DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a toy playhouse showing my new design, the side opposite being a mirror image;

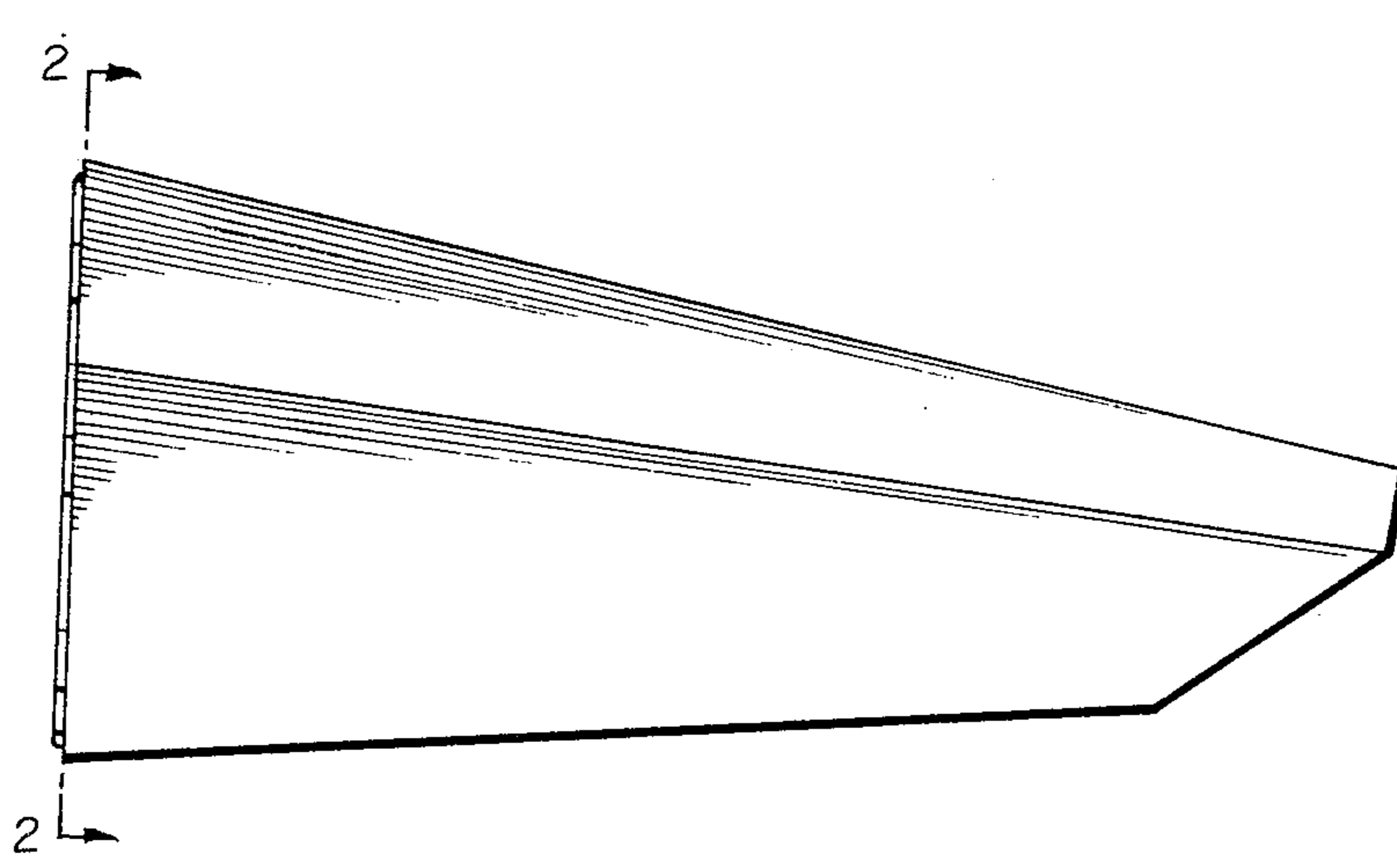
FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view of the design of FIG. 1 taken along line 2—2 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



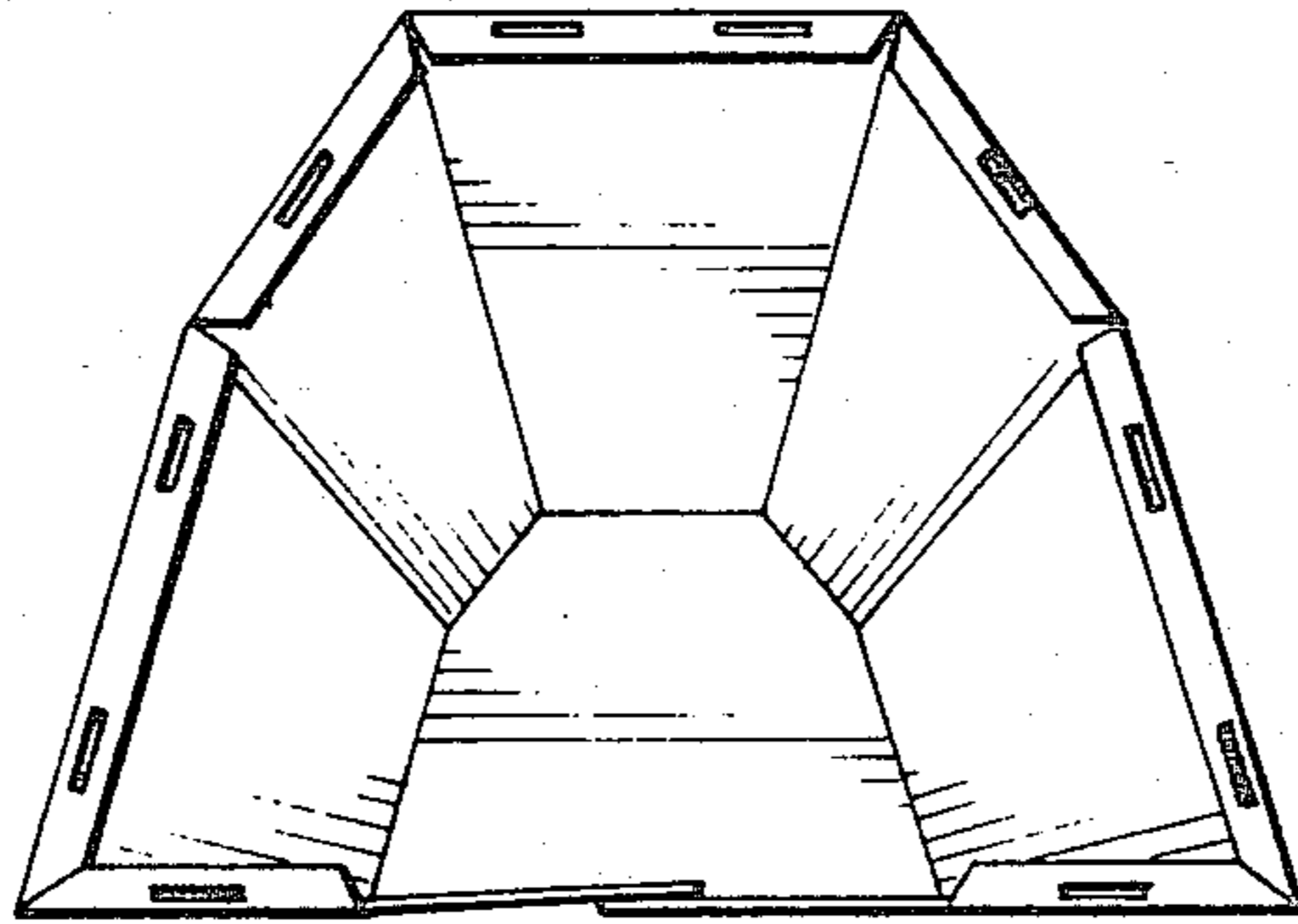

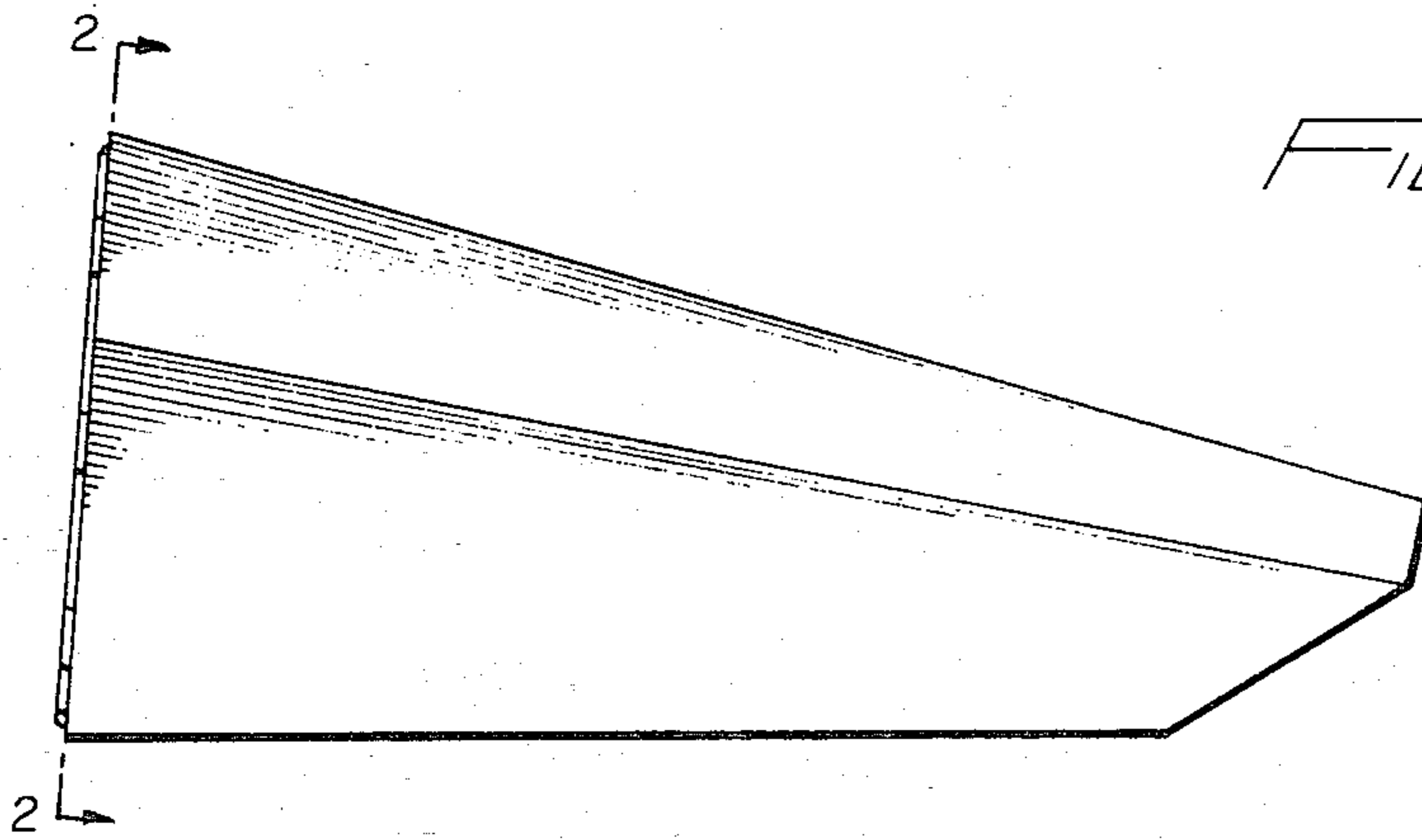

