FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof opposite to that

shown in FIG. 3;


FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view theoeof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and


FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.




