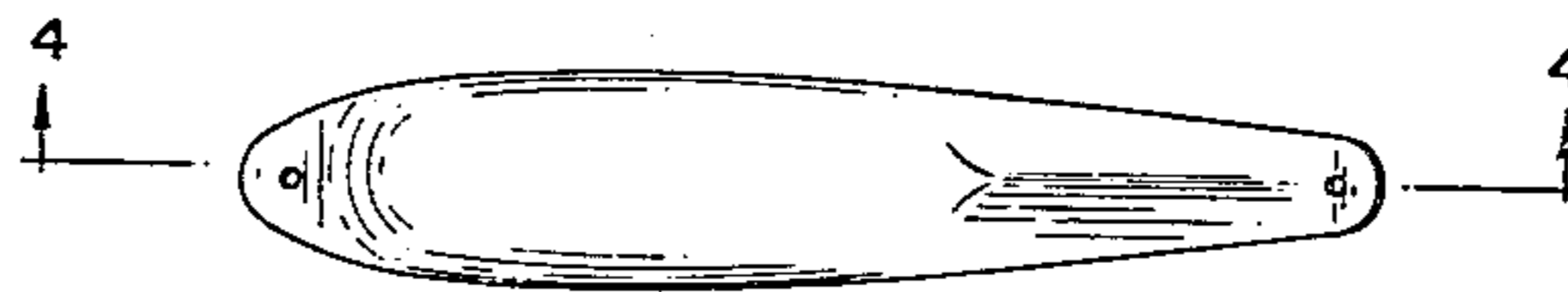
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fishing lure showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along the line 4—4 in FIG. 1 looking in the direction of the arrows.



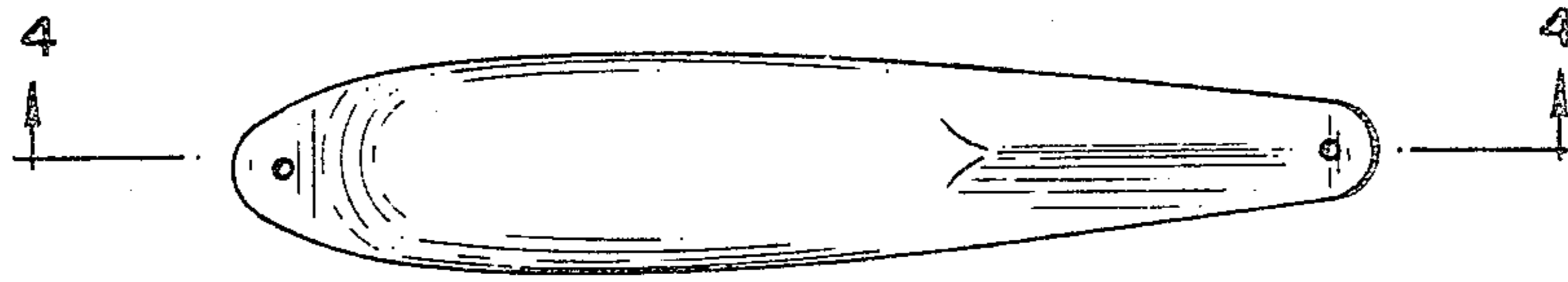

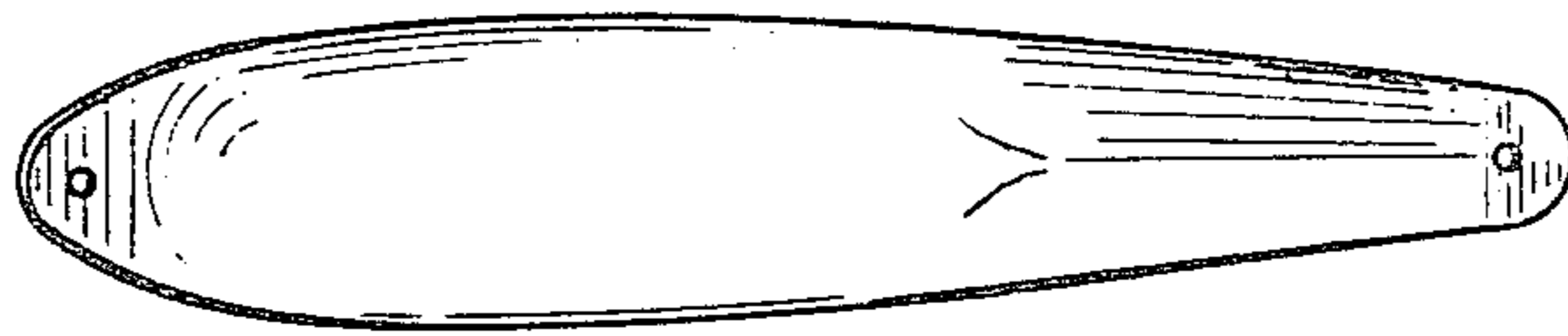

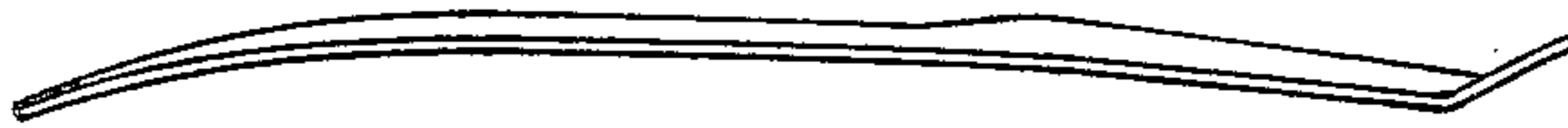

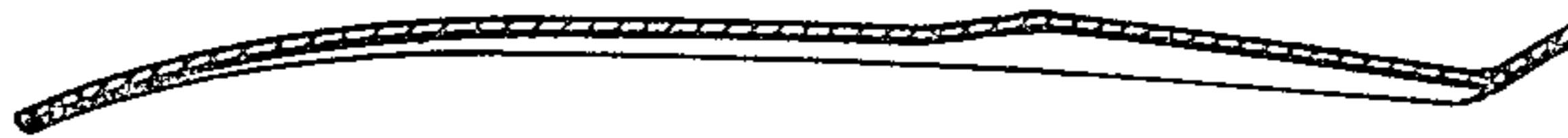
