FIG. 7 is a view like FIG. 1 thereof with the door open.

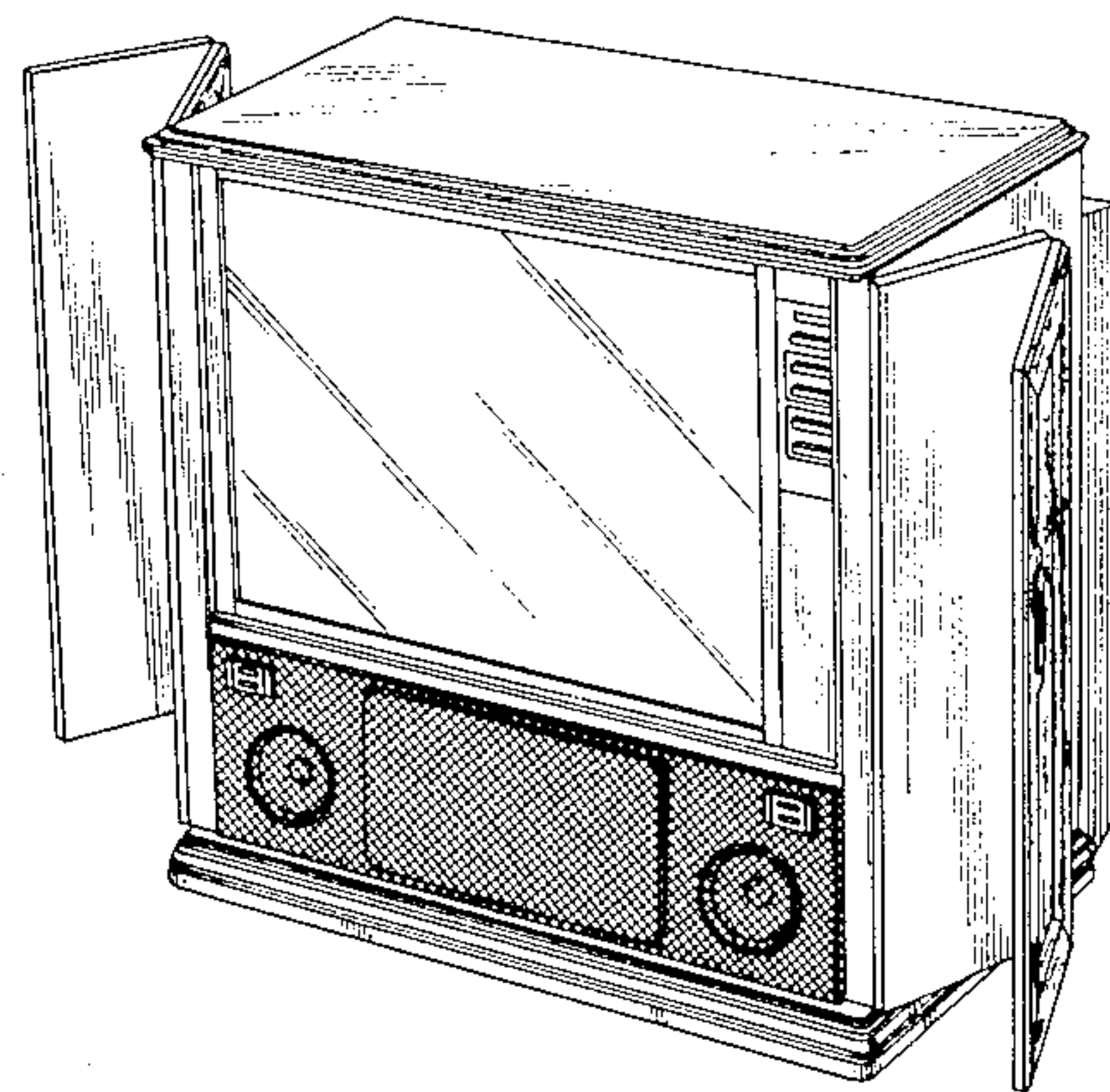
