[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a headlight cover for motorcycle fairing, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a headlight cover for motorcycle fairing, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

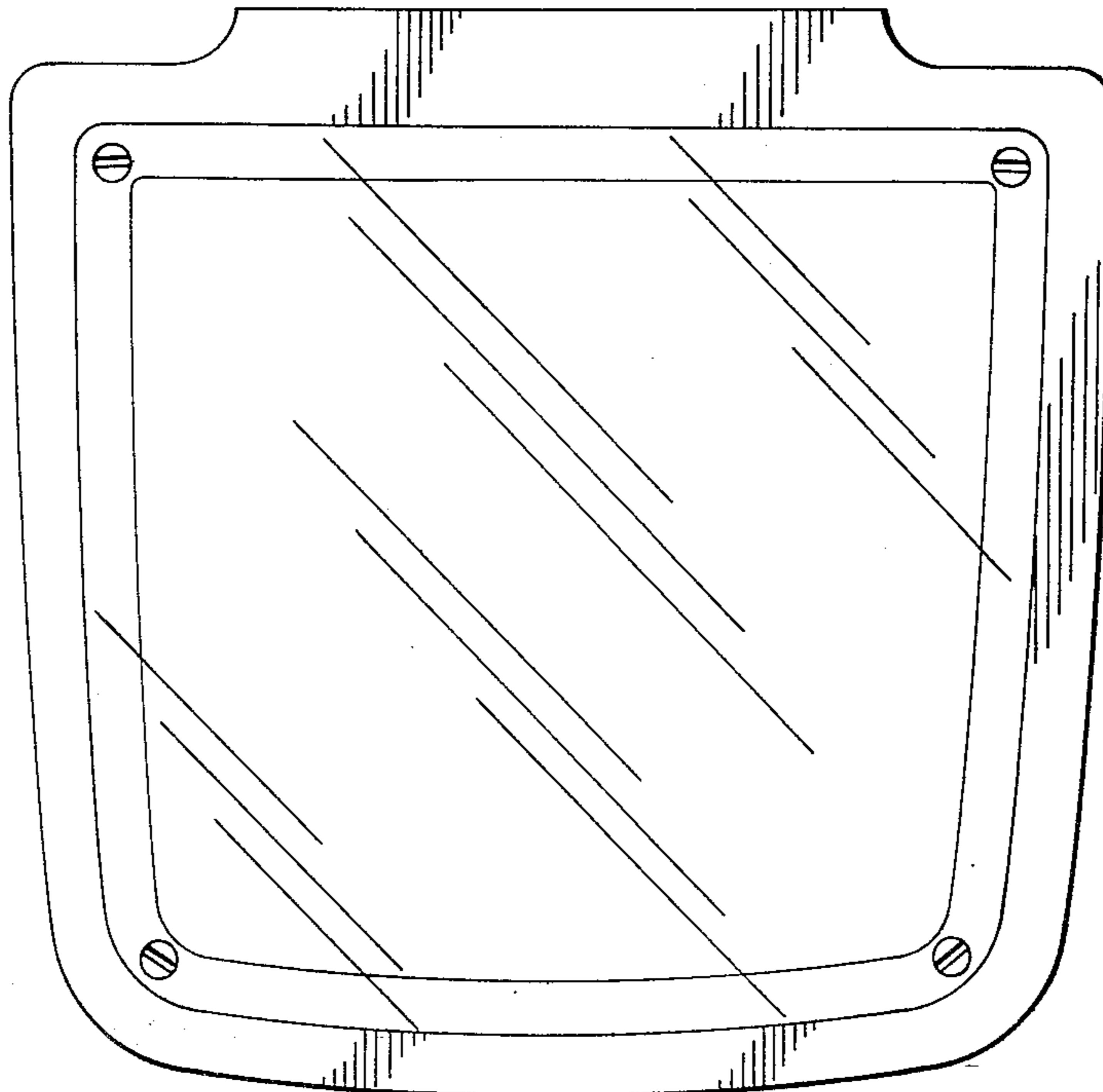

