FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of soft-sided luggage showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, the other end being similar.

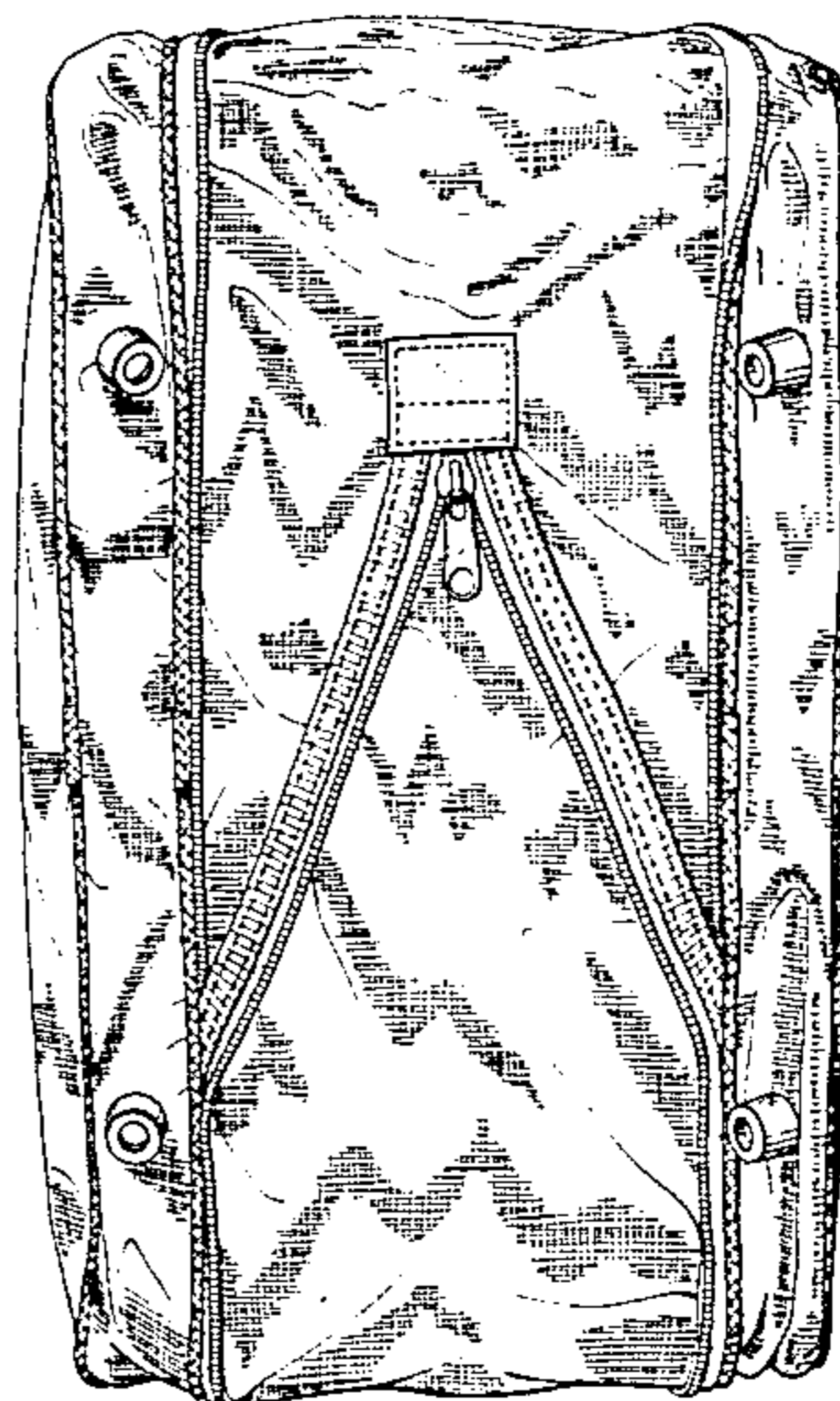
