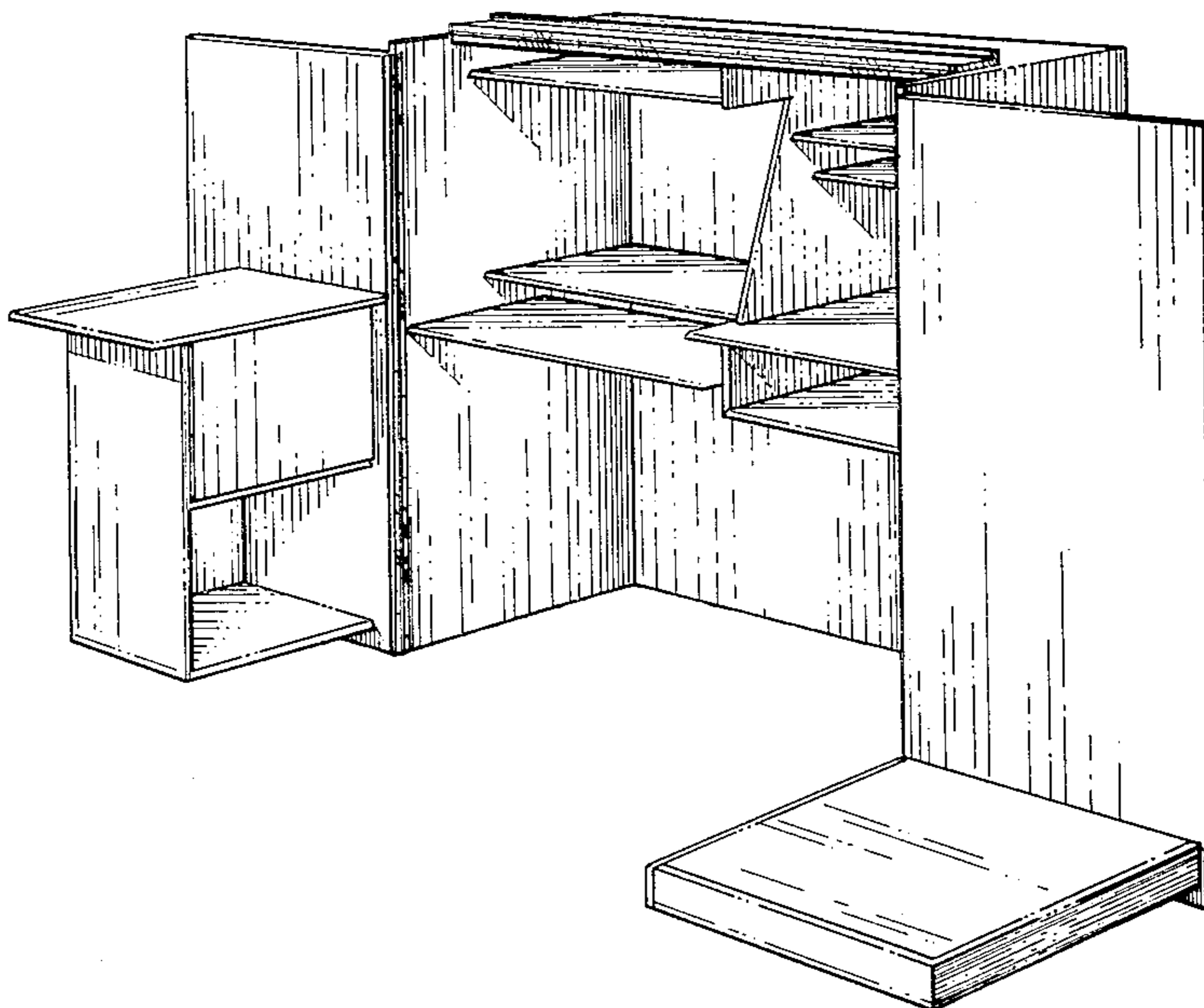