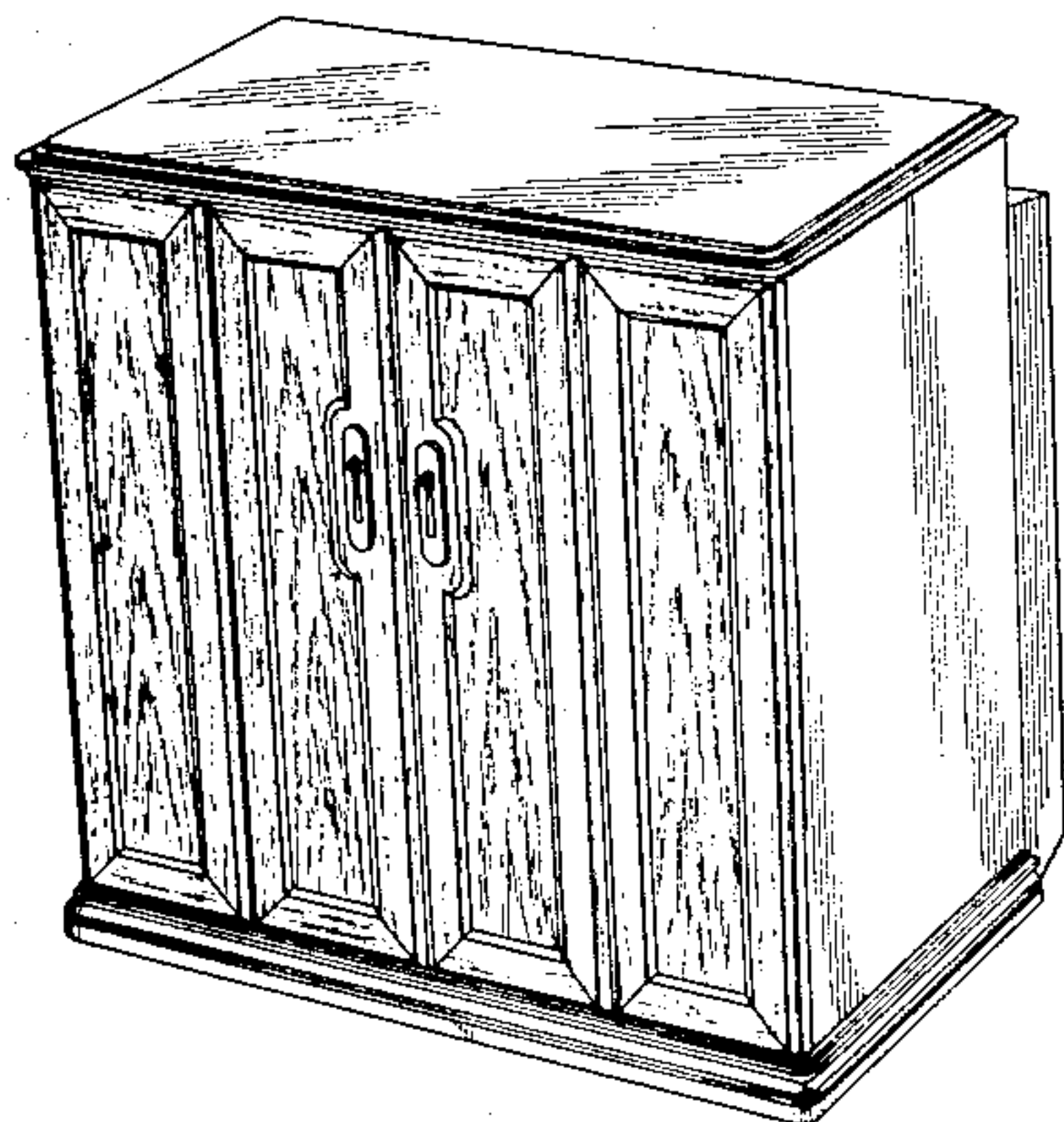

