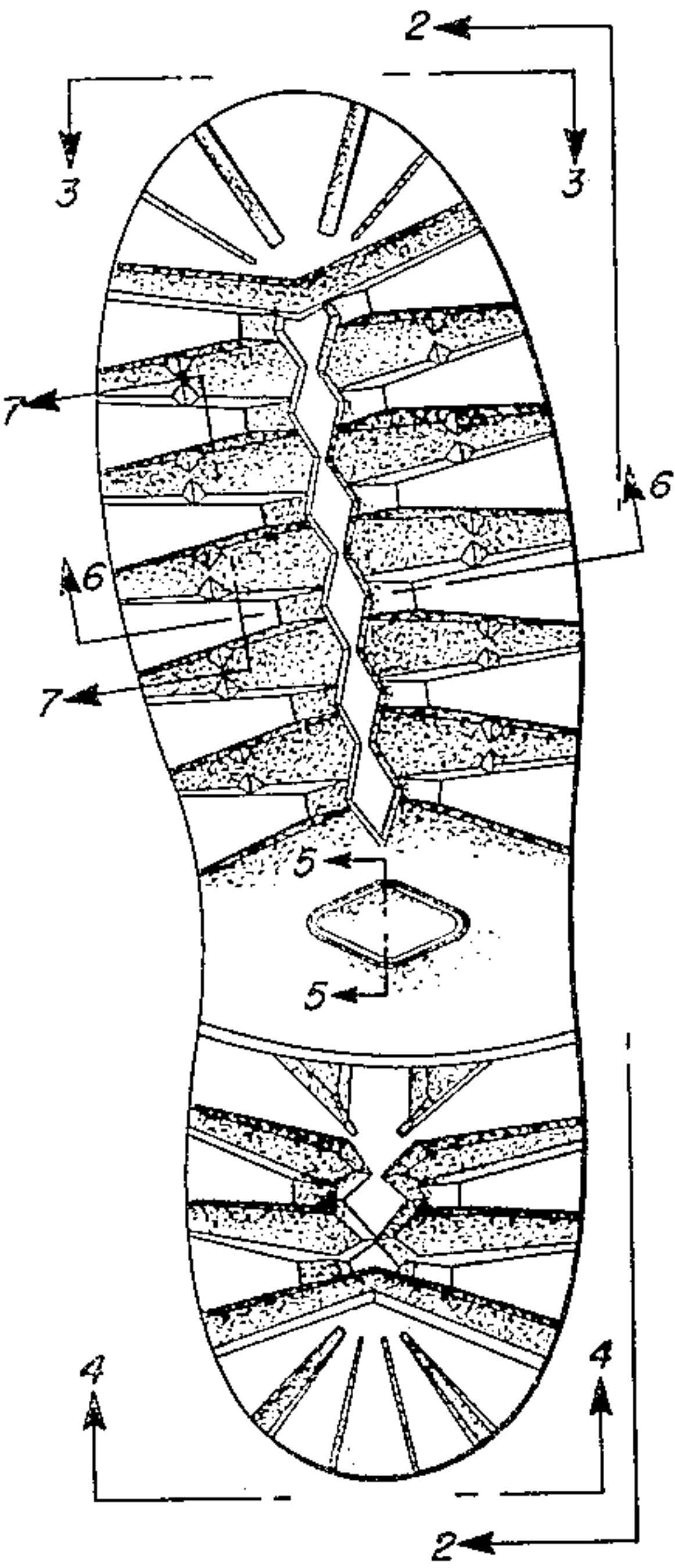

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shoe sole, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view as taken from line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view as taken from line 3—3 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view as taken from line 4—4 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view as taken from line 5—5 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view as taken from line 6—6 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view as taken from line 7—7 of FIG. 1.