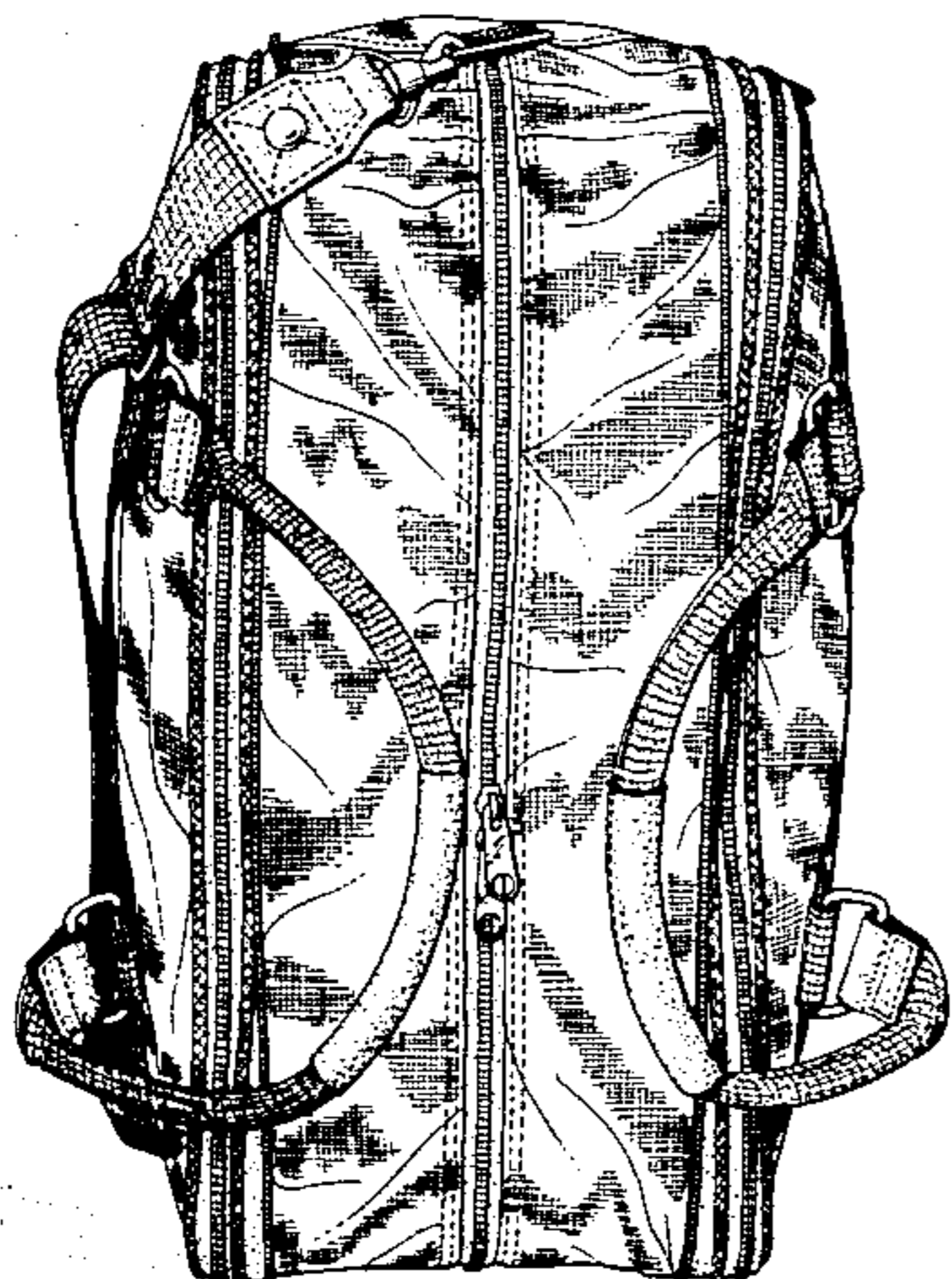