CLAIM

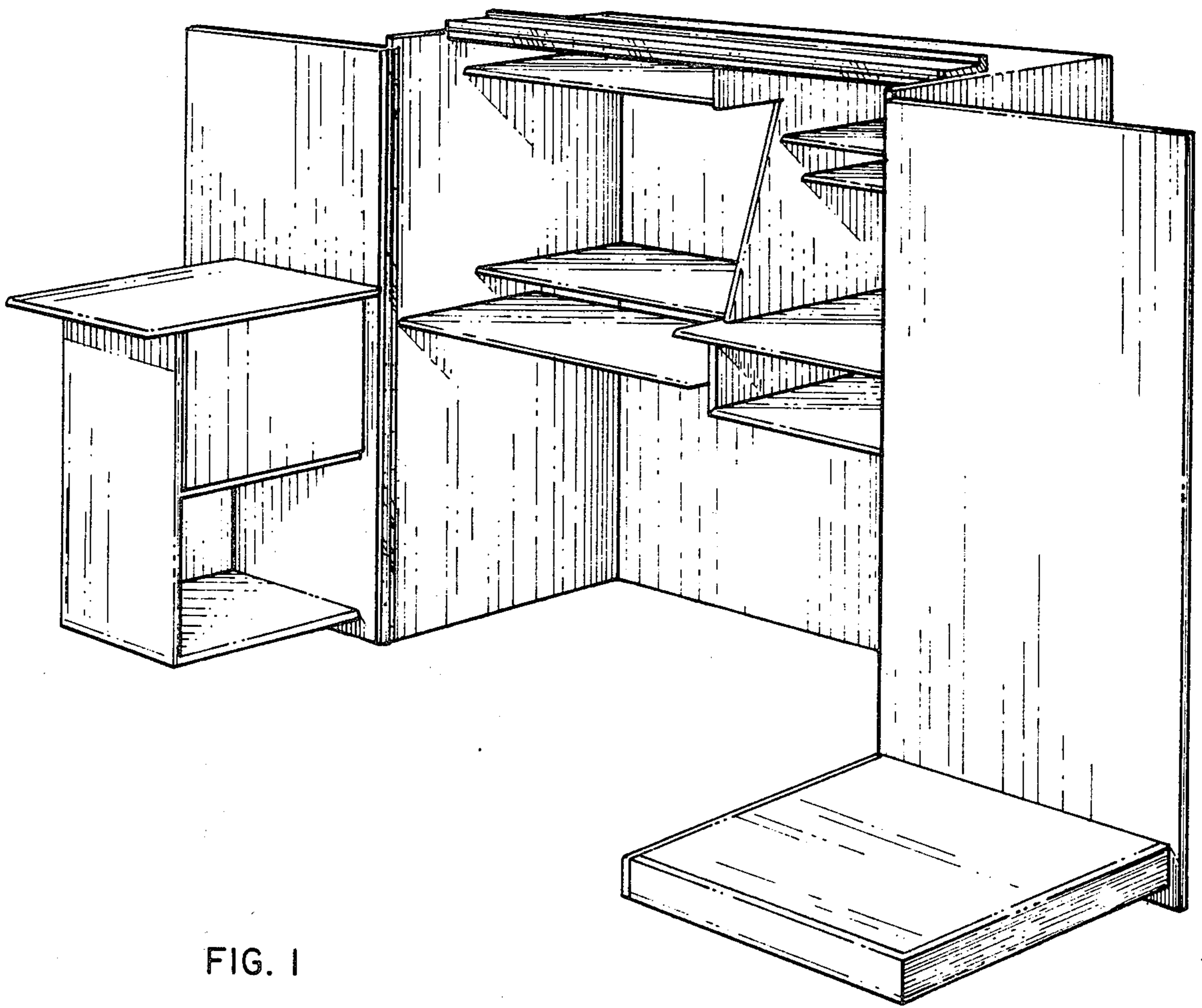

