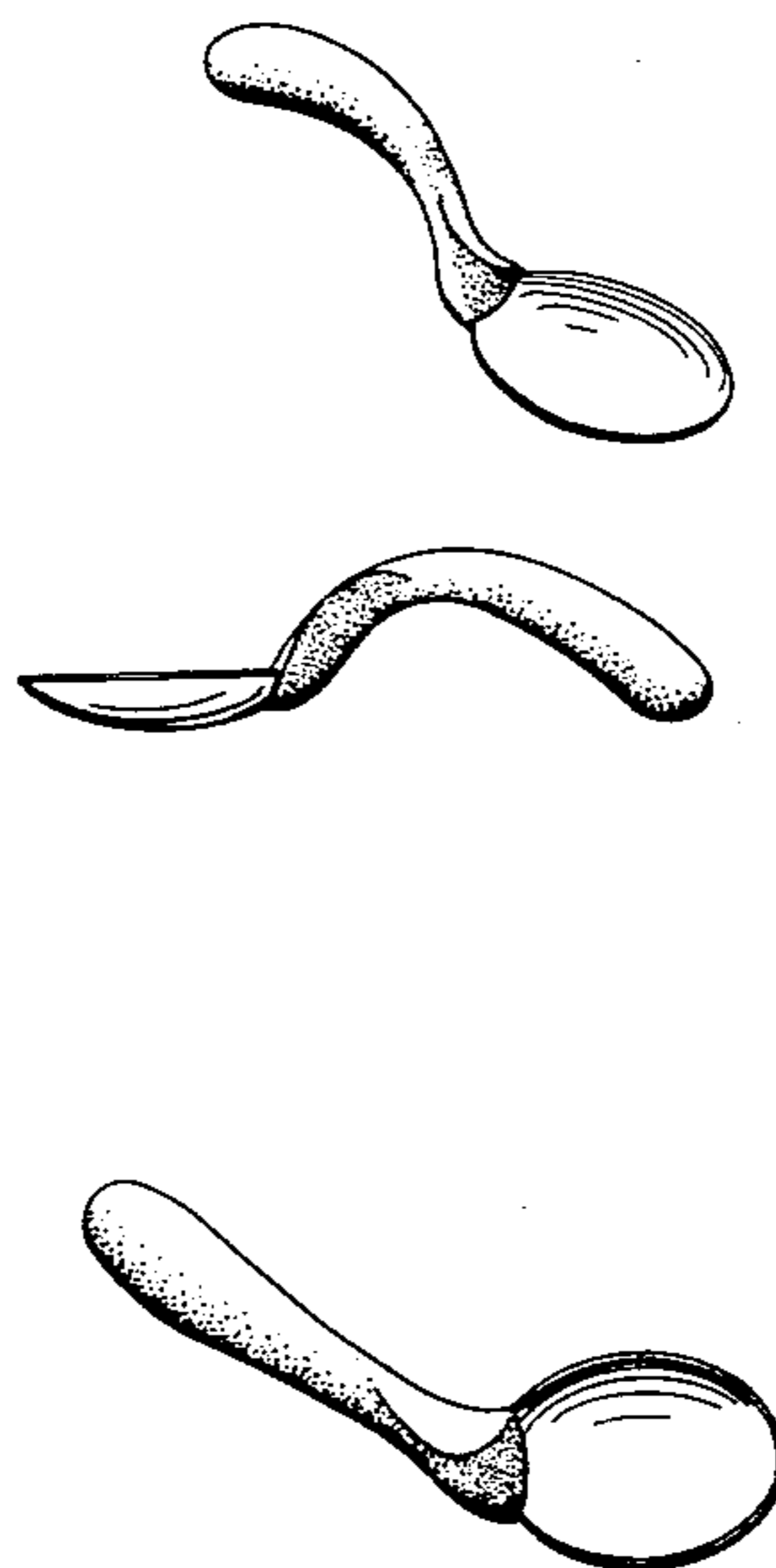

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a spoon