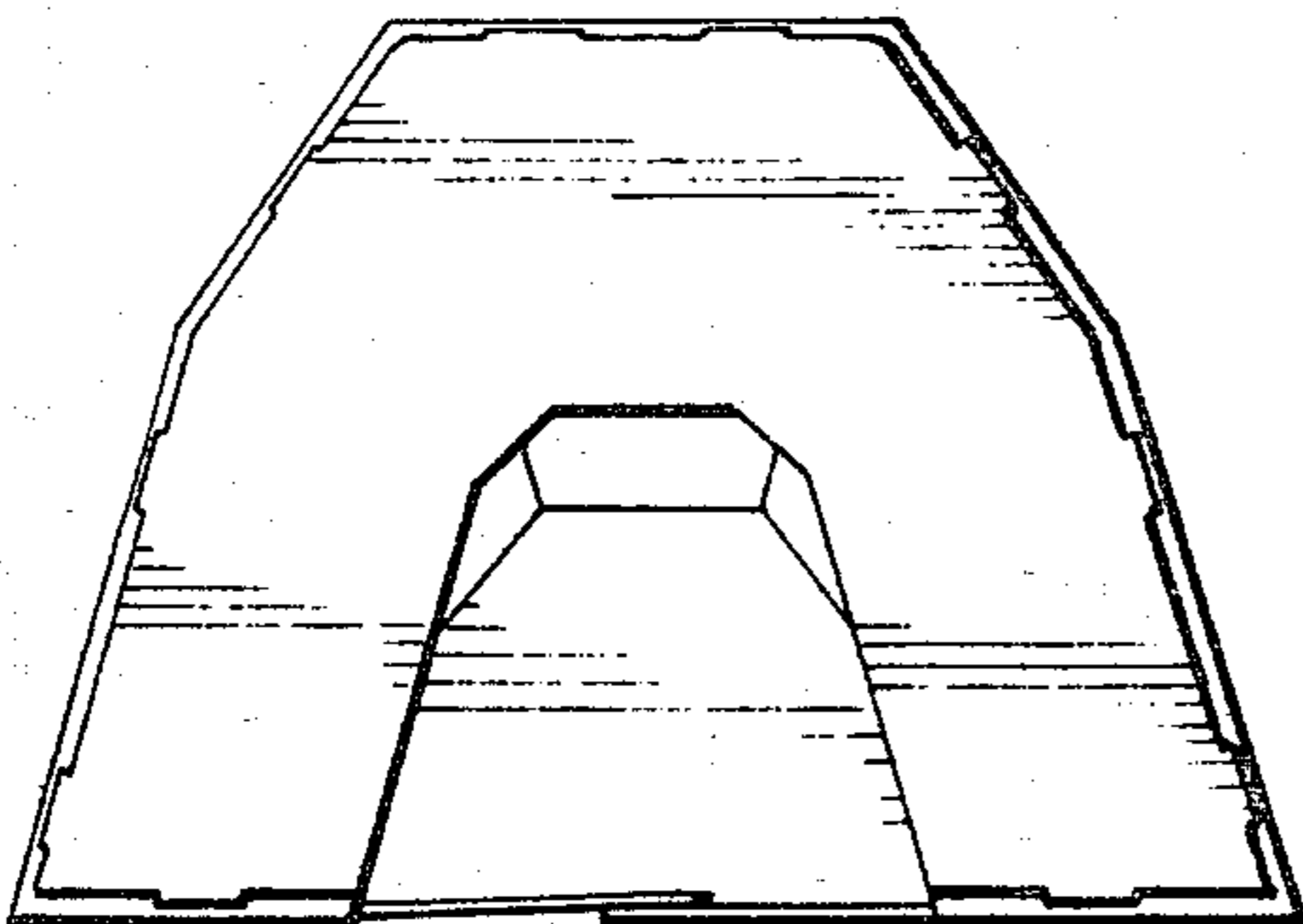

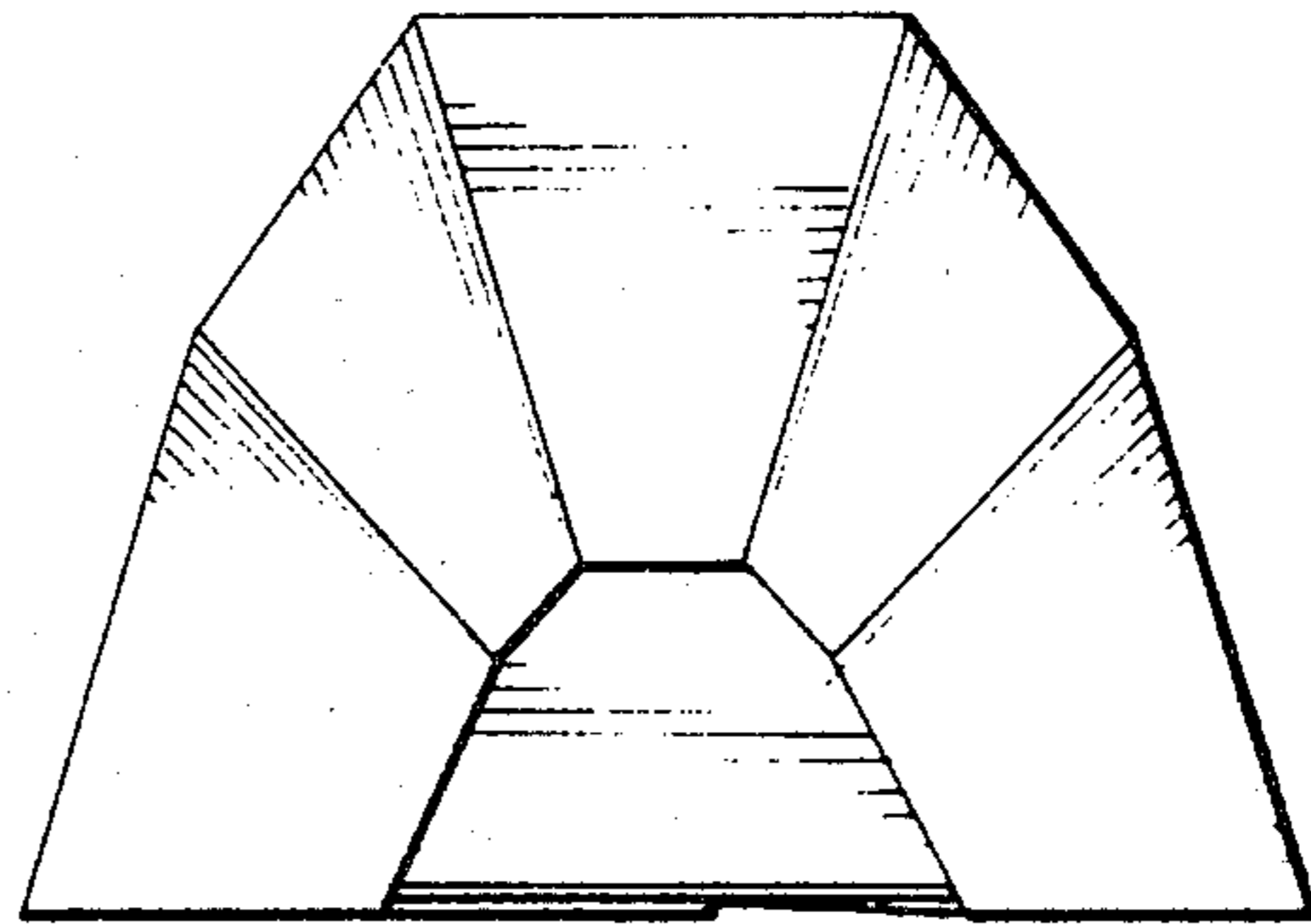