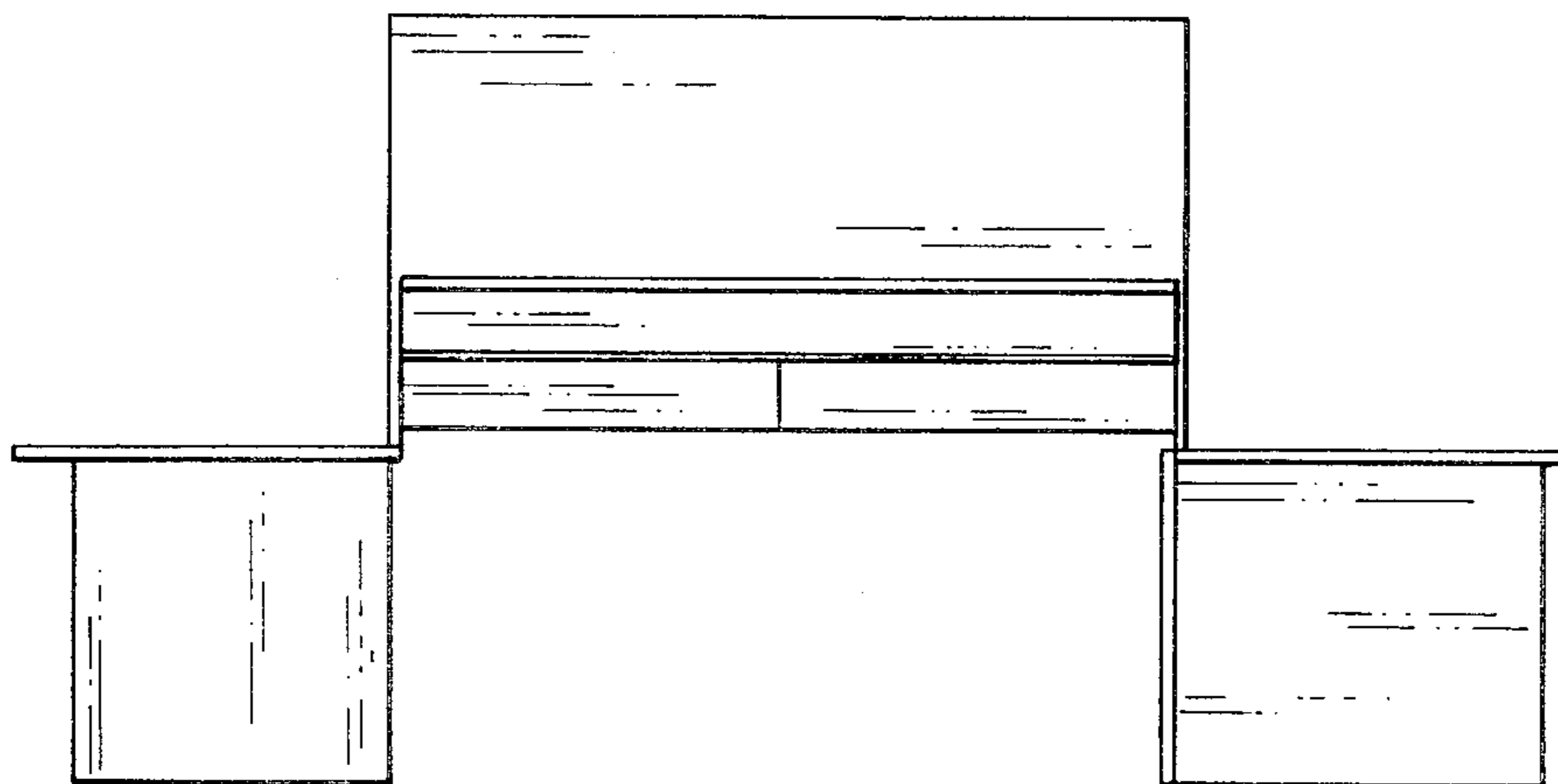