showing one side of my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof of the opposite side;
 FIG. 3 is an elevational view thereof of the one side shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



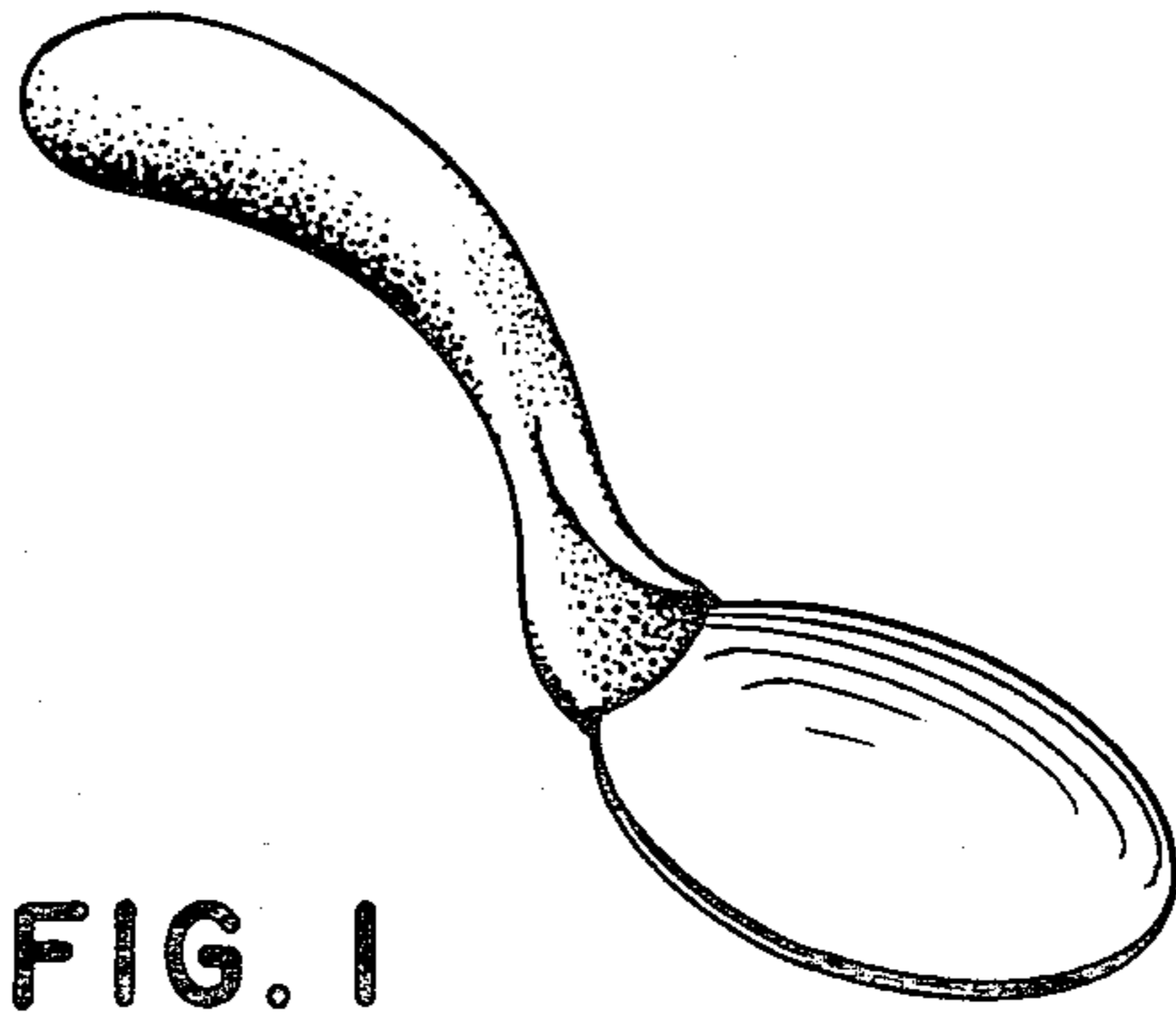

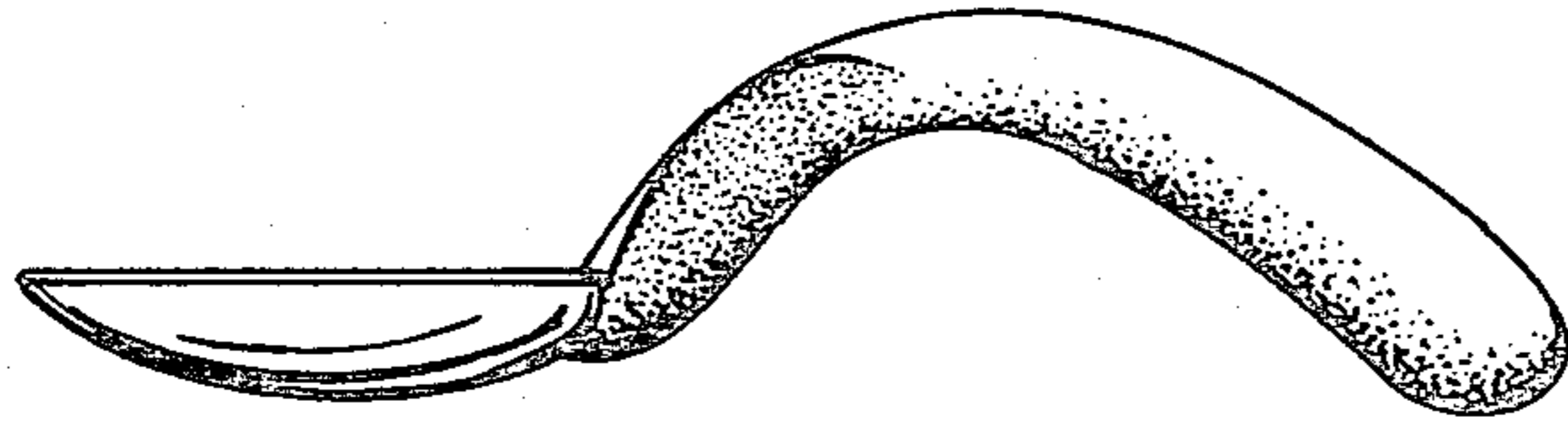