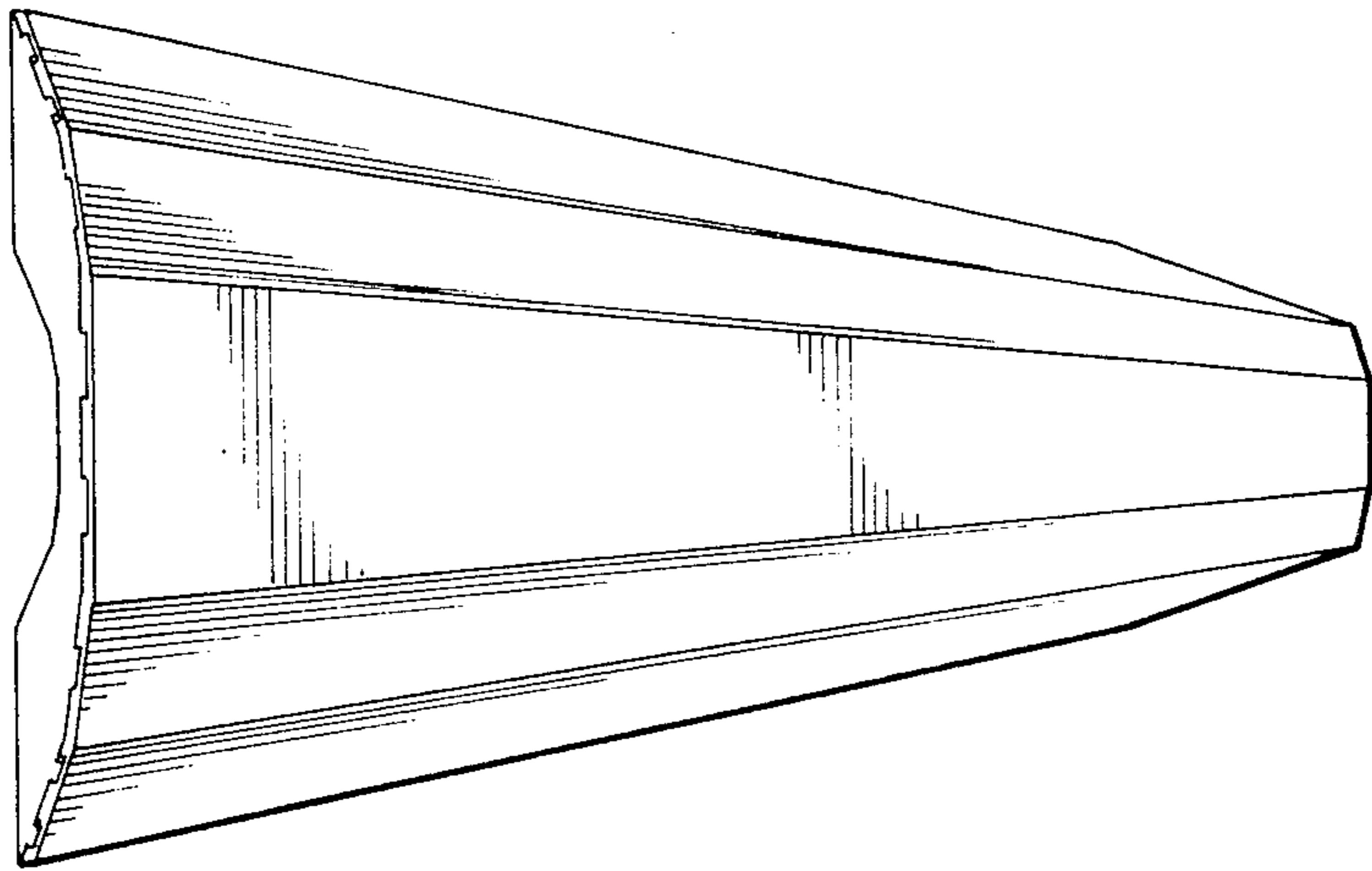

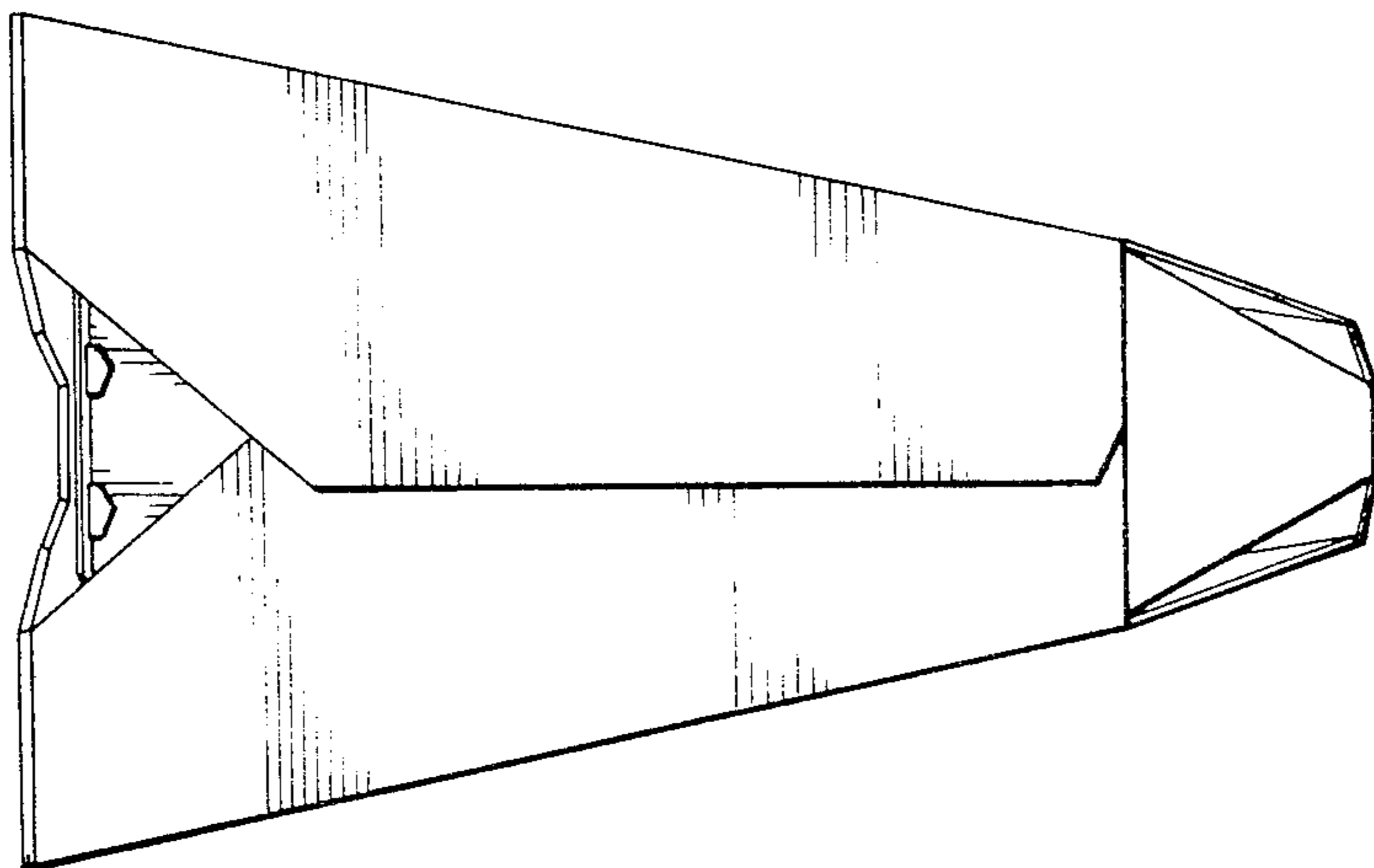