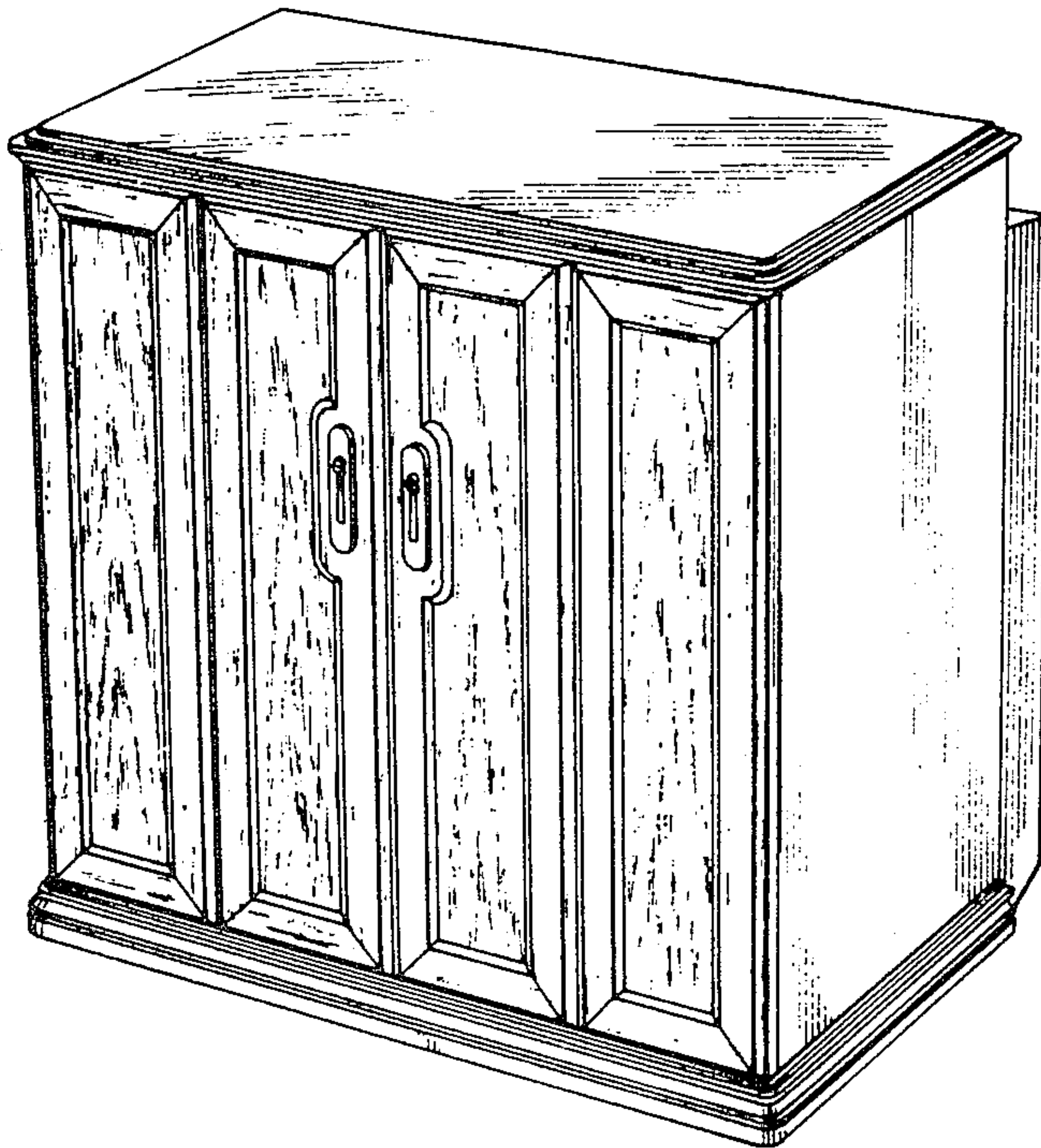