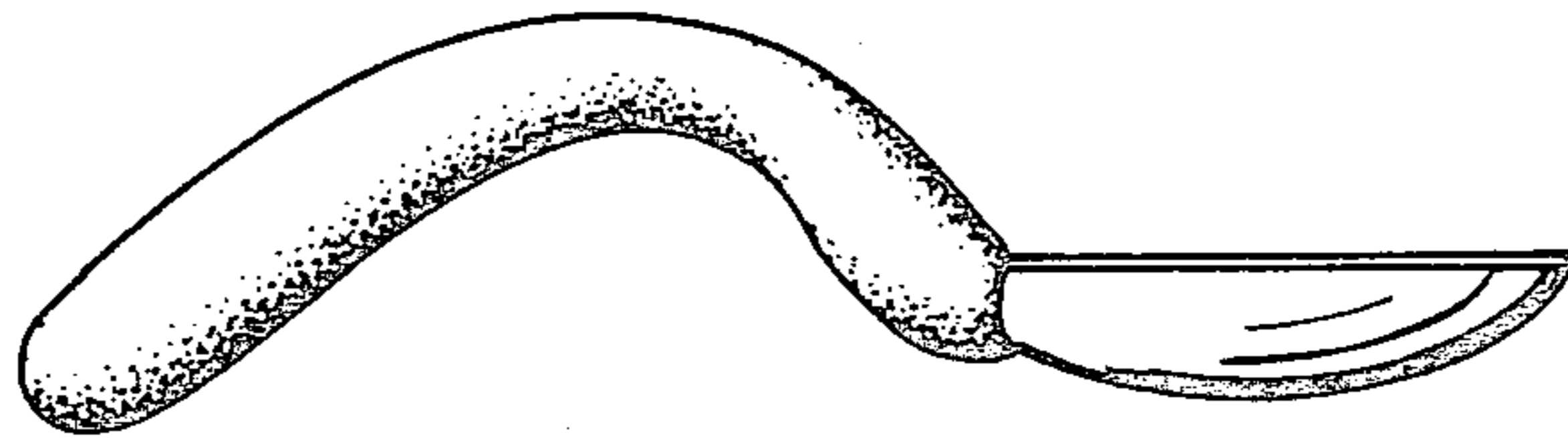

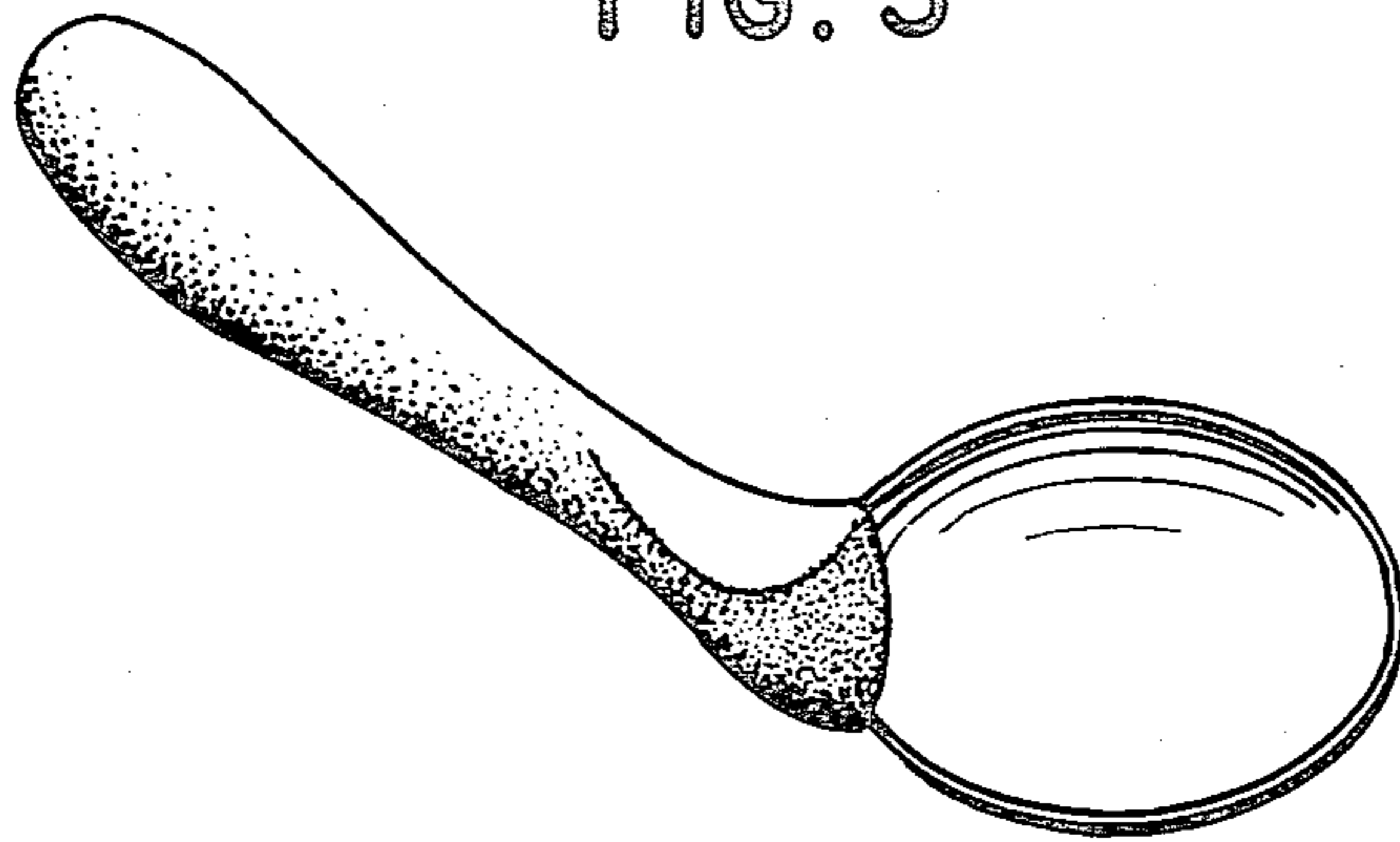

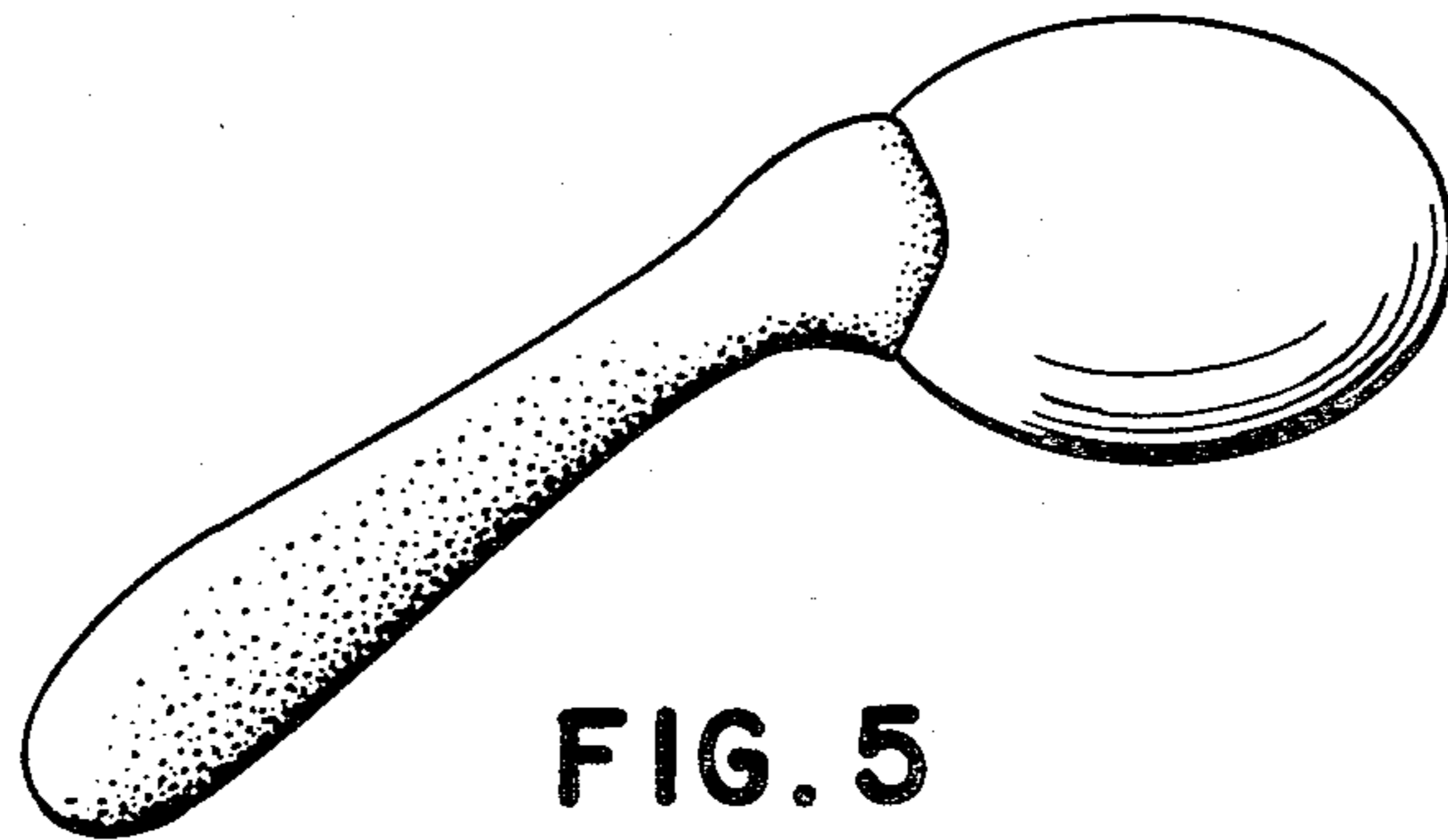
