The ornamental design for a cabinet-top lavatory, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a lavatory embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

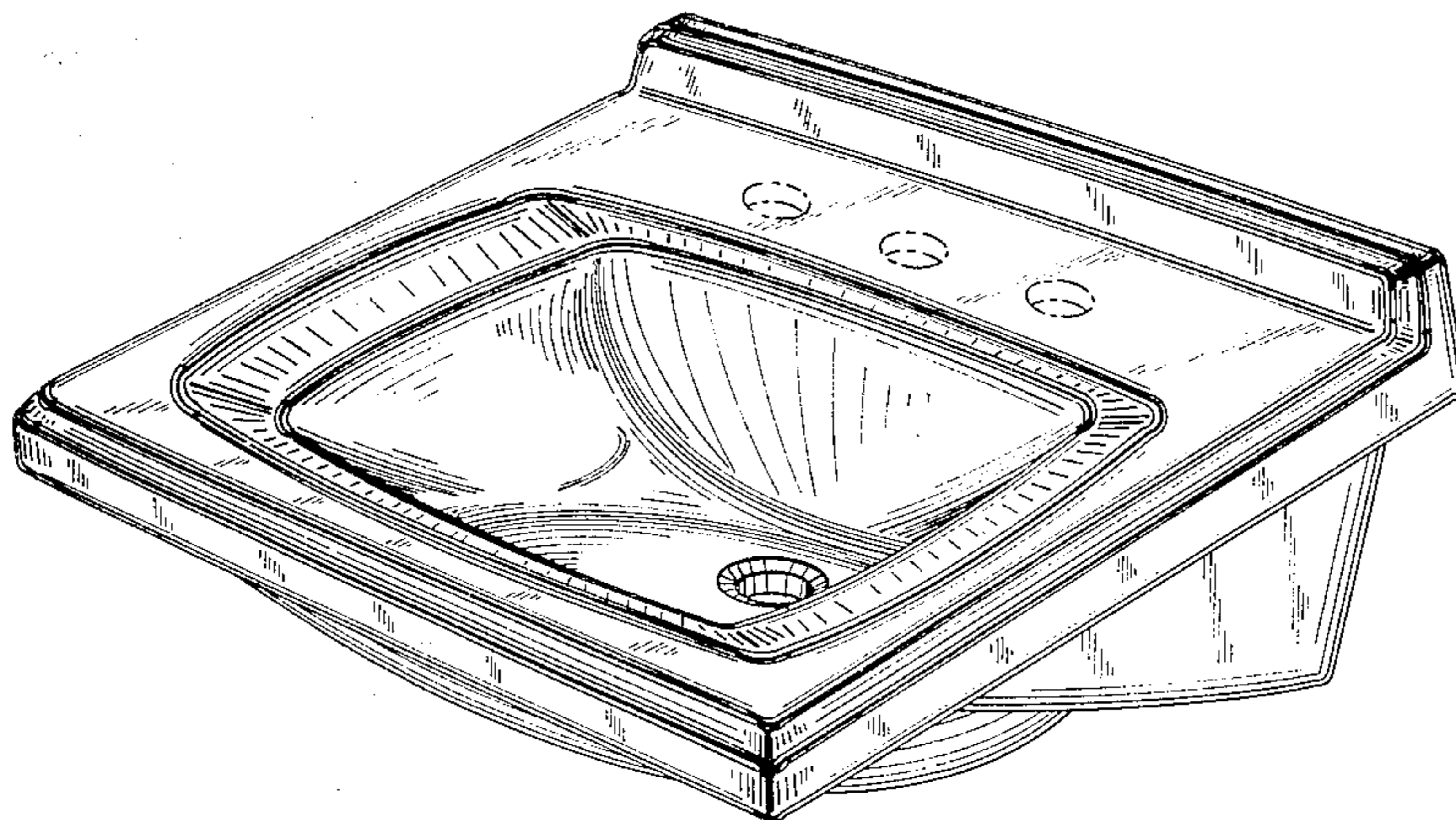
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

The broken line representation of openings in FIGS. 1, 2 and 6 are for purposes of illustration only.