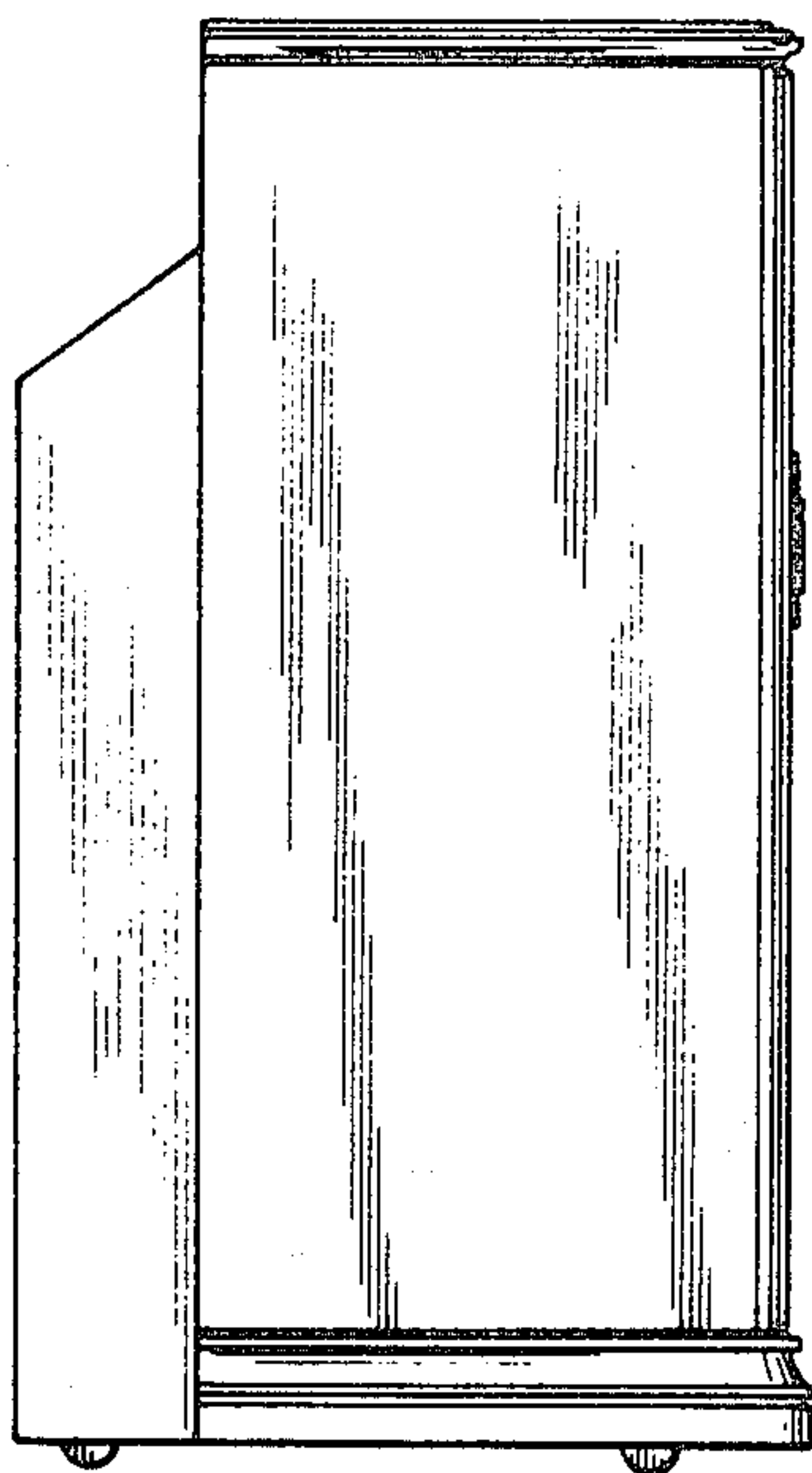

