FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a holder for elongated objects showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

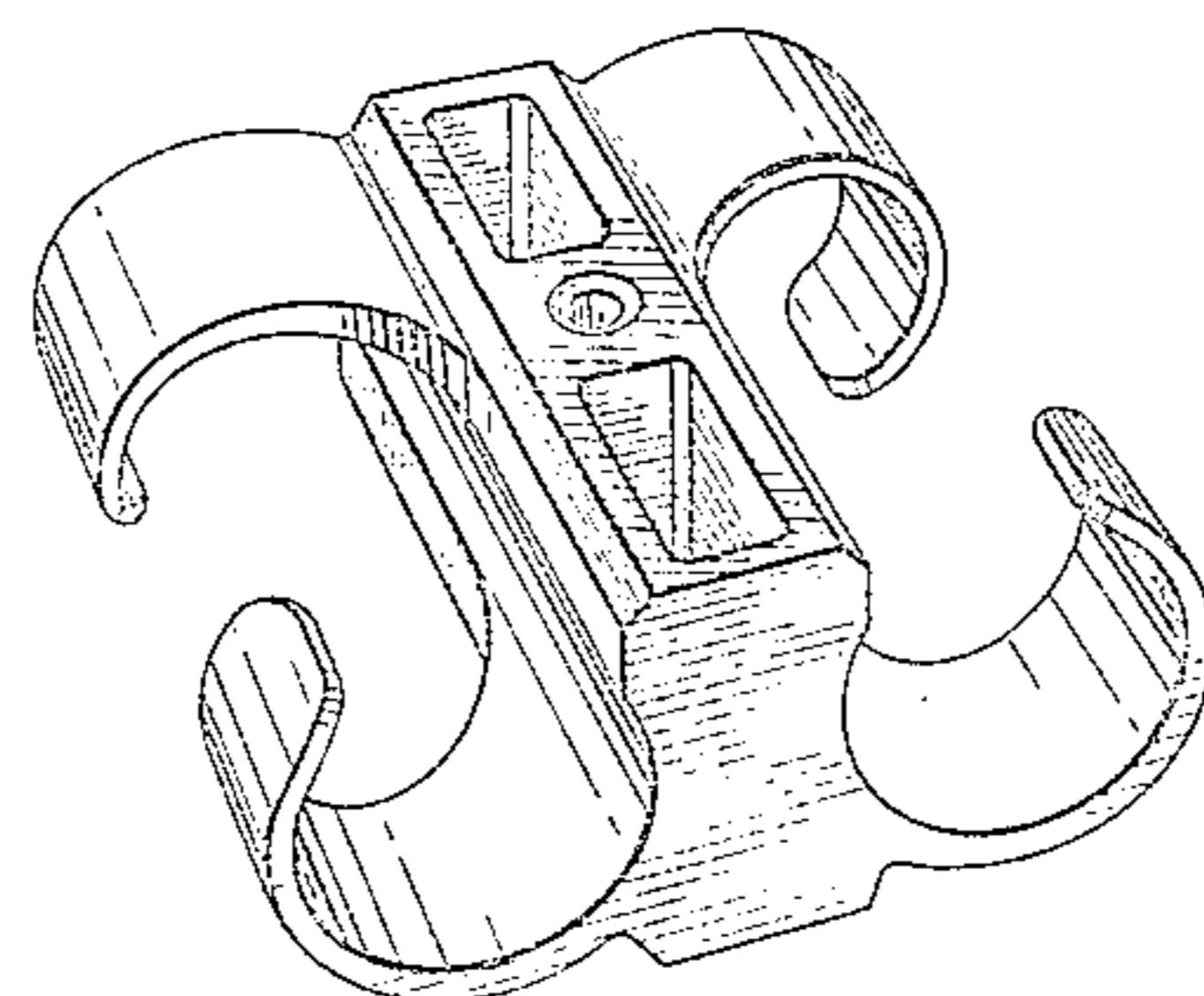
