The grass and ground line are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.

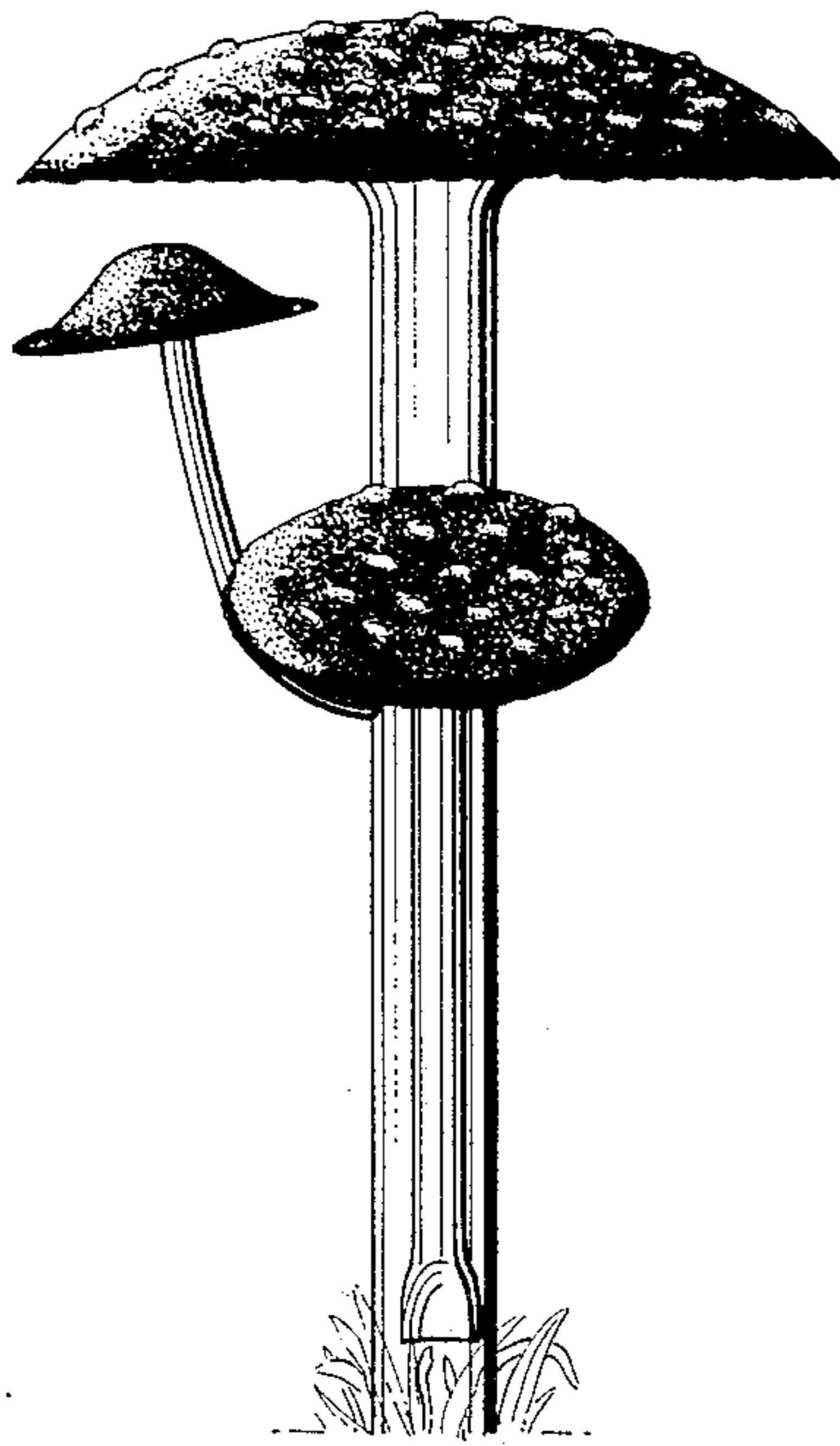

