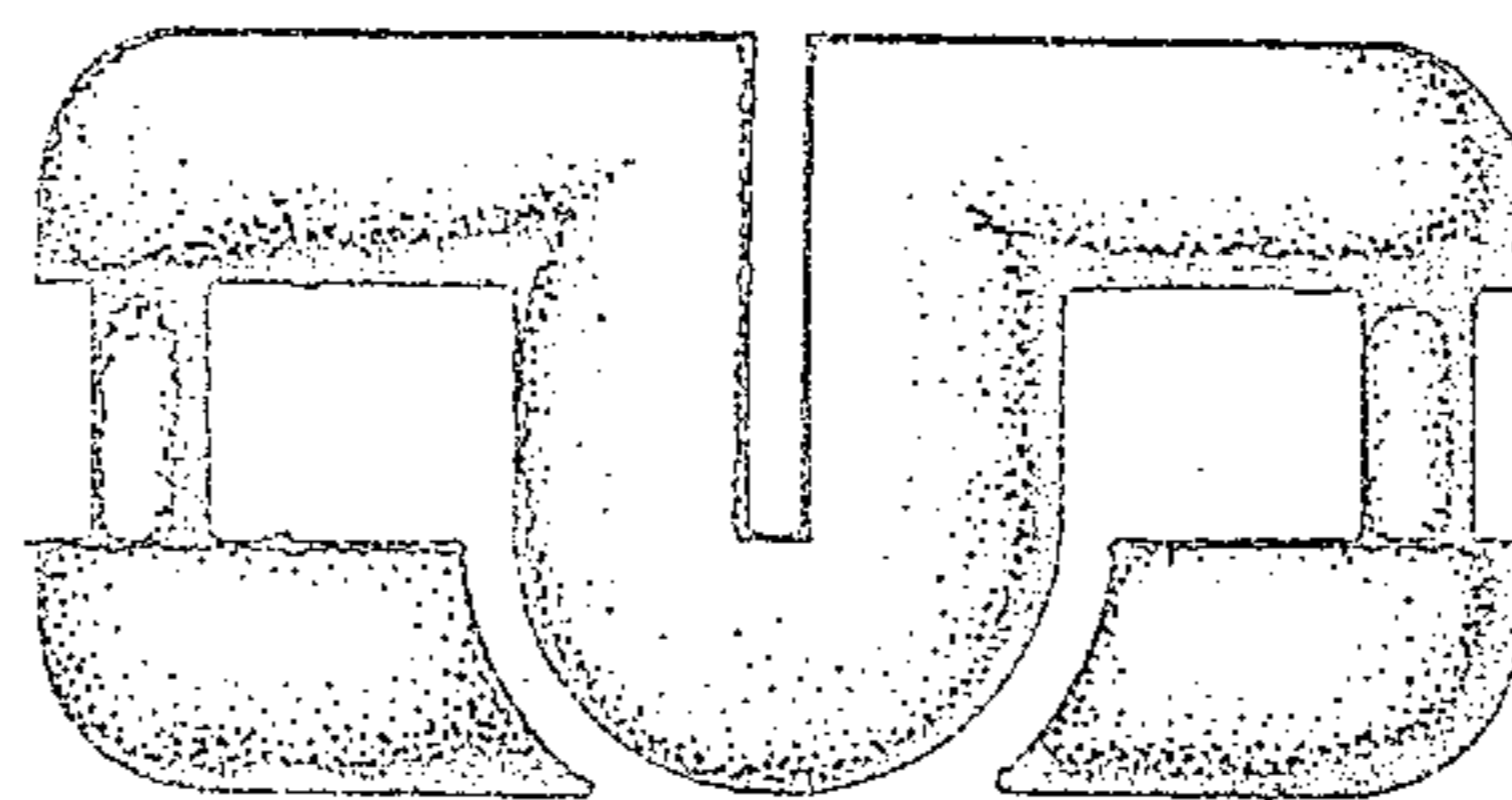
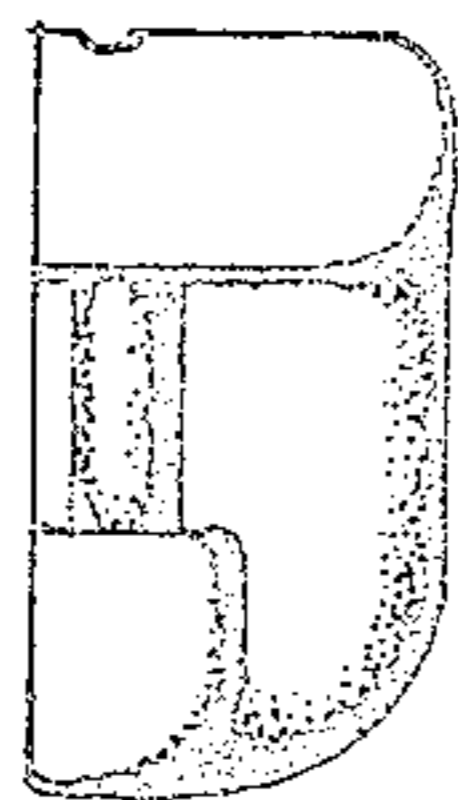

