DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a needlework frame showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a right end elevation thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

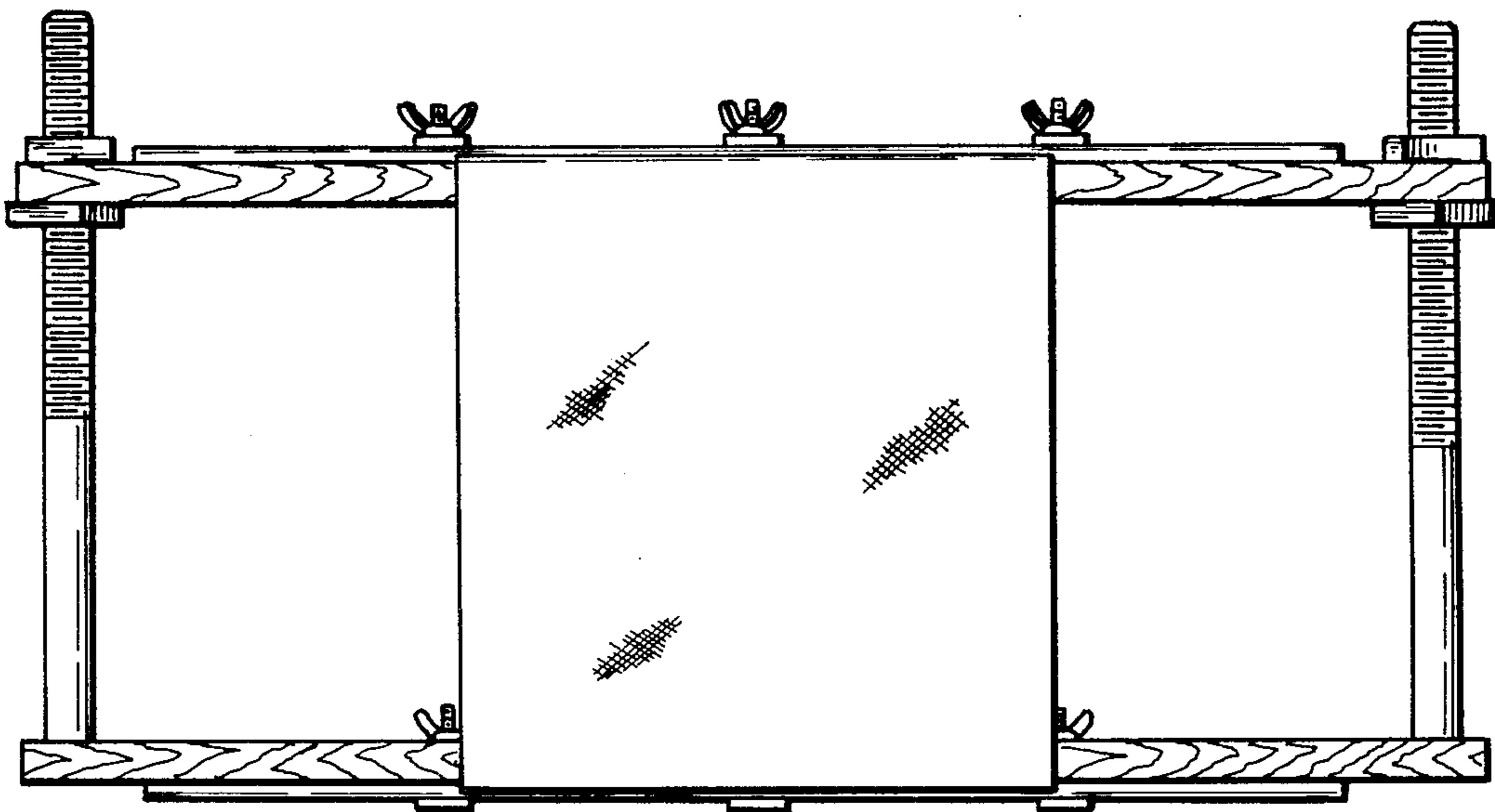