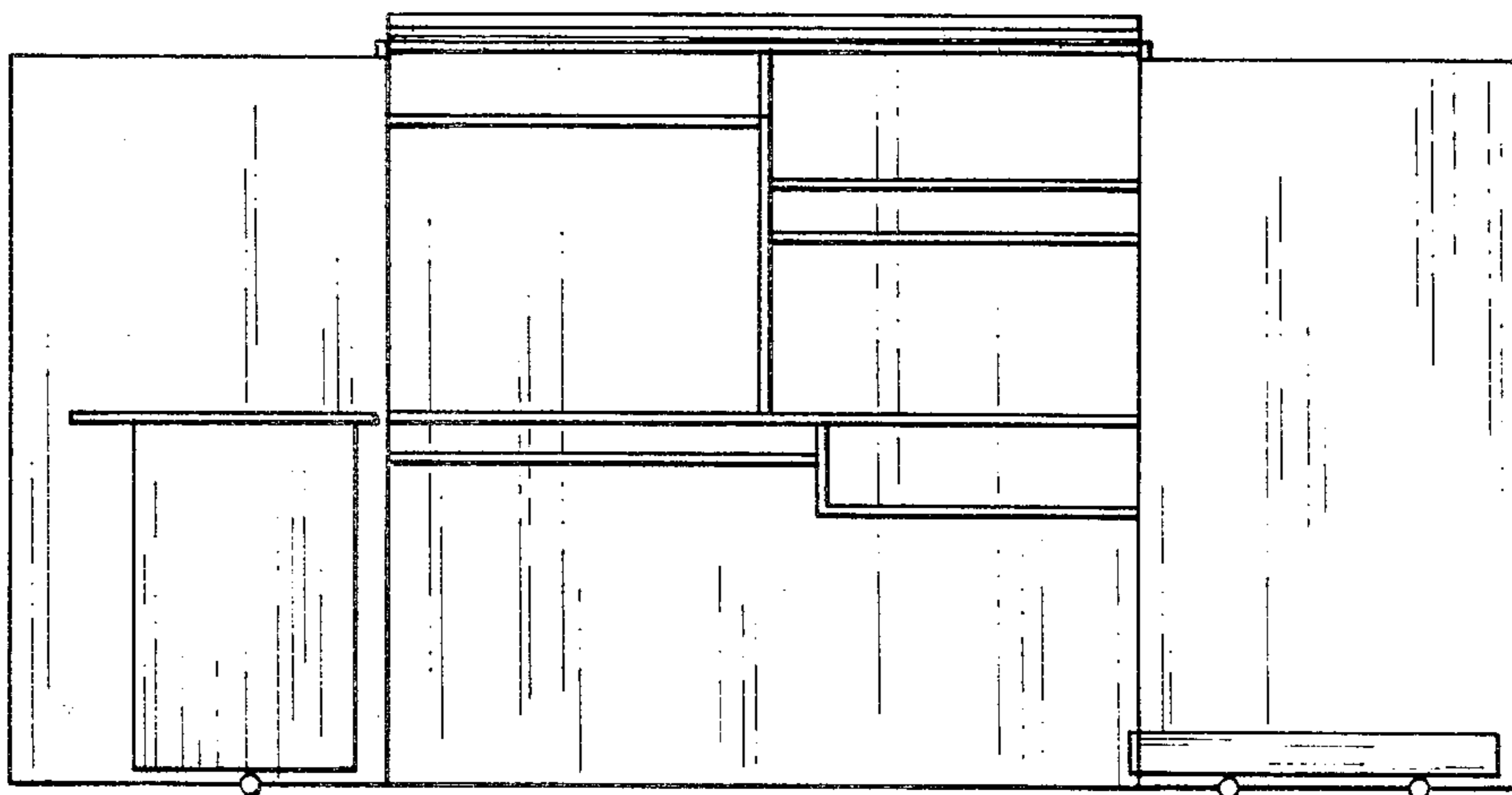