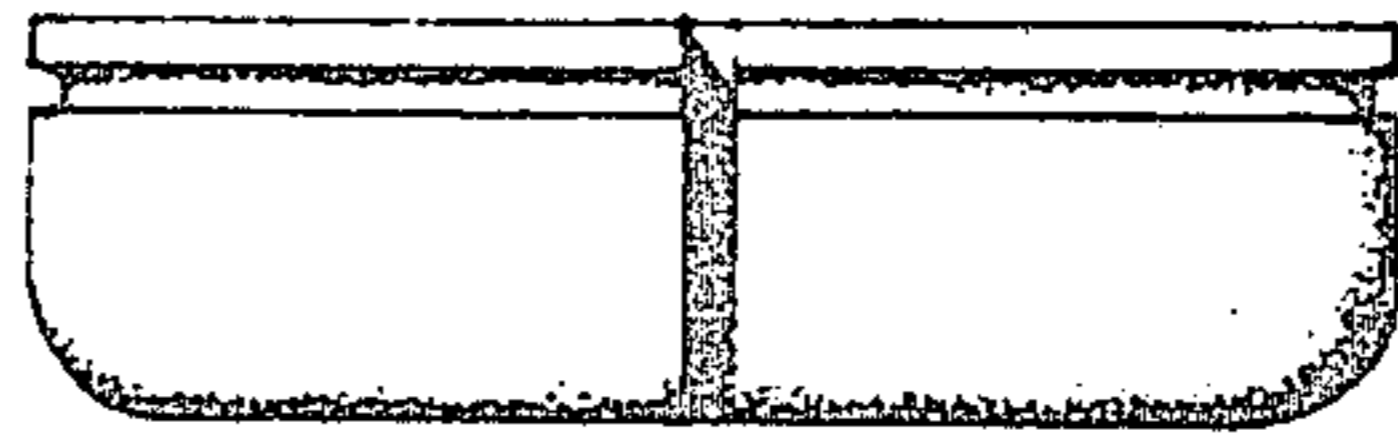
The ornamental design for a link for jewelry chain,

