[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined umbrella and dog repellent holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a combined umbrella and dog repellent holder showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image on the side shown;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of our new design;  
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of the second embodiment of our new design, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the side shown; and  
FIG. 9 is a top front perspective view of a third embodiment of our new design.

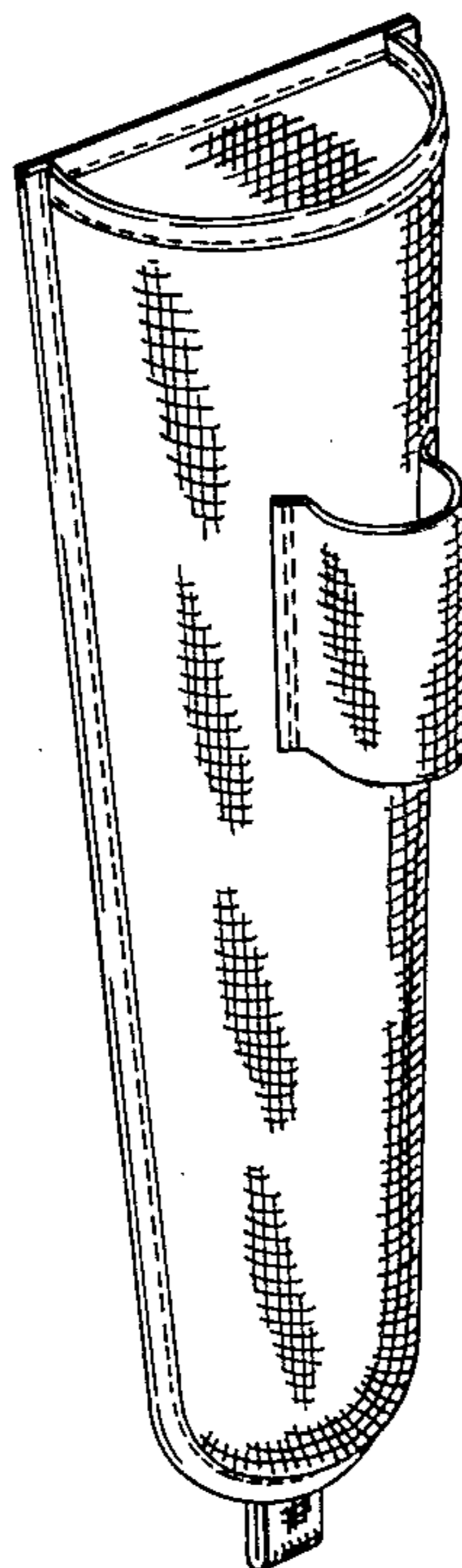

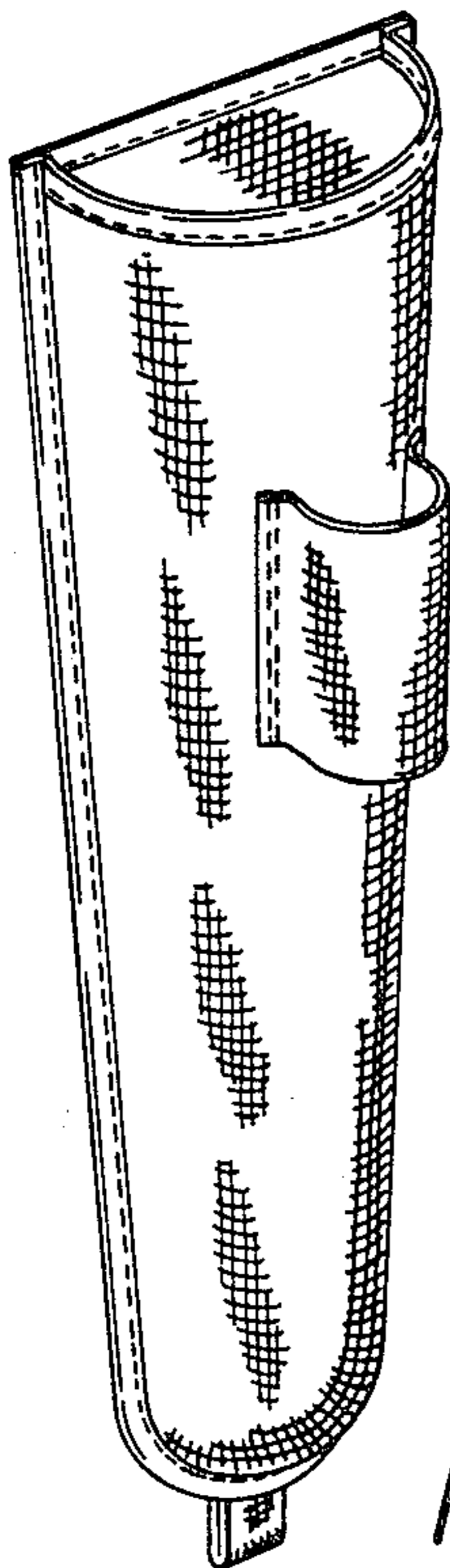

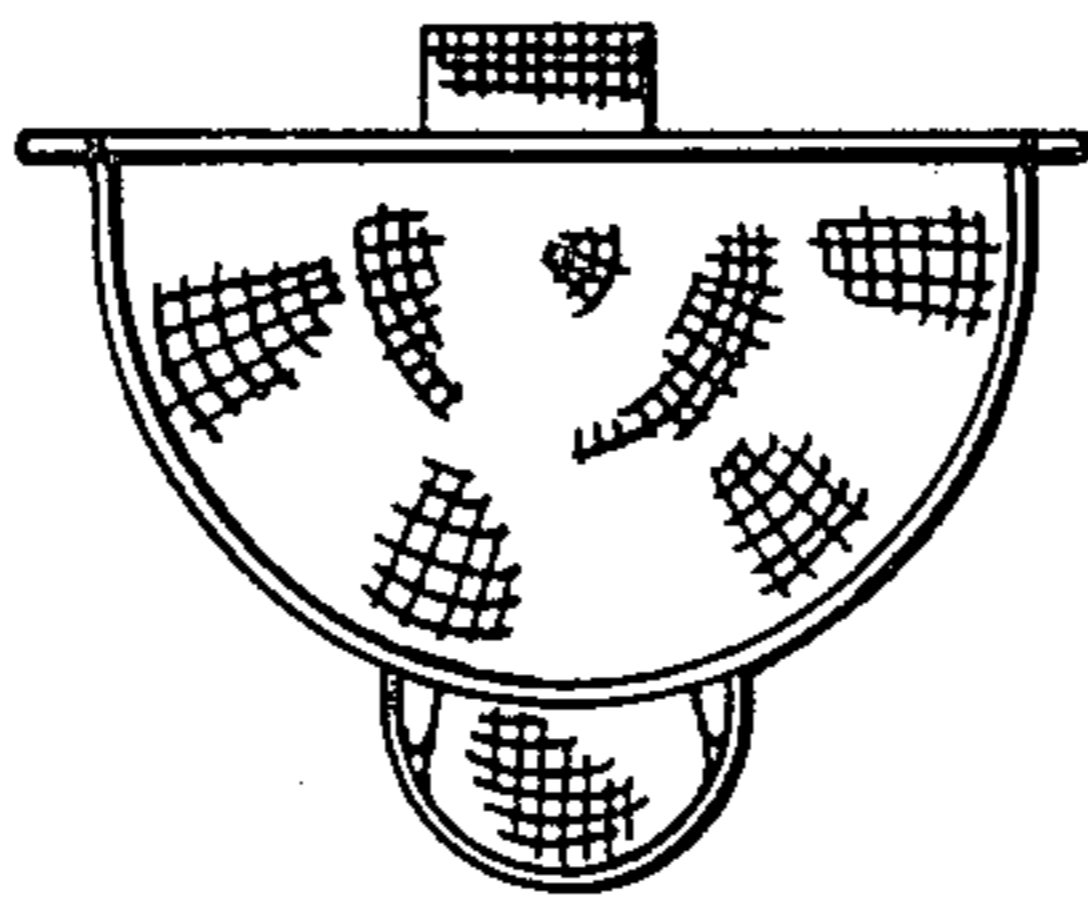

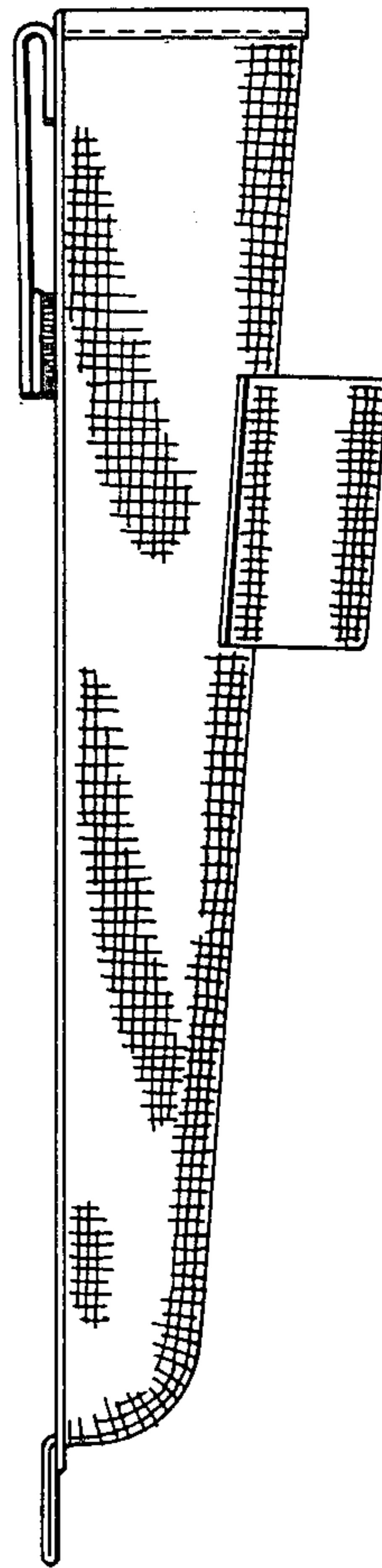