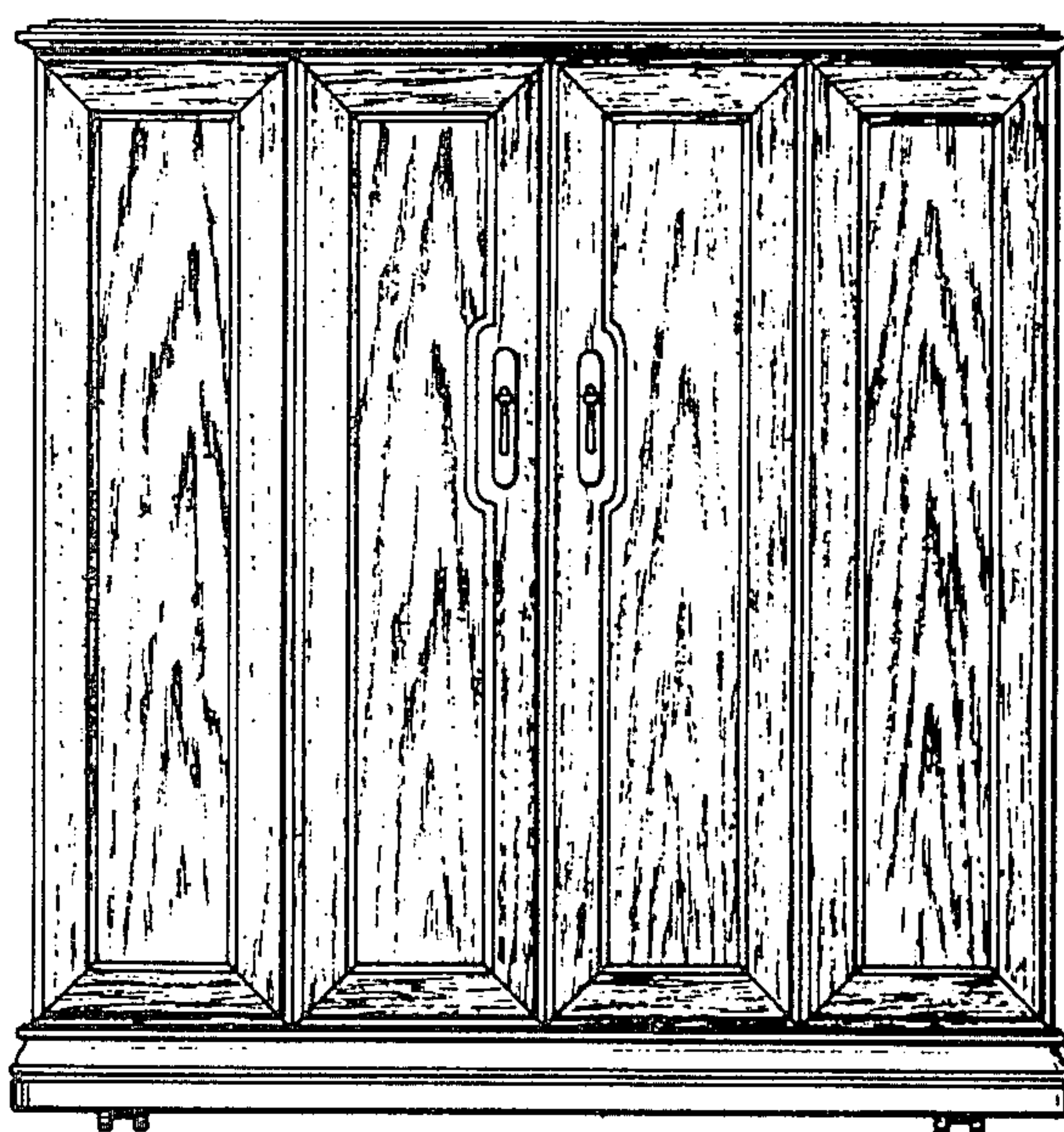

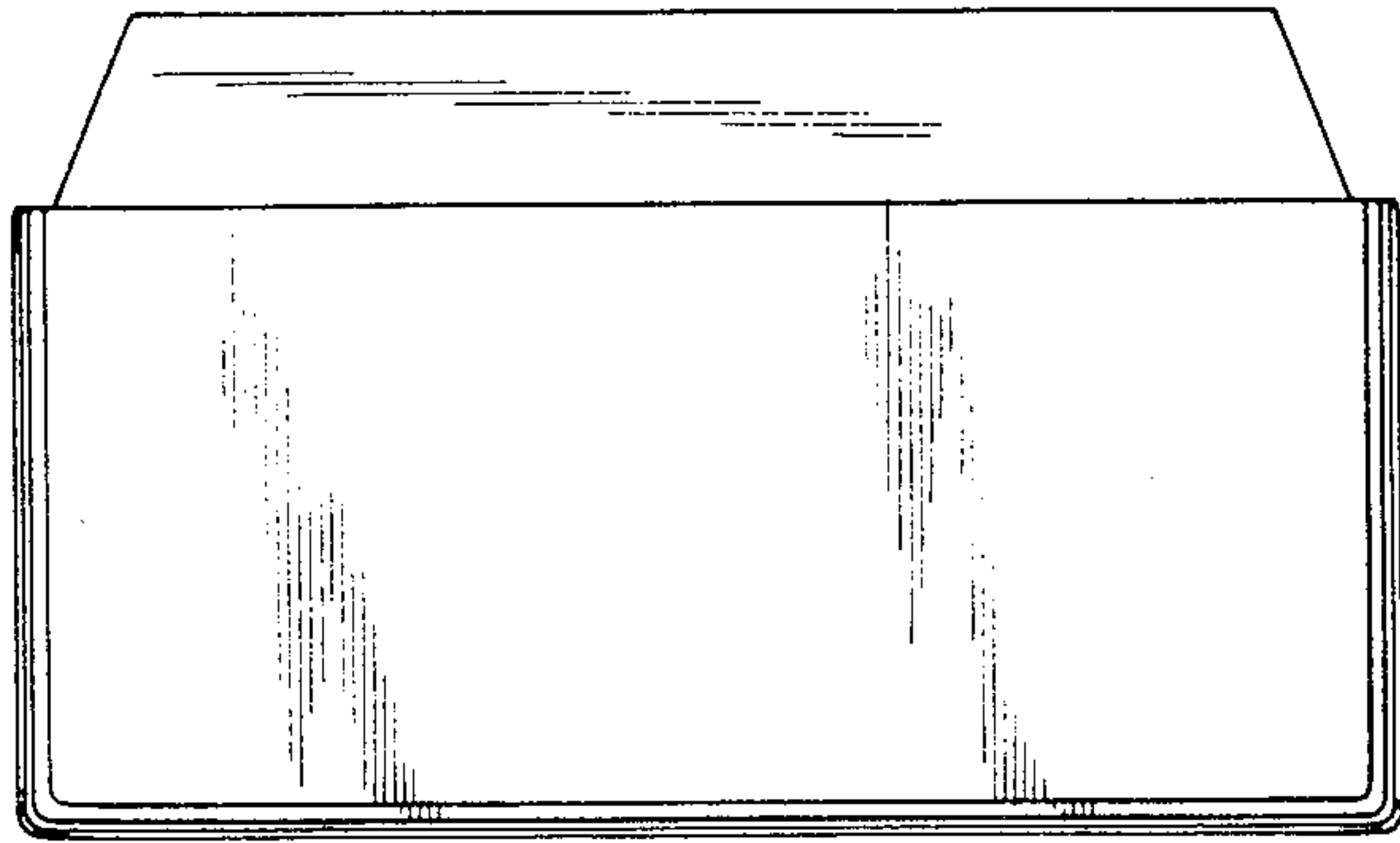