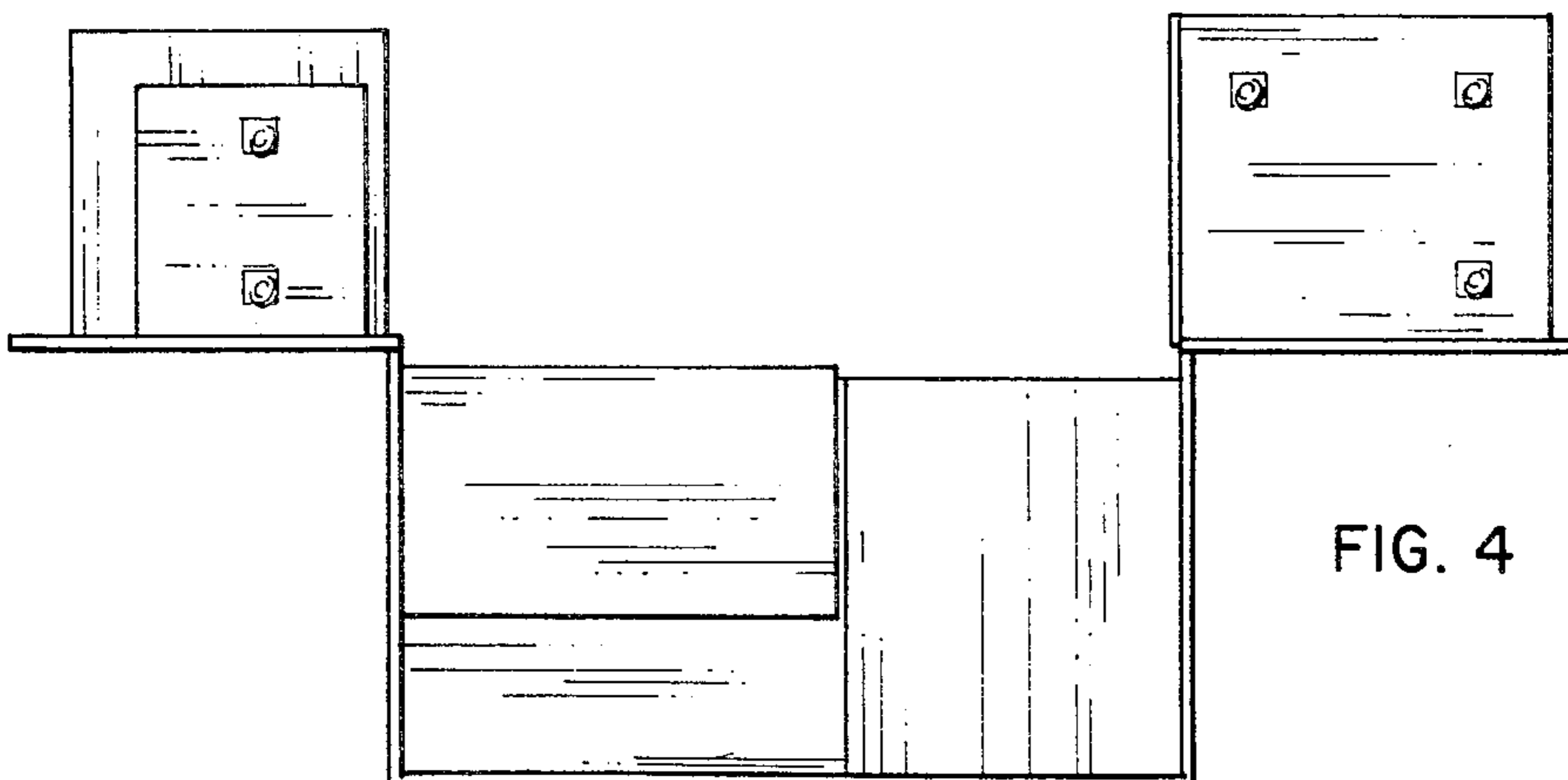