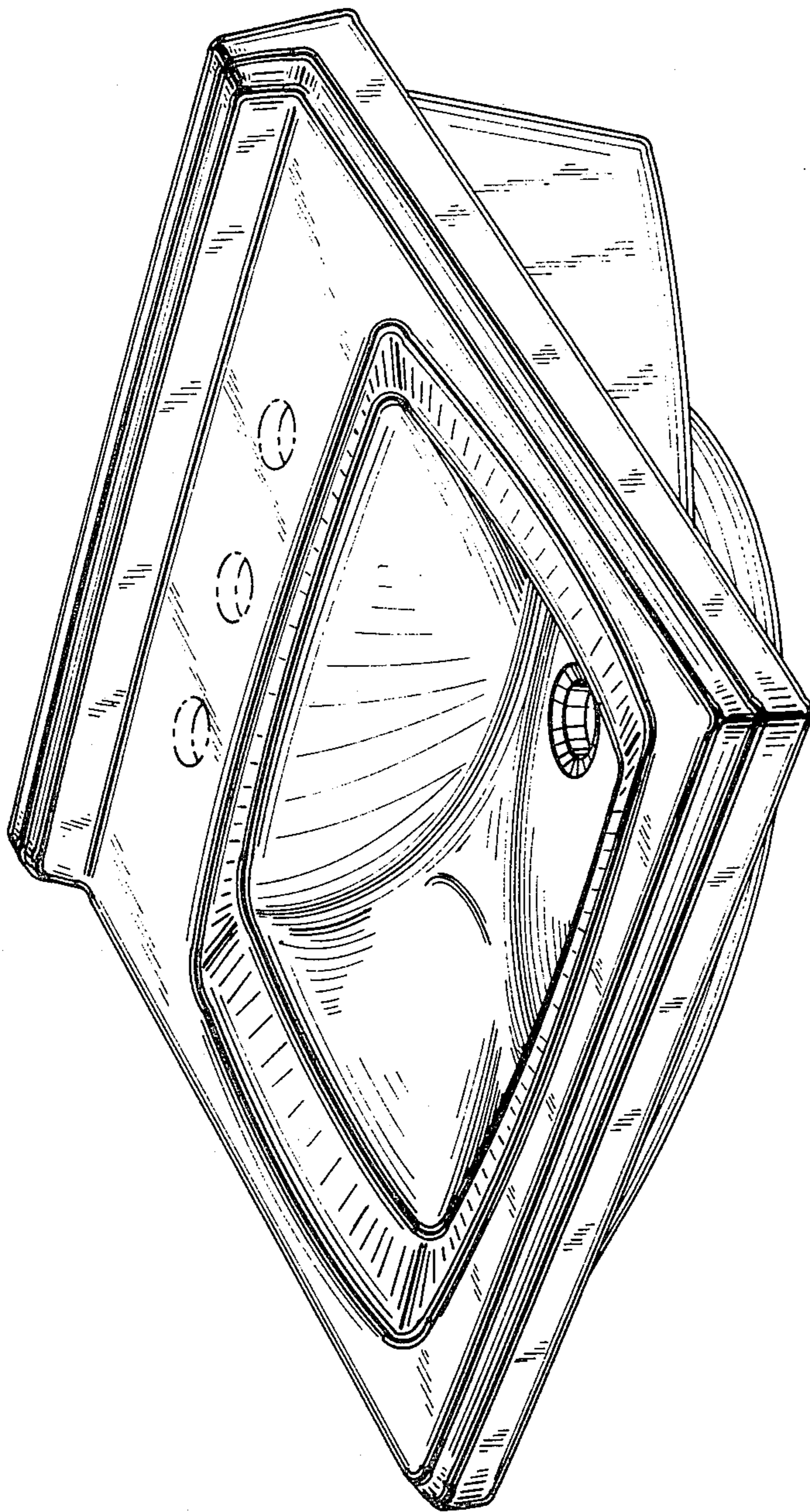