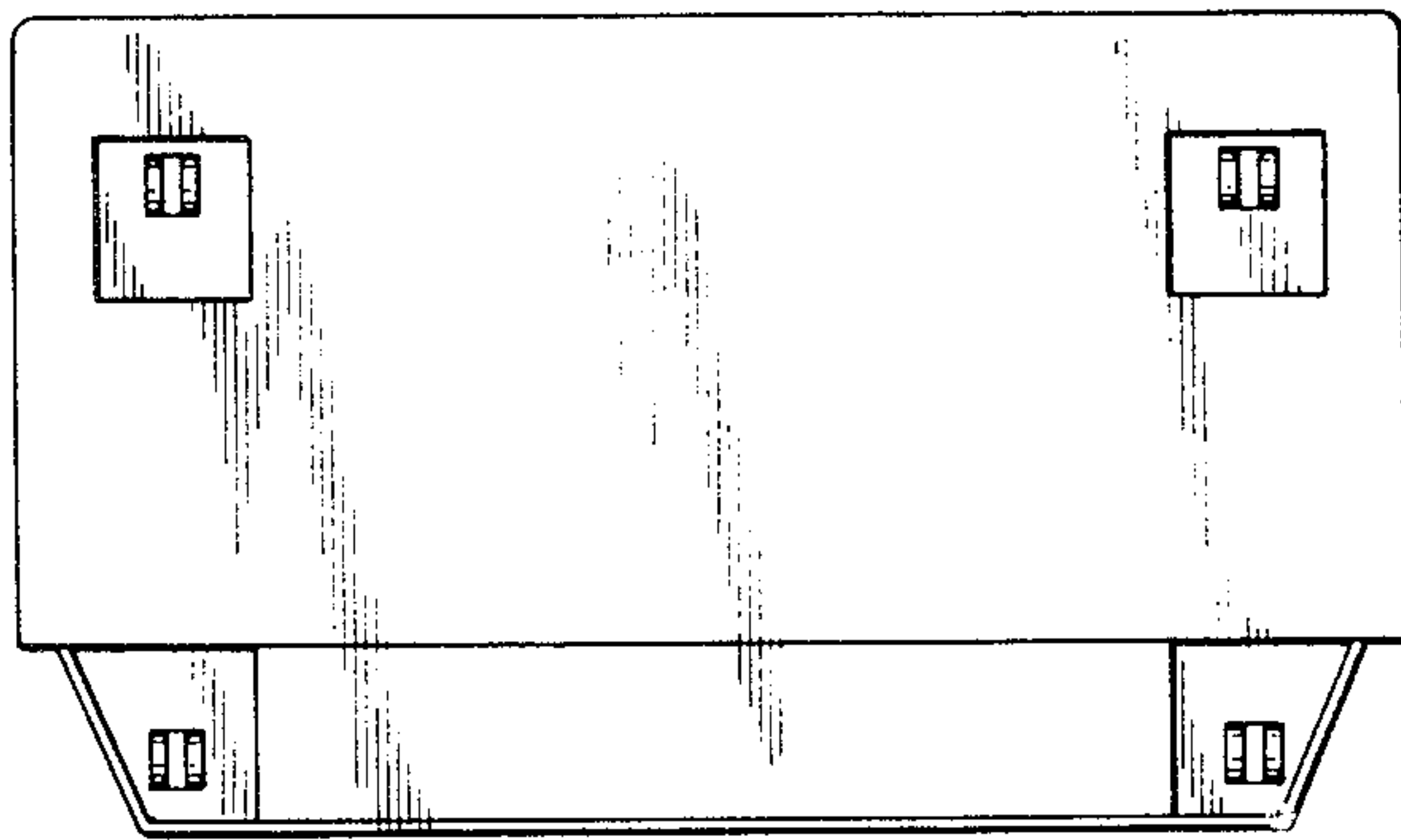