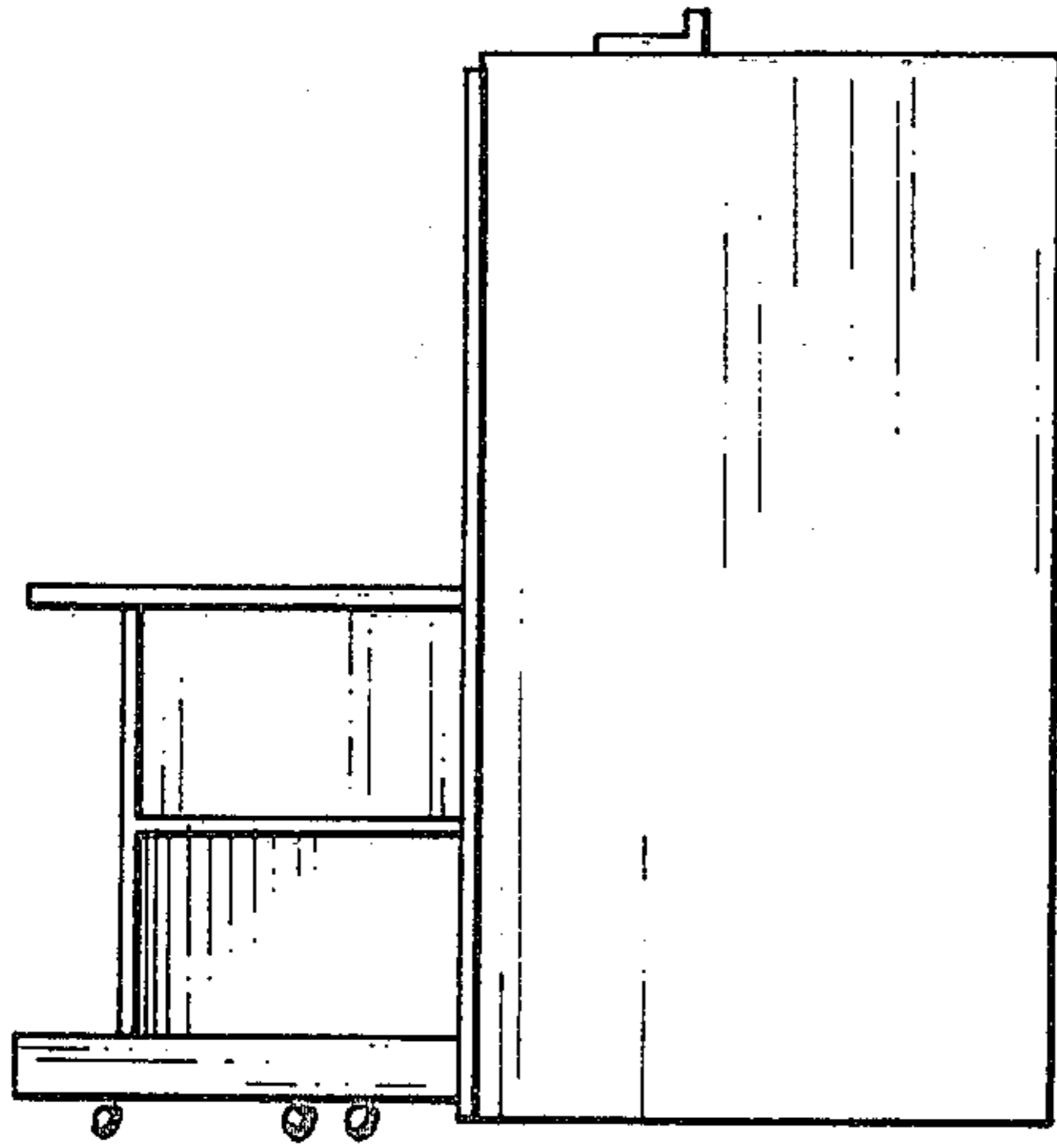