DESCRIPTION

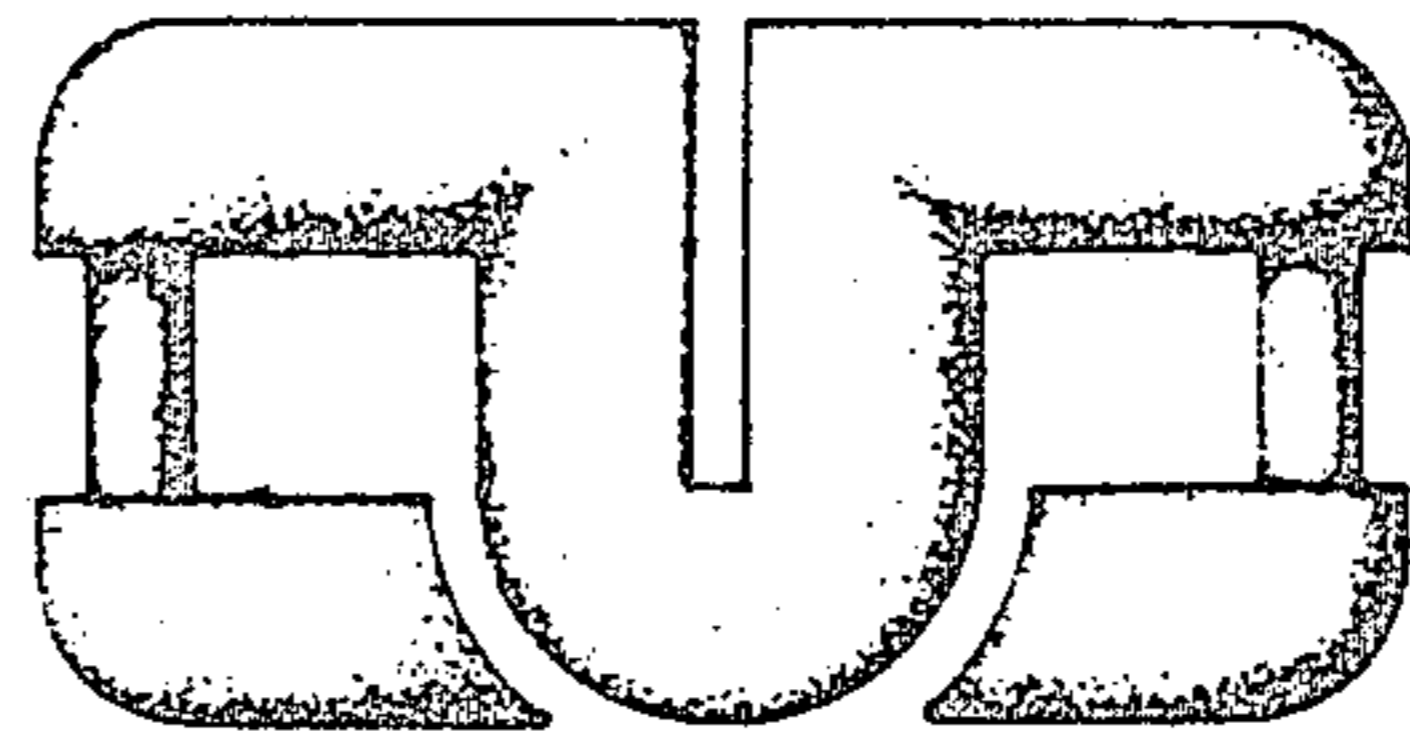
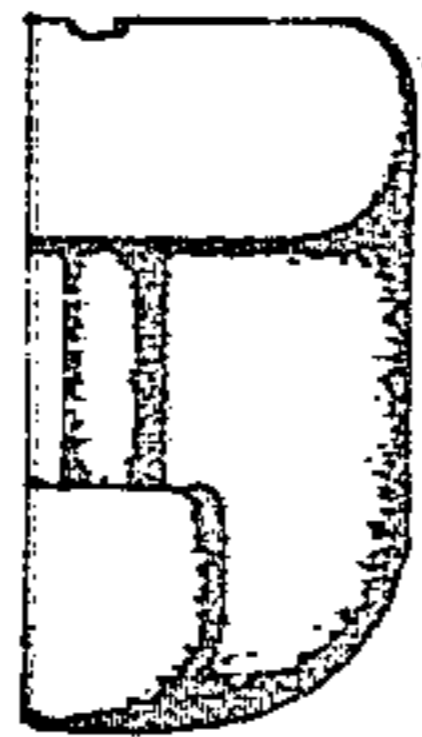
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a link for jewelry chain

a mirror image.



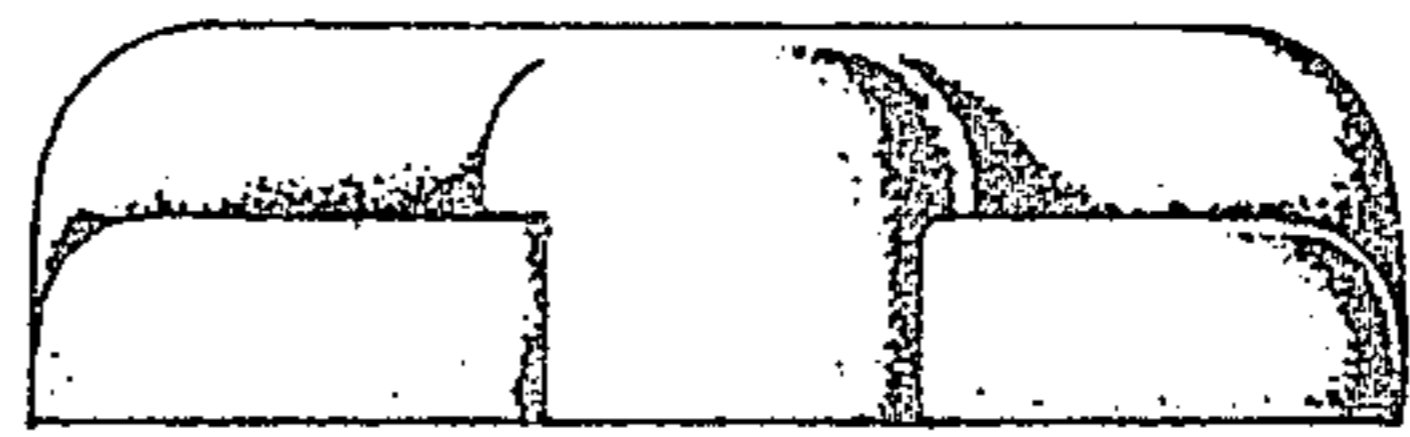