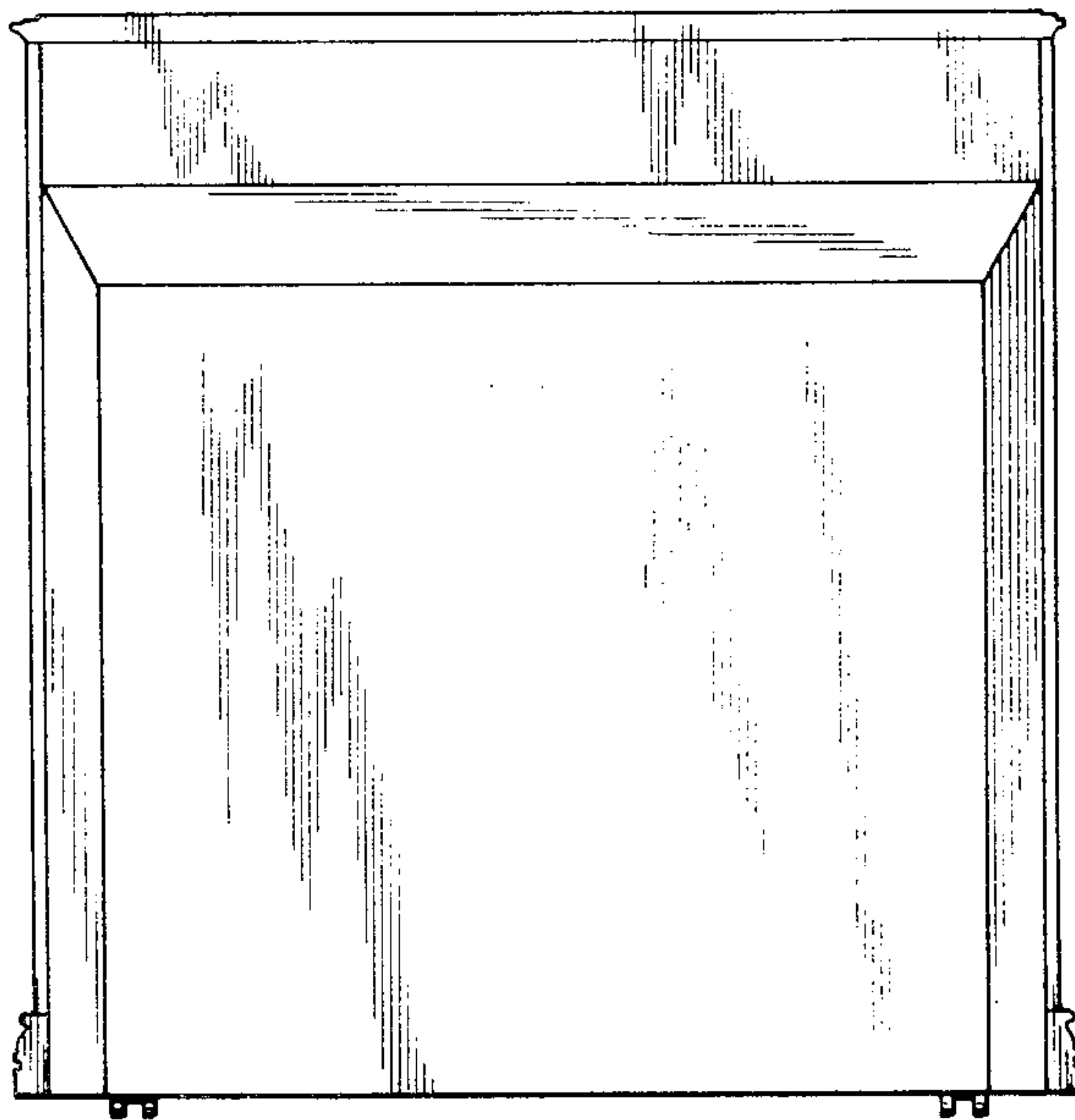