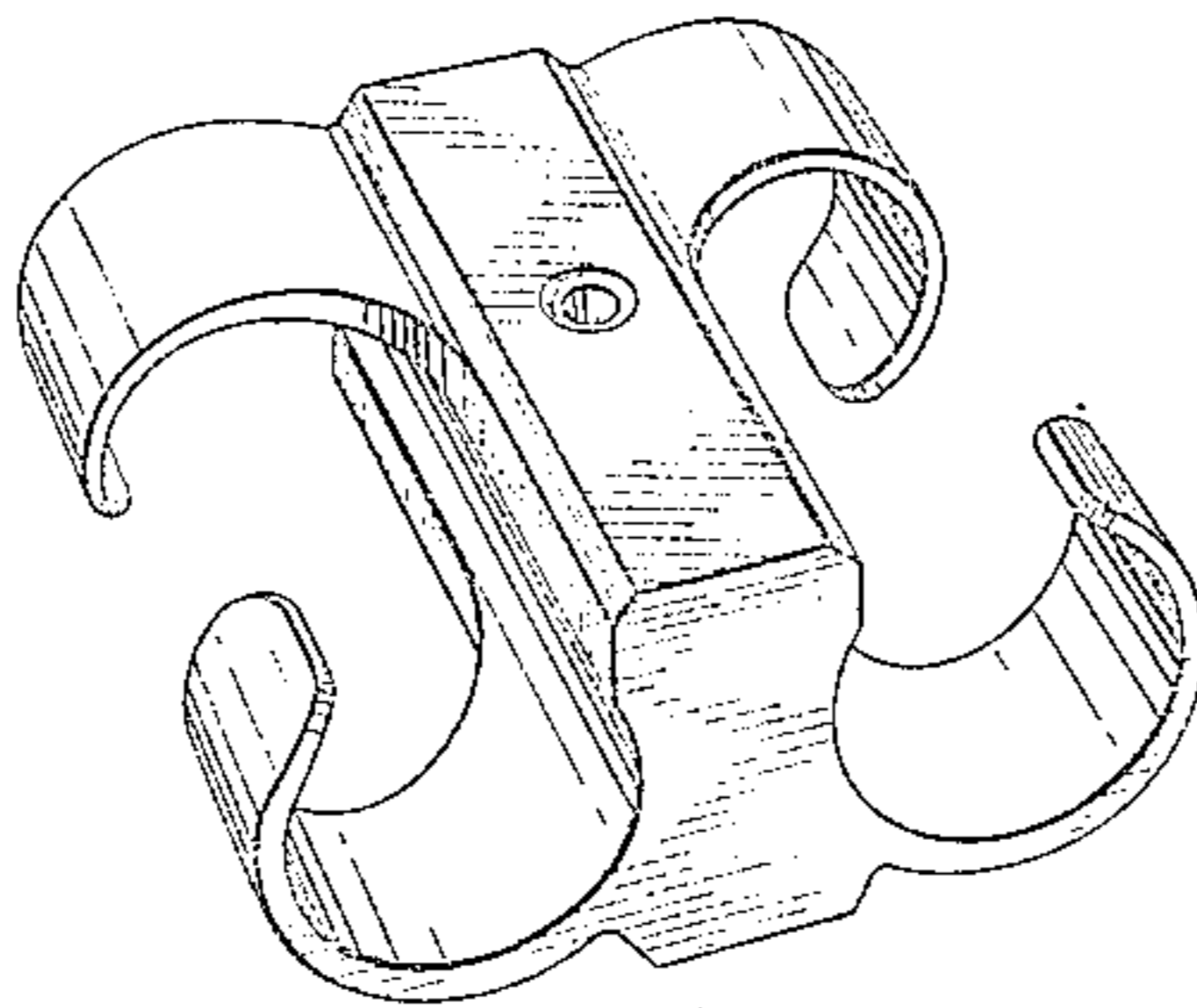

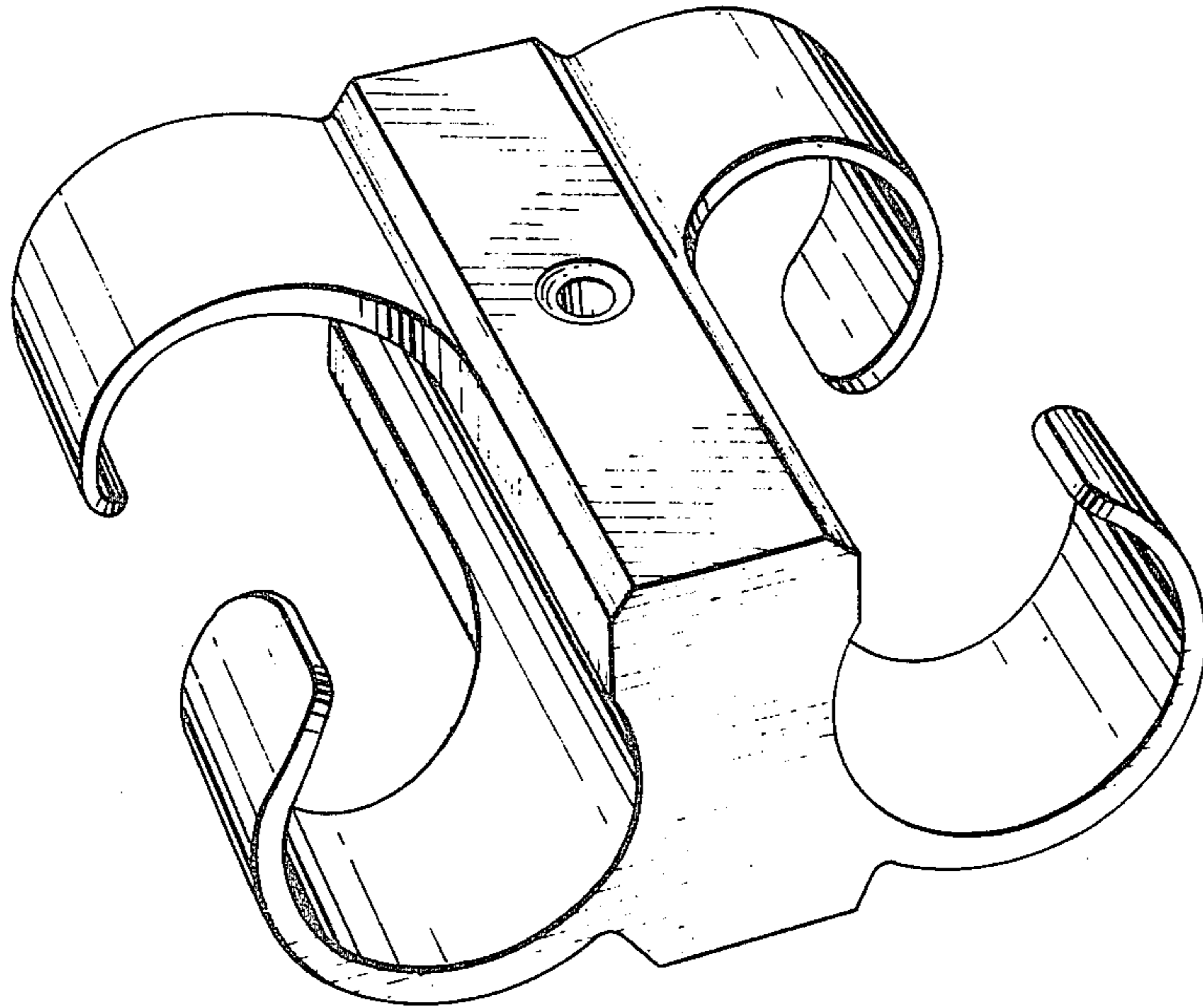