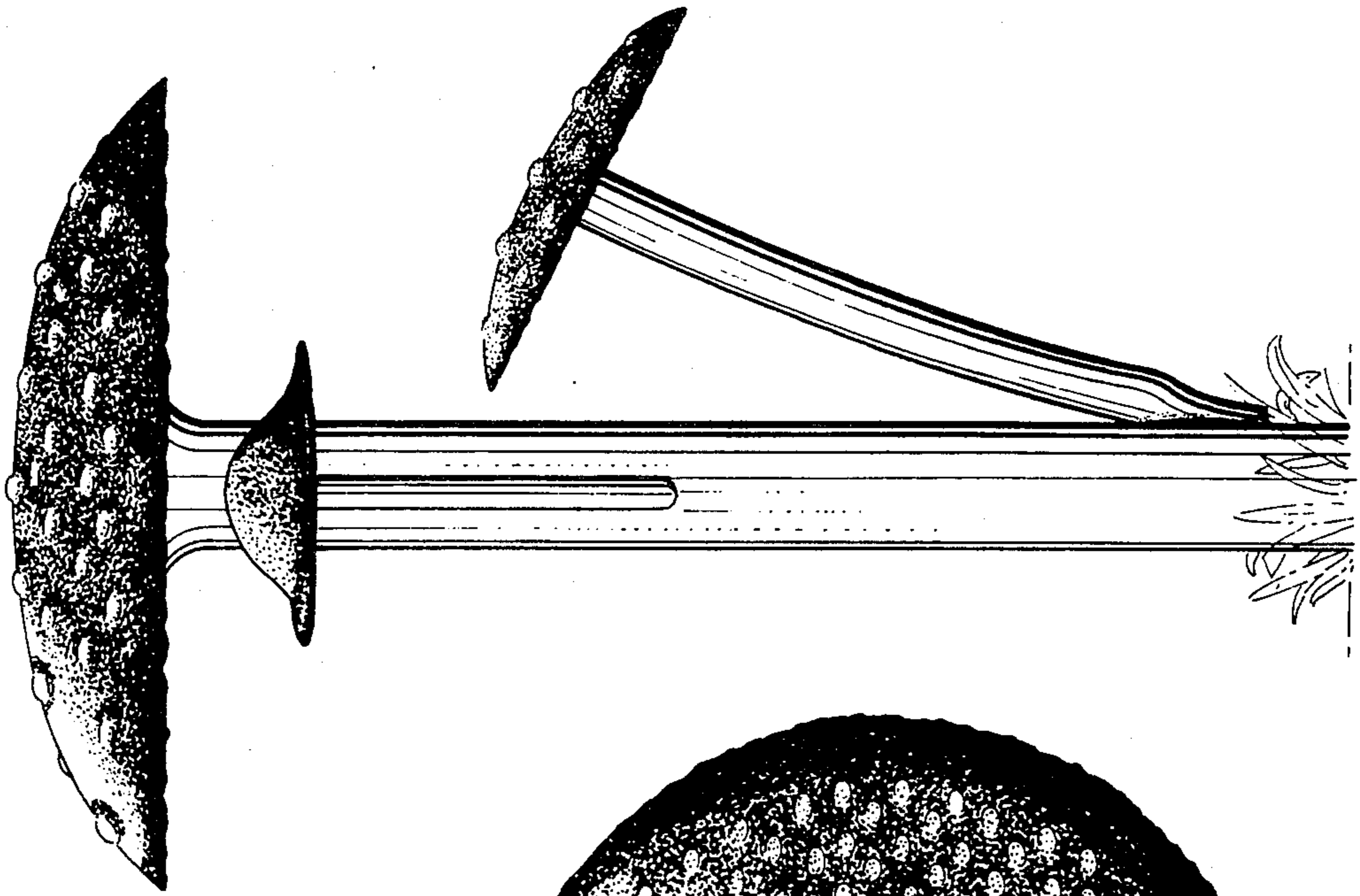

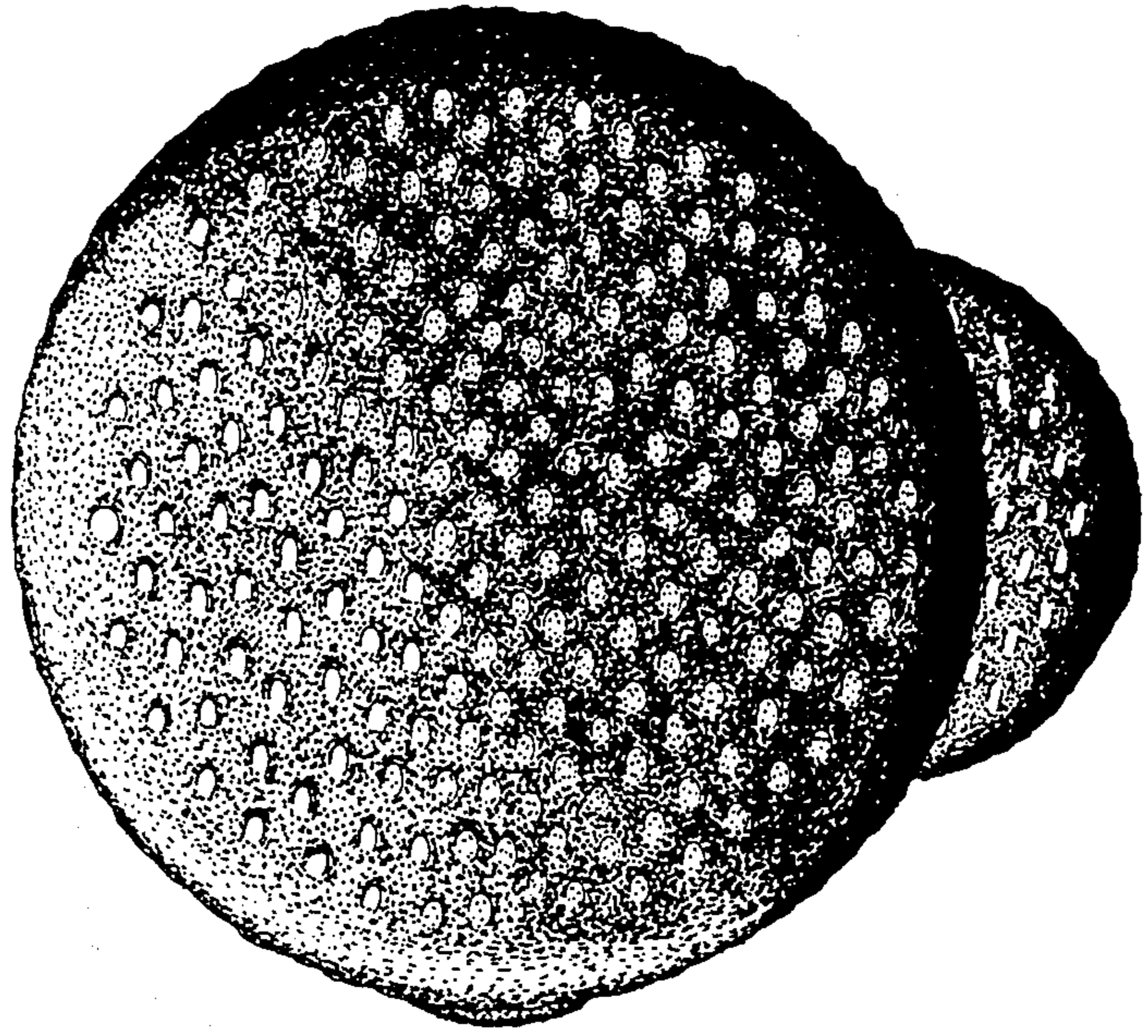