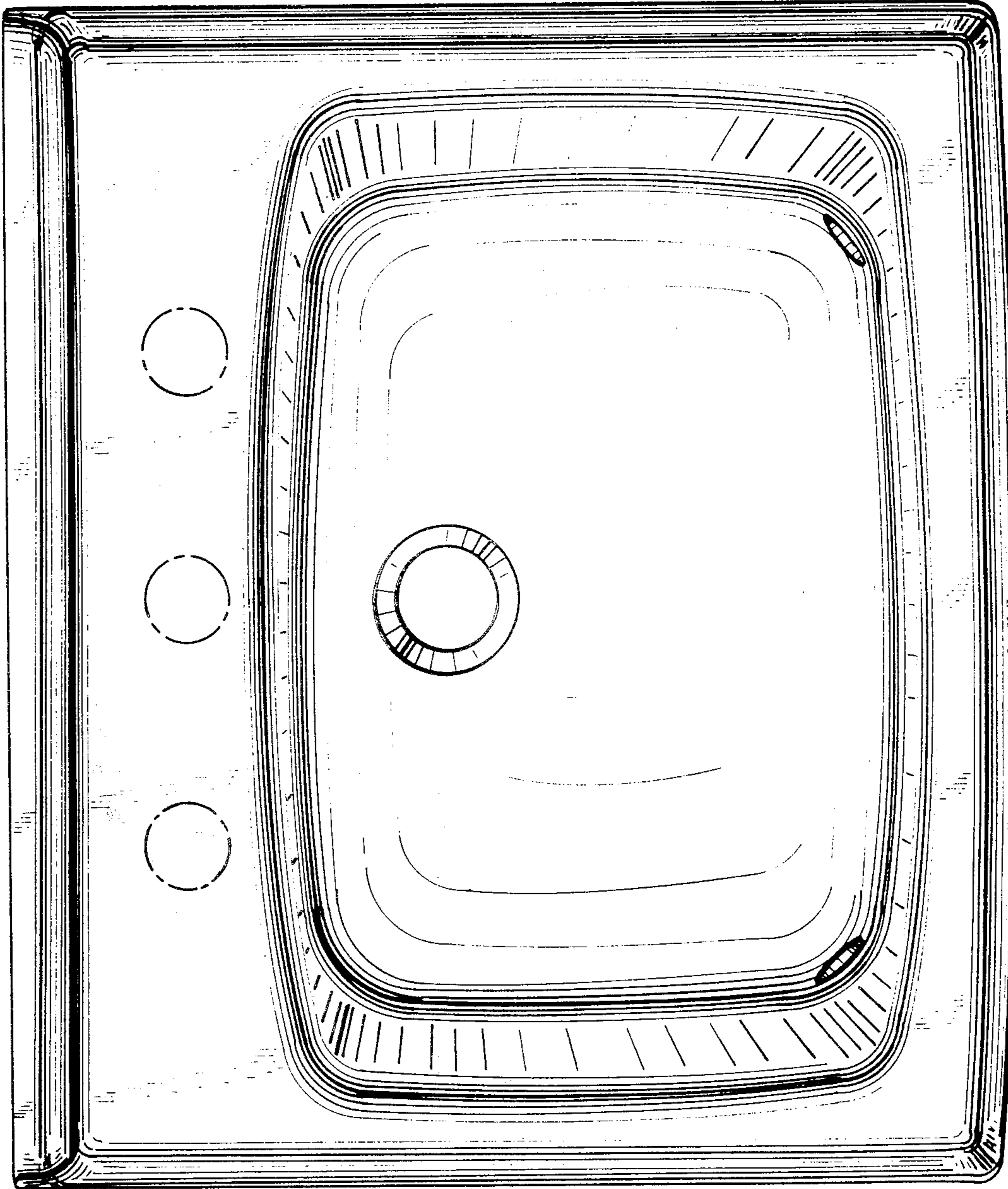