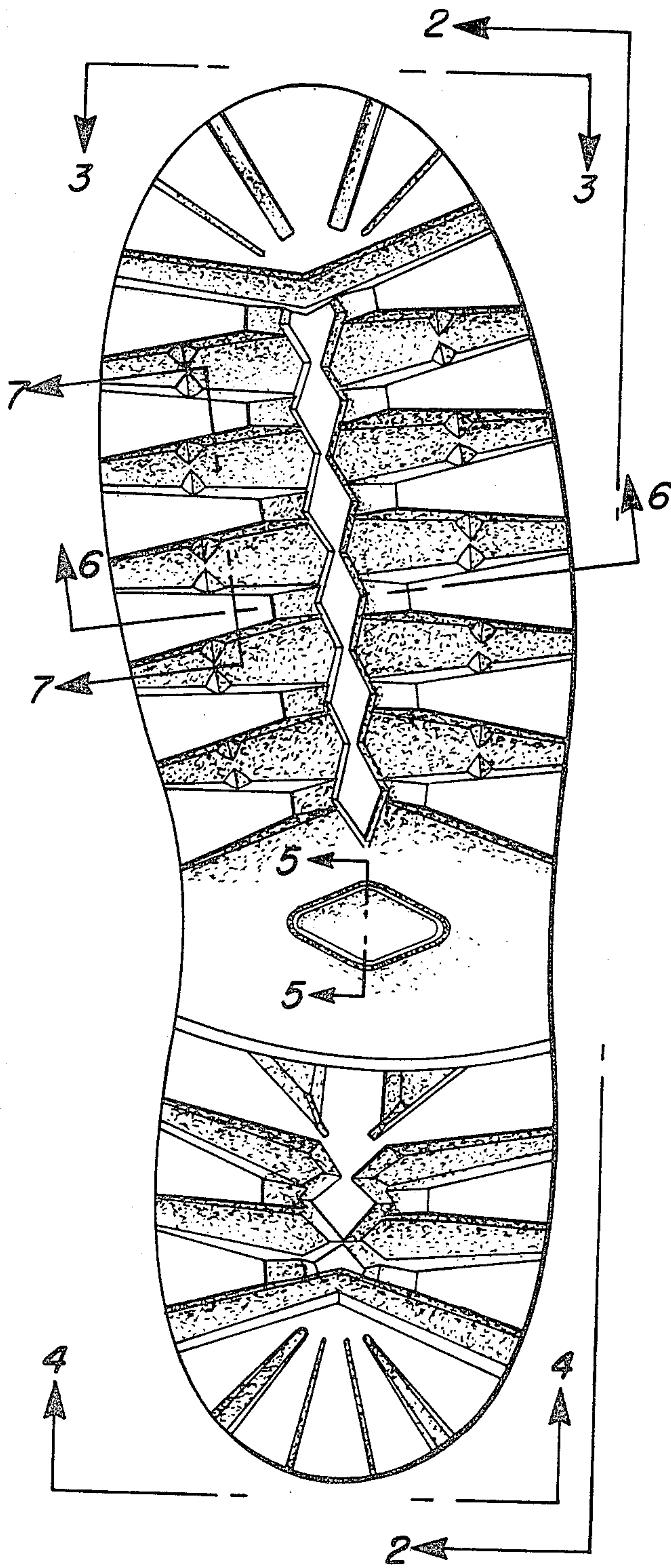

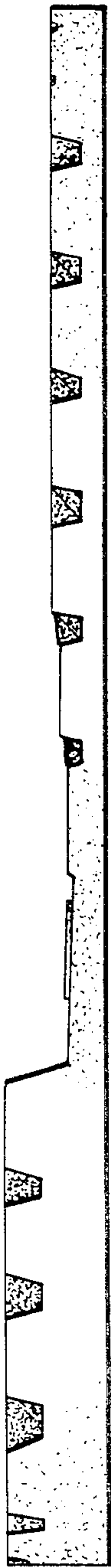

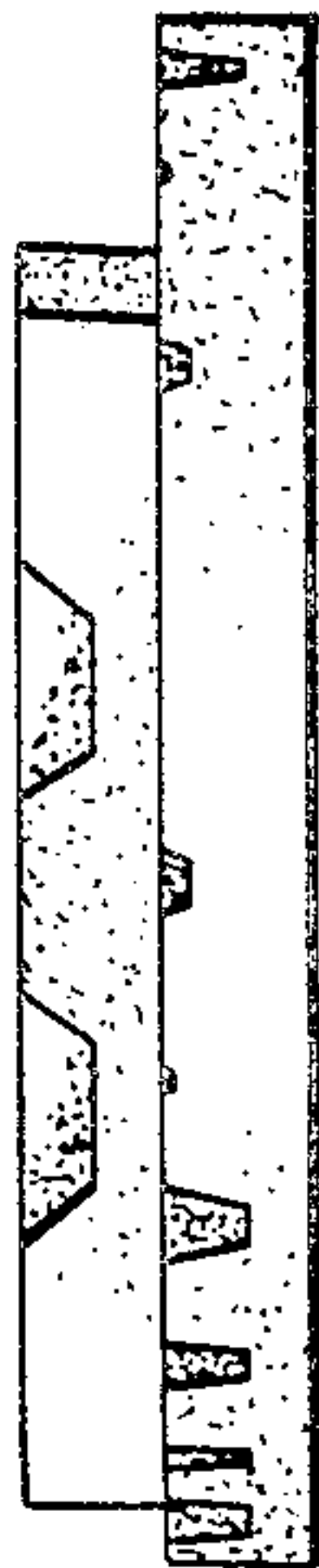

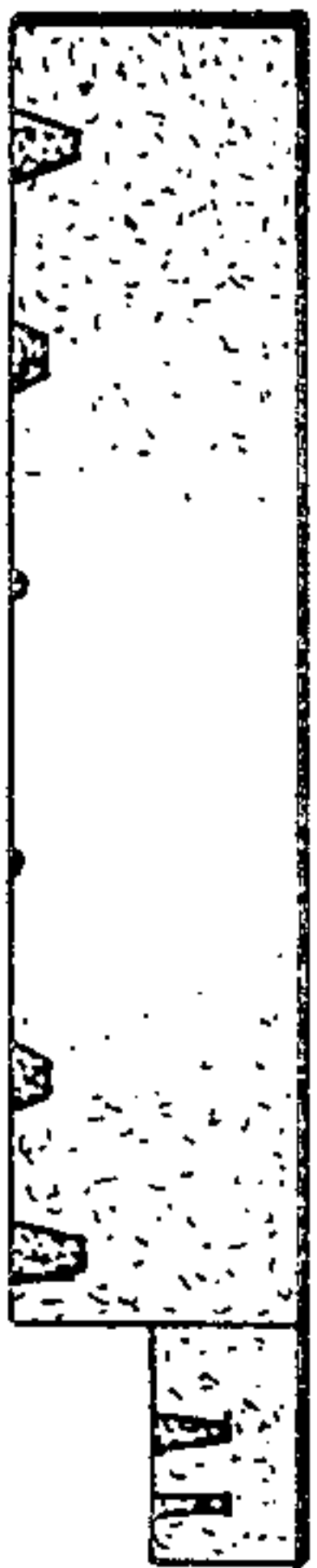