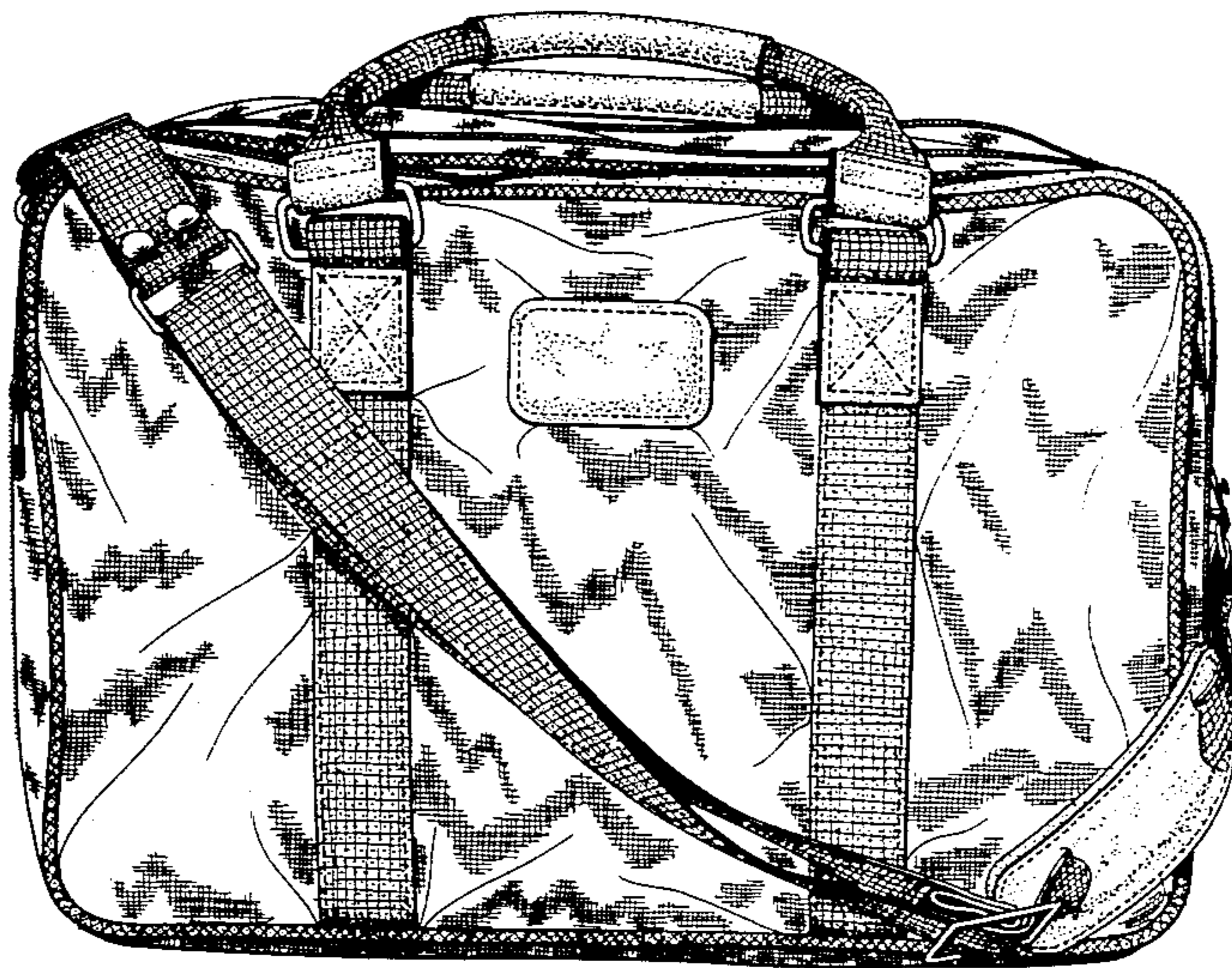

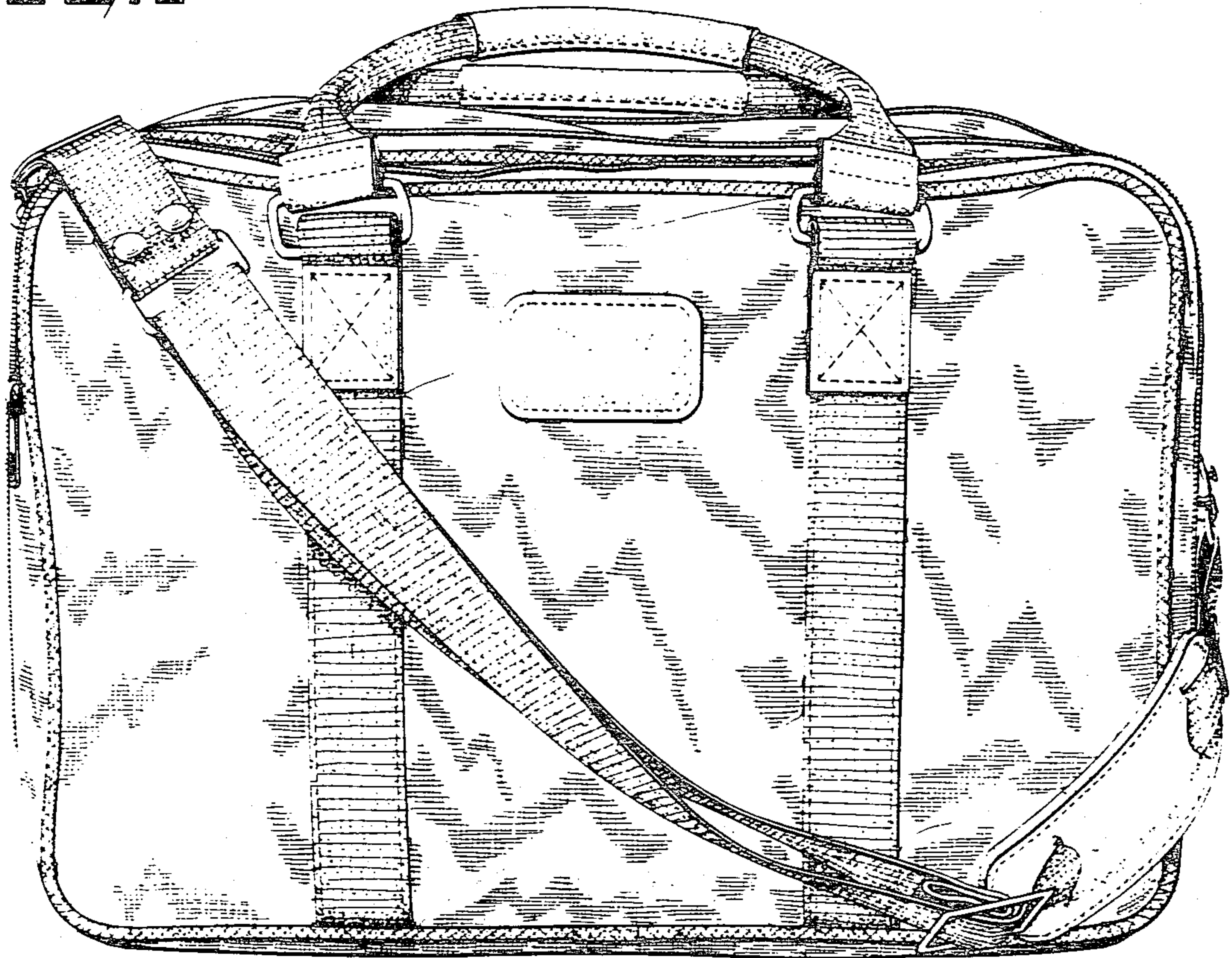