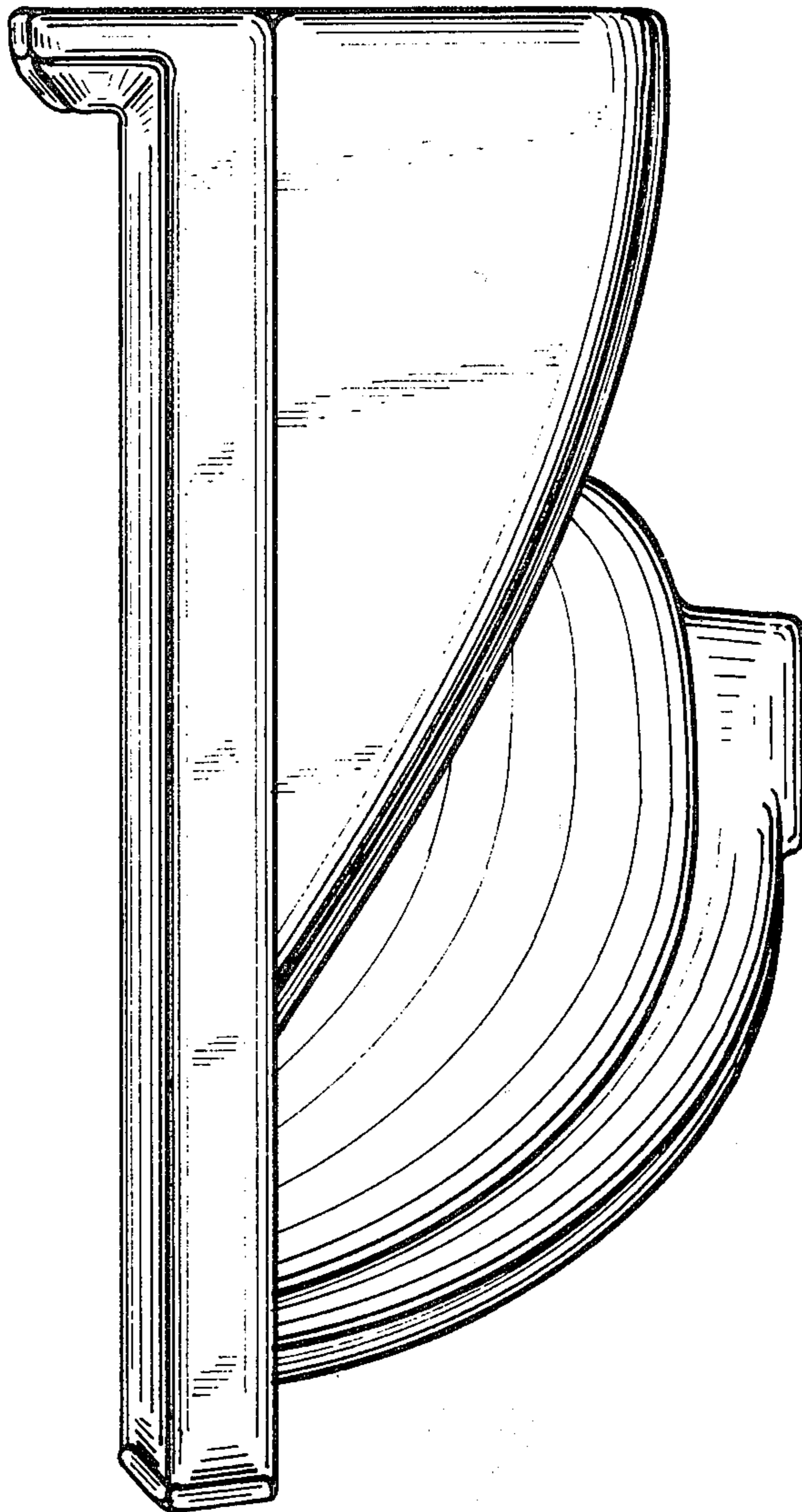