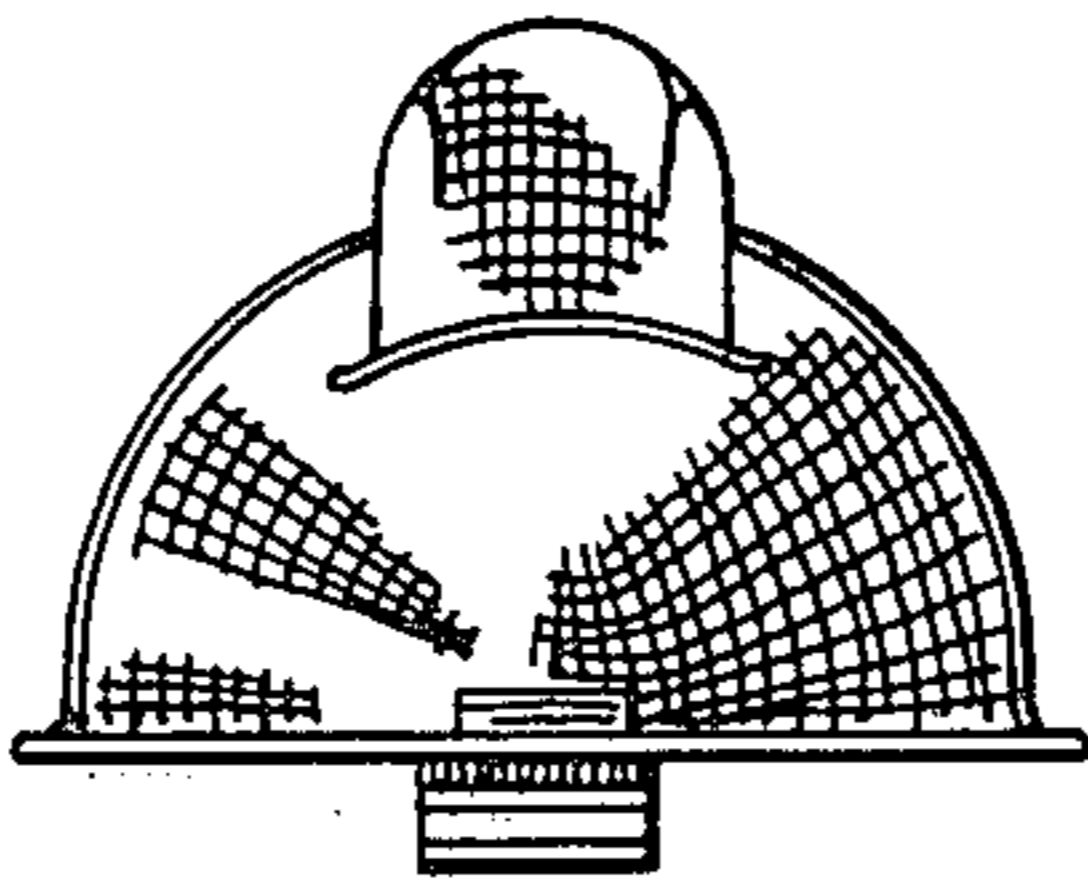

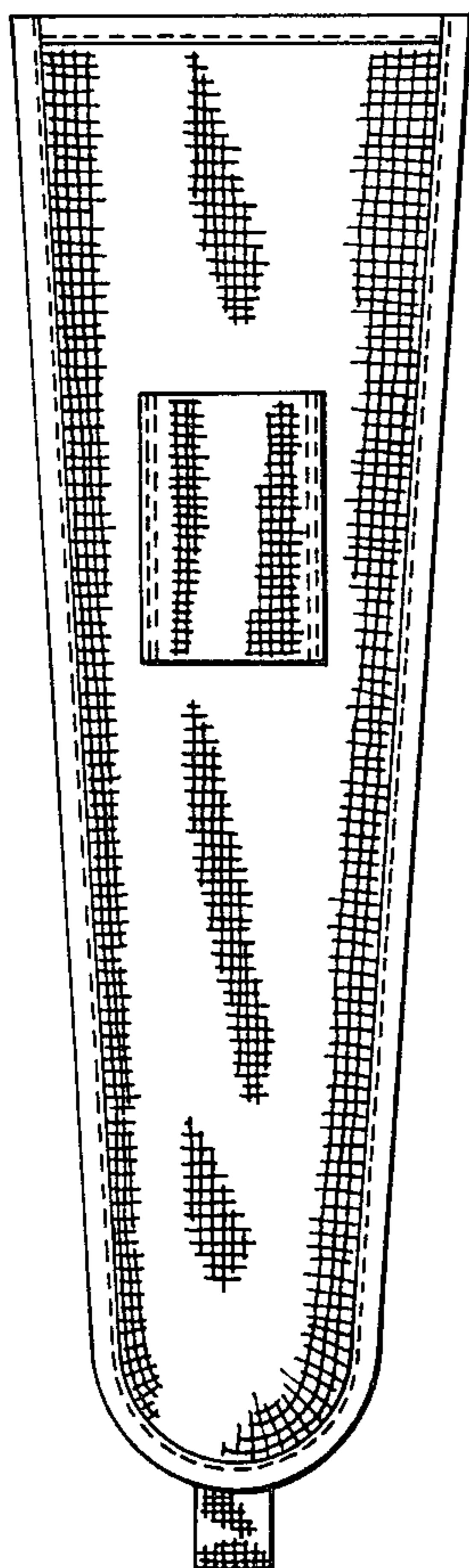

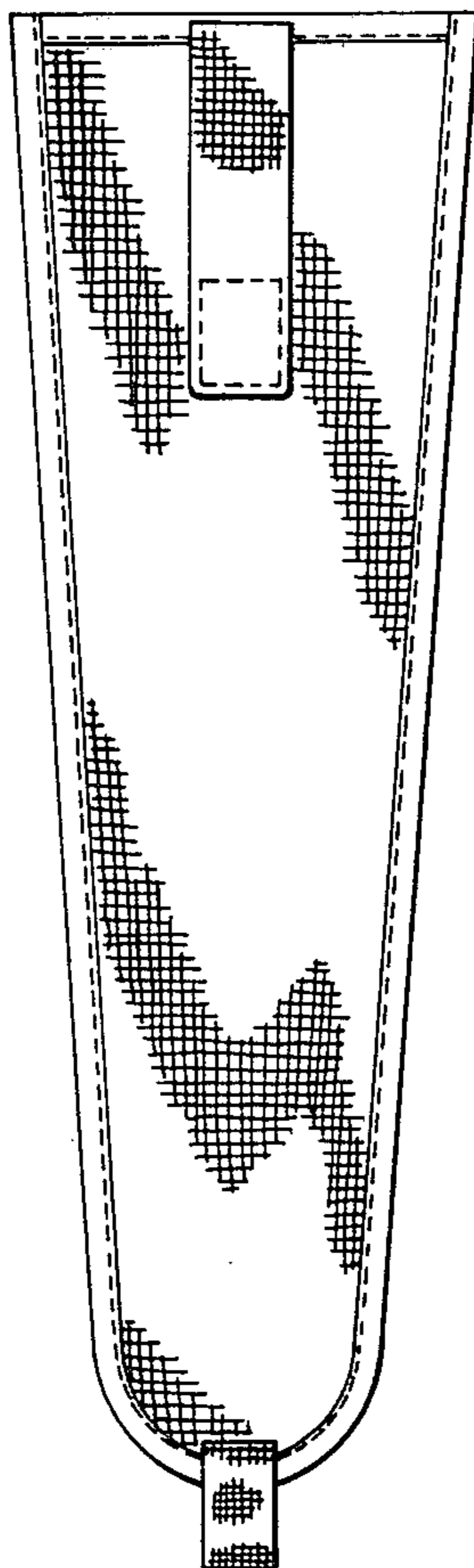

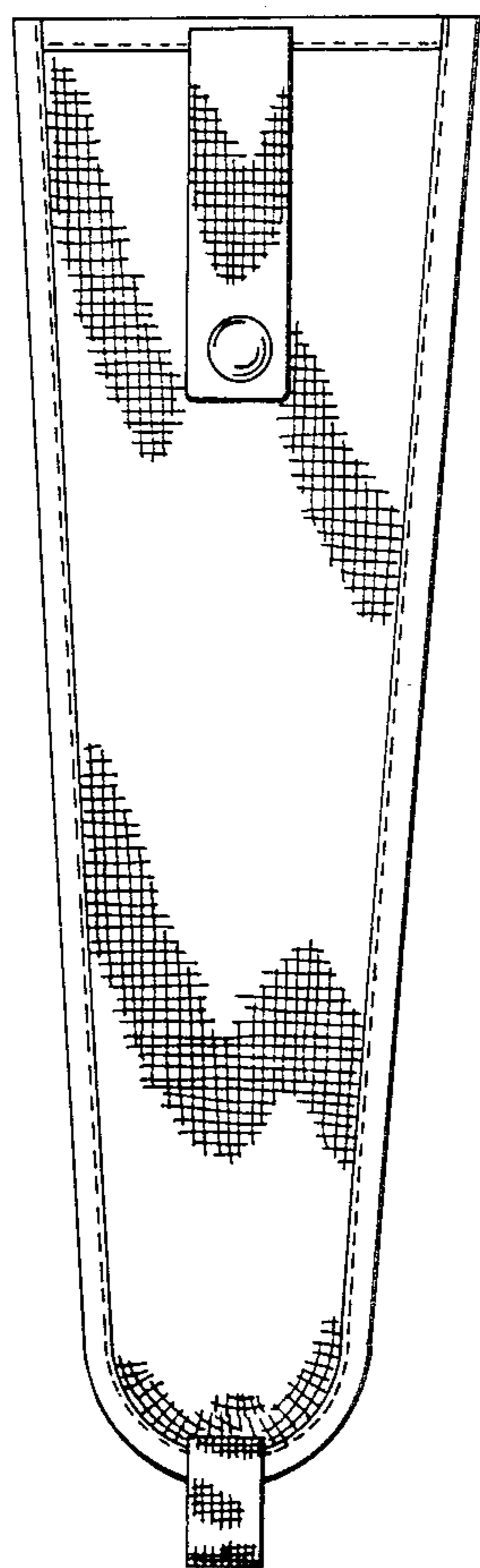

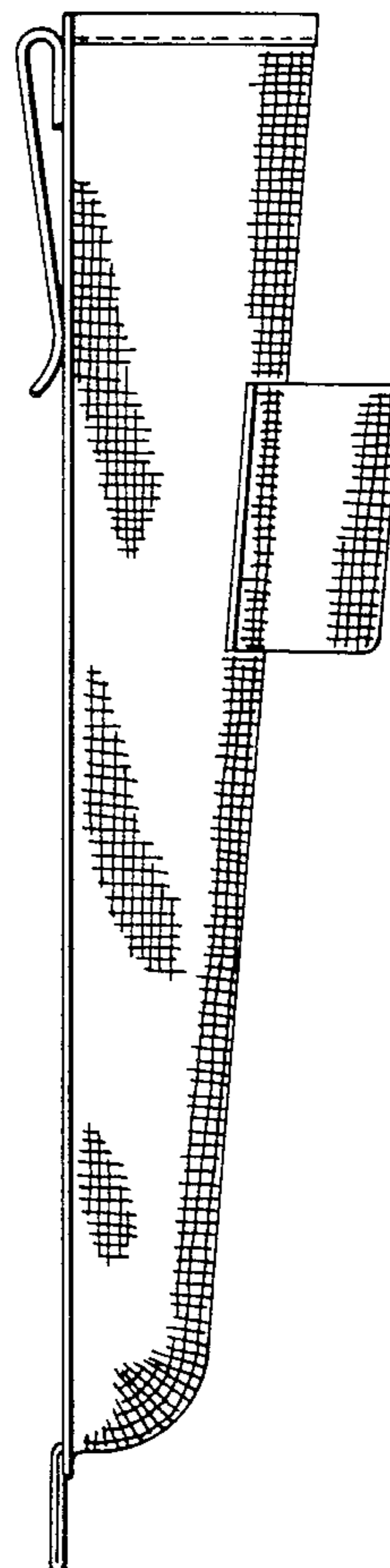