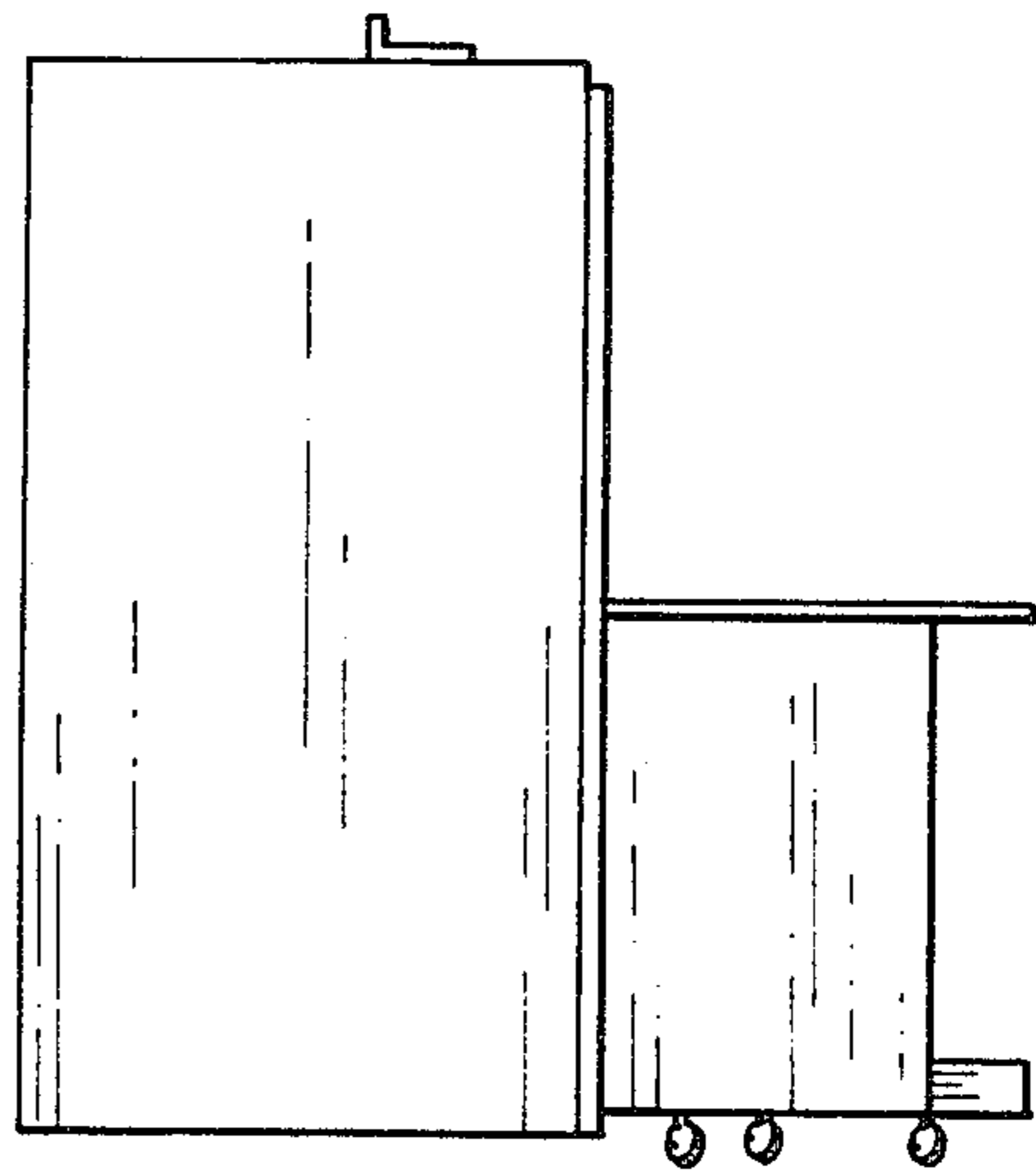