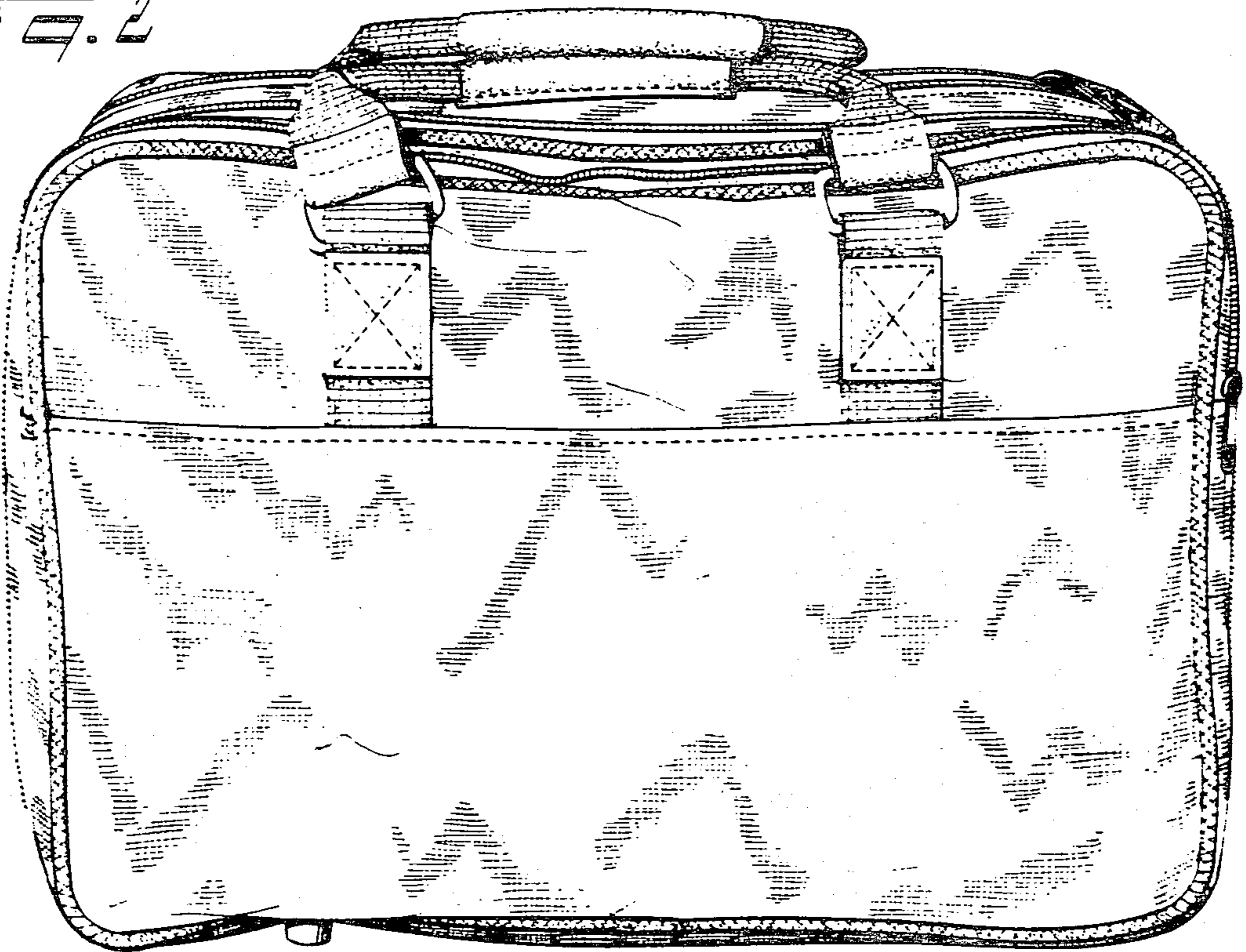