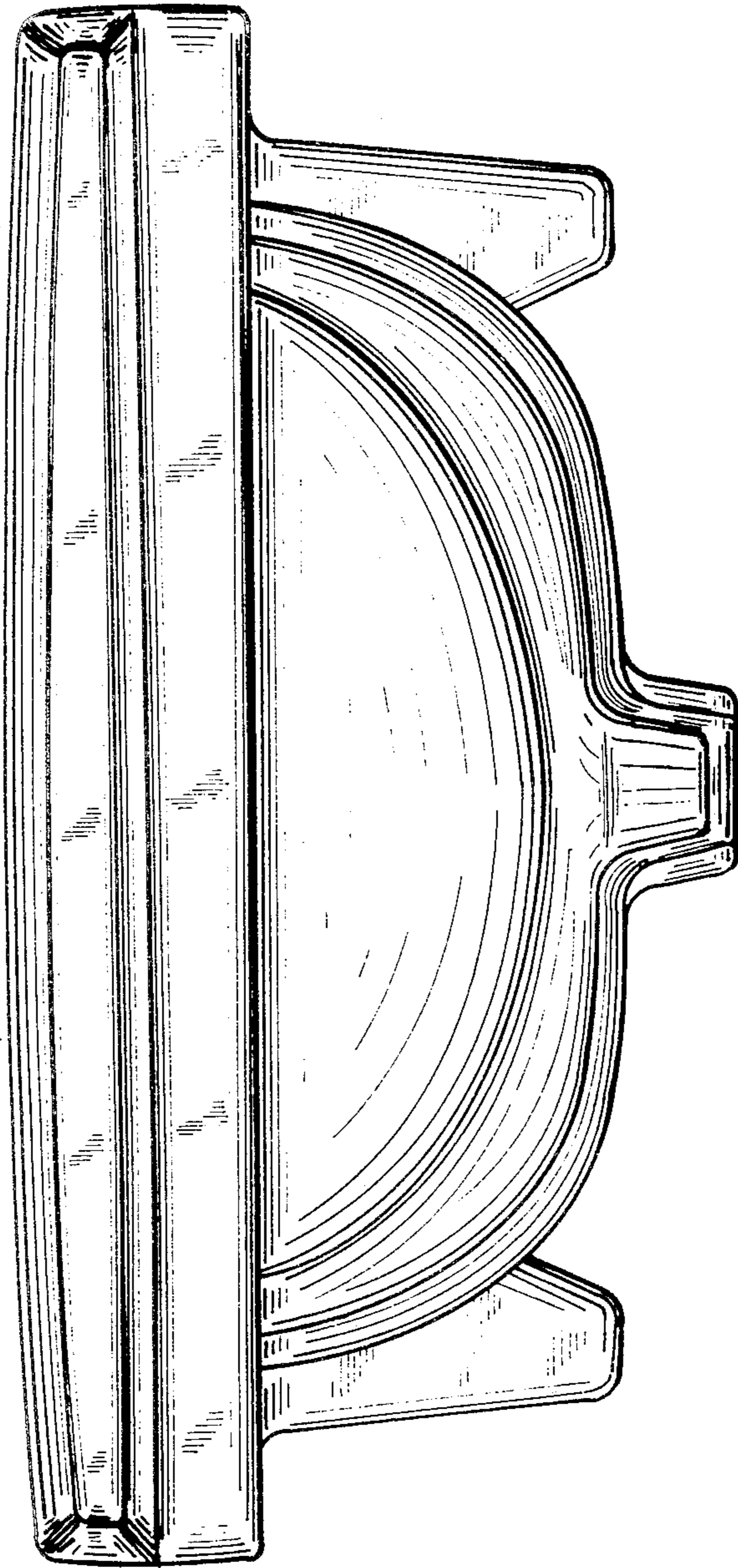