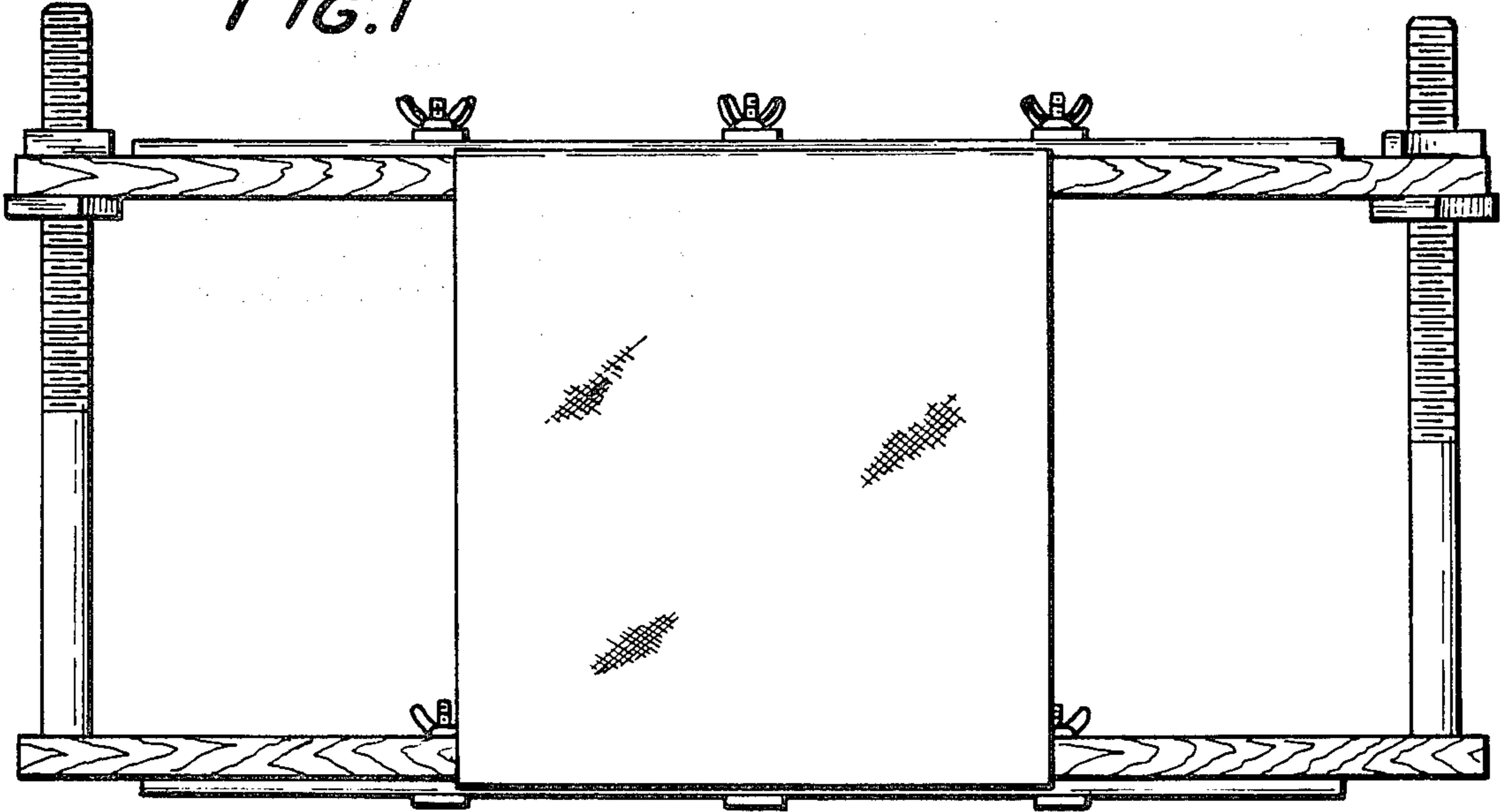

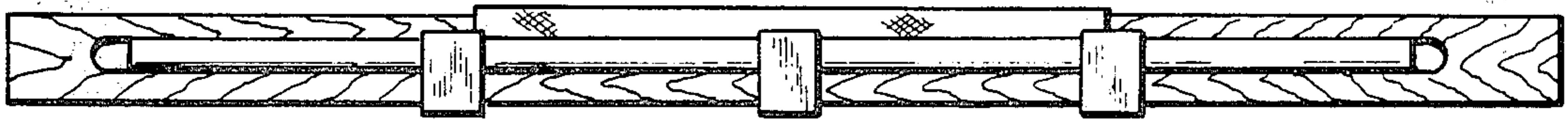

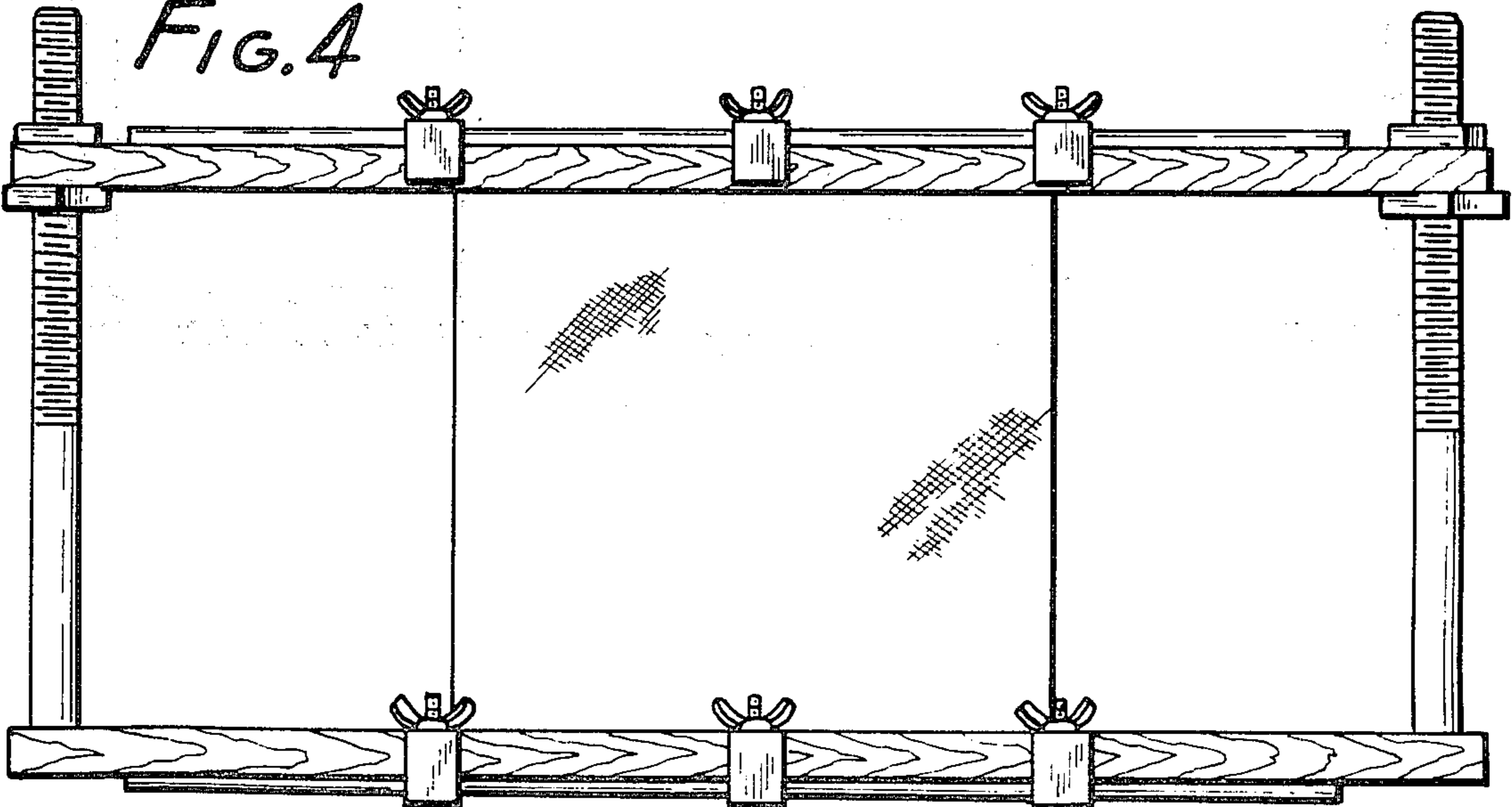