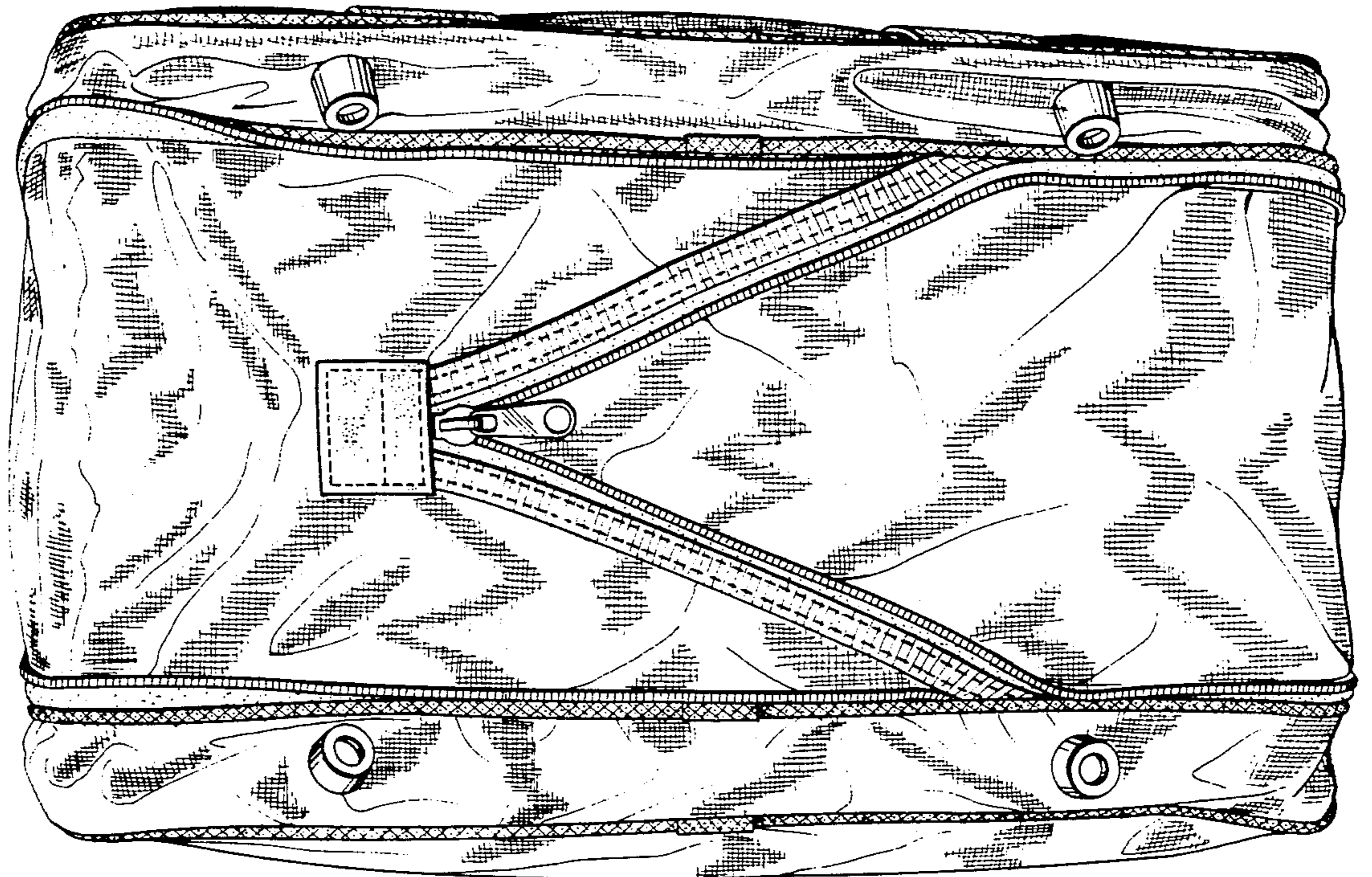

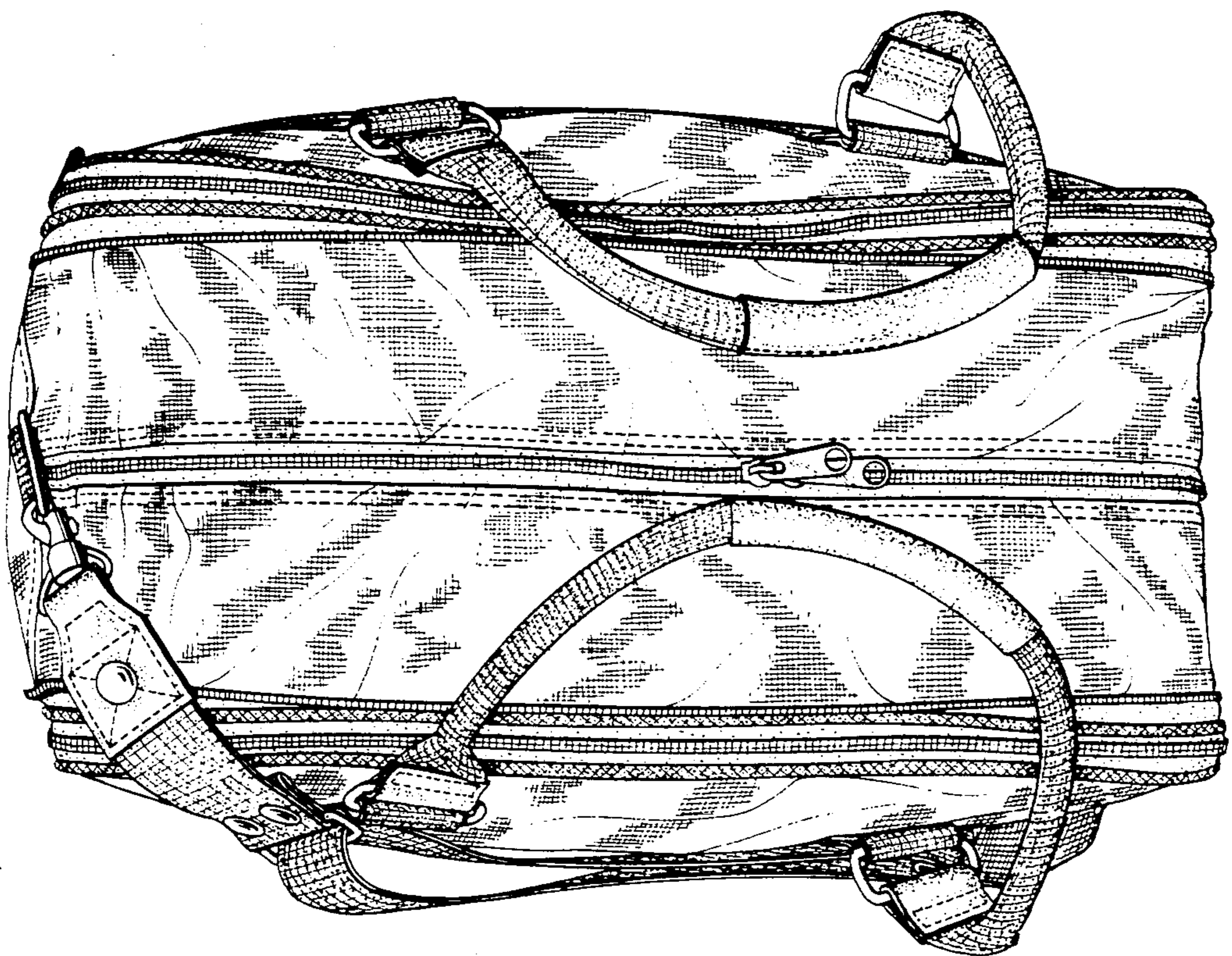