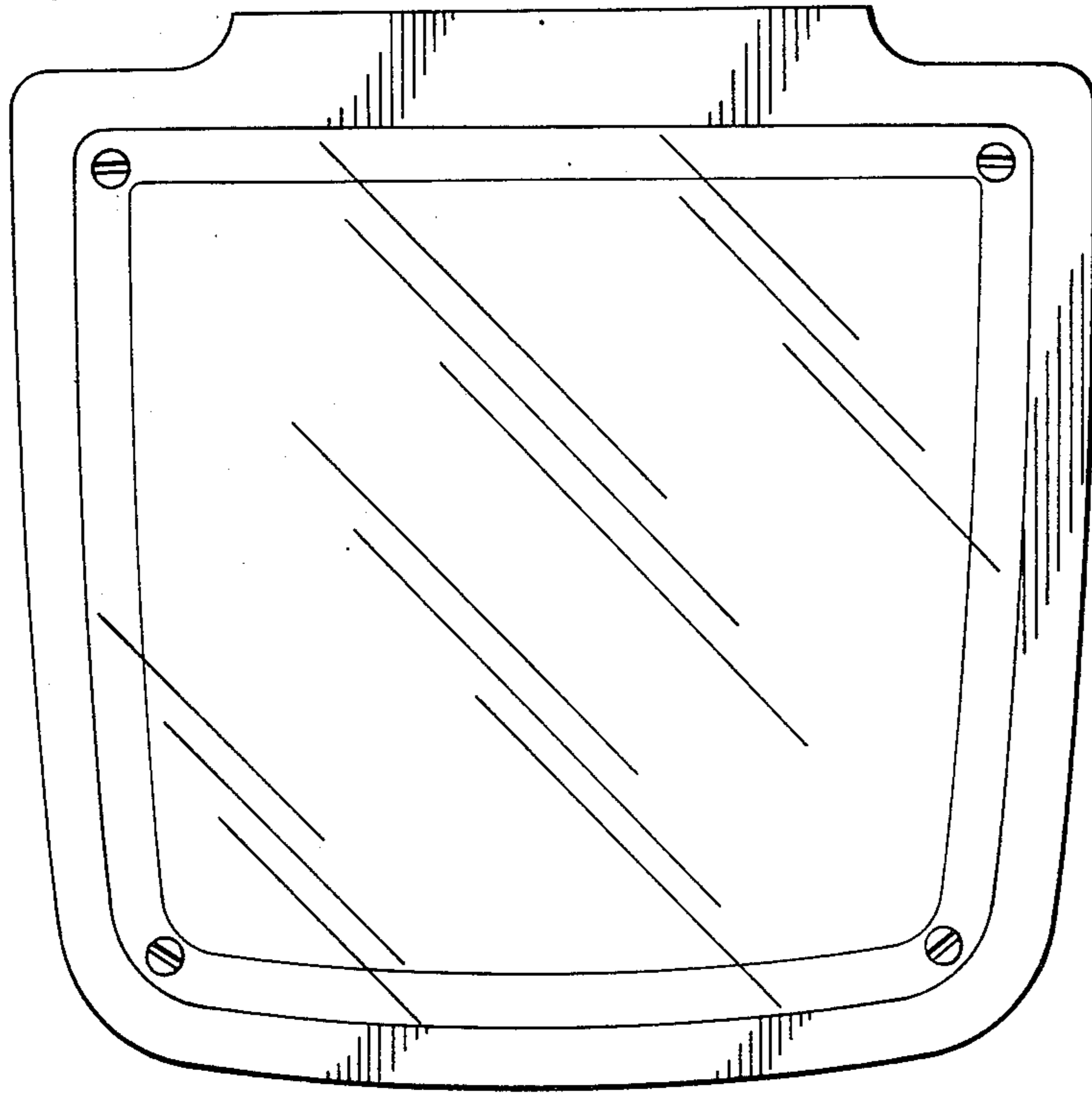

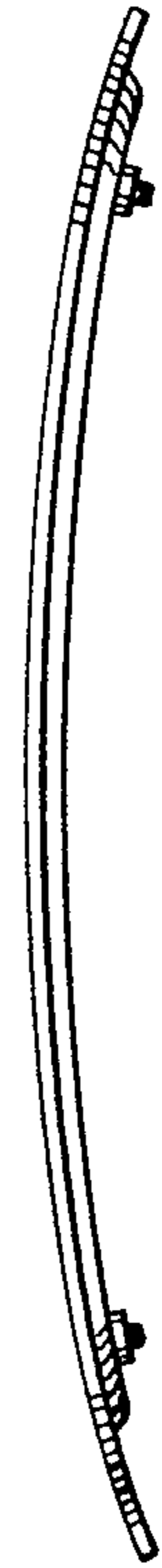

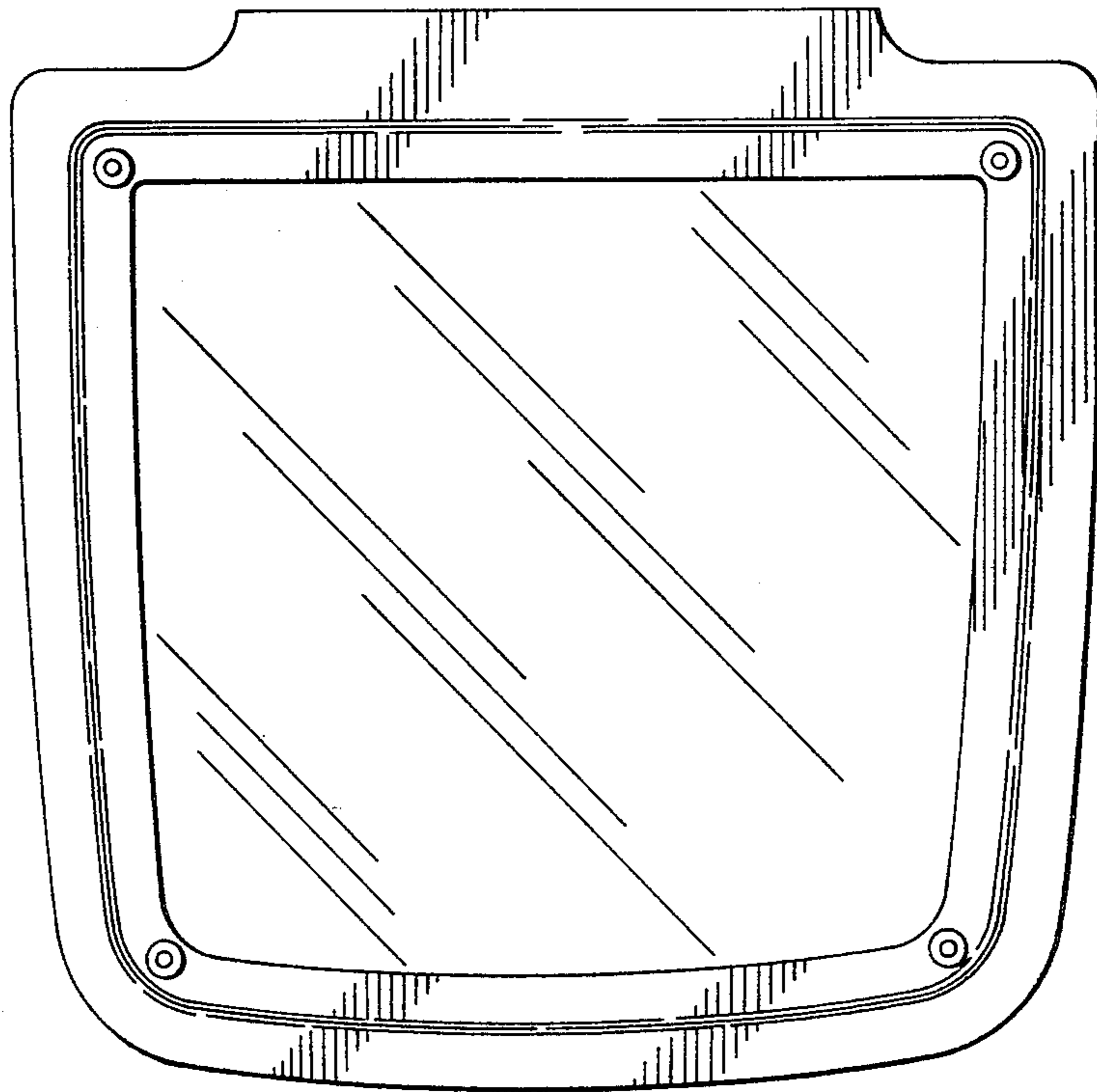

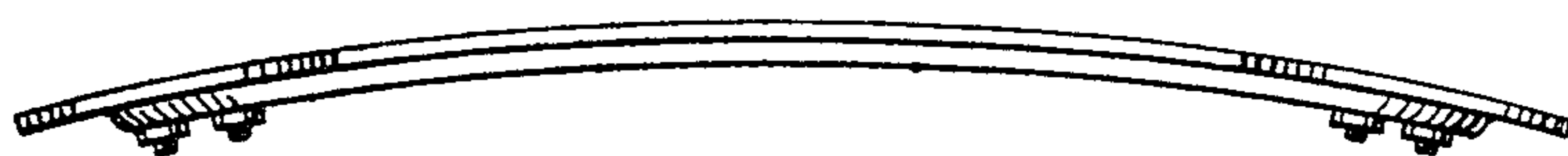