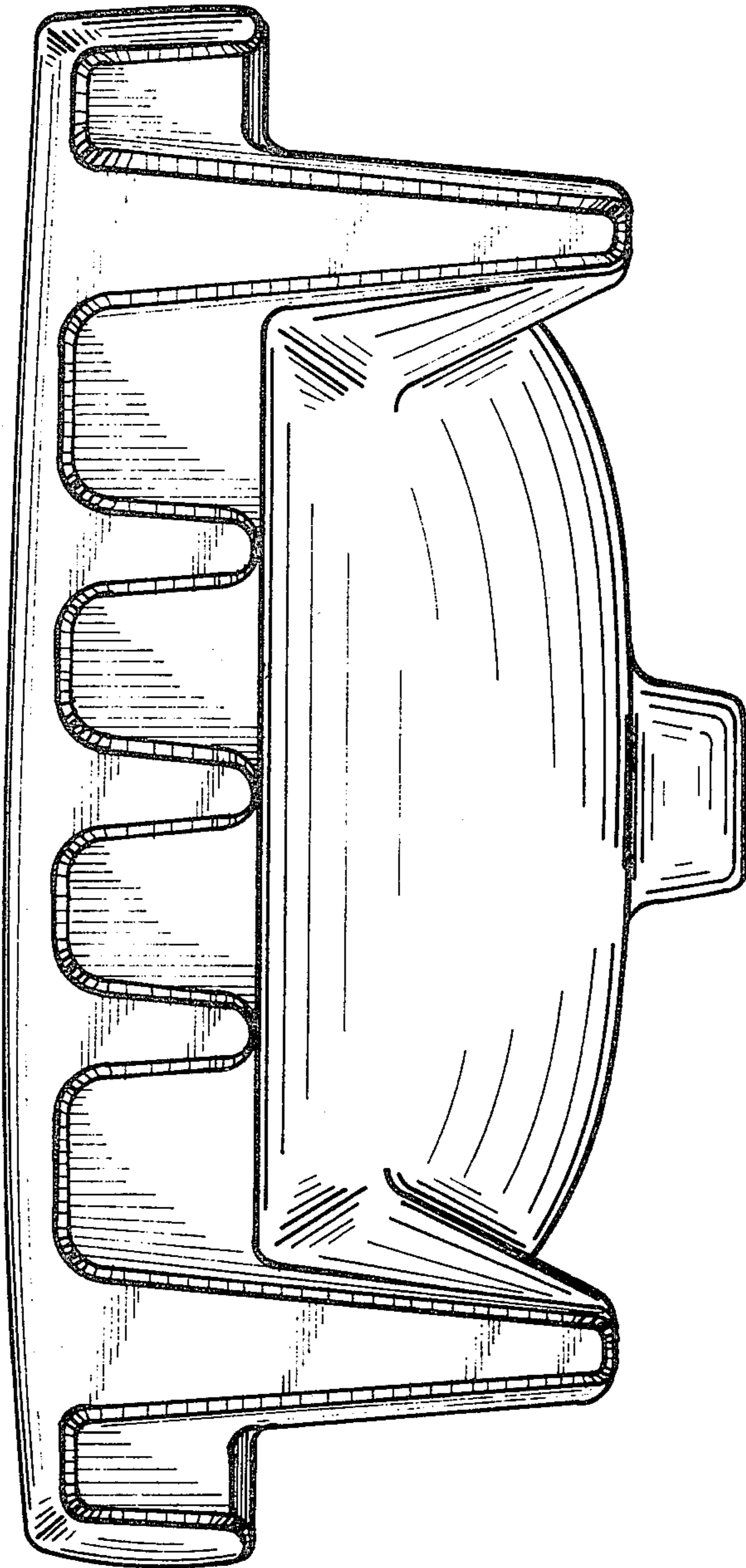