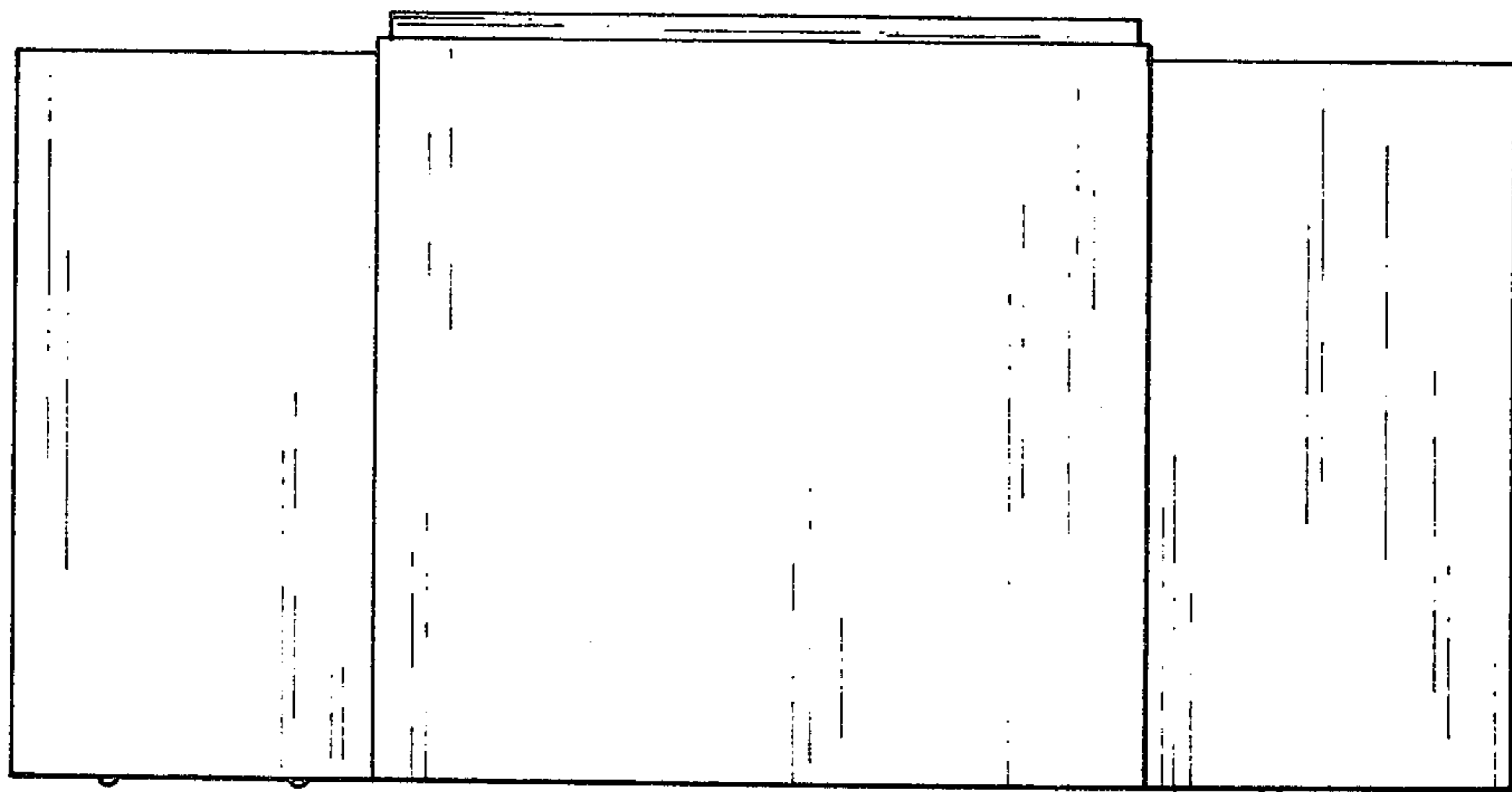
